TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Royals play the middle game of this three-game series...SF is 8-15 all-time against the Royals during regular season play, with just one series victory in eight sets (June 13-15, 2022, won series 2-1)...these teams are meeting at Kauffman Stadium for the first time since April 2017.

- ▶ SF is 3-1 thus far on this nine-game, three-city road trip that started in Baltimore (2-1), Kansas City (1-0) and ends in Arizona (Mon-Wed).
- ▶ The Giants enter today having won five of their last six road games.
- ▶ The Giants are 14-21 (.400) since August 11...the .400 winning percentage in that span is third-lowest in the NL ahead of only Miami (14-22, .389) and Washington (14-22, .389) and sixth-lowest in MLB.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to today's game:

- ▶ **IF Matt Chapman** reinstated from the Paternity List.
- ▶ IF Marco Luciano optioned toTriple-A Sacramento.

CONGRATULATIONS: IF Matt Chapman and his wife, Taylor, welcomed their first child on Thursday, a baby girl named Gia Alexandra.

HEATING UP: OF Heliot Ramos was a home run short of hitting for the cycle last night as he finished the game going 3-for-4 with a double, triple and one RBI.

- ▶ Ramos enters today with at least one hit in each of his last six games (with an AB)...he's 8-for-25 (.320) in that stretch with a .370 OBP and .600 SLG.
- ▶ Ramos has a hit in 12 of his last 16 games overall.

MAYBE NEXT YEAR: With their 5-3 loss to Baltimore on Thursday, the Giants were officially eliminated from the postseason...it's the eighth time in the last 10 years since their last World Series championship that they will not be playing playoff baseball.

ROAD CHALLENGES: The road has been a challenge for SF in 2024 as they enter today with a 34-42 (.447) road record...the .447 road winning percentage is 20th of 30 MLB clubs and is the fourth-lowest in the NL ahead of Colorado (.291), Miami (.360) and Washington (.405).

▶ However, SF has won each of its last two road series which have both come against teams currently in playoff position... the Giants took two-of-three from San Diego September 6-8 and secured a series win at Baltimore to begin this ninegame road trip.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Landen Roupp will be seeking his first Major League win as he makes his third career Major League start in what will be his 22nd big league appearance this season...Roupp has allowed just two runs in 10.0 innings in his first two starting assignments.

- ▶ Opponents are just 15-for-95 (.158) vs. the Giants' starters over the last five games.
- ▶ Giants starting pitchers have limited opponents to three earned runs or fewer in each of their last 12 games, posting a 2.67 ERA (18er, 60.2ip) in that stretch.



TURN BACK TIME: It's been 10 years since the Giants and Royals matched up in the 2014 World Series...Salvador Perez, who fouled out to **Pablo Sandoval** with the tying run at third to end Game 7, is the only remaining position player on an active roster from that Fall Classic.

WALK THE LINE: RHP Ryan Walker suffered his fourth loss of the season Thursday after allowing a walkoff two-run home run to Baltimore's Anthony Santander in the 9th inning...it was the first home run Walker had allowed on the road ALL season and the first earned runs he'd allowed in a game since July 27.

- ▶ Since taking over the closer's role on August 9, Walker has converted all eight of his save opportunities while allowing just three runs (2er) in 16.2 innings...he's struck out 27 and walked just four in that time while opposing hitters have batted .153 (9-for-59).
- ➤ Since the All-Star break, Walker has allowed four earned runs in 26.2 innings for a 1.35 ERA in 25 games...his 1.35 ERA since the break is third-best among relievers (min. 25.0ip) behind ARI's AJ Puk (0.33) and CLE's Emmanuel Clase (0.33).

IT IS OUTTA HERE!: OF Mike Yastrzemski has eight home runs since August 24, all off right-handed pitching...over that span, only Shohei Ohtani has more homers off righties (9) in MLB (Stats, LLC).

GOING FOR 20: With a stolen base in this series, **IF Tyler Fitzgerald** will have 20 stolen bases and 15 home runs (currently has 16) in the first 100 games of his career...the only shortstops to achieve that feat in the modern era are Bobby Witt Jr. and Fernando Tatis Jr. (*Stats, LLC*).

LAST LEG: Following this series against the Royals, the Giants will travel to Arizona for a three-game series against the Diamondbacks starting Monday night...it'll be SF's final three road games of the season before wrapping up the 2024 campaign with three at home against the St. Louis Cardinals.

► The Giants are 4-6 against the D-Backs this season, dropping five of the last seven meetings.

IN THE SHOW: The 26-year-old is making his 22nd appearance (third start) at the MLB level this year with his start today...he's in the rotation because of injuries to **LHP Robbie Ray** (left hamstring strain) and **LHP Kyle Harrison** (left shoulder inflammation)...the rookie made the Giants Opening Day roster out of Spring Training and appeared in 10 games out of the bullpen in March/April before being optioned to Triple-A...Roupp is in his fourth stint at the MLB level this year.

PUSH START: This marks Roupp's third career start at the MLB level...he's made 32 career MiLB starts (eight in 2024)...in those eight MiLB starts this year, he posted a 2.35 ERA (6er, 23.0ip) with 36 strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP.

FINISHING STRONG: Roupp has a 1.07 ERA (3er, 25.1ip) with 25 strikeouts, a .161 opposing batting average, 0.99 WHIP and a 50.0% groundball rate in 10 games (two starts) since being recalled to the Majors on August 9.

CURVE IT: Roupp has heavily relied on his curveball this season with the pitch having a 44.7% usage rate...it has also been his most valuable pitch this season with a +4 run value.....opponents are 6-for-39 (.154) with one extra-base hit against Roupp's curveball over his last 10 games with 18 strikeouts.

ROUPP AS A RIVER CAT: The rookie has appeared in eight games, six starts, for Triple-A Sacramento this season, going 0-1 with a 3.80 ERA (9er, 21.1ip), 30 strikeouts, a 1.31 WHIP and a .187 opposing batting average...in his last three outings for Sacramento, he had a 1.13 ERA (1er, 8.0ip) while striking out eight before being recalled on Aug. 9.

MISSING TIME: Roupp missed nearly a month from the middle of May to the middles of June on the Minor League Injured List with right elbow discomfort.

DO THE SPLITS: Roupp has held righties to a .209/.269/.302 slash line with a .571 OPS, 27 strikeouts and one home run here at the MLB level...lefties are slashing .197/.346/.242 with a .588 OPS, 13 strikeouts and zero homers.

ROAD WARRIOR: Albeit a small sample size, Roupp has been stronger as a visiting pitcher this year...he has not allowed a run while striking out 15 and holding opponents to a .100/.308/.100 slash line (.408 OPS)...today will mark his first road start at the MLB level.

LIMIT THE DAMAGE: Opponents are slashing .283/.394/.433 with an .828 OPS against Roupp with runners on base this season with seven of his nine extra-base hits allowed coming in such situations.

A PROSPECT NO MORE: Roupp entered the season as the Giants' No. 14 prospect according to *Baseball America* and the No. 12 prospect according to *MLB.com*.

DRAFT DAY: The 2021 Draft pick was selected in the 12th round out of UNC Wilmington...he's one of two Giants picks from the 2021 Draft to sign and play in MLB, joining yesterday's starter **RHP Mason Black**.

- ▶ Has made four appearances totalling 9.0 innings for SF since being activated off the 60-day IL on Sept. 1...he's struck out 10 batters in those 9.0 innings.
- ▶ Was on the IL for first 137 games of 2024 undergoing surgery to remove an aneurysm from his upper right arm on March 4 at Stanford Medical Center...the surgery was performed by Dr. Jason Lee.
- Appeared in 33 games (making three starts) for the Giants last season and logged a 3.92 ERA...entered Spring Training this year with a chance to be a mainstay on SF's Major League roster.

#76 SPENCER BIVENS > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Two-Seam FB, Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Sweeper **Last Game:** 9/19 at BAL; 2.0ip, 3h, 1bb, 1ibb (35 pitches)

- ► Has allowed 11 runs (nine ER) in his last 11 games (20.0ip) dating to August 17 (4.05 ERA)...had a 1.90 ERA in the 12 games prior.
- ▶ Opponents are just 5-for-32 (.156) off him with RISP.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut on June 16.
- ▶ Went 5-1 with a 2.92 ERA in 27 relief outings for Triple-A Sacramento...struck out 42 in 49.1ip with opponents hitting .231 off him.
- ▶ Began his professional career with the Savigny-sur-Orge Lions in French Division One in 2019 before coming back stateside to pitch for Steel City in Indy Ball in Washington, PA in 2020.
