THE TWINS: Have gone 2-4 through six games on their current seven-game roadtrip, splitting 2-2 in Detroit, followed by consecutive losses to the Orioles in Baltimore over the last two nights...today, Minnesota will play the three-game series finale at Camden Yards...after today's game, the Twins will travel back to Minneapolis...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then begin a seven-game homestand on Friday with three against the Tigers over the weekend, then four against the White Sox from Monday-next Thursday.

THAT REALLY GOT OUT OF HAND FAST: The Twins lost to the Orioles last night at Camden Yards by a score of 11-3...Chris Paddack (0-1) was the starter and loser, allowing a career-high nine earned runs on a career-high 12 hits in 5.1 innings pitched...Twins pitchers combined to allow a season-high 15 hits, while the 11 runs allowed tied a season high (previously March 31 at KC)...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Ryan Jeffers...Byron Buxton went 1-for-3 and hit his first triple of the season, driving in a run on the play.

CHARM CITY: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the third of six games in 2024...Minnesota will host the O's for three games to complete the regular season from September 27-29.

☞ Minnesota has lost six straight vs. the Orioles, their longest losing streak to Baltimore since August 22, 2011-April 8, 2012, when they dropped seven-in-a-row.

☞ The Twins are 38-23 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.

☞ Since 2018, the Twins have hit 57 home runs in 34 games against the Orioles, their most vs. any opponent outside of the AL Central.

☞ Christian Vázquez has 40 career hits at Camden Yards, his most of any opposing ballpark.

BUCK AND THE BIRDS: Byron Buxton has hit safely in 12-straight games at Oriole Park at Camden Yards, hitting .333 (16-for-48) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.018 OPS in that span...it marks the longest active streak in Baltimore for any major league player...it also is the longest for a Twin in club history...below are the top four hitting streaks for a Twin at this ballpark:

THE LAST DANCE: The Twins are looking to avoid being swept for the second time this season...the other sweep was in two games at Target Field by the Guardians April 4 and 6; the April 7th game was postponed due to rain, giving the Twins no chance to salvage the series finale...Minnesota was swept five times last season, four of which came on the road...one of the sweeps came at the hands of the Orioles in three games at Target Field from July 7-9...the last time they were swept at Camden Yards was to open the 2016 season from April 4-7 (3 games).

JEFF YEAH: Ryan Jeffers has gone 11-for-23 (.478) on this trip, hitting four doubles, one home run with six RBI and a 1.283 OPS...Jeffers enters today with a seven-game hitting streak; his career high is 14, done from July-August of 2023...during his current streak, he is hitting .462 (12-for-26) with four doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, a .481 on-base percentage, an .846 slugging percentage and a 1.328 OPS...additionally, among all AL catchers (as primary position), his 11 RBI on the season are tied with Jonah Heim for second most, trailing Salvador Perez (15).

BROCK WITH YOU: Brock Stewart has begun the season with seven-straight scoreless appearances (7.0 IP), allowing four hits with eight strikeouts...he has not allowed a hit to a right-handed batter (0-for-11)...Stewart's last run allowed came on a Jose Altuve grand slam on May 29, 2023 at Houston...he enters today with a 19.2-scoreless inning streak, the third-longest active streak in baseball, trailing Brusdar Graterol (25.0) and Paul Blackburn (21.1) - *Elias*...since the start of last season, he leads baseball in ERA at 0.52 among all pitchers with a minimum of 30.0 innings pitched.

☞ He ranks in the 93rd percentile in baseball in average fastball velocity (97.2 mph).

MIC DROPS: Orioles-related notes on Bally Sports North analyst Glen Perkins and Twins radio analyst Paul Molitor.

☞ Glen Perkins made his second and third career appearances in this ballpark on September 23-24, 2006, pitching 0.2 innings in the first game and 0.0 with one hit allowed in the second game...Perk earned his second-to-last career win at Camden on August 23, 2015 in a Twins 4-3 12-inning victory...he pitched the 11th inning as the Twins took the lead, then proven closer Tommy Milone saved the game in the 12th.

☞ Paul Molitor played in 35 career games at Camden Yards and hit safely in each of his first seven games here from June 29, 1992-June 28, 1993...Mollie hit one career home run in this ballpark, coming on August 23, 1997, a two-run shot off Terry Mathews...additionally, he played his first career road game in Baltimore at Memorial Stadium on April 14, 1978, going 1-for-4 with two RBI and a run scored...his first career home run came against the Orioles at County Stadium in Milwaukee, a three-run shot off Joe Kerrigan on April 8, 1978.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2018, the Twins played host to Cleveland in San Juan, Puerto Rico at Hiram Bithorn Stadium...it was game one of a two-game series on the island...the Twins lost by a score of 6-1 as Jake Odorizzi was the starter and loser, allowing four runs in 5.0 innings pitched, including a home run to Puerto Rico native Francisco Lindor...the game was played in front of 19,516 fans...in 2009, Jason Kubel became the ninth Twin (11 now) to hit for the cycle against Los Angeles-AL in the Metrodome...he went 4-for-5 in the game, doubling in his first at-bat (1st inning), singling in his second at-bat (3rd inning), tripling in his third at-bat (6th inning) and completing the cycle with a grand slam in his fifth at-bat, capping off a seven-run inning and giving the Twins an 11-9 lead and eventual win...he became the third player in 100 years to finish a cycle with a grand slam (Yankees Tony Lazzeri in 1932 and Oakland's Miguel Tejada in 2001).
