CEDRIC THE ENTERTAINER: OF Cedric Mullins has begun his season with 13 hits in 29 atbats (.448)...His 13 hits are tied for the second-most in the majors...He's hit safely in each of the O's first seven games; he also hit safely in four-straight games to close out the 2020 season and combined has hit safely in 11-straight games, which is the longest active streak in the majors... His seven-game hitting streak just this season, is a career-high for a single-season.

- ♠ Mullins has led off each game this season, and has gone 5-for-7 in his first at-bats of the game; has gone 9-for-13 when leading off any inning, with his nine hits leading all of baseball in this category.
- Ox His 13 hits are the most amongst hitters in baseball batting in the lead off slot.
- $\Theta_{\!\scriptscriptstyle{\mathcal{F}}}$ Mullins has gone 5-for-10 (.500) against left-handed pitching to start the season; in Spring Training, he became a full-time left-handed hitter after switch hitting his entire professional career.

FACING THE SOX: The Orioles and Red Sox face off for the fifth time this season, with the O's taking three of the first four...Since the beginning of last season, the Orioles are 8-6 against the Red Sox.

WAKE UP THE BATS: The Orioles set a Major League record on Thursday by striking out at least 13 times for the fifth-straight game (15, 13, 14, 17, 14)...During this stretch, the O's have averaged 2.25 runs per game, the third-lowest average in the majors...The O's have struck out double digit times in six of their seven games this season.

CALL TO THE 'PEN: The Orioles bullpen has posted a 3.54 ERA (11 ER/28.0 IP) in the first seven games of the season, the eighth-lowest team bullpen ERA in the American League and the 12th-lowest in the majors.

- $\theta_{\!\scriptscriptstyle{\mathcal{S}}}$ LHP Tanner Scott has appeared in 15-straight games with out allowing an earned run (12.0 IP); has allowed just one unearned run during this span...His 99.7 mph recorded pitch on 4/7 at NYY, according to Statcast, is the fastest pitch this year by an Orioles pitcher...Scott owns 23 of the O's 24 fastest thrown pitches this season (Dillon Tate with the other).
- RHP Adam Plutko has tossed 5.1 innings in relief, ranking as the seventh-most in the AL by a reliever
- Ox RHP César Valdez is one of six players in the AL to have recorded two saves this season.

DAYLIGHTFUL: The Orioles have played in four day games this season, with each of their first three wins this season all coming in day games...Since the beginning of the 2020 season, the Orioles are 13-7 (.650) in day games...Their .650 winning percentage is tied for the second-highest in baseball during this stretch and their 13 wins are tied for the fifth-most.

SOMETHING EXTRA: Since the beginning of the 2020 season, and the introduction of a player starting at second base in extra innings, the Orioles have gone 5-4 in extra inning games...Their nine total games are tied for the second-most in the majors during this span, and their five wins are tied for the third-most.

THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY: On this date in 1975, RHP Jim Palmer tossed an Opening Day shutout at Detroit, as the Orioles won the game 10-0...It is one of three shutouts by an O's pitcher on Opening Day in club history.

LOOKING AT THE ROSTER: Here is how the current Orioles 40-man roster was put together (currently have 42 with INF Chris Davis and RHP Hunter Harvey on the 60-day IL)...13 players were originally drafted by the Orioles...11 were acquired via a trade...Eight players were claimed off waivers...Four were selected in the Rule 5 Draft...Three signed as Major League free agents, two originally signed as minor league free agents and had their contracts selected, and one signed as an International free agent.

THE SKIPPER: Brandon Hyde enters his third season as the Orioles Manager...The 2019 season marked his first as a Major League manager, as he was named the 20^{th} manager in O's history on December 14, 2018...He began his first Major League managerial role following 16 professional seasons in the coaching ranks and four as a player...Prior to joining the Orioles, Hyde served as bench coach for the Chicago Cubs in 2018, his second season in that role (also 2014)... Hyde spent three seasons as the Cubs first base coach from 2015-17, and previously served as Chicago's Director of Player Development from August 2012-2013, after joining the Cubs in December of 2011 as their Minor League Field Coordinator...Prior to joining the Cubs, Hyde spent nine seasons in the Marlins organization.

LAST START: Zimmermann earned his first-career big league win in his first start of the season on 4/4 at BOS...Tossed a career-high 6.0 innings, allowing four hits (one home run) and one walk, while striking out five...He set new career highs in innings pitched, and pitches thrown (73).

CAREER VS. BOSTON: Will make his second-straight start vs. the Red Sox after earning the win on 4/4 at Fenway Park...Faced the Red Sox once in 2020, entering in the fifth inning of a 9-1 loss in Boston...Tossed 4.0 innings of one-run ball, giving up just two hits and a walk with a season-high five strikeouts.

MARYLAND, MY MARYLAND!: Zimmermann will make his second-career start at Oriole Park tonight...When he made his debut last September, he became the latest, and 28^{th} overall, Maryland-born player to appear in a game for the Orioles, joining Evan Phillips (2018) and Steve Johnson (2012) as the only other Maryland-born O's to make a start at Oriole Park...The last Maryland-native to earn a win at Oriole Park as a starter was Aaron Laffey with Toronto on 9/25/12...Johnson is the only Maryland-born Baltimore starter to win at Oriole Park.

SPRING TRAINING: Zimmermann made just one start across four games during 2021 Spring Training...He went 0-1 and pitched to a 4.73 ERA (7 ER/13.1 IP) with three walks and 13 strikeouts...All three relief appearances were scoreless outings...Struck out four batters twice, 3/4 vs. BOS, and 3/14 at DFT

MLB DEBUT: Made his Major League debut on 9/17/20 vs. TB, allowing five runs (two homers) on four hits and a walk with two strikeouts through 3.0 innings...Secured his first career strikeout in the first inning when Nate Lowe struck out swinging to end the frame.

2020 HIGHLIGHTS: Zimmermann made two appearances (one start) in 2020, both against AL East opponents; went 0-0 and owned a 7.71 ERA (6 ER/7.0 IP) with seven strikeouts...Held batters to a .222 AVG (6-for-27) with two walks and two home runs...Became the 28th Maryland-born player to appear in a game in Orioles history (since 1954), and the first native Marylander to debut for the Orioles since RHP Branden Kline on 4/20/19 (G2) vs. MIN... Entered the season ranked as the No. 29 Orioles prospect by MLB.com.

2019 MINORS: Split the season between Double-A Bowie and Triple-A Norfolk, going a combined 7-6 with a 3.21 ERA (50 ER/140.0 IP) and 134 strikeouts in 24 starts (25 games)...Earned a promotion to Norfolk on 7/28 after posting a 2.58 ERA (29 ER/101.1 IP) in 17 starts (18 games) for Bowie... Finished the season ranking in the organization's top 10 in strikeouts (3rd - 134), games started (T-2nd - 24), complete games (T-1st - 2), shutouts (T-1st - 2), and innings pitched (2nd - 140.0)...Threw his first career shutout 6/18 at Hartford, allowing just four hits while striking out nine batters; the 9.0 innings set a career-high...Tossed his second shutout of the season in his final start for Bowie on 7/22 at Richmond, tossing 7.0 innings and allowing just five hits...Finished the season as the No. 17 Orioles prospect, according to Baseball America.
