TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Marlins continue a three-game series tonight with the 18th of 19 match-ups between the teams this season...These three games will conclude the season series between the clubs.

- The Braves are one win shy of tying the franchise record for most single-season victories against Florida/Miami...The Braves went 14-5 (.737) against the Marlins last season, matching the mark first set in 2004 and repeated in 2012...The Braves are 13-4 this season against Miami following last night's win, with two more games to play.
- The Braves' 27 wins over Miami the last two seasons are the most by any National League team against a single opponent...Atlanta has outscored Miami 194-113 (+81) in these games.
- RH Julio Teheran is 9-6 with a 3.60 ERA (58 ER/145.0 IP) in 24 career games against Miami, and 2-0 with a 0.36 ERA (1 ER/25.0 IP) in four starts this season...He opened his season with 24.0 consecutive scoreless innings against Miami before allowing a solo home run in his final inning of his last start against them.
- LH Caleb Smith makes his fifth career start against Atlanta, and is 1-2 with a 5.73 ERA (14 ER/22.0 IP) over his first four games...In three starts this season, he is 1-1 with a 6.48 ERA (12 ER/16.2 IP), including allowing 10 hits and six runs in 4.2 innings in his last start against the Braves, August 9 at Marlins Park.

FOURTEEN WINS: With a win tonight or tomorrow, Atlanta will have 14 wins over Miami for the second consecutive season...The Braves went 14-5 against the Marlins last season.

- The last time the franchise won at least 14 games against a single opponent in consecutive years was 1965 and 1966, when the Milwaukee Braves and Atlanta Braves had identical 14-4 records against the Houston Astros.
- The Washington Nationals are the last team in the majors to beat a single opponent at least 14 times in consecutive seasons, when they went 14-5 and 15-4 against Atlanta in 2015 and 2016.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Braves today recalled C Alex Jackson from Triple-A Gwinnett and placed C Brian McCann on the 10-day injured list with a left knee sprain.

- Jackson was recalled for his second stint with Atlanta this season, after also being up from April 7 to April 17...He went 0-for-10 with a walk and three strikeouts in three games while with the
- In 81 games with Triple-A Gwinnett, Jackson has 25 homers and 57 RBI in 81 games, batting .224/.311/.510...He is currently rated by MLB. com as Atlanta's No. 25 prospect.

LOOKING FOR 30/30: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. enters today's game with a National League-most 29 stolen bases this season, leaving him one shy of the fifth 30 home run/30 stolen base season in Braves franchise history.

- Acuña Jr. is also looking to become the second player in baseball history to have at least 30 home runs and 30 stolen bases in a season prior to his 22nd birthday...The only player to do so was Mike Trout, who had 30 home runs and 49 stolen bases as a 20-year-old in 2012.
- Only three Braves have gone 30/30 at any age, with OF Ron Gant doing it last in 1990 and 1991.
- OF Hank Aaron was the first to do so, accomplishing the feat in 1963, while OF Dale Murphy also did it in 1983.

30/30 BY TEAM GAME: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. stands one stolen base away from a 30/30 season, and today is team game No. 128...The quickest a Braves player has ever recorded a 30/30 season is team game No. 149, set by Ron Gant in 1991...The quickest major leaguer to accomplish the feat in the modern era was Cincinnati's Eric Davis, who needed just 105 team games and 90 personal games in 1987.

Gant needed 154 games for his first 30/30 season in 1990...Hank Aaron used 160 team games for the first 30/30 season in Braves history, while Dale Murphy accomplished the feat in 153 team games during the 1983 season.

ONE HUNDRED RBI: Freddie Freeman drove in four runs last night, and now has a majors-most 102 RBI on the season...This year marks the second 100-RBI season of his career...He drove in a career best 109 runs in 2013.

- Freeman hit the 100-RBI mark in Atlanta's 127th game of the season...He became the ninth Braves player to reach the mark that fast and the first since Andruw Jones in 2006 (116 games).
- Freeman also has 99 runs on the season, and is looking for the first 100 RBI/100 run season by a Braves player since Chipper Jones in 2007 (102 RBI/108 runs).

TEHERAN VS. MIAMI: RHP Julio Teheran makes his fifth start of the season against Miami tonight, and is 2-0 with a 0.36 ERA (1 ER/25.0 IP) in his first four turns.

- He tossed 24.0 consecutive scoreless innings against Miami to open the season, before allowing a home run to Starlin Castro leading off the seventh inning in his last start against them, August 9 at Marlins Park.
- Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, just three starters have pitched at least 25.0 innings against one opponent in a season and allowed no more than one run...Pat Jarvis allowed one run over 31.1 innings to Houston in 1971, Ron Reed held San Diego to one run in 26.0 innings in 1974, and Pete Smith tossed 25.0 scoreless innings against the Cubs in 1988.

- Makes his 27th start of 2019...Is the 223rd appearance of his career, and his 220th start.
- Set for his fifth start of the season against Miami tonight, and is 2-0 with a 0.36 ERA (1 ER/25.0 IP) in his first four turns.
  - ★ He tossed 24.0 consecutive scoreless innings against Miami to open the season, before allowing a home run to Starlin Castro leading off the seventh inning in his last start against them, August 9 at Marlins Park.
  - ✓ Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, just three starters have pitched at least 25.0 innings against one opponent in a season and allowed no more than one run...Pat Jarvis allowed one run over 31.1 innings to Houston in 1971, Ron Reed held San Diego to one run in 26.0 innings in 1974, and Pete Smith tossed 25.0 scoreless innings against the Cubs in 1988.
  - Dick Kelley allowed just one earned run (two total) in 27.2 innings against the Dodgers in 1968, while Phil Niekro allowed one earned (three total) over 25.0 innings versus San Diego in 1973.
- A Has allowed one earned run or less in all four of his starts against Miami, and in 14 total starts on the season.
  - ⚠ The 14 starts allowing one earned run or fewer are tied for second most in the majors among traditional starters...Only the Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu (16)
    has more.
  - A Ryne Stanek had 25 such starts while opening for the Rays.
  - ⚠ The Atlanta-franchise record for such starts is 20, set by Greg Maddux in 2002.

#### 2019 Recap

- Last started against the Mets on 8/15 at SunTrust Park and allowed eight hits and six runs over just 1.1 innings, the shortest start of his career.
  - Was his 219th career start, which passed Rick Mahler for sixth most in Atlanta franchise history...Only Phil Niekro (594), Tom Glavine (518), John Smoltz (466), Greg Maddux (363) and Tim Hudson (243) have started more games for Atlanta.
- A Started against the Marlins, 8/9, and allowed five hits and one run over 7.0 innings.
  - Æ Allowed a home run leading off the seventh inning to snap a 24-inning scoreless streak against Miami to open the season.
  - A Pitched exactly 6.0 scoreless innings in each of his three starts against the Marlins to open the season...Teheran's run was just the fourth time since 1908 that a Braves starter had three straight such starts against one opponent in a single season...Warren Spahn first did so against Cincinnati in 1947, before Pete Smith did it against the Cubs in 1988...John Smoltz matched them in 2006 with three straight such starts against San Diego.
- Beat Washington, July 30, for his 73rd career win...Moved into sole possession of 10th place in Atlanta franchise history, passing Steve Avery (72).
  - Since Teheran's first full season in 2013, no pitcher has made more starts for a single team than he has for Atlanta.
- Made his first start after the All-Star break, 7/13 at SD...Allowed three hits and three runs (two earned) over 6.0 innings in Atlanta's 7-5 win.
  - ${\color{blue} {\cal A}}$  Went 5-6 with a 3.75 ERA (42 ER/100.2 IP) in 19 starts before the break.
  - ★ For his career, is 30-28 with a 3.55 ERA (207 ER/524.1 IP) in 89 appearances, 86 starts, after the break...Is 44-42 with a 3.72 ERA in 133 games before the break.
- Made his third start of the season against Miami, 7/5 and fired 6.0 scoreless innings... Took a no-decision in Atlanta's walkoff win, 1-0.
  - ★ Atlanta has two wins this season by a 1-0 score, and both have come in Teheran's starts against Miami.
- Allowed eight hits and six earned runs, 6/18 vs. NYM...The outing stopped a streak of eight straight starts in which he allowed one earned run or less.
  - Æ His run of one-run starts spanned from May 5 to June 13, during which he ranked second in the majors with a 0.81 ERA (4 ER/44.2 IP)... Trailed just Hyun-Jin Ryu of the Dodgers (0.53 ERA).
  - ★ Teheran's eight-game streak was tied for the longest in the majors by
    a traditional starter this season, mathing a run by his rotation-mate Mike
    Soroka...TB's Ryne Stanek has a 14-game run while opening for the Rays.
- ✓ Made his 200th career start, 4/30 vs. SD...Allowed five hits and four runs over a season-most 7.0 innings.
  - A Became the ninth Braves pitcher to make 200 starts for the club since the team moved to Atlanta in 1966...Joins Phil Niekro (594), Tom Glavine (518), John Smoltz (466), Greg Maddux (363), Tim Hudson (243), Rick Mahler (218), Ron Reed (203) and Steve Avery (201).

- Is 1-0 with 3.91 ERA (11 ER/25.1 IP) in 34 games with Atlanta...Twenty-eight of his 34 appearances have been scoreless, including 15 of his last 18.
- Converted his first save chance of the season, 8/14 vs. NYM...Was the seventh save of his career.
- Celebrated 10 years of major league service time on July 27.

- Has four consecutive scoreless appearances spanning 4.0 innings, allowing just two hits and striking out seven.
