RAYS REPORT—The Rays continue a four-game road trip against the Astros (1-0, three to play) tonight in Houston...are 8-1 in their last nine games, 10-4 in their last 14, 13-6 in their last 19, 15-9 in their last 24 and 20-13 in their last 33...have won a season-high three straight, five of six and eight of their last 11 series...are 11-5 on a stretch of 19 games in 20 days [May 13–June 1) and 8-2 over a span in which 15 of 19 games will take place at home (May 19–June 8)...following the latter stretch, 59 of their remaining 97 games (60.8%) will be on the road...are multiple games above 500 for the first time since entering play on April 2)...it would also match their high-water mark from the last two seasons (3x in 2024, last: 57–54 entering play on Aug. 6)...are second in the AL East, 6.5 GB the first-place Yankees (35-20)...have spent two days in first, nine in second, 18 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

* The Rays took last night's series opener, 13-3, after plating five runs in back-to-back innings in the 7th and 8th...it was their third win this season by 10 runs or more, tied for third most in the majors behind the Cubs (5G) and Yankees (4G).

* They have outscored opponents, 57-17 (+40), during their 8-1 stretch, their best run differential over any nine-game span since April 5-14, 2023 (+42)...it increased their season-long run differential from -10 to +30 (239-209), third in the AL behind the Yankees (+113) and Tigers (+84).

* The Rays have not trailed in six of their last seven games...they faced a deficit at some point in 38 of their first 49 games.

* Tampa Bay has scored 40 runs in its last five games, batting .318/389/511 [56-for-176)...the club has pushed across 89 runs over its last 16 contests (5.6 R/G) after averaging 3.8 runs in its first 40 (150R).

* The Rays have scored first in six of seven, eight of 12 and 12 of their last 17 games (12 of first 390.)...they are 18-6 when scoring first, including six straight wins.

* Rayan Pepiot carries an 11.0 scoreless inning streak into t

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Earlier today, the Rays reinstated **OF Jake Mangum** (left groin strain) from the 10-day IL and optioned **OF Chandler Simpson** to Triple-A Durham.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS—The Rays will be opposed by a left-handed starting pitcher for the 17th time tonight, winning three of their last four such games on the heels of a 2-7 stretch from April 16-May 8. see below for a comparison of the club's performance vs. lefties to begin the season vs. their performance over the last three weeks (May 8-pres.):

ALL-AROUND EFFORT—In yesterday's 13-3 win, all nine Rays starters tallied a hit for the third time this season, all of which have come in the last five games (also: May 26 vs. MIN & May 25 vs. TOR)...the three games are tied with five other clubs (ATL, CHC, HOU, KC, NYM) for second most in the majors all season behind the Yankees (4G)...they had four such efforts all of last season and six during their 99-win campaign in 2023...the Rays scored five runs in the 7th and 8th innings last night, marking their 15th time recording multiple five-run (or more) innings in the same game and sixth time turning the trick in consecutive innings (last: May 30, 2019 vs. MIN - 3rd/4th)...it was their third time doing so on the road, joining July 14, 2018 at MIN (7th/8th/9th) and May 22, 2009 at FLA (2nd/3rd)...before last night's win, the Rays had three total innings with five runs or more in their first 55 games of the season and only one on the road (May 13 at TOR - 5R in 9th inn.).

Four different Rays have collected 30 RBI or more (Aranda/Caminero/Diaz/B. Lowe), tied for third most in MLB behind the D-backs and Dodgers (both 5)...it took 92 games for four Rays to reach that mark last season (Arozarena/Diaz/Paredes/Siri). Jonathan Aranda is 9-for-18 (500) over a five-game hitting streak...he has multiple hits and an RBI in four straight games—the last player in MLB with a longer streak was SD Manny Machado (50f) from Aug. 9-14, 2022.. the four-game streak falls one game shy of the longest run in club history (5G), shared by four players: Kevin Kiermaier (May 17-24, 2022), Wil Myers (July 19-26, 2013), Dave Martinez (April 13-22, 2000) and Bobby Smith (Aug. 13-17, 1978).

The Rays are 10-4 since Josh Lowe returned from the injured list on May 15...Lowe has a hit in six of his last seven games, going 9-for-27 (333) with 22B, 1HR and 4 BB. Curtis Mead is batting 391 (9-for-23) with 1 2B, 3 HR and 4 RBI during a career-high eight-game hitting streak.

KID CAMI—Junior Caminero tallied a career-high 6 RBI last night, most by a Ray since Jonathan Aranda (6RBI) on Oct. 1, 2023 at TOR and the most in franchise history by any player before turning 22...at 21 years, 328 days, he became the youngest player in the majors with a 6-RBI game since NYM Francisco Alvarez (21.315) on Sept. 30, 2023 (G2) vs. PHI... since 1982, only two AL hitters have recorded 6-RBI games at a younger age than Caminero: KC Billy Butler (July 3, 2007 vs. SEA - 21.076) and SEA Alex Rodriguez (Nay 17, 1996 at BAL - 20.295). Caminero has 57 career RBI, tied with Will Myers for third most through a Rays hitter's first 102 career games, trailing Evan Longoria (69) and Brandon Lowe (68).

**Caminero has homered in back-to-back games for the third time in his career, first since a three-game streak earlier this season (April 12-14)...he has recorded an extrabase hit in six of his last seven games, batting .414 (12-for-29) with 5 2B, 3 HR, 12 RBI and an .897 slugging pct....the 8 XBH lead the majors in that span (since May 23).

DAWG POUND—Brandon Lowe's 12-game hitting streak matches the longest of his career, joining April 22-May 8, 2019, and is the fourth-longest active streak in the majors...during the streak, Lowe is 16-for-43 (.372) with 3 2B, 4 HR, 6 RBI, 4 BB and 6 SO...he has recorded a hit in 15 of his last 16 games overall, slashing .383/439/,750 (23-for-60) with 10 XBH and 12 RBI...over that stretch (since May 13), he leads MLB in OPS (1.189), slugging pct., runs (T1st, 16) and total bases (45) while tying for second in hits and tying for third in homers (6).

PITCH PERFECT — Rays pitchers have allowed 3 ER or fewer in seven straight games, their longest streak since Sept. 15-24, 2024 (8G)...the staff has a 1.43 ERA (63.0IP 10ER) over that stretch, its lowest over any seven-game span since June 3 (G2)-9, 2023 (1.43)... Tampa Bay has the most efficient pitching staff in the majors, averaging the fewest pitches per inning at 15.5, which would surpass 2022 (15.8) for the fewest in team history and mark the lowest figure in MLB since the 2015 Mets (15.4)... they have thrown 130 pitches or fewer in a club-record six straight games (127.123, 103, 126, 124, 130).

* The rotation has a 1.44 ERA (43.2IP, 7ER) and 0.89 WHIP across their last seven starts, yielding one or zero runs in five of those outings.

* The bullpen has thrown 7.1 straight scoreless frames and has a 1.57 ERA (34.1IP, 6ER) in the last 12 games since May 17, second in MLB behind the Cubs (1.13).

MEN OF STEAL—After a five-steal effort last night, the Rays have swiped multiple stolen bases in 10 of their last 14 games, going 33-for-36 (91.7%)...their 81 SB on the season lead MLB and are second most through their first 56 games of a season in club history, trailing 2009 (90SB)...the 2025 and 2009 Rays are two of four major league clubs since 1976 with 80 SB or more through 56 games, joining the 2024 Nationals (93SB) and 2024 Reds (85SB).

ASTROWORLD—Paired with a three-game set at Steinbrenner Field from May 19-21 (2-1 TB), the Rays and Astros will complete a seven-game season series over 14 days from May 19–June 1...winners of three straight games against Houston for the first time since March 29-31, 2019 the Rays are looking for their first four-game winning streak vs. the Astros since June 21, 2014–Aug. 17, 2015 (6G)...a win tonight would also secure their first season series win over Houston since 2019 (4-3) after going 0-3-1 in the last four years (clubs did not meet in 2020)...the Rays are seeking their third straight series win at Daikin Park, going 5-2 in this venue since the start of 2023.

TONIGHT'S START—Ryan Pepiot (PEP-ee-oh) gets the ball for his team-leading 12th start of the season and fourth on the road in tonight's contest...marks his 55th career appearance (48th start) and 23rd on the road (20th start)...is his second career start vs. the Astros...has thrown four straight quality starts...is seeking his first road win since April 26 at SD...acquired from the Dodgers along with OF Jonny DeLuca for RHP Tyler Glasnow, OF Manuel Margot and cash considerations, Dec. 16, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT—Earned his first win since April 26 at SD after recording a career-high fourth straight quality start in a 13-0 victory over the Blue Jays on May 25 at Steinbrenner Field (W, 7.0IP, 3H, BB, 5SO)...yielded singles in the 1st and 2nd innings before retiring eight of his next nine (1BB in 4th) batters faced...allowed one more single in the 5th inning before putting away his last seven hitters...matched a career high with 7.0 IP (also: Sept. 7, 2023 at MIA)...that game with the Dodgers was also the only other start of his career in which he went 7.0 IP or more, allowed three hits or fewer and walked one or zero batters (W, 7.0IP, 1H, 3SO)... received a career high 13 runs of support.

This was the second start of 7.0 or more shutout innings by a Ray this season (also: Shane Baz on April 25 at SD).

He worked 6.0 IP (or more) for the fourth straight start, matching a career high (4G, Sept. 7-26 [G1] with LAD).

DEEP IN THE HEART OF TEXAS—Pepiot made his first and only career start against the Astros on May 19 at Steinbrenner Field, taking a nodecision despite registering a quality start (6.0IP, 8H, 3ER, BB, 2SO, HR)... he is 3-2 with a 3.94 ERA (45.2IP, 20ER) over eight career starts opposite AL West opponents, yielding three runs or fewer in seven of the eight starts...has struck out five or more batters in six of the eight and allowed four hits or fewer in five of them...has limited opponents from the division to a .212 (35-for-165) opp. average and thrown four quality starts.

QUALITY IN QUANTITY—Pepiot has recorded four straight quality starts, the longest streak of his career and the longest by a Rays pitcher in 2025...joins Taj Bradley (4QS from July 6-25, 2024) as the only Rays pitchers to record four straight quality starts since the beginning of last season...six of his last seven starts have been quality, and he has gone 6.0 IP or more in seven of his last eight outings...Pepiot's seven quality starts on the year are tied with Bradley and Zack Littell for the club lead.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN—Pepiot is 7-7 with a 3.04 ERA (106.2IP, 36ER) and 106 SO in 22 career road games (19GS)...has allowed 3 ER or fewer in 21 of the 22 outings and in each of his last 11 (3.46 ERA/52.0IP, 20ER) dating back to June 21, 2024 at PIT...is 5-6 on the road in that span, but has received multiple runs of support only four times...opponents have hit just .210 (83-for-396) against him in his career when he is pitching away from home.

REVERSE, REVERSE—He has limited lefties to a .188 (19-for-101) average, including a 6-for-42 (.143) clip over five starts in May...it is the fifth-lowest mark among AL right-handed pitchers (min. 100BF), trailing TEX Tyler Mahle (.158), CLE Gavin Williams (.170), CWS Shane Smith (.176) and HOU Hunter Brown (.177)...Pepiot's .143 opp. average vs. lefties in May is the lowest among AL pitchers (min. 40 BF) during the month...lefties are 10-for-46 (.217) with 19 SO in at-bats ending with Pepiot's four-seam fastball and 5-for-37 (.135) with 7 SO against his slider.

* Meanwhile, right-handed hitters are batting .292 (40-for-137) against Pepiot, going 18-for-63 (.286) across his five starts in May... they are hitting .347 (17-for-49) against his four-seamer and .333 (14-for-42) against his slider.

STILL IN NEED OF SUPPORT—Pepiot has seen three runs of support or fewer in nine of 11 starts, two or fewer in seven starts and one or zero in five starts...Tampa Bay is averaging 4.0 runs in 11 games (44 total runs) started by Pepiot and 4.4 runs in its other 45 games (198 total runs)...he has received two runs of support or fewer in 25 of his 37 career starts with the Rays.

**Despite allowing three earned runs or fewer in any of his last seven that support or fewer in give of support or fewer in give of

starts, Pepiot has received three runs of support or fewer in six of those seven outings...the Rays are 2-5 in those starts...Pepiot is 9-0 with a 2.24 ERA (60.1IP, 15ER) in 11 career starts when he receives four or more runs of support (his teams are 11-0 in those starts) and 15-8 with a 2.72 ERA (205.0IP, 62ER) when he limits opponents to three runs or fewer (his teams are 23-17 in those starts).

AMBUSHED—Opponents are 12-for-37 (.324) against Pepiot when putting the first pitch in play, including 6-for-15 (.400) off his four-seam fastball...they are batting .348 (24-for-69) when putting one of his first two offerings in play compared to .207 (35-for-169) in at-bats of three pitches or more pitches or more.

TOP HEAVY—The first three spots in opposing lineups are batting .352/.388/.659 (32-for-91) with 6 HR against Pepiot, but 4-9 hitters have produced a .184/.253/.320 (27-for-147) line with 4 HR...this includes a .077 (2-for-26) average against cleanup hitters, the second-lowest mark among qualified AL pitchers (fifth in MLB) behind SEA **Logan Evans** (1-for-17/.059).

A MODEL OF CONSISTENCY—Pepiot yielded 3 ER or fewer in 17 consecutive starts from June 21, 2024 at PIT-April 9, 2025 vs. LAA, the fourth-longest streak in team history behind runs by Shane McClanahan (23GS, 2021-22), Drew Rasmussen (19GS, 2021-22) and Tyler Glasnow (18GS, 2018-20)...since the streak began, he has permitted 3 ER or fewer in 22 of his 24 starts.

LEADING OFF—Pepiot became the 17th Opening Day starter in franchise history and third in the last three years along with **Zach Eflin** (2024) and **Shane McClanahan** (2023)...he was announced as the club's Opening Day starter on March 23 in place of McClanahan, who was scheduled for his third career Opening Day start before suffering a nerve-related issue in his left triceps during his spring training start on March 22 vs. BOS...he was the seventh pitcher in the last eight years to start on Opening Day for the Rays (2018-25) on the heels of **Chris Archer's** four consecutive starts from 2015-18...it marked the fifth straight year and 25th time in 28 seasons a pitcher below age 30 has started for the Rays on Opening Day... the exceptions: **Charlie Morton** (36) in 2020, **James Shields** (30) in 2012 and **Tanyon Sturtze** (31) in 2002.
