READING WITH THE RAYS—Earlier this week, the Rays and Suncoast Credit Union launched the 13th season of Reading with the Rays, an incentive-based reading program that encourages Pre-K to 12th grade students to read for 24 hours to avoid summer learning loss...typically a summer-based program, this year's program launched early for kids at home participating in distance learning due to the COVID-19 crisis.

- + Rather than visiting participating libraries, parents and kids will download a digital game card at raysbaseball.com/reading to begin reading around the bases...once complete, participants will submit their game card via email to reading@raysbaseball.com to receive special Rays prizes, including two tickets to a future home game.
- + Since 2007, over 300,000 children across nine area counties have spent more than 2.5 million hours of their summers reading.

GAMING FOR GOOD—Blake Snell won the inaugural MLB The Show Players League with a 3-game sweep in the championship series against CWS Lucas Giolito...Snell won 5-1 in Game 1, 3-2 in Game 2 and 6-0 in Game 3...in the best-of-three quarterfinals and semifinals, he defeated LAD Gavin Lux (2-0) and NYM Jeff McNeil (2-1), respectively...the Rays congratulated Snell on Twitter by raising a virtual banner in his honor.

+ Snell's win resulted in a \$30,000 donation to the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Suncoast by MLB, the MLBPA and Sony Interactive Entertainment...with this donation the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Suncoast is planning to expand their feeding program, which provides hot meals at dinner throughout their six Pinellas county locations...each contestant had \$5,000 donated to his local affiliate initially, and the winning player got an extra \$25,000 donated.

COMFORTS OF HOME—FOX Sports Sun continues to air Rays Classics on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and 2019 Rewinds on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays...tonight at 7 p.m. and midnight, FOX Sports Sun will re-air the 13-4 win from Game 4 of the 2008 ALCS at BOS, when the Rays took a 3-1 series lead over the Red Sox...the 13 runs scored in that game remain a Rays postseason record...on Monday and Wednesday at noon, 7 p.m. and midnight, FOX Sports Sun will re-air Game 7 of the 2008

ALCS vs. BOS and Game 2 of the 2008 World Series vs. PHI, respectively.

- + On Sunday, Tuesday and Thursday at noon and midnight, FSS will air the wins from June 9 at BOS, June 10 vs. OAK and June 14 vs. LAA.

FOR THE MOMS—The Rays are 10-12 all-time on Mother's Day including losses in 2018 and 2019...last season they played the Yankees on Mother's Day for the first time and lost, 7-1, in a game delayed 43 minutes in the 9th inning (power)...in 2015, Manager **Kevin Cash** was ejected from a 2-1 loss against the Rangers at home with his mother, **Patsy**, in the stands...the Rays were on the wrong end of **Dallas Braden**'s perfect game on Mother's Day 2010 in Oakland (see the "This Week in Rays History" note below).
