$\Phi$ Mauer made his major league debut in 2004 and is the first Hall of Famer to play his entire career in the 2000s (debuted in 2004)... क Mauer is one of just eight single-team HOFers to play entire career in home state, joining Whitey Ford (New York), Lou Gehrig (New York), Charlie Gehringer (Michigan), Tony Gwynn (California), Barry Larkin (Ohio), Cal Ripken Jr. (Maryland) and 'Phil Rizzuto (New $\Phi$ Mauer is also one of 22 retired MVPs to play their entire career of 15 -plus seasons with one franchise - all are in the HOF.
