BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a season-long 10-game homestand tonight against the Blue Jays...Baltimore is 5-2 in the first seven games against Detroit (2-1), Tampa Bay (3-0), and Toronto (0-1)...Last night, the club had its three-game winning streak snapped.

- 👉 The O's fell to 13-23 when the opponent scores first and 4-8 in one-run games.
- 👉 Baltimore dropped to 4-29 when tied or trailing after seven innings.
- 👉 The two runs allowed are the fewest surrendered in a loss this season...The Birds had two such losses in 2025, both 1-0 defeats on August 12 vs. Seattle and August 1 at Chicago-NL.
- 👉 **Coby Mayo** hit his sixth home run of the year and fourth off a lefty last night...He's slashing .423/.464/1.000 (11-for-26) with three doubles, four home runs, and nine RBI against left-handed pitching since April 21.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles signed right-handed pitcher **Albert Suárez** to a one-year major league contract for the 2026 season, optioned right-hander **Cameron Weston** to Triple-A Norfolk, and transferred righty **Dean Kremer** (right quad strain) to the 60-day Injured List today.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: **Cameron Weston** made his major league debut in the ninth inning last night, tossing 1.0 scoreless frame with a strikeout...He's the fourth Oriole to make their debut this year, joining **Cameron Foster**, **Trey Gibson**, and **Anthony Nunez**.

- 👉 Weston became the 85th Oriole to toss at least 1.0 scoreless inning in their MLB debut, joining **Foster** (4/16 at CLE) and **Nunez** (3/28 vs. MIN) earlier this year.

START ME UP: Orioles starters have produced a 2.23 ERA (12 ER/48.1 IP) over the last nine games since May 19, the third-lowest mark in the AL during that period behind the Yankees (1.70) and Mariners (1.88), and the fifth lowest in the majors...The rotation has allowed two runs or fewer in eight of those games and one run in six...O's starting pitching produced a 5.24 ERA through May 18, the second-worst clip in the majors during that time ahead of the Rockies (5.62).

- 👉 Baltimore pitching has posted a 3.68 ERA at home compared to a 5.86 ERA on the road...It is the largest difference in MLB this season (-2.18, home better) and would be the largest difference in a single season in franchise history (since 1954), per *STATS Perform*.

BLAZING THE TRAIL: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .339/.371/.492 (20-for-59) with four doubles, one triple, one home run, six runs scored, 13 RBI, three walks (1 IBB), and three stolen bases in 23 games in May after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in 21 April games.

- 👉 His May batting average ranks fifth in MLB (min. 60 PA) behind TB's **Jonathan Aranda** (.375), MIA's **Otto Lopez** (.366), PHI's **Brandon Marsh** (.354), and SF's **Luis Arraez** (.352).

- 👉 Alexander tallied a career-high six RBI on Wednesday night against Tampa Bay...He's the second Oriole this year with a six-RBI game (**Rutschman**, 4/24 vs. BOS) after no Orioles had a game of 6+ RBI in 2025.

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .340/.329/.536 (32-for-94) with seven doubles, one triple, five homers, 15 runs scored, 18 RBI, and six walks in 29 games since April 20...Among players with at least 100 plate appearances during that time, he ranks among MLB leaders in batting average (4th), slugging percentage (5th), and OPS (8th, .972).

- 👉 He's hit safely in 18 of 22 starts since April 22...Basallo had a career-high 10-game hitting streak from May 5-17.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 49), doubles (T-5th, 15), times on base (T-4th, 102), and on-base percentage (T-5th, .400).

- 👉 According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in the majors in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2nd, .410).

- 👉 Ward has seen 1,122 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind WSH's **James Wood** (1,130)...He has seen 403 of those pitches in a 3-2 count, second in MLB behind CWS' **Munetaka Murakami** (414).

TWO OUT FOCUS: Baltimore pitching has held the opposition to a .184 batting average (14-for-76) with two outs over the last seven games since May 22...Prior to that stretch, opponents were batting .261 to begin the season...Overall, the Birds' .252 opponent average with two outs is second-highest in the majors ahead of the Angels (.268).

CAMDEN CONFINES: The Birds are 8-3 in their last 11 home games since May 10...Baltimore opened the season 9-11 at home.

- 👉 The Orioles are averaging 4.9 runs per game at home (151 R/31 G) compared to 4.0 (104 R/26 G) on the road...The club has posted a .739 OPS at Camden Yards and a .670 OPS on the road.

OFF TO THE RACES: Baltimore has stolen 15 bags in 17 games since May 10 after swiping 18 bags across its first 40 games...The 15 steals are tied for the AL lead during that time with the White Sox and tied for sixth in MLB...**Blaze Alexander**, **Gunnar Henderson**, and **Leody Taveras** are tied for the team lead with six steals.

JAYS FLY SOUTH: Baltimore and Toronto are meeting this week for the first of four series this season (13 total G)...The clubs are in the midst of seven games in 11 days with the Orioles traveling to Rogers Centre from June 5-7...The O's and Jays will not meet again until September 11-13 in Canada and September 21-23 at Oriole Park.

- 👉 Tonight, the O's look to snap a five-game losing skid against the Jays, their longest skid since a seven-game stretch from September 11 (G1), 2021-June 13, 2022.

- 👉 **Adley Rutschman** has slashed .319/.390/.583 (65-for-204) with 15 doubles, 13 home runs, and 39 RBI in 51 career games against the Blue Jays...His .973 OPS is the second highest by an Oriole all-time against Toronto (min. 150 PA) behind **Harold Baines** (1.071).

- 👉 Orioles broadcaster **Ben Wagner** was with the Blue Jays broadcast booth prior to joining the O's...Wagner was the voice of the Buffalo Bisons, Triple-A affiliate of Toronto, from 2007-17.

- 👉 On May 26 vs. Tampa Bay, **Blaze Alexander** reached on what was ruled an error on **Josh Palacios**...This has been changed to a single.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 10th start of the season and 112th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his six consecutive loss on May 24 (G2) at Detroit after allowing four runs on four hits (1 HR) and two walks with two strikeouts over 4.2 innings...Threw 90 pitches, 57 strikeouts.

⚡ Is 0-6 with an 11.03 ERA (29 ER/23.2 IP), .349 (37-for-106) opponent average, and 2.07 WHIP over his last six starts after going 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP), .214 (15-for-70) opponent average, and 1.05 WHIP in his first three starts of 2026.

⚡ Opposing left-handed hitters are 6-for-20 (.300) with one double, one home run, and six RBI off Rogers over his last three starts after going a combined 2-for-22 (.091) with two doubles over his first six outings.

BLUE JAY WAY: Rogers has made three career starts vs. Toronto, going 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA (5 ER/15.0 IP)...Last faced the Blue Jays on September 12, 2025 at Rogers Centre, where he allowed one unearned run on three hits and four walks in 5.0 innings.

⚡ Has made 20 career starts against AL East opponents, going 4-7 with a 4.27 ERA (44 ER/92.2 IP)...Is on a four-start losing streak against the division dating back to September 26, 2025, over which he holds a 16.05 ERA (22 ER/12.1 IP).

STREAK ENDS TODAY: Rogers has taken a loss in a career-high six consecutive starts, which is the longest active run in the majors this season...It marks the longest losing streak as a starter by an Oriole since Charlie Morton lost six straight starts from March 28-May 7, 2025.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: Opponents are slashing .415/.472/.569 (27-for-65) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, and 21 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

⚡ His 1.041 opponent OPS with two outs is third highest in MLB (min. 50 BF) ahead of CIN's Brady Singer (1.066) and AZ's Merrill Kelly (1.052).

UNDER THE HOOD: Rogers' hard-hit rate is down 11.3 percent from 2025, going from 48.4 percent to 37.1...The 11.3 percent decrease is the fourth-largest year-over-year decrease among all qualified MLB starters behind CLE's Slade Cecconi (-14.1%), LAA's José Soriano (-11.9%), and ATH's J.T. Ginn (-11.6%).

⚡ Opponents are 16-for-62 (.258) with four doubles and three home runs off his four-seamer after going 22-for-139 (.158) with two doubles, one triple, and three homers off the offering in 2025.

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of Dave McNally (1.95 ERA, 1968) and Jim Palmer (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).
