LAST GAME: The D-backs won 6-5 vs. Rockies last night for their fourth walkoff victory and second series win in their last 3.

- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** ended the night with a 1-out RBI double to left field...was his third career walkoff hit (last: double in Bot 9 on May 14, 2023 vs. Giants).
- **Geraldo Perdomo** scored the winning run after his 1-out double ahead of Gurriel...had his third 3-hit performance in his last 9 games...since the All-Star break, his 6 games with 3+ hits are the most in the Majors, ahead of Shea Langeliers/ATH (5).
- **Corbin Carroll** homered (solo in fifth inning) in 3 consecutive games for the first time in his career while his 25th homer matched his career high (also: 2023)...is the third D-back to do so this season, joining Eugenio Suárez (3x - last: July 19-21) and Josh Naylor (April 15-17)...only 6 D-back players have homered in 4 straight games: Suárez (Sept. 29, 2024-March 29, 2025), Eduardo Escobar (April 8-11, 2021), Mark Trumbo (April 3-6, 2014), Mark Reynolds (Aug. 6-9, 2009), Troy Glaus (2x - Sept. 9-13, 2005 & April 6-10, 2005), and Reggie Sanders (April 17-21, 2001).
- **Blaze Alexander** recorded his third multi-hit performance in his last 6 games and has hit safely in 7 of his last 8 games.
- **Andrew Hoffmann** earned his first career MLB win after tossing a scoreless and hitless ninth inning.
- Relievers **Juan Burgos** (D-backs debut, 0 ER in 0.2 IP), **Kyle Backhus** (0 ER in 1.0 IP) and **Andrew Saalfrank** (0 ER in 1.0 IP) combined for 2.2 scoreless, 3-hit frames.

SNAKE BITES: **Geraldo Perdomo's** 21-game on-base streak at home since June 27 (.429 AVG; 33-for-77/.527 OBP/.558 SLG/1.085 OPS, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 13 RBI, 14 walks, 7 K, 2 HBP, 3 SB) is the longest active home streak in the Majors, ahead of Jackson Chourio (14)...he is the only player in the Majors this season with multiple 20+-game home on-base streaks (also: 21 from March 27-May 9)...his career long home on-base streak is 23 games (Sept. 28, 2024-May 9, 2025).

- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 15 of his last 17 home games (since June 27)...in 8 games vs. Rockies this season, has 2+ hits in 5 games...is hitting .467 (14-for-30)/.556 OBP/.833 SLG/1.389 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 9 RBI, 4 BB (2 K), 2 hit-by-pitches and 1 stolen base.

CARROLL'S 25-HOMER, 10-TRIPLE SEASON: **Corbin Carroll** is the first D-back in franchise history to have multiple seasons of 25+ homers and 10+ triples...only 2 other D-backs each have a season reaching the feat: Eduardo Escobar/2019 (35 HR, 10 3B) and Steve Finley/1999 (34 HR, 10 3B).

- Since 1961, Carroll is 1 of 2 players to record 25+ homers and 10+ triples within their first 100 games played, joining Jim Rice/BOS (1977; 27 HR, 11 3B).

VS. OPPOSING STARTERS: In their last 7 games vs. opposing starters, the D-backs have scored 29 earned runs in 31.2 innings (8.24 ERA) with a .301 AVG/.400 OBP/.553 SLG/.953 OPS with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 7 homers and 20 walks...their .953 OPS, .400 OBP, 29 runs and 20 walks vs. opposing starters since Aug. 2 rank best among NL teams.

EARLY SCORING: The D-backs have scored 2+ runs within the first 3.0 innings in 6 straight games (tied for second longest streak in MLB this season, behind 7 by Phillies) and have scored 1+ first inning runs in 5 straight games, the longest first-inning streak in the Majors this season (previous: 7x of 4 straight games).

- Since the All-Star break, among MLB teams in the first 3.0 innings, the D-backs rank in SLG (3rd, .498), OPS (3rd, .842), runs (3rd, 39), extra-base hits (3rd, 26) and homers (T-5th, 10).

CARROLL'S HISTORIC HOME SLATE: **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 10 home games (since July 19), has 4 doubles, 3 triples, 3 homers, 9 RBI, 2 walks and 2 stolen bases...is the first D-back all-time and fourth MLB player since 1941 to record 4+ doubles, 3+ triples, 3+ homers, 9+ RBI, 2+ walks and 2+ stolen bases in a 10-game span within a season at home, joining Carlos González (2013), Larry Walker/COL (1996) and Jeff Heath/CLE (1941).

TRENDING BATS: Over his last 10 games (since July 29), **Geraldo Perdomo** is hitting .400 (14-for-35)/.500 OBP/.571 SLG/1.071 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 8 walks...has struck out 2 times in his last 44 PA.

- **Blaze Alexander**, over his last 8 games since August 1, is hitting .357 (10-for-28)/.471 OBP/.643 SLG/1.113 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI, 4 walks and 2 hit-by-pitches.
- **Corbin Carroll**, over his last 7 games, has a .769 SLG with 1 double, 4 homers and 8 RBI.

ON-BASE MACHINE: **Geraldo Perdomo's** 65 times on base since July 1 rank second in the Majors, behind Nick Kurtz/ATH (65).

- He has reached base in 30 of his 33 games since July 1, hitting .336 (40-for-119)/.448 OBP/.462 SLG/.910 OPS with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 17 RBI and 22 walks (12 K).

HEAD-TO-HEAD WITH NL WEST: **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 27 of his 31 games vs. NL West, batting .339 (39-for-115)/.414 OBP/.530 SLG/.944 OPS with 11 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 21 RBI, 16 walks (16 K).

- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 12 straight games vs. NL West (3 2B, 2 HR, 3 RBI, 10 BB) and in 27 of his 31 games vs. NL West this season, slashing .292/.403/.628/1.031 with 8 doubles, 10 homers, 21 RBI, 19 walks (20 K), 2 hit-by-pitches and 1 stolen base.

LEADOFF TRIPLES & HOMERS: **Corbin Carroll's** 5 leadoff triples are tied for the most by a player in a season since the expansion era (1961), with Nyjer Morgan/WSH (2010), Curtis Granderson/DET (2006), Marquis Grissom/ATL (1996), Darren Lewis/SF (1994), Willie Wilson/KC (1985), Alfredo Griffin/TOR (1980), Omar Moreno/PIT (1980), Ralph Garr/ATL (1975) and Don Kessinger/CHC (1975)...no player has hit 6 in a season.

ON DECK - TEXAS RANGERS: Following today's game, the D-backs head to Arlington for a 3-game series @ Rangers...since 2023, the D-backs are 5-3 in their 8 matchups...the D-backs swept their 2 games vs. Rangers @ Chase Field from Sept. 10-11, 2024, outscoring them 20-4.

NEXT STARTER: RHP RYNE NELSON (6-3, 3.20)

- Did not factor in the decision in his last start on Aug. 5 vs. Padres (ND; 2 ER in 5.2 IP, 6 H, 8 K).
- Has allowed 2 or fewer runs in 9 of his last 10 starts, going 4-1 with a 2.08 ERA (13 ER in 56.1 IP).
- Made his lone start vs. Rangers on the road on May 29, 2024 (L; 4 ER in 6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 K).

AT A GLANCE: Third season with the D-backs...debuted in 2023 and made 5 starts in the Postseason (1 Wild Card, 1 NLDS, 2 NLCS, 1 World Series).

- Named the D-backs' 2022 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after leading the organization's farmhands in wins (11), ERA (3.83) and strikeouts (218).
- D-backs' fifth-round pick in the 2020 draft (Bellarmine University).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: With 1 more out, will eclipse 400.0 career in-nings to become the fifth D-back starter to reach the 400.0-inning mark within their first 74 career starts, joining Merrill Kelly (2019-22), Patrick Corbin (2012-16), Wade Miley (2011-14) and Brandon Webb (2003-05).

- Making his 24th start (13th home start).
- Is 1 win shy of a career high...his 11 wins are tied for second in in the NL with Matthew Boyd/CHC, Jesús Luzardo/PHI, Nick Pivetta/SD, Quinn Priester/MIL and Cristopher Sánchez/PHI, behind Freddy Peralta/MIL (12).
- In his last 3 home starts, is 2-0 with a 2.00 ERA (4 ER in 18.0 IP), op-ponent .206 AVG/.550 OPS, 5 walks and 15 strikeouts.
- Is the first D-back starting pitcher with 10+ wins in his first 23 starts of a season since Zac Gallen's 11 wins in 23 starts in 2023.

LAST START: Earned his career-high-tying 11th win on Aug. 4 vs. Padres after tossing 5.2 innings with 2 runs allowed on 5 hits with 3 walks and 4 strikeouts.

VS. ROCKIES: Making his fourth career start, fourth @ Chase Field.

- Has won his last 2 home starts, going 2-0 with a 3.75 ERA (5 ER in 12.0 IP), 0 walks and 17 strikeouts.
- Struck out 11 batters in his last start on Aug. 12, 2024.
- Has not walked a batter in each of his last 2 home starts (50 BF).

VS. NL WEST: In 3 home starts in 2025, is 2-1 with a 3.00 ERA (6 ER in 18.0 IP), opponent .224 AVG, 8 walks and 18 strikeouts.

- In his last 4 home starts vs. NL West opponents dating back to Sept. 29, 2024, is 3-1 with a 2.70 ERA (8 R-7 ER in 23.1 IP), opponent .209 AVG, 9 walks and 27 strikeouts.
- Over 7 starts this season, is 4-3 with a 4.17 ERA (19 ER in 41.0 IP), opponent .219 AVG, 13 walks and 32 strikeouts.
- In 13 career starts @ Chase Field, is 6-5 with a 4.33 ERA (37 R-33 ER in 68.2 IP) and 84 strikeouts.

HOME COOKIN: In his last 12 home starts (6 quality), is 7-3 with a 3.64 ERA (28 R-26 ER in 64.1 IP) and 59 strikeouts.

- Has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 9 of 12 starts.
- Over 4 starts from April 9-May 8, went 4-0 with a 1.11 ERA (3 ER in 24.1 IP), opponent .236 AVG (21-for-89) /.584 OPS, 6 walks and 20 strikeouts.
- Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings on April 19 vs. Balitmore and 6.1 scoreless innings on May 8 vs. Dodgers.
- Posted 5 straight quality starts in his first 5 home starts from March 29-May 8, going 4-1 with a 1.78 ERA (7 R-6 ER in 30.1 IP), opponent .239 AVG, 7 walks and 25 strikeouts.

GIVE 'EM THE HEATER: Is holding hitters to a .160 AVG (4-for-25)/.320 SLG with 9 strikeouts off his fastball in his last 8 starts...over his last 5 home starts, hitters are just 1-for-11 (.091)/.468 OPS.

EVEN SPLIT: In his last 7 starts, has held righties to a .244 AVG (22-for-90) with 3 walks and 24 strikeouts, while lefties are hitting .243 (18-for-74) with 5 walks and 13 strikeouts.

EARLY RISER @ HOME: Has won 2 of his last 4 day home starts, going 2-0 with a 2.42 ERA (6 ER in 22.1 IP) and 21 strikeouts.

BY INNING: Over his last 5 starts from innings 1-3, has a 0.60 ERA (1 ER in 15.0 IP), opponent .170 AVG, 0.80 WHIP, 3 walks and 8 strikeouts.

- Since the start of the 2024 season, his 15 starts with no walks are tied with Sonny Gray/STL and Shota Imanaga/CHC for second in the NL, behind Miles Mikolas/STL (21).
- Has walked 1 batter or fewer in 12 of 18 starts when tossing 5.0+ innings.

WINNING WAYS: Became the second-youngest D-back starter (26-165) and sixth overall to collect 7+ wins in their first 10 starts of a season, behind Patrick Corbin (23-261, 8 wins in 2013).
