TODAY'S GAME: The Giants limited the Braves to three runs last night but only scored one of their own in a 3-1 defeat that leveled this three-game series...SF will try to win the rubber match tonight to win their third consecutive series before heading on to Cleveland after the game.

- ▶ SF is 6-3 in their last nine games dating to June 24...additionally, the Giants are 7-2 in rubber games this year.
- ▶ The road, however, has been a tough place for the Giants in 2024 as they are 17-26 (.395) outside of Oracle Park...the .395 road win % is 25th of 30 MLB teams and fourth-worst in the NL ahead of only the Cubs (17-28, .378), Marlins (14-27, .341) and Rockies (12-31, .279).
- ▶ SF is 5-10 in its last 15 road games since May 26.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY CAMILO! Giants closer **RHP Camilo Doval** turns 27 years old today...he's never pitched in a game on his birthday during his Major League career...the last time he pitched on his birthday was July 4, 2021 for Sacramento at Las Vegas.

REINFORCEMENTS?: **LHP Blake Snell** (left groin strain) made a third rehab appearance at Triple-A Sacramento last night vs. Reno...Snell worked 5.0 scoreless, hitless innings with one walk and nine strikeouts...he threw 67 pitches, 46 for strikes.

- ▶ Fellow **LHP Robbie Ray** (Tommy John recovery) is scheduled to start tonight for Sacramento at Reno in what is his seventh rehab game (sixth start).
- ▶ **RHP Alex Cobb** (right shoulder) is scheduled to make his second rehab start tomorrow night

TOUGH SLEDDING: SF is in a stretch leading into the All-Star break where they already played the Dodgers, are now facing the Braves and end the first half with series against the Guardians, Blue Jays and Twins...all except Toronto are above .500 and in playoff position.

- ▶ SF is 18-28 (.391) vs. teams currently .500 or better in 2024.
- ▶ Looking at the Giants strength of schedule for the rest of the season, SF's opponents have a combined .491 win %, eighth-lowest of any team's remaining schedule...in the NL only the Padres (.490), Reds (.487) and Mets (.486) have remaining schedules against teams with a lower combined win % than the Giants.

TRUIST SERUM: Atlanta's newish home has been unkind to the Giants since it opened in 2017 with SF going 9-13 vs. the Braves in this ballpark.

- ▶ SF has a chance today to win its second series played here since the park opened in 2018, having gone 1-5 in its previous six trips...the lone win was a three-game sweep of Atlanta in May of 2018...the winning pitchers were **RHP Chris Stratton**, **LHP Ty Blach** and **LHP Andrew Suárez**.

IS THIS A RECORD?: The Giants have gotten 5.0 innings from each of their last three starters in **RHP Spencer Bivens** (Sunday vs. LAD), **RHP Hayden Birdsong** (Tuesday) and **RHP Jordan Hicks** (yesterday).

- ▶ If tonight's starter **RHP Logan Webb** can give SF at least 5.0 innings it'll be the first time since April 15-18 that SF's has had four consecutive starters pitch 5.0 or more innings...the four that did it then were **LHP Kyle Harrison** (close to returning from the IL), Hicks, **RHP Keaton Winn** (on the IL) and Webb.

WEBB SLINGER: **RHP Logan Webb** takes the ball for a 19th time this season with his outing tonight in the finale...he enters this start having thrown 112.1 innings, most in the National League and third-most in the Majors behind SEA's Logan Gilbert and KC's Seth Lugo.

- ▶ Webb has enjoyed pitching at Truist Park, giving up one or fewer runs in three of his four career starts here...last season, however, he allowed four runs on nine hits in 6.0 innings in a 6-5 Giants loss...overall, Webb is 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA (6er, 26.0ip) in this facility with 25 strikeouts to just three walks.
- ▶ It's worth noting that Webb, who relies on his changeup, is facing a Braves team that according to *Sports Info Solutions* rate as the #4 team hitting against changeups from righties (.243 average, .408 slugging %).

'PEN PALS: SF's bullpen has pitched 361.2 innings this season, most in MLB...additionally, **SF's RHPs Tyler Rogers** (44 games) and **Ryan Walker** (43 games) are one and two, respectively, in games pitched this season in the Majors...rookie **RHP Erik Miller** has 40 appearances, tied for 11th-most in the Majors.

PROTOTYPE: OF Heliot Ramos is slashing .294/.371/.515 with 21 extra-base hits (10 doubles, 11 homers), 38 RBI, 23 runs and an .887 OPS in 50 games since being recalled on May 8.

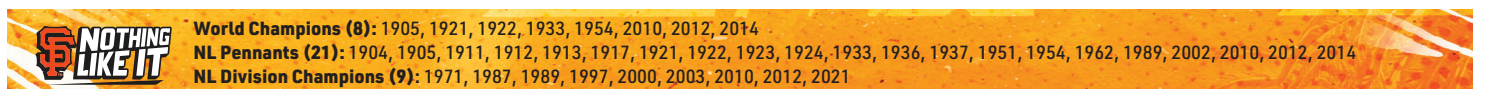
- ▶ His 38 RBI since May 8 are tied for most in the National League with PHI's Alec Bohm and tied for third-most in MLB behind NYY's Aaron Judge (62) and CLE's José Ramírez (46).

SOLER ECLIPSE: DH Jorge Soler is slashing .290/.375/.551 for a .926 OPS in 19 games since June 12...in that span he has nine doubles, three homers, 14 RBI, nine walks and 18 runs scored.

- ▶ Each of Soler's last six hits have gone for extra-bases (five doubles and one homer).
- ▶ In the leadoff spot this year, Soler is posting an .851 OPS and the Giants are 6-3 in those games.

This Date in Giants History

JULY 4, 2009 - Tim Lincecum, the previous year's National League Cy Young Award winner, was in his best form, beating Houston 9-0 with 7.0 scoreless innings, running his streak of scoreless innings to 23. He also scored the Giants' first run in the 5th to move to 9-2 with a 2.23 ERA.

WEBB GEMS: SF's Opening Day starter is in his sixth season with the Giants and made his fifth Opening Day roster in 2024...SF's ace signed a contract extension in April 2023 that keeps him in a Giants uniform through the 2028 season.

LAST TIME OUT: Was saddled with a no-decision in SF's 5-3 win over the Dodgers last Friday at Oracle Park...Webb left with a 3-2 lead after throwing 7.0 innings of two-run ball while striking out six...the Dodgers tied the game in the 9th off closer **Camilo Doval** but SF won it in the bottom half thanks to a walk-off homer from **Brett Wisely**...Webb hit 95.5 mph with a pitch in the 1st inning, his hardest pitch in the Majors since 2021...he told reporters postgame he felt his mechanics in the outing were his best all season.

DADDY LONG LEGS: Webb has finished at least 7.0 innings on 10 different occasions so far this season, most of any pitcher in the Majors...only two other Giants starters this year have finished 7.0 innings (**Jordan Hicks** did so on April 5 vs. San Diego and **Kyle Harrison** has done so twice)...SF's ace enters this outing having thrown 112.1 innings so far this year, third-most in the Majors and most in the NL.

GOIN' DEEP (IN THE GAME): Since the start of 2022, Webb has thrown 520.2 innings, most in the Majors in that time ahead of Aaron Nola (506.1), Miles Mikolas (504.1), Corbin Burnes (502.1) and Logan Gilbert (494.0).

VS. ATLANTA: Is facing the Braves for a seventh time in his career and fifth time here at Truist Park...in 2023, Webb faced the Braves twice and allowed nine runs on 15 hits in 11.1 innings (7.15 ERA)...SF lost both of those contests...in fact, SF has lost each of Webb's last three career starts against the Braves dating to June 20, 2022 after winning each of his first three career starts vs. Atlanta.

TRU DAT: Tonight's outing marks Webb's fifth career start against the Braves in this ballpark...Webb is 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA (6er, 26.0ip) and 25 strikeouts in his four prior starts at Truist Park...he's allowed one ore fewer runs in three of the four starts...the lone start where he didn't was his last time pitching here on August 19 of last year (6.0ip, 9h, 4r, 0bb, 5k).

I'VE WATCHED A CHANGE IN YOU: Webb's changeup has a +4 run value in 2024 after having +28 run value last season (the second-most valuable pitch in the league behind AL Cy Young Award winner Gerrit Cole's fastball)...after giving up seven hits on the pitch two starts ago to the Cardinals in St. Louis on June 23, Dodgers hitters went 3-for-8 on ABs that ended with the changeup....prior to the start at St. Louis, Webb had allowed just 11 hits off the changeup in his previous six starts combined from May 21-June 18.

RECENT HOMER BUG: Webb has allowed three homers in June (40.0 innings) after allowing two homers in his first two months of the season (72.1ip)...his 0.40 HR/9ip would be a career-best after he posted a 0.55 HR/9ip ratio in 2021 and a 0.51 rate in 2022.

CHECK 'EM: Opposing teams had early season success running on Webb in 2024, stealing 10 bases in his first nine starts this year...after a stretch of allowing just one steal in seven starts from May 15-June 18, the Cardinals swiped four bags off Webb on June 23...the Dodgers did not steal a base off him in his last start...Webb's 15 steals against him this year are tied for third-most in MLB behind BAL's Corbin Burnes (21) and COL's Ryan Feltner (18).

BAND TOGETHER: The Giants as a team are 62-47 (.569) in Webb's 109 regular season starts since 2021...SF is 8-10 in his 18 starts in 2024...he's received three or fewer runs of support in 13 of the 18 starts.

BEHIND THE DISH: Webb has strong career numbers with both **C Patrick Bailey** and **C Curt Casali** as his catcher.

BOOTS ON THE GROUND: Through 18 starts this year Webb owns a 58.2% ground ball rate, third-best in the Majors behind PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (61.2%) and ATL's Max Fried (59.2%).

KEEP 'EM OFF THE BASES: Opposing hitters are slashing .293/.347/.425 (.772 OPS) with runners on base off Webb this season...hitters are slashing .235/.270/.290 (.560) with no one on base against Webb.
