IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left pectoral), INF David Hamilton (left hamstring), LHP Kyle Harrison (left forearm), RHP Joel Kuhnle (right shoulder), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Carlos Rodriguez (right shoulder), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list.....Fitzpatrick, Lockridge, Priester, Woodruff and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy (419g, 249-170, .594) is in his third season as Brewers manager.....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025.....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25).....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role).....assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval**, hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez**, hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** and first base coach **Spencer Allen** are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (108 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 70, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7.....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cubs by 6.0 games.....the team has held first place for the last 54 days.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 29-18 at home, going 10-4-1 in series play.....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 30-18 on the road, going 10-5-1 in series play, including this series.....the team is 22-10 in its last 32 road games, including 10-4 in the last 14 contests.....had season-high 5-game winning streaks from 5/31-6/8 and 6/21-7/3.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 24 replay challenges this season, going 16-8.....their last challenge (lost) came on 7/1 vs. Cincinnati as a no blocking of the plate call was confirmed and an out call involving Garrett Mitchell stood.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row.....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game.....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 822 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (914), Astros (853) and Yankees (841).

TODAY'S STARTER: #54 - LHP ROBERT GASSER (8gs, 2-3, 4.15)

2026 Arsenal: Sweeper (27.8%) - Sinker (25.9%) - 4-Seam Fastball (23.4%) - Cutter (16.3%) - Changeup (6.6%)

GASSER AT A GLANCE: Robert Gasser, 27, will be making his ninth start of the season and first against the Pirates.....Gasser last started on Tuesday at St. Louis-G2 and earned a 10-2 win (7.2ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 4k, 1hr, 1hbp, 94 pitches).....his 7.2 innings pitched marked a career high.....the team is 4-4 in his starts.....he has 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .227 (37-for-163, 8hr).....he is 0-0 with a 3.38 ERA in 7 starts this season at Triple-A Nashville (26.2ip, 27h, 12r, 10er, 8bb, 38k, 1hr).....Gasser was acquired from San Diego with three others on 8/1/22 as part of the trade for LHP Josh Hader.....he was selected by the Padres in Competitive Balance Round B of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft from the University of Houston.....he also attended the University of New Mexico in addition to San Joaquin Delta College.

LAST SEASON: Gasser spent most of the season on the 60-day injured list as he recovered from “Tommy John” surgery.....he was reinstated on August 30 and optioned to Triple-A Nashville.....he went 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA in 10 games/6 starts with the Sounds (including his rehab assignment).....he was recalled by the Brewers on September 21 and made 2 starts, coming in losses on 9/21 at St. Louis and 9/27 vs. Cincinnati.....he also made 2 postseason appearances, both coming in relief.

CAREER: Is 4-5 with a 3.51 ERA in 15 starts, all with the Brewers (77ip, 70h, 36r, 30er, 19bb, 61k, 11hr).....he made his Major League debut in 2024.....Gasser underwent “Tommy John” surgery on 6/24/24, performed by Dr. Keith Meister.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-3 with a 2.38 ERA in 9 starts (45.1ip, 12er).....is 0-2 with a 3.48 ERA in 4 starts this season (20.2ip, 8er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 2-2 with a 5.12 ERA in 6 starts (31.2ip, 18er).....is 2-1 with a 4.76 ERA in 4 starts this season (22.2ip, 12er).

CAREER vs. PIRATES: His only career outing vs. Pittsburgh came in a 10-2 win on 5/15/24 at American Family Field (5ip, 6h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 2k).

ODDS & ENDS: Gasser graduated from Oak Ridge [CA] High School.....his father, Jim, was also a pitcher who was drafted by Milwaukee (1984) and San Francisco (1986) but did not sign due to injury.....Gasser enjoys fishing and golf.
