**QUICK HITS:** Recalled from Triple-A Norfolk when roster's expanded on 9/1; his fourth stint with the O's this year...Ranked as the No. 17 prospect in the Orioles system by *MLB Pipeline* and No. 28 by *Baseball America*...Added to the 40-man roster on 11/20/20...Selected to the 2018 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game...Named the 2017 Orioles Jim Palmer Minor League Pitcher of the Year with Class-A Delmarva...Has a twin brother, Lachlan, who pitches in the Minnesota Twins Organization...Originally signed as an international free agent on 8/29/15.

**LAST START:** Did not factor in the decision on 9/7 vs. KC; his fourth Major League start, and first since 8/3 at New York-AL...Threw 4.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits and two walks, while striking out two...Retired seven of his first eight batters, before allowing a one-out walk to score in the third inning; gave up a home run to Carlos Santana in the fourth before escaping a bases loaded jam... Of his 19 balls put in play, nine were hard hit, according to *Statcast*, and three resulted in base hits.

**AGAINST THE AL EAST:** Will be making his second-career start (third appearance) against the AL East this year, and his second against the Yankees; is 0-1 in those outings, pitching to a 8.10 ERA (9 ER/10.0 IP)...His last start against the AL East came at New York on 8/3, in which he threw 2.1 innings, allowing six runs on seven hits, while striking out two.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** Three of his seven appearances this year have come in relief, including his first two-career outings...Is 1-0 as a reliever with a 4.76 ERA (3 ER/5.2 IP), and a .320 (8-for-25) opponents' average, compared to 0-2 in four games with a 7.94 ERA (15 ER/17.0 IP), and a .324 (24-for-74) opponents' average as a starter... Has allowed just one extra-base hit (2B) in relief, compared to nine (4 2B, 3B, 4 HR) as a starter.

**ROAD WARRIOR:** Wells became the fifth pitcher in O's history (since 1954), and the first since Donnie Hart in 2016, to make each his first five-career appearances on the road...He is the first pitcher in MLB to do so since Jose Quijada and Montana Durapau, both in 2019.

**G'DAY, MATE:** On 6/26, a native of Newcastle, Australia, Wells became the third Australian-born player in Orioles history (since 1954) to make his Major League debut, joining RHP John Stephens (born in Sydney) in 2002 and LHP Damian Moss (born in Darlinghurst) in 2003...On 6/29, he became the third Australian-born player to earn a win for the O's, and the first since Moss on 8/20/03...On 7/21 at Tampa Bay, Wells became the 13<sup>th</sup> Australian-born pitcher to start a game in MLB history, and the first Australian-native to start a game for the Orioles since Moss on 9/26/03; was just the second pitcher to do so in the majors this season (Lewis Thorpe, MIN).

**WELCOME TO THE BIGS:** Became the 10<sup>th</sup> Oriole (eighth pitcher) to make his MLB debut this season on 6/26 at Toronto...Threw 2.0 scoreless innings of relief, allowing one hit and two walks...Earned his first career win on 6/29 at Houston, tossing 2.2 innings of relief with two runs on four hits and two walks while striking out one; punched out Myles Straw swinging in the fifth frame for his first career strikeout...Took his first loss on 7/29 at Detroit.

**ON THE FARM:** Is 6-3 in 13 appearances (10 starts) with Triple-A Norfolk this season, posting a 3.29 ERA (20 ER/54.2 IP) with six home runs, seven walks, and 48 strikeouts...Did not give up a run in last five outings (four starts) with the Tides from 7/4-8/28 (22.2 IP); has not allowed a run in seven of his 13 games this year.

**2019 HIGHLIGHTS:** Did not play in 2020 because of the cancellation of the minor league season due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Made 24 starts for Double-A Bowie, finishing 8-6 with a 2.95 ERA (45 ER/137.1 IP), a .236 (123-for-522) opponents' average, allowing 24 walks against 123 strikeouts...Named Orioles Pitcher of the Month for June...Earned Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors (5/27-6/2)...Named an EL Mid-Season All-Star...Ranked among the top 10 in the Eastern League in ERA (6<sup>th</sup> - 2.95), innings pitched (7<sup>th</sup> - 137.1), opponents' average (9<sup>th</sup> - .236), WHIP (5<sup>th</sup> - 1.07), and win percentage (10<sup>th</sup> - .571).

### TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP JOHN MEANS (5-7, 3.42)

Means will be making his 65<sup>th</sup>-career appearance (60<sup>th</sup> start), and his 23<sup>rd</sup> start this season tomorrow vs. the Yankees at Oriole Park...In his last outing on 9/9 vs. Kansas City, Means suffered the loss, throwing 7.0-plus innings, allowing two runs, one after he exited, on five hits and two walks, while striking out five...Four of his five strikeouts came via his curveball, marking a single-game career-high (previous: 3, 5/29)...Recorded his career-high-tying 11<sup>th</sup> quality start of the season (also: 2019); the O's are 5-6 when Means records a quality start this year...Tomorrow will mark his 10<sup>th</sup>-career appearance (seventh start) against the Yankees, in which he is 1-2 with a 5.81 ERA (20 ER/31.0 IP); has not factored in a decision in two starts vs. New York-AL this year, pitching to a 2.79 ERA (3 ER/9.1 IP)...Is 1-4 at Oriole Park this year with a 4.70 ERA (28 ER/53.2 IP), compared to 4-3 on the road with a 2.48 ERA (20 ER/72.2 IP).

- Earned his first career win in his Major League debut on 9/7 vs. KC
- Is the eighth reliever in franchise history (since 1954) to earn the win in his Major League debut, and the first since Alberto Castillo on 4/28/08
- Is the fourth pitcher in O's history (since 1954) to not allow an earned run in at least 3.2 IP of relief in his MLB debut, and the first since Dennis Martínez on 9/14/76
- Has gone 4-3 with a 3.44 ERA (27 ER/70.2 IP) and 71 strikeouts in 18 starts between Triple-A Norfolk (6 GS), Double-A Bowie (10 GS), and Low-A Delmarva (2 GS)
- Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on 7/27 and has gone 1-1 with a 2.00 ERA (6 ER/27.0 IP) and 26 strikeouts in his six starts for the Tides
- Named Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the month for July after going 3-0 with a 2.05 ERA (5 ER/22.0 IP) and 26 strikeouts in four starts for the Baysox
- Ranked as the No. 9 O's prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 10 by *MLB Pipeline*
- Spent the 2020 season at the Alternate Training Site at Double-A Bowie and was added to the 40-man roster on 11/20/20
- Named the Orioles Jim Palmer Minor League Co-Pitcher of the Year in 2019

- Recalled prior to tonight's game; his second stint on the big league roster
- Allowed two runs on two hits in 0.2 innings on 9/11 vs. TOR (G1); three of his past five outings have been 0.2 innings, after throwing 1.1 innings-or-more in seven of his first 11 appearances this year
- Earned his first career win on 9/5 at NYY (1.0 IP, H, ER, HR, BB); pitched on back-to-back days for the second time this year (also: 8/24-25)
- Has allowed an inherited runner to score in each of his past three outings in which he inherited a runner, and in five of his 10 such appearances this year
- Has allowed at least one earned run in seven of his past nine outings (8.2 IP)
- Did not allow an earned run through 11.0 IP to start his career (8/6-21); was the sixth pitcher in O's history (since 1954) to not allow an earned run in his first seven career appearances, and the first since Donnie Hart (7/17-8/18/16)
- First pitcher in O's history to not allow a hit in any of his first four outings (6.1 IP)
- Made MLB debut on 8/6 vs. TB (1.2 IP, 3 K); struck out Ji-Man Choi for first-career strikeout
- Selected to play in the 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game on 7/11 in Colorado

## 81 • CONNER GREENE • RHP 1-0, HLD, 4.76 ERA, 10.06 SO/9 - 14 G

- Did not allow a hit in 1.0 innings on 9/12 vs. TOR; his fourth hitless outing this year
- Has not allowed a run in three-straight outings (since 9/6) for the third time this season (also: 8/10-25, 8/30-9/3)
- Notched his first-career win on 9/10 vs. TOR, throwing 1.2 scoreless innings with two hits and a career-high-tying three strikeouts (also: 9/1 at TOR)

- Threw 1.2 innings on 9/12 vs. TOR, marked his first MLB outing since 9/9/18, while with the Mets; became the 59th player (37th pitcher) used by the O's this year, surpassing the previous club record of 58 players set in 2019
- Had his contract selected from Triple-A Norfolk prior to the game on 9/12
- Has gone 1-1 with a 5.19 ERA (15 ER/26.0 IP) in 25 games for the Tides this year
- Spent the 2020 season at the Orioles Alternate Training Site at Double-A Bowie
- Claimed off waivers by the Orioles from the New York Mets on 9/16/19
- Made his MLB debut for the Mets on 9/4/18 at LAD (1.1 IP, H, HB, K)
- Has gone 21-28 with a 4.69 ERA (177 ER/340.0 IP) in 31 career minor league games, with all but one appearance coming out of the bullpen
- Originally selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida

## 54 • COLE SULSER • RHP 4-4, 7 SV, 3 HLD, 3.15 ERA, 11.26 SO/9 - 52 G

- Is four strikeouts away from 100 for his career
- Earned his seventh save of the season on 9/10 vs. TOR, tossing a season-high-trying 2.0 innings (3x, last: 4/23 vs. OAK) with two hits, one walk, and one strikeout
- Dealt his fourth loss of the year on 9/6 vs. KC (1.0 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, K); his four hits allowed tied his career-high (9/2/20 vs. NYM)
- Earned his fourth win of the season on 9/4 at NYY (1.1 IP, K); completed 1.1 innings-or-more for the first time since 6/30 at HOU (1.2 IP)
- His 3.15 ERA is ranked first among O's relievers and his 11.26 SO/9 ranks first; has recorded at least one strikeout in 41 of his 52 games, and multiple strikeouts in 22 outings
- Earned this sixth save of the year on 8/30 at TOR (1.0 IP, 1 K); became the first Oriole to record a save since he did so on 7/31 at DET
- Has not allowed a hit in nine of his past 18 outings, including four-straight from 7/25-31, tied for the longest streak of his career (also: 8/12-22/20)
- Pitched on consecutive days seven times this season (last: 9/3-4 at NYY)
- Owens reverse splits for his career, with lefties batting .181 (27-for-149) against him, compared to right-handers hitting .250 (40-for-160)

- Completed an inning for the first time since 8/25 vs. LAA (1.1 IP) on 9/11 vs. TOR (G1); each of his last six outings had been less than an inning
- Pitched on back-to-back days (9/7-8) for the sixth time this season (last: 7/30-31)
- Suffered his sixth loss of the season on 9/3 at NYY (0.1 IP, H, R), his shortest outing since also throwing 0.1 inning on 9/1 at TOR
- Allowed three runs for the second time this season on 8/30 at TOR (last: 7/2); picked off Jarrod Dyson on first base in the fifth inning for his first-career pick off
- Did not record a strikeout in eight of his 12 games in August, including four-straight outings from 8/14-22 (career-high: 5, 9/9-17/20)
- Recorded his first career ninth-inning save on 7/24 vs. WSH (1.0 IP, H, 2 K)

## 80 • SPENSER WATKINS • RHP 2-7, 8.75 ERA, 6.08 SO/9 - 12 G (10 GS)

vs. ALL: .333 (67-for-201) vs. LHB: .294 (30-for-102) vs. RHB: .374 (37-for-99)

- Entered in relief on 9/12 vs. TOR (0.1 IP, 7 H, 7 ER, BB, 2 HR); allowed all eight of his batters to face, including four extra-base hits; marked his first relief outing since his MLB debut on 7/2 at LAA (10 starts in-between)
- Recalled from Triple-A Norfolk in prior to game 2 on 9/11
- Has gone 1-2 with a 3.53 ERA (14 ER/35.2 IP) and 30 strikeouts with a 1.09 WHIP in eight games (six starts) for the Tides this year
- Had his contract selected from Triple-A Norfolk prior to the game on 6/30
- Signed by the Orioles as a minor league free agent on February 3, 2021; appeared in three Grapefruit League games (1.2 IP, BB, K)
- Did not play during the 2020 regular season, because of the cancellation of the minor league season due to the COVID-19 pandemic
- Named a Florida State League Mid-Season and Postseason All-Star with Class A-Advanced Lakeland in 2018, and was named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week on 7/1/18
