FOR DADS: Today, the D-backs will celebrate Father's Day as the first 15,000 dads receive a Diamondbacks Polo presented by Budweiser...the team will offer dad-approved dishes, including a St. Louis Rib Sandwich, Brisket Burnt End Nachos, Big Kid Mac Dog and Triple Threat BBQ Sandwich.

LAST GAME: The D-backs scored 5 runs in the ninth inning en route to an 8-7 walk-off win vs. Padres and extended their win streak to a season-high-tying 5 games (also: April 12-17), outscoring opponents, 36-to-17.

- · Marked the third time the D-backs have come back from a 4+ run deficit in the ninth inning this season [source: OptaSTATS].
- Geraldo Perdomo hit a game-tying 3-run triple in the ninth inning...scored the game-winning run on Josh Naylor's fielder's choice to Luis Arraez.
- Eugenio Suarez hit a go-ahead 3-run homer (20) in the fourth inning.
- Zac Gallen posted a no-decision after allowing 4 runs in 6.1 innings with 4 walks and 6 strikeouts.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs signed RHP Anthony De-Sclafani to a Major League contract, optioned RHP Bryce Jarvis to Triple-A Reno after last night's game and transferred RHP Justin Martinez to the 60-day injured list (sprained right ulnar collateral ligament).

D-BACKS ROTATION: The D-backs' starting rotation during the team's 5-game winning streak, has gone 5-0 with a 2.51 ERA (8 ER in 28.2 IP), 9 walks and 25 strikeouts.

JUNE BLOOM: The D-backs are 9-3 in their last 12 games, tied with the Astros for the Majors' best record in June.

HOME WIN STREAK TO START MONTH: The D-backs' 6-game winning streak at home to start the month is tied for the second-longest in team history (also: May 1-6, 2006) behind 11 straight (May 5-27, 2000) [Source: Elias Sports Bureau].

NINTH-INNING COMEBACKS: The D-backs' 3 comeback wins from a ninth-inning deficit of 4+ runs are the most by any team before the All-Star Break since 1933, when the All-Star Game began [source: OptaSTATS].

9 IS FINE: The D-backs have homered in a season-high 9 straight games since June 5, the longest active MLB streak...their 17 homers in that span are tied for second in MLB (also: Reds), behind the Mets (20).

- Is tied for their fifth-longest single-season streak since 2023 (also: May 15-24, 2023).
- · Have homered in 12 of their last 13 since May 31, including 8 multi-homer games...their 24 homers rank second in MLB (Mets 30).

HOME RUN TANDEM: The D-backs are the only team with multiple players with 20+ homers before the All-Star break, Corbin Carroll (20) and Eugenio Suárez (20).

• Are the third D-back duo with 20+ homers before the AS break (Jay Bell 24 and Matt Williams 23 in 1999; Paul Goldschmidt 20 and Jake Lamb 20 in 2017).

GETTIN' RISP-Y: Among NL teams with runners in scoring position since June 1 (12 G), the D-backs are first in AVG (.307), OBP (.402), SLG (.636), OPS (1.038) and second in home runs (7), extra-base hits (13) and total bases (56).

SLUG SURGE: Among NL teams since June 5, the D-backs are third with a .480 SLG (Mets .516, Rockies .504) and .819 OPS (Mets .883, Rockies .855), tied for second with 17 homers (also: Reds), behind the Mets (20) and tied for third with 29 extra-base hits (also: Cubs, Reds), behind the Mets (35) and Rockies (30).

VS. PADRES: Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 13 of his last 14 home games vs. Padres, with an .869 OPS/.350 OBP (15 H, 5 BB, 1 HBP), 2 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers and 8 RBI.

• Lourdes Gurriel Jr., has hit safely in 9 of his last 10 games vs. Padres, batting .395 (15-for-38)/1.073 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers and 7 RBI.

VS. NL WEST: Lourdes Gurriel Jr., in his last 10 starts, is hitting .333 (13-for-39)/.973 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer and 5 RBI, including 5 multi-hit efforts.

- Gabriel Moreno, in his last 25 games, is hitting .340 (32-for-94)/.929 OPS with 7 doubles, 4 homers, 17 RBI and 7 walks.
- Ketel Marte has reached base safely in his last 10 games (.958 OPS, .575 SLG, 4 HR, 7 RBI).

DOWN IN THE 'PEN: Shelby Miller has 14 scoreless home outings (13.2 IP, 8 H, 4 BB, 16).

- Jalen Beeks has held opponents scoreless in 13 of his last 16 games, going 1-0 with a 3.95 ERA (6 ER in 13.2 IP) opponent .212 AVG (11-for-52)/.639 OPS.
- Juan Morillo has held opponents scoreless in 9 of his last 11 games (3.72 ERA, 4 ER in 9.2 IP) with an opponent .212 AVG (7-for-33)/.699 OPS.

26 STRAIGHT FOR MARTE: Ketel Marte's season-best 26game on-base streak since May 13, is the second-longest active MLB streak, behind Jose Ramírez/CLE (39 G).

- Is his second longest career streak (30-gamer, April 26-June 1, 2023).
- In the span, is hitting .313 (31-for-99)/1.044 OPS with 2 doubles, 9 homers, 18 RBI and 18 walks.

ON DECK - TORONTO BLUE JAYS: The D-backs will face the Blue Jays for the fifth time on Toronto (2004, '16, '19, '23).

- The D-backs won 2 of 3 @ Chase Field in 2024, outscoring the Blue Jays, 24-13.
- The D-backs are 6-5 all-time @ Blue Jays.

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (8-4, 5.50)

- Tied for the NL lead with 8 wins (also: Robbie Ray/SF).
- Won his last start on June 10 vs. Mariners, allowing 2 runs in 5.0 innings with 1 walk and 4 strikeouts.
- Will make his first career appearance vs. Blue Jays.

In 4 home starts from Sept. 3, 2019-April 8, 2022, went 3-0 with a 0.38 ERA (1 ER in 23.2 IP), opponent .169 AVG, 0.93 WHIP and 28 strikeouts.

WILD, WILD, NL WEST: Has 7 quality starts in his last 10, going 6-1 with a 2.52 ERA (20 R-18 ER in 64.1 IP) and 70 strikeouts.

• In 3 of his last 5 starts, has allowed 2 or fewer runs over 7.0 innings.

SUCCESS IN THE WEST: In 3 starts (all quality) vs. NL West and AL West opponents, is 2-0 with a 0.45 ERA (1 ER in 20.0 IP), opponent .191 AVG, 0.90 WHIP, 5 walks and 26 strikeouts.

GIVE 'EM THE CHANGEUP: His 51.2 chase pct. on his changeup ranks best in the Majors among starting pitchers (min. 100 pitches), ahead of Gavin Williams/CLE (50.0), Tarik Skubal/DET (49.3) and Paul Skenes/

"That's the pitch I go to when I need something, it always has been... When it's on, it's one of the pitches I go to when I need one. If I can locate it, it's a super tough pitch to hit for a couple different reasons. It looks like the fastball, similar speed as the fastball, and I try to make it look like the fastball as much as I can."

CUTTING EDGE: His .100 AVG off his cutter is lowest among starting pitchers, ahead of Max Fried (.111) and MacKenzie Gore/WSH (.130).

STAY AHEAD: When ahead in the count, is holding batters to a .101 AVG (11-for-109) with 0 walks and 40 strikeouts.

FROM THE SECOND TIME ON: His .187 opponent AVG (35-for-187) from the second time thru the order on ranks fifth among NL starters.

PICKOFF PROWESS: His 11 pickoffs since 2022 are tied with Robbie Ray/SF for fifth among starting pitchers, behind Taijuan Walker (15), Patrick Corbin (14), Max Fried/NYY (12) and Charlie Morton/BAL (12).

CLIMBING THE FRANCHISE LIST: His 823 career strikeouts rank seventh on the club's all-time strikeouts list, behind Randy Johnson (2,077), Brandon Webb (1,065), Robbie Ray (998), Zac Gallen (923), Patrick Corbin (897) and Curt Schilling (875).

2024 RECAP: Went 5-1 with a 4.17 ERA (38 R-36 ER in 77.2 IP) and 65 strikeouts over 13 starts in his sixth season with the D-backs.

- Placed on the 15-day injured list (right shoulder strain) on April 23... transferred to the 60-day injured list on May 2...reinstated from the 60-day injured list (right shoulder strain) on Aug. 11.
- Since Aug. 11, his 13.86 strikes looking above average (SLAA) and his 111.5 pct. strikes looking rate vs. Average (SL+) were the highest among NL starters.
- Threw 6 different pitches 10+ times each (first time in career).

CONSECUTIVE 5.0+-INNING STREAK: His 38 consecutive starts of 5.0+ innings from April 6, 2023-Sept. 5, 2024 marked the second longest streak in the Majors since 2022, behind only Mitch Keller (49 straight starts; April 5, 2023-July 8, 2024).

POSTSEASON WARRIOR: In Game 2 of the World Series @ Rangers on Oct. 28, 2023, became the fourth D-backs pitcher (5 times overall) to allow 1 run or fewer over 7.0+ innings in a World Series start (also: Randy Johnson, Curt Schilling [2x] and Miguel Batista...additionally, his 9 strikeouts tied Schilling for second-most strikeouts in a World Series game by a D-backs starter behind Johnson's 11 strikeouts.

· Also retired the first 11 batters, surpassing the record for most consecutive batters retired by a D-backs pitcher to start a World Series game (prev: 10 by Randy Johnson on Oct. 28, 2001 in Game 2 vs. Yankees) [Elias Sports Bureau].

USA! USA!: Selected to pitch for Team USA in the 2023 World Baseball Classic, his the first time pever articipating with a national team.

- Went 0-1 with an 8.31 ERA (4 ER in 4.1 IP) over 2 games.
- Started the fourth game vs. Colombia and championship vs. Japan.

ARIZONA KID: Grew up in Scottsdale, Ariz., and attended Desert Mountain High School, Yavapai College and Arizona State University... attended Arizona State University (2010) and helped the Sun Devils reach the College World Series in 2010...went to Yavapai College in Prescott, Ariz.
