The 2024 Baltimore Orioles Media Guide, as well as the latest game notes, rosters, press releases, and other team information, can be found at oriolespressbox.com.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles used a five-run first inning to beat the Mariners, 9-2, in the series opener...**Gunnar Henderson** hit a leadoff homer while **Colton Cowser** added a two-run double in the opening frame...**John Means** surrendered two runs over 6.0 innings to earn his second win of the season and first at Oriole Park since April 25, 2021.

Ø The first five batters scored to start the game, the first time the Birds have done that since the first six scored to begin July 30, 2023 vs. New York-AL.

Ø **Jorge Mateo** and Henderson tripled to begin the seventh inning, the first time the Orioles have hit back-to-back triples since July 3, 2008 vs. Kansas City (4th inning, **Adam Jones** & **Brandon Fahey**); **Adley Rutschman** and pinch-hitter **Austin Hays** followed with doubles, marking the first time the team has hit four consecutive extra-base hits since September 23, 2018 at New York (6th inning, **Trey Mancini**, **Tim Beckham**, **Renato Núñez**, & **Joey Rickard**).

LEADING ACTORS: **Gunnar Henderson** and **Jordan Westburg** have hit leadoff homers the last two games, the sixth time in O's history (since 1954) the team has hit a leadoff homer in at least two consecutive team games and for the first time since **Melvin Mora** did it from June 28-29, 2002...**Brady Anderson** homered in four straight games from April 18-21, 1996, the only time in Orioles history the team has hit a leadoff home run in more than two straight team games...Anderson also did so in both games of a doubleheader on August 21, 1999 vs. Chicago-AL, **Pete Stanicek** and **Ken Gerhart** did so from June 22-23, 1988 at Toronto, and **Al Bumbry** did so on August 4-5, 1982 vs. Boston and vs. Kansas City.

Ø Baltimore leads MLB with five leadoff homers this season; Henderson's four leadoff home runs are tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB this year.

WHAT'S TRENDING: At 28-14 (.667), the Orioles have the second-best record in the AL and third-best in MLB behind the Yankees (.674, 31-15) and Phillies (.696, 32-14)...Since the start of 2022, Baltimore is 212-154 (.579), the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.585, 216-153), Braves (.633, 231-134), and Dodgers (.650, 241-130).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 65 home runs, the second-most homers through the first 42 games of a season in O's history behind 1987 (66)...The most through Baltimore's first 43 games of a season is 67 in 1987.

Ø The Orioles have an MLB-best seven players with at least six homers: **Gunnar Henderson** (13), **Adley Rutschman** (9), **Anthony Santander** and **Jordan Westburg** (7), and **Colton Cowser**, **Ryan Mountcastle**, and **Cedric Mullins** (6); the Yankees rank second with five players with at least six long balls.

Ø Henderson's 13 home runs are tied for the MLB lead with Houston's Kyle Tucker and Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani; he is the eighth Oriole with at least 13 home runs in the team's first 42 games and the first since Manny Machado in 2018 (also 13).

THE ERAS TOUR: The O's have an MLB-best 2.12 ERA (33 ER/140.0 IP) in their last 15 games since April 29...During that time, the Birds have surrendered an MLB-low 92 hits while holding opponents to a .186 batting average (92-for-494)...The 2.12 ERA is the best mark in a 15-game span in a single season by the Orioles since September 6-21, 2014 (2.06).

BIG TIME RUTSCH: **Adley Rutschman** enters today ranked third in the AL in hits (55), fourth in batting average (.318), and tied for sixth in total bases (89)...He is tied for the AL lead and tied for second in MLB in multi-hit games (18).

Ø Rutschman has hit safely in 22 of his last 24 games since April 19 and 27 of his last 30 since April 11; for the season, he has reached safely in 35 of his 41 games and has a hit in 34 of those.

Ø He has an extra-base hit in four straight games, matching his career high set earlier this season from May 2-5; he had his three-game home run streak snapped last night. Since April 19, he's slashing .346/.364/.625 (36-for-104) with five doubles, eight homers, 14 runs, 21 RBI, three walks (1 IBB), and a stolen base; over that period, he leads the AL in batting average and hits, ranks second in total bases (65), tied for second in homers, and third in RBI.

Ø Rutschman had a career-long 11-game hitting streak from April 19-30, the longest by an O's batter this season.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue their season-long eight-game homestand today with the second of three games against the Mariners (was originally a nine-game homestand before Tuesday's game was postponed due to inclement weather)...Baltimore is 4-2 so far after winning last night, splitting a weather-shortened two-game set with Toronto earlier this week, and taking two of three against Arizona over the weekend.

Ø Since the start of 2023, the O's are 65-41 (.613) at Oriole Park, the second-best home record in the AL (TB, 67-40, .626) and the fifth-best mark at home in MLB.

AGAINST SEATTLE: The O's and Mariners meet for the first time this season this weekend at Camden Yards...Following these three games, the Birds will travel to Seattle from July 2-4 to complete the season series...Baltimore went 4-2 against the M's in 2023, with three of those games going to extra innings and another being decided by one run.

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: With today's game, the Orioles will extend their sweepless streak to 106 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties), which will pass the 1903-05 New York Giants for the third-longest such streak in MLB history...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Baltimore's current streak trails only the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124) and 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115)...During this current stretch, the O's have now avoided being swept in the final game of a series 14 times: May 15 vs. Toronto (2G), May 8, 2024 at Washington (2G), April 14, 2024 vs. Milwaukee (3G), August 10, 2023 vs. Houston (3G), July 19, 2023 vs. Los Angeles-NL (3G), July 2, 2023 vs. Minnesota (3G), June 18, 2023 at Chicago-NL (3G), June 8, 2023 at Milwaukee (3G), May 28, 2023 vs. Texas (3G), September 21, 2022 vs. Detroit (3G), September 18, 2022 at Toronto (3G), July 3, 2022 at Minnesota (3G), June 11, 2022 at Kansas City (3G), and May 19, 2022 vs. New York-AL (4G)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: **Gunnar Henderson** and **Colton Cowser** were voted American League Player and Rookie of the Month, respectively, for March/April...It marks the first time in team history that the O's claimed both awards in the same month.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles reinstated right-handed pitcher **Grayson Rodriguez** from the 15-day Injured List (right shoulder inflammation)...He will start today's game...In a corresponding move, right-handed pitcher **Mike Baumann** was designated for assignment.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Oriole manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 343 wins rank fifth all-time among Oriole managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his seventh start of the season this afternoon and the first of his career against Seattle...Activated from the 15-day Injured List prior to today's game (right shoulder inflammation), retroactive to April 30...Posted a 7-4 record and 4.35 ERA (59 ER/122.0 IP) across 23 starts in his rookie campaign last year...Began last season with Triple-A Norfolk before being promoted and making his MLB debut on April 5 at Texas...Optioned to Norfolk on May 27...Recalled on July 17 for the remainder of the season...Originally selected by the Orioles in the first round (No. 11 overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up the win, his fourth of the season, on April 29 vs. New York-AL...Allowed five hits and three walks with three strikeouts across 5.2 shutout innings; has now tossed 12.0 consecutive scoreless innings against the Yankees to begin his career...Threw 101 pitches, 54 strikes; the 101 pitches tie a career high (5/9/23 vs. TB).

AGAINST THE MARINERS AND THE AL WEST: Facing the Mariners for the first time in his career and the AL West for the ninth time...Allowed seven runs on 11 hits (1 HR) and one walk with seven strikeouts in 4.1 innings in his last start against an AL West foe on April 23 at Los Angeles-AL...Owns a lifetime 2-3 record with an 8.22 ERA (35 ER/38.1 IP) in his eight prior regular season starts against the division; also faced the Rangers in Game 2 of the 2023 ALDS, allowing five runs on six hits and four walks with strikeouts in 1.2 innings...Across the nine regular season and Postseason starts, AL West opponents are slashing a combined .341/.411/.549 (59-for-173).

HOME SWEET HOME: Owns a 3-0 record with a 1.53 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP) across his three home starts this season...Has not received the loss in a home regular season start since May 26, 2023 vs. Texas.

DAY 'N' NITE: Owns a 2-0 record with a 2.19 ERA (3 ER/12.1 IP) across both of his afternoon starts this season, compared to a 2-1 record with a 4.57 ERA (11 ER/21.2 IP) in his four night starts.

GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS: In Rodriguez's 10 starts in his initial stint with the club in 2023, he notched a 7.35 ERA (37 ER/45.1 IP)...After being optioned to Norfolk, he returned to Baltimore on July 17 and posted a 2.58 ERA (22 ER/76.2 IP) across his remaining 13 starts...Has posted 10 quality starts in his last 17 outings, dating back to July 28, 2023...Did not register a quality start in his first 12 outings to begin his career.

GAS 'EM UP: Punched out 129 batters for the O's last season, the most for an Orioles rookie since 2012 (Wei-Yin Chen, 154)...His mark ranks sixth among rookies in team history (since 1954)...He became the 20th rookie pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 100 batters.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Rodriguez opened last season with the Norfolk Tides, earning the nod as their Opening Day starter...Recalled by the Orioles on April 5, making his MLB debut in a start at Texas...Marked the first of six Orioles to make their big-league debut last year...Earned his first career win on April 29 (G2) at Detroit, throwing 5.0 shutout innings and striking out nine...Tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings on September 16 vs. Tampa Bay, tied for the longest outing by an Oriole in 2023; at 23 years old, 304 days old, became the youngest O's starter to work 8.0 scoreless frames since Zack Britton (23-141) tossed a shutout on May 12, 2011 vs. Seattle, and the youngest rookie right-hander to do since Brad Bergesen (23-257) worked 8.0 scoreless on June 9, 2009 vs. Seattle.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 2 of the ALDS against the Rangers on October 8...Allowed five runs on six hits and four walks across 1.2 innings...Marked the most runs that Rodriguez had surrendered since May 26 when he allowed eight, also against the Rangers.
