TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and San Diego Padres today meet for a four-game midweek series to round out their season slate against one another...The Padres swept the Braves in three games at Petco Park from June 22-24.

 Atlanta secured the series over Texas last night with a win, 8-5...Drake Baldwin and Austin Riley combined to go 8-for-9 with four home runs, five runs and six RBI.

 Since the beginning of the 2025 season, the Braves are just 1-9 (.100) against the Padres...Their lone win in that span occurred here at Truist Park on May 24, 2025 (7-1).

 Atlanta has multiple wins against every National League club since 2025, except for San Diego...The Padres are tied with the Mets, Phillies and Giants for the most wins against the Braves since the start of 2025.

 LH JP Sears has made four career starts against Atlanta, including one this season on June 24...In that outing, he allowed two earned runs across 5.2 innings...All-time, the native of Sumter, SC, is 1-1 against the club with a 3.80 ERA (10 ER/23.2 IP)...His club is 3-1 when he pitches against Atlanta.

 RH Bryce Elder has twice faced the Padres, going 0-2 with a 9.82 ERA (8 ER/7.1 IP)...Atlanta hasn't given him a single run of support in either of those outings...The right-hander from Decatur, TX, surrendered two earned runs across 4.1 innings against San Diego on April 17, 2022, and six earned runs across 3.0 innings on May 19, 2024.

WIN: The Braves last night secured a series win over the Rangers, 8-5...It signified Atlanta's 21st series victory of the season, tied for the most in Major League Baseball alongside the Los Angeles Dodgers and Milwaukee Brewers...The Braves already have as many series wins this season as they did in the entirety of the 2025 campaign.

 Atlanta scored at least five runs for the ninth consecutive home game dating to July 1...It's the club's longest run in a single season since a 10-game streak from June 1-17, 2019.

 The Braves won their 10th rubber match of the season, tied for the second most in MLB behind Washington (11)...Atlanta's .667 winning percentage with the series on the line also ranks second behind the Nationals (.688).

 The club has won 11 weekend series this season, tied with the Dodgers and Brewers for the highest total in MLB.

 The Braves have averaged more than 10 hits per game throughout their last 12 contests...The team has logged 122 hits in a 12-game span for just the fourth non-overlapping span since the beginning of the 2024 season.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Major League Baseball today announced Drake Baldwin as the National League Player of the Week...Within the voting period, the backstop led the majors in batting average (.714), on-base percentage (.733), slugging percentage (1.357), hits (10), runs (tied, 5), RBI (8, tied) and total bases (19).

 Baldwin is Atlanta's first Player of the Week winner this season and the first since Matt Olson won the award for the week of September 20 last season...Olson, Michael Harris II and Ronald Acuña Jr. each won the award last year...This is Baldwin's first career Player of the Week honor.

 He became the first NL player to record 10 hits and three home runs in a three-game series since Adrián González (LAD) in 2015...The Athletics' Nick Kurtz is the only other player, MLB-wide, to do so since then (2025)...The last major-league catcher to meet that criteria in a three-game series was Mike Piazza (LAD) in 1995.

 Per OptaSTATS, Baldwin became the youngest MLB player in the modern era (since 1900) with five-plus hits and two-plus home runs in a single game while appearing as a catcher (25 years, 113 days).

 Baldwin became the first Brave with five hits and multiple home runs in a game since Ozzie Albies on June 30, 2021...Albies and Baldwin are the only two Braves in the modern era to do so while also stealing a base.

 Only three other catchers have posted a five-hit game in modern franchise history: Biff Pocoroba (1982), Eddie Pérez (1999) and Johnny Estrada (2004).

RILEY HEATING UP: Austin Riley last night went 3-for-4 with two home runs and four RBI...He contributed his second multi-homer game of the season (also April 17 at PHI) and the 10th of his career.

 Riley's three hits matched his season high, which he's posted on four other occasions, most recently on June 22 against these San Diego Padres.

 Yesterday, his first home run took place in an 0-2 count, signifying his first 0-2 home run since August 1, 2024, versus Miami.

 Riley has 88 career extra-base hits in July, the second most in MLB since his debut in 2019 (Rafael Devers, 88)...He's tied with Matt Olson for the fourth most July home runs in that span (45).

 Both of his home runs yesterday left the bat at over 100 mph...Riley has at least one hit with an exit velocity of over 100 mph in five of his last six games since July 10, and is hitting .381 (8-for-21) with six runs scored, six RBI and a 1.290 OPS in that stretch.

 Today, Riley is penciled to bat cleanup in Atlanta's order...He hasn't batted higher than fifth in the lineup since May 18 versus Miami, when he hit fourth.

Makes his 19th start of the season and the 97th of his career, in the opener of a four-game series against San Diego at Truist Park...Atlanta is 10-8 in his 18 turns.
- 🔥

Makes his third career start against the Padres and his first appearance against the club since May 19, 2024...Is 0-2 with a 9.82 ERA (8 ER/7.1 IP) in two career starts vs. San Diego.
- 🔥

Has never earned a win against the Padres...His two previous starts against the club came on May 19, 2024 (3.0 IP, 9 H, 6 ER) and April 17, 2022 (4.1 IP, 3 H, 2 ER).
- 🔥

Takes the mound for the first time since July 9 at Pittsburgh and makes his first start at Truist Park since June 21.
- 🔥

Carries a 5-6 record and a 4.12 ERA (47 ER/102.2 IP) through 18 starts...Has posted an 86-to-32 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a 1.25 WHIP this season.
- 🔥

Has pitched to an 8.47 ERA (32 ER/34.0 IP) over his last seven starts, after opening the year with a 1.97 ERA (15 ER/68.2 IP) across his first 11 turns.
- 🔥

Left-handed batters are hitting .212 (53-for-250) with nine home runs against him this season, the 10th-lowest opponent average against lefties among qualified right-handed pitchers.
- 🔥

Right-handers are batting .297 (43-for-145) with six homers.
- 🔥

Has incorporated a cutter into his arsenal this season after not throwing the pitch across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25.
- 🔥

Throws it almost exclusively to left-handed batters, who account for 49 of the 54 at-bats he has ended with the offering...Opponents are batting .185 (10-for-54) against the pitch.
- 🔥

His four-seam fastball has averaged 91.2 mph over his four starts since June 8, down from 92.1 mph over his first 12 starts through May 31.
- 🔥

Is one of just five pitchers in Atlanta history to make at least six starts in March/April and compile an ERA under 2.00, joining Tom Glavine (1997, 2000, 2002), Greg Maddux (1994), Tim Hudson (2007) and Julio Teheran (2014)...Finished March/April with a 1.88 ERA (9 ER/43.0 IP) over seven starts.
- 🔥

Has recorded 10 quality starts in 18 outings this season.
- 🔥

Over his last 25 starts, dating to August 24 of last season, Elder is 8-8 with a 3.73 ERA (61 ER/147.1 IP) and a 1.17 WHIP...His 16 quality starts over the span are tied for the fourth-most in the majors, trailing only Miami's Sandy Alcantara (20), Los Angeles' (NL) Yoshinobu Yamamoto (19) and Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (18).

Since the start of the 2023 season, Atlanta is 48-39 in Elder's starts...His 87 starts for the Braves over the span lead the staff.

Received a no-decision July 9 at Pittsburgh, allowing four runs (three earned) on five hits over 4.0 innings in a 10-5 Atlanta win at PNC Park...Surrendered three home runs, matching his career high - solo shots to Bryan Reynolds and Enmanuel Valdez in the third inning and a two-run drive to Jack Mangum in the fourth.
- 🔥

Took the loss June 21 against Milwaukee, allowing a season-high eight earned runs on a career-high 12 hits over 6.0 innings in a 9-4 defeat at Truist Park...Surrendered all eight runs in the second inning, capped by William Contreras's two-out, three-run home run...Became the first Braves starter to allow eight or more earned runs while completing at least 6.0 innings since Terry Mulholland on May 19, 2000 against San Diego.

Has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 14 of his 18 starts this season.
- 🔥

His May 27 loss at Boston (3.1 IP, 5 ER) snapped an 11-start season-opening streak of allowing three earned runs or fewer, leaving him one of three Braves since 2013 to open a season with at least 11 such turns, joining Reynaldo López (17 in 2024) and Max Fried (11 in 2020).

Joined Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz and Michael Soroka as the only starters in Atlanta-franchise history to make the All-Star team in their second year playing.
- 🔥

Atlanta won 21 games started by Elder in his first full season with the Braves, the second most team victories on the season...Trailed only teammate Spencer Strider's 26 team wins that year.
- 🔥

Made six starts in his career of at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, the most such games in Braves franchise history (since 1900) in a player's first 25 starts...Irv Young (1905), Clif Curtis (1909-10) and Ian Anderson (*20-21) each had five such starts.
- 🔥

Was originally drafted by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas...Was the fifth member of the 2020 draft class to debut, and the lowest-selected pick to do so.
- 🔥

Of the first five members to play in the majors from the 2020 draft class, three were selected with the first 11 picks in the draft - Detroit's Spencer Torkelson (No. 1 overall), the Angels' Reid Detmers (No. 10) and the White Sox's Garrett Crochet (No. 11).

The other two were both selected by Atlanta, and chosen with the 126th (Spencer Strider) and 156th (Elder) overall selections.
