NATIONALS NEWS

WASHINGTON VS. WASHINGTON
Following a day off on Thursday, the Washington Nationals welcome the Seattle Mariners to Nationals Park for a three-game weekend series...Washington has won seven of its last 10 games against Seattle dating back to Aug. 24, 2022 and overall, the Nationals are 20-8 (.714) against the Mariners since 2005.

- The Nationals enter this series with a 24-18 (.571) record since April 25 and have won 10 of 15 series over this stretch...They are coming off a 4-2 road trip with series victories at Arizona (2-1) and San Francisco (2-1).

VOTE FOR OUR ALL-STARS
All-Star voting is now open and **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** have placed themselves among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League...See charts to the right for position specific rankings.

- Abrams has reached base safely in 13 of the last 15 games...He has two doubles, three home runs, six RBI, two hit by pitches, six walks, three stolen bases and 10 runs scored during that span.
- Wood is hitting .337/.452/.568 with four doubles, six homers, 14 RBI, 19 walks, five stolen bases and 26 runs scored in his last 25 games.

DAYLEN'S DAYS
Daylen Lile is 13-for-34 (.382) with a triple, homer, seven RBI, one hit by pitch, four walks, three stolen bases and five runs scored over his last nine games since June 1.

- He checked in with a career-high four hits on June 10 at San Francisco.
- On the season, he leads the Nationals with 72 hits...His 15 doubles are tied for the most on the Club and tied for second among National League outfielders.

CORNER BATS
Since May 22, Washington's corner infielders **Luis Garcia Jr.** (5 HR, 19 RBI), **Curtis Mead** (6 HR, 13 RBI) and **Jorbit Vivas** (1 HR, 4 RBI) lead Major League Baseball with 12 home runs and 34 RBI.

- Luis Garcia Jr.** is slugging .621 with three doubles, a triple, five home runs and 19 RBI...He is coming off a series in San Francisco in which he went 4-for-9 (.444) with two doubles and a homer.
- Curtis Mead** is slugging .587 with two doubles, six homers and 13 RBI...His six home runs are tied for fifth in all of Major League Baseball since May 22.

START ME UP
Since May 20, National pitchers who have started games have pitched to a 2.61 ERA, the second-best mark in Major League Baseball over this span behind only the Los Angeles Dodgers (2.37 ERA)...The group's .217 opponents' average and 1.10 WHIP each rank fourth in Major League Baseball.

- Washington has used an opener six times during this stretch...The Openers have allowed just two earned runs and one home run in 8.0 innings (2.25 ERA).
- While not always starting the game, **Andrew Alvarez** (5 G/2 GS, 4.24 ERA), **Cade Cavalli** (4 G/4 GS, 3.52 ERA), **Foster Griffin** (4 G/4 GS, 2.05 ERA), **Jake Irvin** (1 G/1 GS, 0.00 ERA), **Zack Littell** (4 G/3 GS, 2.35 ERA) and **Miles Mikolas** (4 G, 3.72 ERA) have pitched to a combined 3.26 ERA (36 ER/99.1 IP) since May 20.

BACKSTOP BATS
Drew Millas and **Keibert Ruiz** have been the most productive offense catching tandem in Major League Baseball since May 6...Combined, they rank among all MLB catching groups in OPS (1st, .905), batting average (1st, .304), RBI (11st, 24), hits (1st, 35) and home runs (14th, 6).

- Ruiz is 11-for-32 (.344) with two doubles, a homer and five RBI and has hit safely in eight of his last 10 games... Since May 6, he is hitting .362 with a .667 slugging percentage (9 2B, 4 HR) and 18 RBI in 20 games.
- On the season, Ruiz is tied for second among Major League catchers with 14 doubles and seventh among all catchers (min. 130 PA) in slugging percentage (.489).

ACE OF BASES
Nasim Nuñez leads Major League Baseball with 25 stolen bases and as a club, Washington ranks second in the league with 70 stolen bases behind the Miami Marlins (80).

- The Nationals have stolen 12 consecutive bases without being caught and have been caught just twice in 24 attempts since May 22.

SAVES ON SAVES
The Washington Nationals have had nine separate pitchers record at least one save this season, tied for the second-most in Major League Baseball with the Cincinnati Reds and behind the Minnesota Twins (11) and the second-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.) behind the 2017 Nationals (11).

- Gus Varland** (5), **Richard Lovelady** (4), **Clayton Beeter** (4), **PJ Poulin** (2), **Orlando Ribalta** (2), **Andrew Alvarez** (1), **Brad Lord** (1), **Mitchell Parker** (1) and **Paxton Schultz** (1) have all recorded saves this year.

FARM REPORT

WILLITS WOVES FOR WILMINGTON
Wilmington shortstop **Eli Willits** has launched three home runs in his first three games since being promoted to High-A Wilmington...He recorded his first multi-homer game of the season on June 10, his second game with the Blue Rocks...He's hitting .387/.473/.661 with seven doubles, two triples, five homers, 22 RBI, 12 walks and eight stolen bases in his last 15 games between Single-A Fredericksburg and Wilmington.

The Nationals and Mariners will meet three times this season (All three in Washington D.C.)...**Sean Doolittle** pitched 11 games for the Mariners in 2021...**Shawn O'Malley** joined the Nationals after spending six seasons (2020-25) as a hitting coach in Seattle's system...He played in 113 Major League games with the Mariners in 2015-16...Manager of advance scouting **Dan Kaplan** spent four seasons (2020-23) with Seattle before joining the Nationals...Mariners bench coach **Manny Acta** was Washington's manager from 2007-09...Seattle's first base coach **Eric Young Jr.** served the same role for two seasons (2022-23)...Mariners outfielder **Victor Robles** played for the Nationals from 2017-24 and helped the Nationals to the 2019 World Series title...**Jose A. Ferrer** pitched for Washington from 2023-25.

CAREER

Veteran starter is one of 27 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 67 starts and maintain an ERA under 3.99 since the beginning of 2024.

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 21-27 with a 3.99 ERA in 80 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.

LAST START

Littell allowed one earned run on two hits with four strikeouts and one walk en route to his fifth win in a row on June 6 at Arizona.

- He did not allow a baserunner until a hit by pitch in the fourth inning and did not give up a hit until a single to lead off the fifth.

vs. SEATTLE

Littell is set to make his third career start and fourth career appearance against Seattle...He is 0-1 with a 1.93 ERA (3 ER/14.0 IP) and 12 strikeouts.

STREAKIN'

Littell is in the midst of a six-game winning streak since May 3, tied for the second-longest active winning streak in Major League Baseball...He is 6-0 with a 2.27 ERA, a .197 opponents' average and just two home runs allowed in seven games during this streak.

- The six wins over this stretch are tied for the most in Major League Baseball with Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski and Philadelphia's Cristopher Sanchez.
- He ranks among National League pitchers (min. 35.0 IP) in opponents' slugging (5th, .299), home runs per 9.0 innings (6th, 0.50), ERA (7th, 2.27) and opponents' average (9th, .197) since May 3.

MAY FLOWERS

Went 5-0 in the month of May, pitching to a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP) with a .209 opponents' average and 19 strikeouts across six appearances.

- He ranked tied for first in Major League Baseball for wins in the month of May with Milwaukee's **Jacob Misiorowski**.

He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball...Did not issue a walk in 13 starts, tied with Tarik Skubal for the most-such outings in MLB...Was acquired by the Reds at the Trade Deadline.

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL)...Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances with Minnesota (2019), San Francisco (2021) and Tampa Bay (2023).
