MIAMI MARLINS (35-35) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (35-35)

June 13, 2026 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 4:05 EDT - Game #71/Home #38

RHP Lake Bachar (0-0, 2.97 ERA) vs. RHP Bubba Chandler (2-7, 4.91 ERA)

THE PIRATES: have lost six of their last seven games (since June 5 at Atlanta), including three of the first four games on this six-game homestand vs. Los Angeles-NL (1-2, Tuesday-Thursday) and Miami (0-1, Friday-Sunday), after winning eight of their 11 games from May 24-June 4...Will depart for a six-game, seven-day road trip against the Athletics (June 15-17) and Colorado (June 19-21) following Sunday's homestand finale...Have the fifth-most runs scored (354) in Major League Baseball, behind Los Angeles-NL (375), Washington (374), Milwaukee (358) and Atlanta (355)...Have struck out the fourth-most batters (634) in Major League Baseball, trailing only Milwaukee (654), Philadelphia (649) and Cleveland (648).

FISH FRY: Pittsburgh has gone 10-5 (.667) against Miami since the beginning of the 2024 season, including taking two of three contests here at PNC Park in the last series from June 9-11, 2025...The Pirates are 46-30 (.605) all-time against the Marlins at PNC Park (since 2001)...They are looking to win three straight home series against Miami (they also swept a three-game series here from September 9-11, 2024) for the first time since winning four consecutive home series against the Marlins from 2012-15.

HOME(R) HAPPY: The Pirates have hit multiple home runs in seven straight home games (since May 29 vs. Minnesota) for just the second time in the Modern Era (since 1901), along with a seven-game streak from May 18-31, 2006...Pittsburgh has already hit a total of 48 home runs in 37 games at PNC Park this season after hitting just 49 home runs at home during the 2025 season.

GOING THE EXTRA MILE: Pittsburgh has recorded at least one extra-base hit in 43 straight games (since April 26 at Milwaukee)...That is the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and the third-longest streak by any Major League team this season, trailing only Detroit (44 games, March 28-May 16) and Baltimore (44 games, April 5-May 24 [G1])...The Pirates' 127 extra-base hits since April 26 are tied for the sixth-most in all of Major League Baseball.

40 BUCS: Antwone Kelly became the 40th different Pirate to appear in a game this season when he pitched 2.1 innings of relief in his Major League debut on Friday vs. Miami...Pittsburgh has used 20 different position players and 20 different pitchers this year...Kelly became the fifth Pirate to make their Major League debut this season, joining Konnor Griffen (April 3 vs. Baltimore), Wilber Dotel (April 19 vs. Tampa Bay), Brandon Bidois (May 13 vs. Colorado) and Esmerlyn Valdez (May 22 at Toronto)...He also became the first Pirate and just the seventh Major Leaguer from Aruba to play in a game.

LOWE OR NEVER: Brandon Lowe homered for the second time in as many games with his solo shot (off Sandy Alcántara) in the eighth inning on Friday vs. Miami...He is looking to become the first Pirate with an extra-base hit, an RBI and a run in four straight games since Ke'Bryan Hayes from August 8-11, 2023 (also four games)...Lowe is also looking to go deep in three straight games for the second time this season (also April 12-14)...The last Pirate to have multiple such streaks in a season was Sean Rodríguez, who homered in three consecutive games twice in 2016 (July 8-10 & September 17 [G1]-18).

SEVENTH HEAVEN: Pirates pitchers have seven-plus strikeouts in 18 straight games (since May 24 at Toronto)...That is their longest single-season streak in the Modern Era (since 1901)...It trails New York-NL (26, April 19-May 18) and Philadelphia (21, April 25-May 17) for the longest in all of MLB this year.

ANCHOR DOWN: Bryan Reynolds extended his on-base streak to 19 straight games (since May 23 at Toronto) with his fourth-inning single on Friday night vs. Miami...He has gone 22-for-68 (.324) with six doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, 12 walks, a .978 OPS and 15 runs during the streak...Reynolds' last such streak of more than 19 games came from June 1-29, 2024 (25 games).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

June 13, 1988: The Pirates improved to 35-27 on the season after picking up an 8-0 win over the Cubs at Chicago's Wrigley Field. Bob Walk improved to 7-4 after striking out five batters and tossing a shutout. Bobby Bonilla went 3-for-5 with an RBI double and a two-run home run. Barry Bonds went 2-for-4 with a solo home run, an intentional walk, a stolen base and three runs scored in the victory.

LAST TIME OUT: Chandler lost a 3-2 decision after allowing three runs (two earned) on one hit and two walks (he had seven strikeouts) over his 5.1 innings of relief on June 7 at Atlanta...He became only the second Pittsburgh reliever in the Modern Era (since 1901) to pitch at least 5.1 innings while allowing one/zero hits and striking out seven batters in any appearance, joining Bill Swift (7.1ip) on July 28 (G2), 1935 vs. St. Louis.

STARTING OVER: Chandler will make his 13th start of the season today vs. Miami and his first since winning a 10-6 decision after allowing four runs in 5.0 innings on June 2 at Houston...He has a 5.05 ERA (57.0ip/32er) and 55 strikeouts across his first 12 starts.

GIMME FIVE: Chandler struck out a career-high 11 batters in 5.0 innings on May 22 at Toronto...He joined Erik Bedard (May 3, 2012 at St. Louis) as the only Pirates in the Modern Era (since 1901) to have at least 11 strikeouts in an outing of 5.0 or fewer innings...Chandler also became one of 11 Major Leaguers (since earned runs became an official stat in both leagues in 1913) to have at least 11 strikeouts and zero earned runs in an outing of 5.0 or fewer innings (he was only the fourth rookie to accomplish that).

FINISHING STRONG: Chandler went 2-0 with a 1.08 ERA (16.2ip/2er), 19 strikeouts (zero walks issued), a .123 batting average against (7-for-57) and a 0.42 WHIP over his final three starts of the 2025 season, including 5.2 innings of one-run ball in his final start on September 27 at Atlanta (he is a native of Lawrenceville, GA, located approximately 30 miles from Truist Park)...He became the first Pittsburgh pitcher during the Modern Era (since 1901) to make three consecutive starts with one or zero runs allowed, zero walks issued and at least six strikeouts...Chandler also joined Milwaukee's Corbin Burnes (four starts) in 2021, Arizona's Zac Gallen (three starts) in 2023 and Detroit's Tarik Skubal (three starts) last season as the only Major League pitchers during the Modern Era to make at least three consecutive starts with four or fewer hits allowed, one/zero runs allowed, zero walks issued and at least six strikeouts.

A BIT OF BOTH: Chandler went 2-1 with a 5.12 ERA (19.1ip/11er) in four starts and 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0ip/3er) in three relief appearances in 2025...Nine of the 11 runs he allowed as a starting pitcher came during his first career start (Sept. 7 vs. Milwaukee).

RELIABLE ROOKIES: Chandler (starter) and Braxton Ashcraft (reliever) each struck out six batters while issuing zero walks in Pittsburgh's 2-0 win last season on September 20 vs. the Athletics...They were the first pair of Pirates teammates during the Modern Era (since 1901) to each strike out six batters without issuing a walk in the same game... They were the ninth pair of Pirates since 1901 to both have six strikeouts in a game, the first since Chad Kuhl (eight)/Richard Rodriguez (six) on May 6, 2018 at Milwaukee.

DYNAMITE DEBUT: Chandler secured a 4.0-inning save in his Major League debut on August 22 vs. Colorado...He was the first Pirates pitcher to earn a save in his MLB debut (stat became official in 1969), and he was one of four Major Leaguers to earn a 4.0-inning save in his MLB debut, joining Boston's Bob Stanley (April 16, 1977 at Cleveland), St. Louis' Zack Thompson (June 3, 2022 at Chicago-NL) and San Francisco's Keaton Winn (June 13, 2023 at St. Louis)...He was the only one to not surrender a run.

- Has collected each of his 12 hits off right-handed pitchers this season (his last hit off a southpaw was a single off Cincinnati's Taylor Rogers, 4/11/25).
