AT HOME: The Brewers are 5-3 at home, going 2-0-0 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 3-6 on the road, going 1-2-0 in series play.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....Murphy was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after guiding the team to a 93-69 record and the NL Central division championship.....he became the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Returning from the 2024 coaching staff is associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).....first base coach Julio Borbón, lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf and hitting coach Eric Theisen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has not made any replay challenges in 2025.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight.....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons.....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 674 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

#### TONIGHT'S STARTER: #46 - RHP QUINN PRIESTER (1gs, 0-0, 1.80)

PRIESTER AT A GLANCE: Quinn Priester, 24, will be making his second start of the season.....Priester made his season and Brewers debut last Thursday at Colorado and received no decision in the Brewers' 7-2 loss (5ip, 6h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 72 pitches)....he was acquired from Boston on April 7 in exchange for OF Yophery Rodriguez, a Competitive Balance Round A selection and a player to be named.....Priester began the season at Triple-A Worcester, where he made his only appearance in a start on 4/3 at Jacksonville, taking a 5-1 loss (4ip, 6h, 2r, 2er, 0bb, 6k, 1wp, 87 pitches).

LAST SEASON: Priester went 3-6 with a 4.71 ERA in 11 games/7 starts between Pittsburgh (10g/6gs) and Boston (1g).....his teams went 1-6 in his starts.....he had 2 quality starts.....opponents batted .277 (56-for-202, 7hr).....he went 1-5 with a 4.42 ERA as a starter (36.2ip, 18er) and 2-1 with a 5.54 ERA as a reliever (13ip, 8er).....he was traded by Pittsburgh to Boston on 7/29/24 in exchange for INF/OF Nick Yorke.

CAREER: Is 6-9 with a 6.02 ERA in 22 games/16 starts (104.2ip, 70er) while pitching for Pittsburgh (2023-24) and Boston (2024).....he is 3-8 with a 5.95 ERA as a starter (81.2ip, 54er) and 3-1 with a 6.26 ERA as a reliever (23ip, 16er).....Priester was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (18th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Has gone 26-17 with a 3.61 ERA in 87 games/84 starts while pitching in the Pittsburgh [2019-24], Boston (2024) and Milwaukee (2025) organizations (408.2ip, 361h, 188r, 164er, 149bb, 428k, 27hr).....has held opponents to a .235 batting average.....was a 2023 International League All-Star and Triple-A Indianapolis Pitcher of the Year....was named Pirates Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2022.....was selected to the All-Star Futures Game in 2021.....was a 2021 East League All-Star and High-A East League Pitcher of the Year.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 1-1 with a 5.06 ERA in 3 games/2 starts (16ip, 9er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 3-5 with a 5.18 ERA in 13 games/9 starts [66ip, 38er].....went 2-4 with a 4.67 ERA in 7 games/4 starts last season [34.2ip, 18er].
