TODAY'S GAME: The Giants can sweep the Mets with a victory in this afternoon's series finale following last night's 5-1 win.

- ▶ The last time SF swept the Mets here at Oracle Park in a three-game series was just under 10 years ago from June 6-8, 2014...the winning pitchers in that series for the Giants were **LHP Jeremy Affeldt** (two wins in relief) and **RHP Tim Lincecum**.
- ▶ The win moved the Giants to 4-2 on their current 10-game homestand after going 2-2 vs. Arizona over the weekend.
- ▶ SF has now won consecutive games for a third time this season (also March 29-30 and April 17-18) and can win three straight for a first time this season with a win today.
- ▶ A win today would also move the Giants back to .500 for the first time since the fourth day of the season (March 31) after a loss to the Dodgers dropped them to 2-2.
- ▶ The Giants have won four of their first five day games at home this year (Sunday's loss to Arizona is the lone loss).

ROSTER MOVES: LHP **Blake Snell** was placed on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to April 23) with a left adductor strain.

- ▶ **RHP Landen Roupp** (#65) was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento to take Snell's spot on the roster.

I GOT FIVE ON IT: With last night's victory, SF clinched this series versus the Mets and by doing so the Giants have now won or tied their last five series vs. the Mets at home dating to 2019...the stretch is SF's longest such streak in the matchup since they won or tied their first six series here at Oracle Park between 2000 and 2005 (*Stats, LLC*).

WEBBMASTER: RHP **Logan Webb** spun 8.0 innings of shutout ball in last night's victory to run his scoreless innings streak to 19.0 innings dating to the fourth inning of his April 13 start at Tampa Bay.

- ▶ Webb's 19.0 inning scoreless streak is now the longest of his career, surpassing a 17.0-inning stretch from August 6-17, 2021.
- ▶ The streak is the longest by a Giants starter since **LHP Carlos Rodón** rattled off a 21.0-inning streak from June 7-22, 2022.
- ▶ Over his last four starts, Webb is 3-0 with a 0.93 ERA (3er, 29.0ip) with 16 strikeouts and just three walks...SF is 4-0 in those games.
- ▶ Webb's 8.0 innings last night helped him re-take the MLB lead in innings pitched entering play today (38.2ip), moving him just ahead of the Dodgers Tyler Glasnow (37.0ip).

I'M JUST THE OPENER: RHP **Ryan Walker** will open this afternoon's ballgame for the Giants with **LHP Blake Snell** hitting the Injured List.

- ▶ Walker excelled in this role last season, opening 13 games for SF and posting a 2.21 ERA in those games.
- ▶ He recorded more than three outs in seven of those 13 games and recorded eight outs twice as an opener (July 26 vs. Oakland and July 29 vs. Boston).
- ▶ This is the first time the Giants will use the opener strategy in 2024 after using it quite often last year in the middle of the season...in 2023, SF used an opener 35 times and went 18-17 in those games with a team ERA of 3.64 in those games.

WADE'S WORLD: IF/OF **LaMonte Wade Jr.** remains one of MLB's best on-base machines in 2024.

- ▶ Wade has reached base in 19 of 23 games where he's had an at-bat this season, and is slashing .357/.456/.482 with 10 runs, four doubles, a home run and seven RBI.
- ▶ His .357 batting average is tied for second in MLB (min. 60 PA) with HOU's Jose Altuve...they trail LAD's Shohei Ohtani (.364)... Wade's .456 OBP is second-best in the Majors behind LAD's Mookie Betts (.458).

GROUND CHUCK: Entering play today, Giants pitching has a 50.4% groundball rate, tied for second-best in the Majors with Atlanta behind the Philadelphia Phillies at 51.5%.

- ▶ SF's groundball rate is quite consistent with last year's 49.6% rate that led the Majors in 2023.
- ▶ After last night's outing, **RHP Logan Webb** boasts a 59.7% groundball rate good for fourth-best in the Majors...if you look at the top-10, you'll see a lot of Orange & Black.

NO HARD FEELINGS: OF **Michael Conforto** grabbed two more hits last night and is 4-for-8 with three runs scored, a homer and one RBI in this series so far against his former club.

- ▶ He was 1-for-10 with two runs scored and one RBI in three games against his old mates last season.

HE'S HEATING UP: OF **Mike Yastrzemski** went 2-for-3 with three RBI in last night's win...he's 6-for-his-last-15 with three runs scored, one homer and seven RBI over his last five games.

- ▶ The three-RBI game was his first since June 19 of last year when he had four RBI...that is a span of 70 games between his games with at least three RBI.

GET SOME REST: The Giants will enjoy an off day tomorrow before welcoming the Pittsburgh Pirates to Oracle Park for a three-game series to close out the homestand beginning Friday.

- ▶ SF has had some trouble with the Pirates here at home since 2019, dropping three of the four series played against them.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/23 vs. NYM; S, 0.2ip, k (5 pitches)

- ▶ Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), Doval has made seven appearances and gone 1-0-4 with three hits allowed, one run allowed, three walks, and 12 strikeouts (7.0ip).
- ▶ Nine of his 12 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/21 vs. ARI; 2.0ip, h (21 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL last Friday...made season debut Sunday, tossing 2.0 shutout innings...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Made five rehab appearances between San Jose (A) and Sacramento (AAA)...threw 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits with seven strikeouts.
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP John Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/20 vs. MOD (w/A San Jose); 1.0ip (8 pitches)

- ▶ Returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day IL on Monday...veteran reliever suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Was placed on the IL the next day...made two rehab appearances for Single-A San Jose totalling 2.0 innings last Thurs. and Sat.
- ▶ Appeared in 33 games for SF in 2023 and posted a 2.97 ERA with 43 strikeouts over 33.1 innings of work (11.61 SO/9).
- ▶ Made his Giants debut on May 31 after he missed the entire 2022 season recovering from TJ surgery.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/21 vs. ARI; L, 1.0ip, 2h, 2r, er, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last eight outings dating to April 3, Miller has allowed three runs (two earned) over 8.1 innings (2.16 ERA) with 13 strikeouts, one walk, a 0.48 WHIP and a .107 opposing batting average (3x28).
- ▶ LHBs are 2-for-15 off him early on...RHBs are 3-for-23.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances in Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

Last Game: 4/20 vs. ARI; 1.0ip (9 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in eight games for SF so far, allowing two runs over 6.1 innings of work with five strikeouts.
- ▶ Is 6-2 with a 2.80 ERA, 68 strikeouts and a 1.10 WHIP since April 18 of last season (62 games, 54.2 innings).
- ▶ Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with a 3.83 ERA and averaging 11.15 SO/9 (64k, 51.2ip).
- ▶ Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6).
- ▶ His .211 opposing average in 2023 was the second-lowest in his career (had a .206 opponent's average in 2018 with MIN).

#71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/23 vs. NYM; 0.1ip, 3h, r, er (14 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in 12 of SF's first 25 games.
- ▶ Opposing batters have gone 13-for-41 (.317) with a .333 BABIP off Rogers early here in 2024...last year hitters batted .236 with a .274 BABIP off him.
- ▶ Appeared in 68 games in 2023, his third consecutive season appearing in 68+ games.
- ▶ His 84.4 mph average exit velocity in 2023 was second-best in MLB.
- ▶ Rogers' 27.6% opposing hard hit rate was eighth-best in the Majors.
- ▶ Since his MLB debut on August 27, 2019, no pitcher in the Majors has appeared in more games than Tyler (274g).

#65 LANDEN ROUPE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Curveball, Changeup, Cutter

Last Game: 4/19 vs. ARI; 1.2ip, 4h, 4r, 3er, bb, k (39 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled today with **LHP Blake Snell** going on the IL after being optioned to Triple-A yesterday to make room for **RHP Mitch White**.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut on March 29...six of his eight outings have been scoreless.
- ▶ Is the Giants No. 11 prospect according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 14 according to *Baseball America*.
- ▶ Roupp struck out 42 batters over 31.0 innings (12.2 K/9ip) with Double-A Richmond in 2023 and held opponents to a .206 average.
- ▶ Did not pitch after June 30 last year after landing on IL w/back inflammation.

#74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Slider

Last Game: 4/22 vs. NYM; 1.0ip (6 pitches)

- ▶ Will open today's game...was used as an opener 13 times last season and posted a 2.21 ERA in the role.
- ▶ His 13 appearances are tied for most in the Majors.
- ▶ 10 of Walker's 13 appearances have been scoreless.
- ▶ Has stranded four of his six inherited runners so far in 2024.
- ▶ His 26.4% opposing hard hit rate in 2023 was fifth-best in MLB...so far in 2024 opponents have a 25.0% hard-hit rate.
- ▶ Used his sinker and slider essentially equally in 2023 (50.3% sliders and 49.6% sinkers)...so far in '24 he's been at 55.8% sinkers and 44.2% sliders.

#54 MITCH WHITE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Sweeper, Curveball, Sinker

Last Game: 4/12 vs. COL (w/TOR); 2.0ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, bb, 2k (41p)

- ▶ Activated yesterday after being acquired by the Giants last Saturday night from the Blue Jays in exchange for cash considerations.
- ▶ Made four appearances with Toronto (three in long relief) and allowed six runs in 10.0 innings (5.40 ERA) with 10 hits allowed, four walks and six strikeouts.
- ▶ Bay Area native was born in San Jose, went to Bellarmine College Prep in San Jose and attended Santa Clara University.
- ▶ Was drafted by the Dodgers in the second round of the 2016 draft when current Giants PBO Farhan Zaidi was the GM of the Dodgers.
- ▶ Grew up a Giants fan (**Matt Cain** was his favorite player)...attended all the Giants World Series runs while in high school and college.

- ▶ Is 15-for-45 (.333) with four runs, two doubles, one triple and five RBI in his last 14 games dating to April 8.
- ▶ Has appeared in 24 of SF's 25 games, starting 23 at shortstop.
- ▶ Is 7-for-18 (.389) with eight RBI w/RISP in the early going.
- ▶ Is 14-for-52 (.269) versus a fastball in '24...was 22-for-104 (.212) off them last season.
- ▶ Has been worth +6 OAA this year, tied for best in MLB (any position).
- ▶ Since 2018, he has 53 DRS per *Fangraphs*, tied for most among MLB shortstops in that span with BOS Trevor Story.

#14 PATRICK BAILEY ▶ C

- ▶ Clubbed his second HR of the year with his first career splash hit on Saturday...was the third catcher in Giants history to hit a home run into McCovey Cove (others: **A.J. Pierzynski** and **Steven Vogt**).
- ▶ Tied his career high with four hits on Saturday (second time).
- ▶ Is 14-for-44 with six XBH and a .942 OPS vs. RHPs...is 3-for-13 with one double and a .538 OPS vs. LHPs so far in 2024.
