Moved to 4-2 in rubber matches...Improved to an MLB-best 24-0 when outhitting their opponents; entering today, the Twins are the only remaining undefeated team when recording more hits than their opponent (17-0), according to the Elias Sports Bureau.

Corbin Burnes earned the win after allowing one run on seven hits and one walk with a season-high-tying 11 strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

WHAT'S TRENDING: At 29-15 (.659), the Orioles have the second-best record in the AL and third-best in MLB behind the Yankees (.688, 33-15) and Phillies (.708, 34-14)...Since the start of 2022, Baltimore is 213-155 (.579), the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.585, 217-154), Braves (.631, 231-135), and Dodgers (.651, 243-130).

LEADING ACTORS: Baltimore leads MLB with six leadoff homers this season...**Gunnar Henderson** has hit five of those, the most in MLB...**Jordan Westburg** has the other for the 0's...Since the start of 2021, the Orioles have 23 leadoff blasts, ranked fourth in the AL and tied for eighth in MLB.

Henderson's five leadoff home runs are tied for the fourth-most in a single season in 0's history with **Cedric Mullins** (2022), **Seth Smith** (2017), **Adam Jones** (2016), and **Don Buford** (1971); he trails **Brady Anderson** (7 in 1999 & 2000), Mullins (8 in 2021), and Anderson (12 in 1996).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are tied with the Yankees for the MLB lead with 68 home runs, the second-most homers through the first 44 games of a season in 0's history behind 1987 (69)

The most through Baltimore's first 45 games of a season is 70 in 1987.

The Orioles have an MLB-best eight players with at least six homers: Gunnar Henderson (15), Adley Rutschman (9), Anthony Santander and Jordan Westburg (7), and Colton Cowser, Ryan Mountcastle, Cedric Mullins, and Ryan O'Hearn (6); the Yankees rank second with five players with at least six long balls

THE ERAS TOUR: The 0's have an MLB-best 2.28 ERA (40 ER/158.0 IP) in their last 17 games since April 29...During that time, the Birds have surrendered an MLB-low 108 hits while holding opponents to a .193 batting average (108-for-560).

LEFTY LOOSEY: Facing left-handed pitching this season, Orioles batters have an MLB-best 24 home runs, .511 slugging, .854 OPS, and 245 total bases...They also lead the AL in hits (136), average (.284), on-base percentage (.342), doubles (29), triples (4), and RBI (78)...Three Orioles rank in the top 10 in MLB in OPS against left-handed pitching: **Adley Rutschman** (4th, 1.170), **Gunnar Henderson** (9th, 1.056), and **Anthony Santander** (10th, 1.049).

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson is tied with Houston's Kyle Tucker for the MLB lead with 15 home runs...He also ranks among AL leaders in total bases (T-1st, 104), slugging percentage (2nd, .598), runs scored (3rd, 34), triples (T-3rd, 4), extra-base hits (4th, 23), OPS (5th, .946), and RBI (T-10th, 31)...According to MLB's Sarah Langs (@SlangsOnSports), he is the sixth player in MLB history age 22-or-younger to hit at least 15 homers in his team's first 44 games of a season, joining San Diego's Fernando Tatis, Jr. in 2020 (15), Washington's Bryce Harper in 2015 (16), Seattle's Alex Rodriguez in 1998 (16), Washington Senators' Harmon Killebrew in 1959 (17), and Milwaukee Braves' Eddie Matthews in 1953 (16).

BIG TIME RUTSCH: Adley Rutschman enters today ranked fourth in the AL batting average (.309), tied for fifth in hits (55), and tied for ninth in total bases (89)...He is tied for second in the AL and third in MLB in multi-hit games (18).

WRAPPING UP THE HOMESTAND: The Orioles wrapped up their season-long eight-game homestand with a 5-3 record against the Diamondbacks (2-1), Blue Jays (1-1), and Mariners (2-1)...It was originally a nine-game homestand before Tuesday's game against the Jays was postponed due to inclement weather.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Orioles begin a seven-game road trip tonight with the first of three games in St. Louis...The O's will then play four games in Chicago against the White three games in St. L Sox from May 23-26.

- The Orioles are 12-5 (.706) on the road this season, one of two MLB teams with a road winning percentage of .700+ in 2024 (Phillies .714, 15-6).
 Baltimore's .439 slugging percentage on the road leads MLB.

BIRDS OF A FEATHER: The Orioles and Cardinals are meeting for their first and only series of the season this week...It is the first meeting between the squads since the 0's dropped two out of three in Baltimore from September 11-13, 2023...The last time the 0rioles traveled to St. Louis was from May 10-12, 2022, when they took two out of three at Busch Stadium... Entering this series, Baltimore and St. Louis have only squared off in the regular season 18 times in team history; the 18 regular-season games against the Cardinals are tied for Baltimore's fewest against a single active opponent with the Dodgers, who the Birds will travel to for three games later this season. travel to for three games later this season.

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles havegone 106 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept, which passes the 1903–05 New York Giants (105) for the third-longest such streak in MLB history...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Baltimore's current streak trails only the 1942–44 St. Louis Cardinals (124) and 1906–09 Chicago Cubs (115)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in 0's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971–72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13–15, 2022 at Detroit (0–3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27–29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0–3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 344 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing Hank Bauer (407), Paul Richards (517), Buck Showalter (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Earl Weaver (1,480).

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his ninth start of the season and the second of his career against the Cardinals...Made his fourth Opening Day roster...Went 13-5 with a 4.12 ERA (79 ER/172.2 IP), allowing 171 hits (27 HR) with 55 walks and 157 strikeouts across 32 starts in his 2023 campaign...The 0's went 24-8 in his starts and his careerhigh 13 wins were tied for sixth in the American League...Acquired by the Orioles along with INF Breyvic Valera, 0F Yusniel Diaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Rylan Bannon in exchange for INF Manny Machado on July 18, 2018...Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV.
