RAY REPORT—The Rays open a six-game, seven-day homestand against the Reds (three to play) and Twins (three to play) at Tropicana Field...have won seven of their last nine games and are 10-4 in their last 14 on the heels of a 2-5 start...are 4-2 on a stretch of 27 games in 29 days from April 14-May 13, with off days coming on April 23 and April 30...are a half-game behind the Yankees for the best record in the AL and first place in the AL East...marks their best start since 2023 (18-3) and ties the fifth-best start in franchise history...have held sole possession of first five of the the last six days...have spent six days in first, six in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

- * The Rays dropped the rubber match against the Pirates yesterday, 6-3, their third loss in four rubber matches in 2026.
- * Rays hitters went 2-for-4 with runners in scoring position yesterday...since April 10, the club has slashed .312/.371/.441 (29-for-93) in such situations, rank highly in the majors in hits (T1st), average (4th), RBI (T6th, 38), on-base pct. (T7th), and slugging pct. (8th) over that span...on the season, the team is 59-for-202 (.292) with RISP, third in the majors and second in the AL behind the Tigers (.295).
- * The Rays have scored first only three times in their last 13 games, including none of their last four contests, despite a 9-4 record in that span...their AL-most seven comeback wins are fifth most in the majors, they are one of seven MLB clubs and three AL clubs that have posted a .500 or better record in games their opponent scored first (6-6), joining the Guardians (5-5) and Twins (4-4).
- * **Jesse Scholtens** will take the mound for his first start since Sept. 15, 2023 vs. MIN...the right-hander has spun 9.2 scoreless innings this season, one of six pitchers in the majors to have thrown 9.0 scoreless innings or more this season...he joins **Yonny Chirinos** (2018), **Matt Moore** (2013), **Drew Rasmussen** (2023), **Jeffrey Springs** (2023), and **Doug Waechter** (2003) as the only pitchers in franchise history to have tossed 9.0 scoreless innings or more over their first two appearances of the season (last: Rasmussen, April 3-9, 2023 - 13.0IP)...Chirinos (April 1-11, 2018 - 14.1IP) is the only pitcher in franchise history to throw 10.0 innings or more over their three outings of a season without a run allowed.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Today, the Rays selected the contract of RHP **Trevor Martin** from Triple-A Durham and placed RHP **Mason Englert** on the 15-day IL (right forearm strain)...to make room on the 40-man roster, RHP **Michael Grove** has been transferred from the 15-day IL to the 60-day IL (right shoulder surgery).

- * Martin has thrown 9.1 scoreless innings in seven games this season with Triple-A Durham...he would be the first Rays player to make his major league debut this season...16 Rays made their major league debut last season, tied for second most in the AL and most since 2022 (19).

YANDY MAN CAN—**Yandy Díaz** singled in the 5th inning on Saturday at PIT for his 910th hit with the Rays, tying **B.J. Upton** for fourth on the club's all-time list...with 102 HR, he is also two homers shy of matching seventh-ranked **Carl Crawford** (104HR) (see tables to the right)...Díaz had his eight-game hitting streak and 15-game on-base streak come to an end yesterday...despite this, he has hit safely in 17 of 21 games and reached safely in 19 of 21 so far this season...his streak was tied with **ATH Nick Kurtz** and **SEA Julio Rodríguez** for the longest on-base streak in the AL...Díaz ranks highly in the AL in hits (T1st, 28), average (2nd, .337/28-for-83), on-base pct. (5th, .427), OPS (8th, .933), RBI (T8th, 18), total bases (T8th, 42), and slugging pct. (13th, .506).

- * From the 7th inning on, Díaz is batting .542 (13-for-24), tied for the best in the majors...he paces the majors with a .533 (16-for-30) average against relievers...he is also tied for the second-best average with RISP (10-for-20) alongside DET **Kevin McGonigle** and trails behind only CLE **Steven Kwan** (.529).
- * Díaz has reached base safely 41 times, tied for third in the majors behind HOU **Yordan Alvarez** (49) and LAA **Mike Trout** (43) and most in club history through the Rays first 21 games, surpassing **Evan Longoria** in 2012 and **Jonny Gomes** in 2006 (both 40 TOB)...the record through 22 games was previously 41 TOB, shared by Longoria in 2012, Gomes in 2006, and **Fred McGriff** in 1998...with nine games left, Díaz is on pace to reach safely 58 times by the end of April, which would best **Tommy Pham** (52) in 2019 for the most TOB over such a span in Rays history.
- * He is 15 hits shy of reaching 1,000 for his career, which would make him the 20th Cuban-born player in major league history to reach the milestone.

SIMPSON STREAKS—**Chandler Simpson** has hit safely in his last seven games home games, tied for the second-longest home hitting streak of his career behind a 10-game streak from July 22-Sept. 3, 2025...over this seven-game streak, he is batting .462 (12-for-26) with 1 3B, 3 RBI, 6 R, 6 SB, and a 1.000 OPS...he also has a stolen base in back-to-back home games for the fifth time in his career (last: Sept. 21, 2025-April 6, 2025)...he has never swiped a bag in three consecutive home games.

- * Simpson also has an active 12-game hitting streak against NL opposition...it is tied for the sixth-longest streak in franchise history and marks the longest since **Harold Ramirez's** 13-game streak (April 19-Aug. 31, 2022).

SMALL BALL—The Rays pace the majors in contact rate (80.1%), singles (139), infield hits (34, per Baseball-Reference), ground-ball hits (76), and sacrifice hits (9, T1st with MIL) while ranking second in strikeout rate (18.6%) to the Blue Jays (18.3%)...they lead the AL in bunt hits (6) while ranking second in stolen bases (24)...they have gone from first to third or scored on singles 16 times, tied with the Mariners and Guardians for second in the AL to the Tigers (21)...the Rays rank fourth in the AL and tied for seventh in the majors with 1.5 BsR, an all-encompassing baserunning metric calculated by FanGraphs...they also are second in the AL with 25 "productive outs," defined by Baseball-Reference as advancing any runner with none out or driving in a baserunner with the second out of an inning.

- * **Chandler Simpson** leads baseball with 11 infield hits while **Yandy Díaz** is tied for fourth in the AL with five...**Jonny DeLuca's** 5 RBI as a pinch hitter are the most in MLB, and he is one of two players in the AL with multiple hits as a pinch hitter (2-for-5) along with HOU **Joey Loperfido** (2-for-4).
- * Seven Rays have recorded multiple stolen bases, most in the AL...six have tallied a hit as a pinch hitter, second most in MLB to the Rockies (8).
- * The Rays have won an AL-high-tying five games without the benefit of a home run, matching the Red Sox...they have scored five runs or more without homering an MLB-best six times and have scored only 26 of their 103 runs via their 18 HR...the club is undefeated (4-0) when out-homering opponents, but it has also managed a .500 record (6-6) when being out-homered.

CIN CITY—The Rays and Reds enter the series with both clubs above .500 on the season and the Reds leading the NL Central...Rays opponents have led their division at the start of the series in three of their last four sets (NYY, PIT, CIN)...last season the Rays were swept in Cincinnati (3G) between July 25-27...this series marks the fifth time in franchise history the Reds have visited Tropicana Field, with both clubs claiming two series apiece and the Rays taking the last two series from June 19-21, 2017 (2-1) and July 26-28, 2024 (2-1).

- * **Nick Fortes** leads all active Rays hitters with a .324 (11-for-34) average against the Reds...he has a hit in nine of his 14 games against the club with 2 2B, 1 HR, 2 RBI, 1 BB, 5 R, 3 HBP, and 1 SB...the .324 average is his second-best against any team in his career and best against any NL team.
- * In 14 career games against the Reds, **Yandy Díaz** has slashed .261/.320/.587 (12-for-46) with a .907 OPS...he has homered in four of the last eight games (April 18, 2023-pres.), with an RBI in five of the last 10 games (July 10, 2022-pres.).

MEMORY LANE—The last time the Reds played at Tropicana Field was on July 28, 2024...the Rays plated two runs in the 8th inning on a passed ball and a **Richie Palacios** bases-loaded walk to come

TONIGHT'S START—Jesse Scholtens takes the mound tonight against the Reds for his third appearance and first start of the 2026 season...marks his 31st career appearance and first against Cincinnati...was claimed off of waivers on Aug. 4, 2025 from the White Sox and is in his second stint on the active roster this season (April 8-9, April 11-pres.).

LAST TIME OUT—Cole Sulser (2.0IP, 3H, OR, BB, SO) was utilized as the opener while Scholtens handled the bulk of innings, spinning 5.0 scoreless frames with one hit allowed, two walks allowed, one hit-by-pitch, and three strikeouts...retired eight of the first nine batters faced and 12 of the first 14...stranded **Andrew Benintendi** on third base after a triple in the 5th inning, his lone extra-base hit allowed of the season...additionally stranded two runners on in 7th inning before handing the ball over to the bullpen.

- ✦ Marked the 18th relief outing by a Ray of 5.0 scoreless innings or more and the longest since **Josh Fleming** (6.0IP) on April 26, 2023 vs. HOU...also marked the longest scoreless outing of his career, surpassing his first relief appearance of the year on April 8 vs. CHC (4.2IP).
- ✦ At the end of the 2nd inning, Scholtens reached 100.0 career innings pitched.

FROM PITCH ONE—Scholtens' last career start came on Sept. 15, 2023 vs. MIN with the White Sox...he suffered the loss after he went 4.0 innings and was tagged for six runs (5ER) on seven hits, three walks, and one home run with five strikeouts...marked a career high in runs allowed and tied his career high in earned runs allowed (4x)...was his most strikeouts as a starter since Aug. 12, 2023 vs. MIL (also 5SO), one shy of a career-high (2x, last: Aug. 6, 2023 at CLE).

O-H-NO NO—Scholtens has never faced the Reds in his career...in four outings (one start) vs. the NL Central, he is 0-1 with a 3.38 ERA (16.0IP, 6ER) and 16 SO...has worked 4.0 innings or more in each of his last two appearances.

- ✦ The right-hander finished his collegiate career at Wright State (Dayton, Ohio) University 62 miles away from Great American Ball Park...he earned All-Horizon League honors as a senior, with a 10-1 record, 2.95 ERA (109.2IP, 36ER), and 95 strikeouts in 16 starts...tossed the first perfect game in program history on March 11, 2016 at Dayton University in a 1-0 win with a collegiate-career-best 12 strikeouts.

READY TO GO—The right-hander has made 30 career appearances and 11 starts in the majors, with 16 of the 30 being 4.0 or more innings...as a starter in his career, he is 0-6 with a 5.87 ERA (53.2IP, 35ER), and 38 strikeouts compared to a 2-4 record, 3.65 ERA (49.1IP, 20ER), and 39 strikeouts as a reliever...in those 11 career starts, he has received three runs of support or more on two occasions to a 2.85 RSA...as a reliever, he has a 5.11 RSA (49.1IP, 28RS).

- ✦ Between Aug. 1-12, 2023, he spun three consecutive quality starts against Texas (6.0IP, 1ER), Cleveland (6.0IP, 2ER), and Milwaukee (6.1IP, 3ER).
- ✦ Has gone 5.0 innings or more in six career starts (last: Sept. 10, 2023 at DET - 5.0IP).

YOU SHALL NOT SCORE—Scholtens across his first two appearances this season has tossed 9.2 scoreless innings...he is one of six pitchers this season in the majors to throw 9.0 scoreless innings or more...marked the first time a Rays pitcher has thrown 9.0 scoreless innings or more over their first two outings of a season since **Drew Rasmussen** (April 3-9, 2023) went 13.0 scoreless innings...only one pitcher in franchise history has not allowed a run over their first three outings of a season (**Yonny Chirinos**, April 1-11, 2018 - 14.1IP), minimum 10.0 innings pitched.

CAREER RECAP—Began the year in the White Sox organization in 2025, making his season debut May 6 with Triple-A Charlotte in his first appearance post-Tommy John surgery after suffering a rehab setback during spring training...made eight appearances (6 starts) with the Knights, but was designated for assignment Aug. 3 before being claimed off waivers by the Rays Aug. 4 and optioned to Triple-A Durham...made seven starts with the Bulls before he was recalled Sept. 20 and finished the year in the majors.

- ✦ Made two appearances with the Rays out of the bullpen...on Sept. 20 vs. BOS, worked 3.0 IP with 1 ER allowed in his first major league outing since Sept. 20, 2023 at WSH...on Sept. 25 at BAL, collected a career-high 9 SO over 5.1 IP of relief, generating a career-high 17 whiffs, most by a Rays reliever in the pitch-tracking era (since 2008)...tied **Ryan Yarbrough** (May 31, 2018 at OAK) for the most strikeouts by a reliever in franchise history.
- ✦ Had a 34.2 pct. whiff rate, 31.6 pct. strikeout rate and 32.1 pct. chase rate...his 12 SO marked the most in team history through a pitcher's first two relief appearances with the Rays, surpassing **Cooper Criswell** (10) in 2023.
- ✦ Across 17 outings (15 starts) between Triple-A Durham (7 starts), Triple-A Charlotte (8G/6GS), and Class-A Winston-Salem (2 starts), went 2-2 with a 4.72 ERA (68.2IP, 36ER)...allowed 3 ER or fewer in 14 of the 17 appearances.
- ✦ Missed the 2024 season after suffering a torn right UCL during spring training that required March 1 Tommy John surgery, performed by Dr. Keith Meister in Arlington, Tx. ...placed on the 60-day IL on Feb. 27 and spent the year rehabbing at the White Sox training complex in Arizona.
- ✦ Broke into the majors in 2023, appearing in 26 games (11 starts) after the White Sox selected his contract on April 7...was in the majors from April 7-13, May 22-June 1, and June 16-end of season...made his final appearance on Sept. 20 at WSH and was placed on the 15-day IL on Sept. 24 with a left calf strain.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: LHP STEVEN MATZ (3-0, 3.80)

LAST TIME OUT—Went 5.1 innings on April 16 at CWS and allowed two runs on six hits, one walk, one home run with four strikeouts...the Rays are 4-0 when he starts, the first time the team has won four straight starts by a pitcher to start a season since they won eight in a row started by **Shane McClanahan** (March 30-May 8, 2023).

vs. REDS—Matz has made eight career outings (six starts) against the Reds in his career...he holds a 4-1 record, 4.46 ERA (34.1IP, 17ER), and 37 strikeouts...his last outing came on June 21, 2025 at Busch Stadium and went 1.2 innings with three runs allowed, two hits allowed, two walks allowed, one home run and one strikeout.
