#STLFLY: The St. Louis Cardinals are playing the last of a four-game series against the Los Angeles Dodgers looking to split the series with a win. Currently, the Cardinals are in the midst of a seven-game homestand against the Dodgers (Sept. 6-9) and Reds (Sept. 10-12). St. Louis began today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 14.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and 3.5 games behind the 2nd Wild Card position held by San Diego with Cincinnati and Philadelphia in their path.

HOME DAZE: The Cardinals are 7-3 in their last 10 home day games and 13-9 overall this season. Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, the Cardinals are 253-155 (.620) in home day games, the 3rd best record in MLB behind the Dodgers (182-103, .639) and Yankees (314-191, .622) and out-distancing the Red Sox (225-160, .584) and Rays (225-160, .584). *Elias Sports Bureau*

SOSA POP!: Since August 26, Cardinals infielder **Edmundo Sosa** leads all National League players with a .400 (16-40) batting average, hitting safely in 10 of 12 games. Since the All-Star Break, Sosa leads all Cardinals batters with a .333 BA (30-90) ranking T-7th in Major League Baseball.

KEEPING THEM OFF THE BOARD: Relievers **Luis García** (21.1-1st) and **T.J. McFarland** (17.0-T2nd) own the top two active scoreless innings streaks in Major League Baseball. García is two outs from passing his career-high in scoreless innings (21.2 IP, June 14-July 29, 2017 w/PHI), while McFarland is currently extending his career-long.

FIRST FAMILY: First baseman **Paul Goldschmidt** leads the Cardinals and ranks T-4th in the National League with Austin Riley (ATL) at 149 hits. Prior to Goldschmidt's arrival, the last Cardinals first baseman to record 149 hits was **Matt Adams** with 152 in 2014. Goldschmidt has tallied 150 or more hits in seven seasons throughout his career.

FIRST STATE, FIRST PLACE: Born in the state of Delaware, Cardinals first baseman **Paul Goldschmidt** (1,544) is five hits away from passing **Delino DeShields** (1,548) for the all-time mark for hits by a player born in the "First State". Goldschmidt leads almost all other Delaware-born offensive categories including runs, doubles, home runs, RBI, walks, extra base hits.

FROM NOLAN TO ROLEN: **Nolan Arenado**'s next blast will be his 30th of the season as he looks to become only the 4th Cardinals primary third baseman with a 30-homer season and first since **Scott Rolen** (34 in 2004) ... Arenado also seeks to become the second Major Leaguer joining **Nelson Cruz** with six 30-homer seasons since 2015, achieving the feat faster than **Manny Machado** (24 HR) who also has five seasons of 30+ homers from 2015-19.

SEPTEMBER SUCCESS: With 24 games remaining on the Cardinals schedule, St. Louis has 13 games remaining at Busch Stadium. Since 2006, when the Cardinals opened Busch Stadium III, the 'Birds have the 4th-highest winning percentage at home in the month of September at 122-86 (.587), trailing only the New York Yankees (.633, 133-77), Los Angeles Dodgers (.615, 112-70) and Toronto Blue Jays (.597, 126-85). *Elias Sports Bureau*

THERE GO THOSE MEN: **Paul Goldschmidt** and **Nolan Arenado** have made a career of success against the Los Angeles Dodgers. Goldschmidt (33 HR, 101 RBI) and Arenado (28 HR, 90 RBI) are the current active leaders in home runs and RBI against the Dodgers. The duo is attempting to continue where Cardinals Hall of Famer **Stan "The Man" Musial** left off, the all-time MLB leader against the Dodgers in runs (299), hits (522) RBI (270) and 3rd in home runs (74).

FLIPPING THE SWITCH: **Dylan Carlson** has 121 hits this season, four behind current assistant coach **Willie McGee** (125) for 5th place all-time among Cardinals rookie switch-hitters. **Vince Coleman** (170) holds the record in 1985 with Hall of Famer **Red Schoendienst** (157), **Jimmy Brown** (145) and **Lee Magee** (133) remaining atop the list.

LOS ANGELES CONNECTIONS

Jack Flaherty was born in Burbank Calif...graduated from Harvard-Westlake High School, where he went 23-0 with an 0.63 ERA over his final two seasons and 35-3 overall throughout his high school career...led Harvard-Westlake to the 2013 state title, pitching a complete-game shutout and driving in the lone run in a 1-0 win in the CIF Championship at Dodger Stadium....resides in Sherman Oaks...grew up a Dodgers fan.

Andrew Knizner and **Trea Turner** were teammates at North Carolina State University in 2014.

Paul Goldschmidt was originally selected by the Dodgers in the 49th round of the 2006 MLB Draft but did not sign....was teammate of **A.J. Pollock** in Arizona for parts of seven seasons (2012-18).

Nolan Arenado graduated from El Toro High School in nearby Lake Forest, Calif. and resides in San Clemente, Calif....grew up a Dodgers fan...one of his favorite players growing up was outfielder **Shawn Green**...singled off **Josh Wall** for his first MLB hit (April 29, 2013 at Dodger Stadium).

Ron "Pop" Warner was born in Alhambra, Ca

Mike Maddux pitched parts of the 1990 (11 games) and 1999 (49 games) seasons with the Dodgers...his younger brother, Hall of Famer **Greg Maddux**, pitched parts of the 2006 and 2008 seasons with the Dodgers.

Luis García signed with the Dodgers as an International free agent in 2004 and pitched parts of four seasons in their minor league organization...traded by Los Angeles with a player to be named later (**Victor Garate**) to the Nationals for **Ronnie Belliard** (August 31, 2009).

Max Scherzer is a native of Chesterfield, Mo...graduated from Parkway Central (Mo.) High School...originally selected by St. Louis in the 43rd of the 2003 MLB Draft, but did not sign...pitched at the University of Missouri (2005-07).

Joe Kelly pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2012-14), including 11 games (four starts) in the Postseason...originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2009 MLB draft...later traded by the Cardinals with **Allen Craig** to Boston for **Corey Littrell**, **John Lackey** and cash.

Albert Pujols played 11 seasons with St. Louis (2001-11), hitting combined .328/.420/.617 with 445 home runs and 1,329 RBI, with 10 straight seasons of .300-30 HR-100 RBI (2001-2010)...won three NL MVP awards (2005, '08-09)...named NL Rookie of the Year (2001)...member of two World Series Champion squads (2006, '11) and three NL pennant-winning teams (2004, '06, '11)...selected nine NL All-Star squads (2001, '03-10)...won six Silver Sluggers (2001, '03-08) and two Gold Gloves (2006, '10)...originally selected by St. Louis in the 13th round of the 1999 MLB draft, by then Scouting Director **John Mozeliak**...resides in St. Louis County, Mo.

Daniel Ponce de Leon graduated from La Mirada (Calif.) High School in 2010, where he was named the school's All-Athlete of the Year as a senior...Played sophomore season at nearby Cypress (Calif.) College in 2012.

Jobel Jiménez was minor league outfielder in the Dodgers system for two seasons (1993-94)...spent five seasons as an outfield instructor and VSL scout for the Dodgers (1994-98).

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 34th career appearance and 5th start today. Is his 4th start of the season and first since being recalled from Memphis (AAA) on September 3.
- Is making his second career appearance vs. the Dodgers and first career start.
- Made seven starts with Memphis (AAA) over three different stints this season, going combined 2-3 with a 4.50 ERA (34.0 IP) and 25 strikeouts.
- Since last rejoining the Memphis rotation on August 1, Woodford made four starts and went 2-2 with a 4.50 ERA (22.0 IP) and 17 strikeouts.
- As a Cardinals starter this season, has gone 1-2 with a 5.93 ERA (13.2 IP) in three starts during the month of July.
- Has made eight relief appearances of 2.0 innings or more, most on the Cardinals.
- In his 21 appearances this season, the Cardinals are 2-19, with Woodford earning the winning decision in both of the games he's pitched that St. Louis has won (5/28 at ARI & 7/19 vs. CHI).
- Is 1-2 with a 5.40 ERA in four career starts and 2-1 with a 4.62 ERA in 29 career relief appearances.
- Limiting opposing right-handers to a .193/.330/.301 (16-83) with a .631 OPS this season. Last season, right-handers hit .302/.326/.744 (13-43) with 1.070 OPS.

LAST TIME OUT

- Yielded two hits over 5.1 scoreless innings in relief in Saturday's 4-0 loss to the Brewers at American Family Field. Stranded his only inherited runner, faced one over the minimum, and fanned five of his 16 batters faced.

- His 2nd-longest relief outing in the majors in 2021 came at Arizona (5/28), striking out a career-high six in 2.2 scoreless innings en route to an 8-6 victory.
- Suffered his first loss as a Major League starting pitcher (7/24), exiting after 5.0 innings with a 3-1 deficit. Allowed a home run to Joey Votto which ignited a 6-game HR streak for the Reds' veteran.
- Started for the first time in 2021 and since his Major League debut (8/15/20 - Game 2 of DH at CWS), vs. CHI (7/19) and earned the win by holding the Cubs to one run over a career-high 5.2 innings matching his season-high with six strikeouts.
- Struck out a season-high six batters in relief at ARI (5/28) over 2.2 scoreless innings earning the win.
- Did not allow a home run in his first eight appearances of the season (4/3-5/30), covering 13.0 innings and 59 total batters faced.
- Made seven relief appearances of 2.0 innings or more, three of them scoreless.
- Was credited with four games finished, most recently at CHI (6/11).
