



# Washington Nationals (3-6) vs. San Francisco Giants (4-6)

## RHP Trevor Williams (1-0, 3.38) vs. LHP Blake Snell (Season Debut)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants continue their opening homestand with a three game series against the Washington Nationals... SF is coming off it's first winning series of the year after taking two of the last three games from the Padres.

- ▶ The Giants have dropped six of their last seven contests against the Nationals, dating back to 2022 and have gone 1-2 at home against the Nationals in each of the last two seasons, which marked the first time San Francisco has gone under .500 in consecutive seasons at home against Washington since doing so in 2005-06 (1-2 in each season).

**SNELLZILLA:** Reigning National League Cy Young award winner **LHP Blake Snell** will take the mound for his first start in a Giants uniform tonight.

- ▶ Snell signed a two-year, \$62M deal—with an opt-out after the first year on March 19.
- ▶ Last season, he posted a 14-9 record and led the Majors with a 2.25 ERA and a .181 opponents average...he also recorded a career-high 234 strikeouts, which was tied for third in the Majors...he went 4-0 with a 0.47 ERA and a 0.89 WHIP over his final six starts and ended the season with a 19.0-inning scoreless streak.
- ▶ Over his career, Snell has posted a 2-0 record with a 2.33 ERA (7er, 27.0ip) in five starts vs. the Nationals.
- ▶ In four career starts at Oracle Park, Snell has posted a 2-0 record with a 1.59 ERA (4er, 22.2ip), 31 strikeouts and a 1.01 WHIP...last season, he threw 12.0-scoreless innings and struck out 18 Giants batters over two starts here...he enters tonight's game with a 18.0-inning scoreless streak at Oracle Park covering his last three starts here dating back to August 30, 2022.

**SHOOOOTING TWO:** Snell was one of two former Cy Young Award winners that the Giants added this offseason along with **LHP Robbie Ray** via a trade with Seattle...according to Sarah Langs via *Elias* the Giants are the sixth team to acquire two former Cy Young winners in an offseason.

**CLOSE CALLS:** Four of the Giants last five games have been decided by one run with SF winning two of the four.

- ▶ In fact, the Giants have won their last eight games at home that have been decided by a single run dating back to August 13, 2023.
- ▶ Overall, San Francisco went 25-19 in one-run games last season.

**GETTING COMFORTABLE:** **OF Michael Conforto** has reached base safely in each of his 10 games this season and is slashing .351/.415/.703 with four doubles, three homers and 10 RBI.

- ▶ He is 5-for-13 (.385) with a homer and two doubles against tonight's starter Trevor Williams.
- ▶ Conforto and **IF Matt Chapman** have combined for 19 RBI while all other Giants have combined to drive in 22 runs.

**'PEN TO PAPER:** After a tough start to the season, the Giants bullpen has performed better in recent days...SF relievers have allowed just one run (a HR) on nine hits with 17 strikeouts over their last five games in 14.1ip (0.63 ERA), as opposed to a 10.00 ERA (20er, 18.0ip) with four homers and 10 walks over their first five contests.

- ▶ The Giants have needed to rely heavily on their young pitchers, with four relievers make their MLB debuts in the past week (**RHP Nick Avila**, **LHP Erik Miller**, **RHP Landen Roupp**, **RHP Kai-Wei Teng**).

**WAKE UP THE BATS:** The Giants scored just six runs over their last three games and are averaging a total of 3.0 runs per game (21 runs in seven games) since March 31, the second-fewest in the National League.

- ▶ After starting the season off 11-for-26 (.423) with runners in scoring position, the Giants have just five hits in their last 45 at-bats (.111) with RISP and were just 1-for-17 (.059) over their three-game set with the Padres.

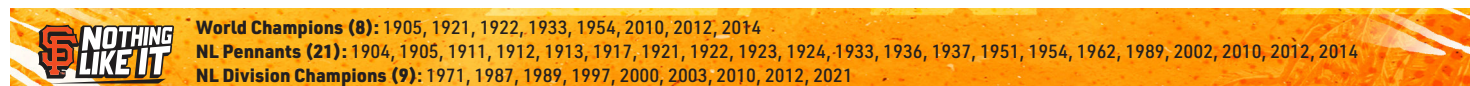
**WHERE'D THE HOMERS GO?:** San Francisco has not recorded a home run in it's last three games...the Giants need a home run tonight to avoid their first four-game homerless drought since May 16-20, 2023.

**HARD KNOCKS:** The Giants are hitting the ball harder than anyone this season after ranking in the bottom half of the Majors in 2023 (depicted in the table below).

**SELL OUT, WITH ME, OH YEAH:** The Giants logged their third consecutive sellout yesterday, matching their total number of sellout for all of last season.

- ▶ The Giants' combined attendance of 120,908 this past weekend was their most in the first three home games of a season since drawing 125,791 fans in the first three games of the 2018 season (two vs. Seattle, one vs. LAD)...this excludes the 2020 and 2021 seasons due to COVID capacity restrictions.

**CITY BY THE BLAKE:** The reigning NL Cy Young will make his Giants debut tonight to kick off his 2024 season.

**WHAT HAVE YOU BEEN UP TO?:** When the Giants broke camp, Snell stayed back in Scottsdale and struck out 11 Brewers over 4.1 shutout innings in a Double-A Minor League camp game on March 30...he most recently threw 77 pitches on Wednesday in a sim game, facing **OF Mike Yastrzemski**, **OF Austin Slater** and **IF/OF Tyler Fitzgerald**.

**CYZILLA:** Snell won his second career Cy Young and first in the National League last season (also: 2018 with Tampa Bay)...he went 14-9 with an MLB-leading 2.25 ERA to become the seventh pitcher in MLB history to win the Cy Young in both leagues:

**VS. WASHINGTON:** Snell has pitched quite well against the Nationals, going 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA (7er, 27.0ip), 36 strikeouts, a .204 opposing batting average and a 1.26 WHIP over five starts...last season Snell allowed a single run on four hits and four walks while striking out six over 5.0 innings at Washington on May 25.

**2023 LEADERBOARD:** In addition to leading MLB in ERA, Snell finished first in opposing average (.181), opponent slugging percentage (.286), opponent OPS (.579), hits allowed per 9.0 innings (5.75) and percentage of pitches put in play (12.8%)...below is where Snell ranked in MLB.

**WALK IT BACK:** The lefty became the first pitcher since ERA was established in both leagues in 1913 to finish as baseball's walks (99) and ERA leader (2.85)...the Nationals offer an interesting challenge in that as they have a 7.1% walk rate (T-27th in MLB) since the start of last season and a 31.1% chase rate, which is tied for the sixth-highest in the league.

**RARE 1-2 PUNCH:** Per Sarah Langs and Elias, the duo of **LHP Blake Snell** and **RHP Logan Webb** make the Giants just the seventh team in MLB history to have both of the top-2 Cy Young Award vote getters from the prior season.

**NO TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE:** 109 of Snell's 234 strikeouts last season came on his curveball...opponents hit .079 on the pitch with a .140 slugging percentage...the pitch had a run value of 22 last season after posting a run value of three in 2023...the 22 run value was the second-best rated curveball behind Atlanta RHP Charlie Morton's 25, and rated as the sixth-best pitch overall...since the start of last season, Washington has .214 batting average (T-19th) against curveballs with a .584 OPS (26th in MLB).

**NEXT BEST THING:** In addition to the high strikeout numbers, Snell was also excellent at keeping the ball on the ground, finishing 16th in MLB and ninth in the National League with a 44.4% ground ball rate...Washington has a 45.3% ground ball rate since the start of last season (27th in MLB), and a 44.0% rate in 2024 (20th in MLB).

### #58 NICK AVILA ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 4/6 vs. SD; 2.0ip, h, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A on April 1 and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- ▶ Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- ▶ Selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- ▶ Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action... went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.
- ▶ Attended San Joaquin Delta College (Stockton) before playing his 2019 season at California State University, Long Beach... would go on to be selected in the 26th round of the 2019 draft by SF.

### #75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Cutter, Sinker

**Last Game:** 4/7 vs. SD; S, 1.0ip, h, 3k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded his first save of the season yesterday, striking out the side and allowing one hit vs. San Diego.
- ▶ Made his third Opening Day roster.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ His 26 saves before the All-Star break were tied for second-most in Giants history since saves became an official stat in 1969...only **Rod Beck** in 1997 had more (29) before the break.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/3 at LAD; 1.0ip, 2k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Made his first career Opening Day roster...the southpaw made his debut on Opening Day, striking out one in 1.0 inning in San Diego.
- ▶ Appeared in four games on SF's road trip, allowing five runs in 3.2ip.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ In five spring outings, Miller gave up one earned run (a HR) on four hits (.211 avg) with six strikeouts in 4.2 innings.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- ▶ His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.

### #33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker, Cutter

**Last Game:** 4/3 at LAD; 1.0ip, h, r, er, hr (21 pitches)

- ▶ Made his eighth OD roster, second with SF...made three appearances on the Giants trip, allowing a run in two of his three outings.
- ▶ Averaged 15.95 SO/9 this spring after striking out 13 of 38 batters faced.
