To find the latest Orioles Game Note Rosters, Supplemental Bios, Press Releases, Orioles 2021 Media Guide. and other team related information. please visit www.oriolespressbox.com WRAPPING UP WITH NEW YORK-AL: The O's and Yankees begin their final series of the season tonight ith game one of a three-game set...The O's are 7-9 against New York-AL this season, including 3-4 at Oriole ...The last time the O's defeated the Yankees more than seven times in a season was in 2016 when they went 10-9...Of the O's 19 remaining games, including today, 12 will come against the AL East...The O's have gone 17-47 against the division this season, and 7-25 at Oriole Park...The O's have not won a series at home against the AL East this season (0-8-2), while going 2-8-0 in series' on the road.

OF Cedric Mullins has slashed .297/.358/.585 (70-for-236) with 18 home runs in 62 games against the AL East this season; his 18 home runs against the AL East are the third-most in the majors (Semien, TOR - 20 and Guerrero, Jr., TOR - 28)...He's slashing .318/.352/.591 (21-for-66) with five home runs against the Yankees; his five home runs are tied for the second-most against an opponent this season.

RAKING ROOKIE: INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle's home run on Sunday was his 28th of the season, tying him with Cal Ripken, Jr. in 1982 for the most in a single-season by a rookie in Orioles history...His 28 home runs are the second-most by a rookie in the majors this season (García, TEX - 29)...There have been four 30+ home runs seasons by a rookie in the American League since 2000 (Judge, NYY - 52 in 2017, Abreu, CWS - 36 in 2014, Jiménez, CWS - 31 in 2019, Trout, LAA - 30 in 2012).

- Mountcastle has played in 160 career games across this season and last, posting a slash line of .279/.331/.497 (164-for-588) with 27 doubles, 33 home runs, 80 runs, and 102 RBI...He is the only Oriole in club history to record at least 100 RBI in their first 160 games and his 33 home runs are the second-most by an Oriole in their first 160 games (Jay Gibbons - 34).
- his 31 RBI and 14 home runs since the All-Star Break (42 G) lead the O's; he's slashing .281/.335/.594 (45-for-160) in the second half...His .5938 second half slugging percentage is the fourth-highest in the AL.
- 🕭 His 79 RBI are the fifth-most in a single-season by an O's rookie; trailing only Jim Gentile (98 - 1960), Cal Ripken, Jr. (93 - 1982), Eddie Murray (88 - 1977), and Ron Hansen (86 - 1960)

THE MAN AT THE TOP: OF Cedric Mullins sits at 29 HR and 28 SB on the season...He is looking to besixth player (10th time) in Major League history 5'8"-or-shorter to record 30 home runs in a single season: José Altuve (31 - 2019), Jimmy Rollins (30 - 2017), Kirby Puckett (31 - 1986), Yogi Berra (30 - 1956 and 30 - 1952), Hack Wilson (56 - 1930, 39 - 1929, 31 - 1928, 30 - 1927).

- 🕭 His eight leadoff home runs are tied for the most in the majors (Schwarber, WSH/BOS) and are the second-most in a single season in Orioles history (since 1954), trailing only Brady Anderson's 12 in 1996...28 of his 29 homers have come batting leadoff (July 4 at LAA, entered the game as a pinch-hitter); Anderson (35, 1996) holds the franchise record for the most home runs while batting first, and is also the only player in O's history with more than 30 homers in a season out of the leadoff spot.
- $\theta_{\!\scriptscriptstyle P}$ He is batting .360/.398/.656 (45-for-125) in the first inning this season...Mullins' 45 first-inning hits are the most in the majors and also the most in any single inning in the majors...Mullins' 19 first-inning extra-base hits (9-2B, 2-3B, 8 HR) also lead all of baseball.
- Mullins is the first player in Orioles history (since 1954) to have recorded at least 28 HR/28 SB in a single season...Since 2000, he is one of 12 center fielders in the majors to have reached these numbers; he's the first in the AL to do so since Mike Trout, LAA in 2016 (29 HR/30 SB).
- There have been just two 30-30 seasons in the AL since 2013 (Betts, BOS and Ramírez, CLE -2018)...Only 32 players (44 times) in Major League history have recorded seasons with at least 30-2B/30-HR/30-SB.
- He is one of six players in the majors, and just one of two in the AL (Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., TOR), to have a current batting average of at least .300, while also posting a .900+ OPS
- Mullins' 289 total bases are the fifth-most in the majors, trailing only: Guerrero, Jr., TOR (329), Semien, TOR (314), Pérez, KC (295), and Ohtani, LAA (290).
- ⊕ He's made 133 starts for the O's this season (140 games), with 131 coming in center field and two as the DH; all have come while batting lead off...His 131 starts in CF lead the majors

SEPTEMBER HAZE: OF Austin Hays has hit safely in 18 of his last 19 games, including a career-high 17game hitting streak from August 24-September 11 (G1)...Hays is slashing .298/.327/.660 (14-for-47) with four home runs in 11 September games...His four homers are tied for his most in a month this season (August)... His eight extra-base hits (3-2B, 3B, 4 HR) in the month are tied for the sixth-most in the AL.

- (5) For his career, Hays has slashed .304/.342/.536 (68-for-224) with 12 home runs in 65 September games...Has 15 total homers in all other months combined.
- This season, he is batting .297/.333/.531 (52-for-175) with nine home runs against left-handed pitching, while hitting .221/.272/.398 (54-for-244) with nine homers against right-handed pitching.

WALK THIS WAY: INF Trey Mancini has drawn a walk in a career-high seven-straight games...It's the longest active streak in the majors and tied for the seventh-longest streak in baseball this season...It's the longest streak by an Oriole since Manny Machado also did so in seven-straight in 2017; the last Oriole with a walk in eight-straight games was Brian Roberts in 2009, the O's record is 10-straight games.

🔗 Mancini reached base safely in 11 of his 15 plate appearances (5-H, 5-BB, HBP) during his last series against the Yankees (September 3-5 in New York)...On the season, Mancini is slashing .288/.422/.481 (15-for-52) in 15 games against the Yankees

NOTES ON THE LONG BALL: The Orioles have homered at least three times in three of their last four games: they have gone 9-11 when homering at least three times and are 27-27 when homering at least two times

- 🔈 The Orioles have homered 54 times at home since the All-Star Break (28 G), the most in the majors...Their 111 home runs at home on the season are the second-most in the AL and the third-most in the maiors.
- Orioles players have recorded 16 multi-home run games this season, tied for the second-most by a team in the majors with the Chicago Cubs, trailing only Toronto's 21 such games

PROVIDING A LITTLE EXTRA: OF Anthony Santander has homered in three of his last four games; is one home run away from 50 for his career...He's recorded an extra-base hit in four-straight games, tied for the longest active streak in the majors...Since August 1, Santander is slashing .292/.326/.577 (40-for-137) with six doubles. 11 home runs. 25 runs scored, and 21 RBI.

CHEERS TO YOU, HENNY!: In April of this year, longtime Baltimore sportswriter and official scorer Jim Henneman retired from scoring...Henneman began his writing career with the Baltimore News-American (then News-Post) in 1958 before being named public relations director of the Baltimore Bullets in 1968, a position he held until 1973. He returned to the News-American as an Orioles beat writer until 1979, when he moved to The Baltimore Sun on the Orioles beat from 1980-95...Henneman was the primary official scorer at Orioles home games from 1997-2019... A former president of the BBWAA, Henneman has covered Baltimore sports for eight decades and continues to write for PressBoxOnline.com...Congratulations, Henny!

QUICK HITS: Recalled from Triple-A Norfolk when roster's expanded on 9/1; his fourth stint with the O's this year...Ranked as the No. 17 prospect in the Orioles system by MLB Pipeline and No. 28 by Baseball America...Added to the 40-man roster on 11/20/20...Selected to the 2018 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game...Named the 2017 Orioles Jim Palmer Minor League Pitcher of the Year with Class-A Delmarva...Has a twin brother, Lachlan, who pitches in the Minnesota Twins Organization...Originally signed as an international free agent on 8/29/15.

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision on 9/7 vs. KC; his fourth Major League start, and first since 8/3 at New York-AL...Threw 4.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits and two walks, while striking out two...Retired seven of his first eight batters, before allowing a one-out walk to score in the third inning; gave up a home run to Carlos Santana in the fourth before escaping a bases loaded jam... Of his 19 balls put in play, nine were hard hit, according to *Statcast*, and three resulted in base hits.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Will be making his second-career start (third appearance) against the AL East this year, and his second against the Yankees; is 0-1 in those outings, pitching to a 8.10 ERA (9 ER/10.0 IP)...His last start against the AL East came at New York on 8/3, in which he threw 2.1 innings, allowing six runs on seven hits, while striking out two.

WHAT A RELIEF: Three of his seven appearances this year have come in relief, including his first two-career outings...Is 1-0 as a reliever with a 4.76 ERA (3 ER/5.2 IP), and a .320 (8-for-25) opponents' average, compared to 0-2 in four games with a 7.94 ERA (15 ER/17.0 IP), and a .324 (24-for-74) opponents' average as a starter... Has allowed just one extra-base hit (2B) in relief, compared to nine (4 2B, 3B, 4 HR) as a starter.

ROAD WARRIOR: Wells became the fifth pitcher in O's history (since 1954), and the first since Donnie Hart in 2016, to make each his first five-career appearances on the road...He is the first pitcher in MLB to do so since Jose Quijada and Montana Durapau, both in 2019.

<u>G'DAY, MATE:</u> On 6/26, a native of Newcastle, Australia, Wells became the third Australian-born player in Orioles history (since 1954) to make his Major League debut, joining RHP John Stephens (born in Sydney) in 2002 and LHP Damian Moss (born in Darlinghurst) in 2003...On 6/29, he became the third Australian-born player to earn a win for the O's, and the first since Moss on 8/20/03...On 7/21 at Tampa Bay, Wells became the 13th Australian-born pitcher to start a game in MLB history, and the first Australian-native to start a game for the Orioles since Moss on 9/26/03; was just the second pitcher to do so in the majors this season (Lewis Thorpe, MIN).

WELCOME TO THE BIGS: Became the 10th Oriole (eighth pitcher) to make his MLB debut this season on 6/26 at Toronto...Threw 2.0 scoreless innings of relief, allowing one hit and two walks...Earned his first career win on 6/29 at Houston, tossing 2.2 innings of relief with two runs on four hits and two walks while striking out one; punched out Myles Straw swinging in the fifth frame for his first career strikeout...Took his first loss on 7/29 at Detroit.

ON THE FARM: Is 6-3 in 13 appearances (10 starts) with Triple-A Norfolk this season, posting a 3.29 ERA (20 ER/54.2 IP) with six home runs, seven walks, and 48 strike-outs...Did not give up a run in last five outings (four starts) with the Tides from 7/4-8/28 (22.2 IP); has not allowed a run in seven of his 13 games this year.

2019 HIGHLIGHTS: Did not play in 2020 because of the cancellation of the minor league season due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Made 24 starts for Double-A Bowie, finishing 8-6 with a 2.95 ERA (45 ER/137.1 IP), a .236 (123-for-522) opponents' average, allowing 24 walks against 123 strikeouts...Named Orioles Pitcher of the Month for June...Earned Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors (5/27-6/2)...Named an EL Mid-Season All-Star...Ranked among the top 10 in the Eastern League in ERA (6th - 2.95), innings pitched (7th - 137.1), opponents' average (9th - .236), WHIP (5th - 1.07), and win percentage (10th - .571).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP JOHN MEANS (5-7, 3.42)

Means will be making his 65th-career appearance (60th start), and his 23th start this season tomorrow vs. the Yankees at Oriole Park...In his last outing on 9/9 vs. Kansas City, Means suffered the loss, throwing 7.0-plus innings, allowing two runs, one after he exited, on five hits and two walks, while striking out five...Four of his five strikeouts came via his curveball, marking a single-game career-high (previous: 3, 5/29)...Recorded his career-high-tying 11th quality start of the season (also: 2019); the O's are 5-6 when Means records a quality start this year...Tomorrow will mark his 10th-career appearance (seventh start) against the Yankees, in which he is 1-2 with a 5.81 ER A (20 ER/31.0 IP); has not factored in a decision in two starts vs. New York-AL this year, pitching to a 2.79 ERA (3 ER/9.1 IP)...Is 1-4 at Oriole Park this year with a 4.70 ERA (28 ER/53.2 IP), compared to 4-3 on the road with a 2.48 ERA (20 ER/72.2 IP).
