THE TWINS: Began the post-All-Star break portion of their schedule with a loss to the Brewers last night...this afternoon, they will continue their five-game homestand with the second of two against Milwaukee...tomorrow night, they will welcome the Phillies for a three-game series from Monday night-Wednesday afternoon.

☞ Minnesota has gone 47-30 (.610) in its last 77 games since April 22, the most wins in the AL and second most in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (48-28, .632).

☞ The Twins are 27-19 (.587) at home this season, owning the fourth-best home winning percentage in the American League...Twins have won 10 of their last 15 home games since June 12.

ADJUST YOUR BUNNY EARS: Today's Border Battle season series finale will be streamed live and free on The Roku Channel, as part of Major League Baseball's Sunday Leadoff deal with Roku...Bally Sports North's Cory Provus (play-by-play) will have the call, along with Bally Sports Wisconsin's Tim Dillard (analysis) and Sophia Minnaert (sideline).

OFF WISCONSIN, TWINS FALL TO THE CREW: The Twins lost to the Brewers last night in 12 innings by a score of 8-4, a game that was tied at 1-1 through 10 innings...the loss made them 4-4 in extras in 2024...Pablo López was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...Minnesota used six relievers as Steven Okert (3-1) was dealt the loss, allowing three runs (2 earned) in the 11th and 12th inning...the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by Carlos Santana, who hit his 14th home run of the season, tying the game at 3-3 in the 11th inning.

THE BATTLE OF I-94: The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the fourth and final time this season...Twins are 1-2 against Milwaukee this season after splitting a two-game series at American Family Field from April 2-3, followed by last night's loss...the Twins are 243-235 all-time against the Brewers (since 1970) and are 70-61 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998.

☞ Willi Castro is a career .385 (15-for-39) hitter with two doubles, two triples, five RBI, seven runs scored and a .929 OPS in 13 games against the Brewers.

☞ Carlos Santana is hitting .302 (13-for-43) with three doubles, three home runs, six RBI, five walks and a .956 OPS in his last 11 games against the Brewers.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins are 10-11 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona and 1-2 at San Francisco.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .329 (24-for-73) with two doubles, five home runs, 13 RBI, a .562 slugging percentage and a .937 OPS in 19 games against the NL this season...his OPS ranks 11th-best among AL players (min. 70 PAs)...his batting average ranks ninth.

☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with four doubles in 12 games vs. the NL this season.

BUCK TRUCK: Byron Buxton is hitting .362 (38-for-105) with 11 doubles, one triple, six home runs, 22 RBI, six walks, 25 runs scored, a .414 on-base percentage and a 1.071 OPS in his last 29 games, since June 7...since that date, he ranks among the major league leaders (min. 100 at-bats) in batting average (3rd) and OPS (3rd)...he also leads the Twins this season in average exit velocity (91.7 mph - t-1st with Trevor Larnach) and hard hit percent (47.8%).

☞ Buxton also has multiple hits in nine of his last 16 games, since June 25; he's hitting .421 (24-for-57) with nine doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, four walks, 18 runs scored, a .477 on-base percentage and a 1.319 OPS in that span, in which the Twins are 10-6.

EVERYONE, ALL HERE, ALL AT ONCE: Last night's attendance was 41,679, the highest in Target Field's history for a regular season baseball event...the previous high was 41,378 on July 2, 2011 vs. Milwaukee...Target Field also surpassed the 1-million mark for 2024.

☞ The highest attended event in the ballpark's history was Pink's "Summer Carnival" Tour, drawing 44,627 on August 10, 2023.

☞ The largest two-game series in Target Field history was 77,887 from May 10-11, 2011 vs. Detroit.

LET'S NOT DO THAT: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the sixth time in 2024...their previous five sweeps were April 4-6 vs. Cleveland (2 games - PPD/weather-shortened series), April 15-17 at Baltimore (3 games), May 14-16 vs. New York-AL (3 games), May 17-19 vs. Cleveland (3 games) and June 4-6 at New York-AL (3 games).

☞ The last time the Twins were swept in Interleague Play was by the Brewers in two games from August 22-23, 2023 at American Family Field...the last time the Twins were swept in Minnesota by the Brewers was in two games from June 24-25, 1998.

BASEBALL IM-MAUER-TALITY: Twins legend Joe Mauer will be formally enshrined in the National Baseball Hall of Fame this afternoon, with a ceremony starting at 12:30pm CT on the grounds of the Clark Sports Center...the 2009 American League Most Valuable Player spent his entire 15-season career with his hometown Twins...some notes about Mauer's career and induction, courtesy of MLB Network.

☞ Mauer is the third catcher elected to HOF on first ballot (Johnny Bench, Ivan Rodriguez)...he is also the fourth player to make HOF after being drafted first overall (Ken Griffey Jr., Chipper Jones, Harold Baines).

☞ Mauer made his major league debut in 2004 and is the first Hall of Famer to play his entire career in the 2000s (debuted in 2004)...he is also the first player born in the 1980s to enter Cooperstown (born in 1983).

☞ Mauer is one of just eight single-team HOFers to play entire career in home state, joining Whitey Ford (New York), Lou Gehrig (New York), Charlie Gehringer (Michigan), Tony Gwynn (California), Barry Larkin (Ohio), Cal Ripken Jr. (Maryland) and Phil Rizzuto (New York)...only Harmon Killebrew (1,329) played more games in a Minnesota Twins uniform than Mauer (1,858).

☞ Mauer is also one of 22 retired MVPs to play their entire career of 15-plus seasons with one franchise — all are in the HOF.

- ☞ Making his second career start vs. Milwaukee...in his previous start on July 13, 2022, he logged 5.1 innings, allowing one run on two hits (1 HR), two walks and three strikeouts...didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-1 win.
- ☞ Ranks fourth among qualified pitchers with a 6.53 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched July 12 at San Francisco...took his sixth loss of the season in a 7-1 Twins loss, allowing five runs on six hits in 5.1 innings, with three walks and six strikeouts...allowed three runs in the first two innings...pitched scoreless third and fourth innings before runs in innings 5-6...collected his 500th career strikeout in the third inning on a swinging strike to Heliot Ramos.
☞ Season-high three walks.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start July 6 vs. Houston and earned his sixth win of the season in a 9-3 Twins win...started his day by striking out two of the first three batters he faced and tossing back-to-back scoreless innings...allowed his first run of the game on a Alex Bregman double with two outs in the third inning...gave up a two-run home run to Jon Singleton in the fourth inning...pitched a scoreless fifth inning before exiting the game in the sixth inning with bases loaded; was relieved by Jorge Alcala, who stranded all three inherited runners...allowed three runs on five hits (1 HR), one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.2 innings.
☞ 110 pitches tied the second most in a start in his career, also doing so on August 9, 2022; career high is 112 on June 22, 2023 (his complete-game shutout).

VS. MILWAUKEE: Facing the Milwaukee Brewers for the second time in his career.
☞ In his previous start on July 13, 2022, he logged 5.1 innings, allowing one run on two hits (1 HR), two walks and three strikeouts...didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-1 win.
☞ Making his fifth Interleague start of the season...in his prior four starts he is 1-2, 3.91 ERA (25.1 IP, 11 ER), seven walks, 25 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .191 (17-for-89) opponent batting average...making 18th career Interleague start; in previous 17 he is 6-8, 5.94 ERA (89.1 IP, 59 ER), 26 walks, 98 strikeouts, a 1.33 WHIP and a .263 (93-for-354) opponent batting average.

BACK AT HOME: Through nine home starts in 2024, Ryan has gone 4-3 with a 3.81 ERA (54.1 IP, 23 ER), seven walks, 58 strikeouts and eight home runs allowed, compared to 2-3, 3.28 ERA (60.1 IP, 22 ER), 12 walks, 66 strikeouts and eight home runs in 10 road starts.
☞ In 41 career home starts, he is 18-12, 3.69 ERA (234.1 IP, 96 ER), 55 walks, 274 strikeouts and 19 quality starts...Twins are 23-18 in Ryan's 41 home starts.
☞ Since making his debut in 2021, he leads Twins pitchers with 18 home wins...has four home wins this season, which is tied with Bailey Ober and Chris Paddack for the team lead.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .208/.246/.377 with eight home runs, nine walks and 56 strikeouts in 224 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .235/.277/.434 with eight home runs, 10 walks and 68 strikeouts in 235 plate appearances.
☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .208 (169-for-814) with 32 doubles, five triples, 28 home runs and a .632 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .240 (213-for-886) with 53 doubles, three triples, 44 home runs and a .740 OPS.
☞ In his last start against San Francisco, left-handed hitters went 3-for-10 with two walks and two strikeouts...right-handed hitters went 3-for-10 with one walk and four strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in 19 starts this season...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and sweeper the most, combining to throw the two pitches 68.3 percent of the time in his last start against San Francisco...here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

☞ In his last six starts since June 13, opponents have hit .200 (14-for-70) with 25 strikeouts against Ryan's 4-seam fastball.

RUNNERS ON: With runners in scoring position vs. Ryan, opponents are hitting .228 (18-for-79) with two home runs, five walks and 24 strikeouts...with the bases empty, opponents are hitting .194 (57-for-294) with nine home runs, 11 walks and 88 strikeouts.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Enters today with 502 career strikeouts, 27th in Twins history (1961-present)...next up are Glen Perkins and Dean Chance, tied for 25th with 504 strikeouts.

QUALITY STARTER: Has recorded eight quality starts in his last 14 starts...leads the Twins with 11 quality starts this season and is tied for 10th in the American League (t-15th in MLB)...has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 15 of his 19 starts.

CAREER NOTES

- 2024 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
