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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore closes out the pre-All-Star schedule beginning tonight with a three-game set against the Royals at Camden Yards...The Birds are coming off a 1-2 series against the Cubs and enter play today 12.5 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 4.0 games back in the Wild Card.

- 🦅 **Trevor Rogers** did not factor into Thursday's decision after throwing 6.0 innings of one-run ball, allowing five hits (1 HR) and two walks with four strikeouts...He owns a 1.19 ERA (4 ER/30.1 IP) over his last five starts since June 14.
- 🦅 **Jeremiah Jackson** registered his third pinch-hit hit of the season in the eighth inning with a two-run double...The three pinch-hits are tied with **Samuel Basallo** for the team lead...He became the second Oriole this season to record a go-ahead RBI in the eighth inning or later as a pinch-hitter, joining **Adley Rutschman**, who broke a 7-7 tie in the ninth inning with an RBI single on May 5 at Miami.
- 🦅 The O's tallied a win despite recording three hits, marking their second win of the season when registering three or fewer knocks (also 3 H, 5/11 vs. NYY).

YOUNG MONEY: Over his last eight starts since May 24 (G1) vs. Detroit, **Brandon Young** is 4-1 with a 2.83 ERA (15 ER/47.2 IP)...The Birds are 6-2 in those games.

- 🦅 Overall, Baltimore is 11-3 (.786) in Young's starts this season...The .786 winning percentage is the third highest by any MLB starter (min. 10 GS) behind PHI's Wheeler (12-2, .857) and WSH's Foster Griffin (15-4, .789).

WALKING IT OUT: **Taylor Ward** drew his 71st walk yesterday, surpassing Ken Singleton (70 BB, 1975) for the most free passes drawn by an Oriole before the All-Star Break in franchise history (since 1954)...The only other Orioles to surpass 60 walks prior to the All-Star break are Randy Milligan (69 BB, 1990), Bobby Grich (67 BB, 1973), and Albert Belle (66, 1999).

- 🦅 Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 85 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Athletics (81 G)...The Orioles have drawn multiple walks in 14 straight games, their third such streak this season (15 G, 5/29-6/13 & 14 G, 4/28-5/11).
- 🦅 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).
- 🦅 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank fourth in MLB with 362 walks this year.

ROYAL FLUSH: The Orioles are 161-99 (.619) at home all-time against the Royals, their second-highest home winning percentage against any club in franchise history (since 1954), trailing the Pirates (16-3, .842).

- 🦅 **Pete Alonso** has reached base safely in 14 of 15 career games opposite Kansas City, slashing .345/.455/.745 (19-for-55) with four doubles, six home runs, 11 runs, 13 RBI, and 11 walks against 11 strikeouts.
- 🦅 Alonso's 1.200 career OPS against the Royals is the second highest among all active players (min. 60 PA), trailing LAD's Shohei Ohtani (1.232).

OPENING STATEMENTS: The Orioles rotation has posted a 3.65 ERA in 45 games since May 20, the fourth-best starter ERA in the AL and seventh best in the majors during that time.

- 🦅 Prior to this stretch, the club posted a 5.20 ERA from its starters, third worst in the majors ahead of the Rockies (5.69) and Nationals (5.25) through May 19.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: **Pete Alonso** ranks fourth in the AL and 11th in the majors with 62 RBI...He is batting .275/.364/.519 (64-for-233) with nine doubles, 16 homers, 39 runs, 49 RBI, 32 walks, and three hit-by-pitches in 62 games since May 1.

- 🦅 On Wednesday, he became the 21st player (28th occurrence) in Orioles history to hit at least 20 homers before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) and Anthony Santander (24) in 2024...Chris Davis holds the team record pre-break with 37 home runs in 2013.
- 🦅 Alonso is the 24th player (31st occurrence) in O's history to drive in 60 runs before the All-Star break and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (63) in 2024...The last Oriole with more than 63 RBI before the break is Manny Machado, who had 65 in 2018...Chris Davis holds the team record pre-break with 93 RBI in 2013.
- 🦅 Alonso played in his 500th consecutive game on June 27 vs. Washington and has played 510 straight games, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (873 G) among active players...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is one of 39 players since 1900 to play in at least 500 consecutive games.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .353/.398/.503 (54-for-153) with 10 doubles, two triples, three home runs, 19 runs, 27 RBI, 10 walks (1 IBB), six stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 55 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

- 🦅 Since May 1, his .353 batting average is second highest in the majors (min. 150 AB) behind MIA's Otto Lopez (.356).
- 🦅 Alexander is batting .365 (19-for-52) with five doubles, two triples, one home run, and 25 RBI with runners in scoring position.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 7-14 (.333) in one-run games, the lowest winning percentage in MLB, with the next closest teams being the Angles, Mets, and Tigers (each 9-16, .360).

- 🦅 Twenty two of Baltimore's 43 wins have been in come-from-behind fashion (51.2%)...It signals the highest rate of such wins by an Orioles team since 2010 (54.5%), per *STATS Perform*.

ALL-STAR ADLEY: **Adley Rutschman** was named to the 2026 All-Star Game, earning his third career selection (2023 & 2024).

- 🦅 Rutschman is the fourth catcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to earn multiple All-Star Game selections, joining Matt Wieters (4), Gus Triandos (3), and Andy Etchebarren (2).
- 🦅 According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Rutschman is one of six catchers in MLB to earn at least three All-Star Game selections in their first five full seasons since 1990, joining Brian McCann (4), Mike Piazza (4), Ivan Rodriguez (4), Jason Kendall (3), and Salvador Perez (3).
- 🦅 Baseball Savant credits Rutschman with a Fielding Run Value of nine, tied with DET's TOR's Brandon Valenzuela for the highest figure among all catchers and tied for the seventh-highest clip among all position players behind CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (17), STL's JJ Wetherholt (15), KC's Bobby Witt Jr. (13), BOS' Ceddanne Rafaela (12), and LAD's Andy Pages and WSH's Jacob Young (both 10).

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his 15th start of the season and the 27th of his career tonight in the series opener vs. Kansas City...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his seventh win of the season on July 4 at Cincinnati after allowing four runs on eight hits and three walks in 5.0 innings pitched with five strikeouts...The four earned runs matched a season high (also 4/30 [G2] vs. HOU)...Threw 102 pitches, 65 strikes.
👉 Snapped a 10-start stretch of allowing three runs or fewer...Has still done so in 12 of his 14 starts this season.
👉 Has tossed 5.0 innings in three consecutive outings following five straight quality starts from May 24 (G1)-June 16.

HEY, HEY, HEY, HEY: Young is scheduled to make his first career start opposite Kansas City tonight, marking the 17th MLB team he has faced since debuting in 2025...He is 1-2 with a 2.61 ERA (6 ER/20.2 IP) over four career starts against the AL Central, and the O's have won both his starts vs. the division this season (4/6 at CWS & 5/24 [G1] vs. DET).
👉 The 2.61 ERA is his lowest mark against any AL division, ahead of the AL East (3.60) and AL West (5.88).

HERE, THERE AND EVERYWHERE: Young's 34.6 percent chase rate is a 6.8 percent increase from 2025 (27.8%) and is tied for the fourth-best mark in the AL (min. 75.0 IP) behind TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (36.8%), NYY's Cam Schlitler (35.2%), and SEA's Bryan Woo (35.0%).

PLATOON: Young allowed a career-high six hits, including two doubles, to righties in his last start on July 4 at Cincinnati...Prior to that, he held right-handed batters to a .138 (4-for-29) opponent average with one double, one walk, and 10 strikeouts over his previous four starts from June 10-27...Righties hit .309 (25-for-81) with three doubles and two home runs off Young over his first nine starts of the season.
👉 Lefties went 2-for-10 (.200) with one triple in his last start after he allowed a career-high seven hits to left-handed batters on June 27 vs. Washington.

VELO UPTICK: Young's average fastball has climbed to 94.1 mph in 2026, up 1.6 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.6 mph increase is the fifth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB this season, trailing LAA's Ryan Zeferjahn (+2.2 mph), SD's Adrian Morejon (+1.9 mph), CWS' Sean Newcomb (+1.8 mph), and ATH's Hogan Harris (+1.7 mph).
👉 He has limited the opposition to a .181 (21-for-116) clip on his four-seam fastball this season...The .181 average off the offering is the fifth-lowest mark in the AL (min. 500 four seamers thrown) behind CLE's Parker Messick (.147), BOS' Payton Tolle (.162), SEA's Emerson Hancock (.175), and NYY's Cam Schlitler (.180).

THEM CHANGES: Young is averaging 83.2 mph and 1,368 revolutions per minute (RPM) on his split finger over his last eight starts since May 24, during which opponents are hitting .190 (8-for-42) with one double and one triple...Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles.
👉 Last season opponents hit .281 (18-for-64) off his split finger with six doubles and five home runs...Threw the pitch 17.8 percent of the time in 2025 compared to 20.3 percent this season, marking a 2.5 percent increase in usage.
👉 However, threw his splitter 7.8 percent of the time (8 pitches) in his last start on July 4 at Cincinnati, during which opponents went 2-for-2 with one triple.

SWEET VICTORY: Baltimore is 11-3 (.786) in games started by Young this season after going 3-9 (.250) in 2025...That included a seven-game winning streak by the Orioles from May 6-June 10, over which he went 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA (12 ER/41.2 IP) and five quality starts.

NO FLY ZONE: Young has allowed two home runs over his last eight starts since May 24 (47.2 IP)...His 0.38 HR/9 during that span is tied for the second-lowest mark in MLB (min. 45.0 IP) with LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto, trailing teammate **Shane Baz** (0.36).
👉 Prior to that, Young allowed five home runs and held a 1.52 HR/9 over his first six starts of the season (29.2 IP).

RISP: Young allowed three hits with runners in scoring position in his last start on July 4 at Cincinnati, marking only the third time this season that he's given up multiple hits with RISP (5 H, 4/24 vs. BOS & 2 H, 5/6 at MIA)...Over his previous nine starts from May 11-June 27, opponents slashed .167/.175/.167 (6-for-36) with no extra-base hits with RISP.
👉 Opponents slashed .333/.370/.542 (16-for-48) off Young with runners in scoring position in 2025 with four doubles and two home runs.

Allowed a season-high-tying two earned runs on 6/29 vs. CWS (also 5/29 vs. TOR), marking his only earned runs allowed in June...Gave up 4+ hits for the first time since 9/26/25 at NYY (also 4 H)
