PERDOMO TO RECEIVE HEART & HUSTLE AWARD DURING PREGAME:

D-backs' 2025 Heart & Hustle Award winner, Geraldo Perdomo, in partnership with the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLB-PAA), will be recognized on field tonight during pregame festivities...the annual award is given to active players who exemplify a true passion for the game and who best embody the values, spirit, and traditions of the game.

- At the conclusion of the season, all alumni and fans will vote to select the final winner from the 30 team winners, which will be announced in mid-November on MLB Network...no D-back has ever won the overall award.

LAST GAME:

- Zac Gallen earned his second straight win after allowing 1 run in 6.0 innings on 4 hits with 6 strikeouts.
- Blaze Alexander hit his second homer (solo in fourth inning) with his second multi-hit game of the month and a season-high 4 RBI.
- Corbin Carroll hit his 24th homer (2-run in fifth inning) and homered in back-to-back games for the first time since May 12-13 @ Giants...was the first time in his career where he homered vs. LHP in consecutive games...has never homered in 3 consecutive games.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled RHP Juan Burgos from Triple-A Reno and optioned RHP Casey Kelly following last night's game.

SNAKE BITES:

Geraldo Perdomo's 20-game on-base streak (.411 AVG; 30-for-73)/.511 OBP/.534 SLG/1.046 OPS, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 13 RBI, 13 walks, 7 K, 2 HBP) at home (since June 27) is the longest active home streak in the Majors, ahead of Jackson Chourio (14)...he is the only player in the Majors this season with multiple 20+-game home on-base streaks (also: 21 from March 27-May 9)...his career long home on-base streak is 23 games (Sept. 28, 2024-May 9, 2025).

- Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 14 of his last 16 home games...in 7 games vs. Rockies this season, is slashing .480/.581/.880, with 6 extra-base hits and 8 RBI.

HITTIN' AT HOME:

Corbin Carroll, in his last 9 home games (since July 19), has 4 doubles, 3 triples, 2 homers, 8 RBI, 1 walk and 2 stolen bases...is the 10th MLB player all-time to record 4+ doubles, 3+ triples, 2+ homers, 8+ RBI, 1+ walks and 2+ stolen bases in a 9-game span within a season at home, joining Adalberto Mondesi/KC (2019), Larry Walker/COL (1996), Juan Samuel/PHI (1987), Jeff Heath/CLE (1941), Kiki Cuyler/CHC (1930), George Sisler/SLB (1921), Babe Ruth/NYY (1920), Braggo Roth/PHA (1919) and Bert Daniels/NYY (1912).

VS. OPPOSING STARTERS:

In their last 6 games vs. opposing starters, the D-backs have scored 24 earned runs in 27.0 innings (8.00 ERA) with a .394 OBP/.538 SLG/.932 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers and 17 walks...their .394 OBP and 17 walks vs. opposing starters since Aug. 2 rank best among NL teams.

EARLY SCORING:

The D-backs have scored 2+ runs within the first 3.0 innings in 5 straight games and have scored 1+ first inning runs in 4 straight games.

- Since the All-Star break, among MLB teams in the first 3.0 innings, the D-backs rank in SLG (2nd, .500), runs (T-2nd, 36), OPS (3rd, .840), homers (T-3rd, 10) and extra-base hits (T-3rd, 25).

TRENDING BATS:

Over his last 9 games (since July 29), Geraldo Perdomo is hitting .355 (11-for-31)/.462 OBP/.516 SLG/.978 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 7 walks...has struck out 2 times in his last 39 PA.

- Corbin Carroll, over his last 6 games, has a .727 SLG with 3 homers and 7 RBI.
- Alek Thomas, over his last 7 games (since July 29), is hitting .409 (9-for-22)/.462 OBP/.682 SLG/1.143 OPS with 2 homers, 4 RBI and 2 walks...his .409 AVG ranks seventh in MLB (min. 25 PA).

HEAD-TO-HEAD WITH NL WEST:

The D-backs are 17-14 (.548) vs. NL West opponents this season, the second most interdivision wins, behind the Dodgers (19).

- In head-to-head NL West play, the D-backs own the best OPS (.813), SLG (.483) with the most homers (56), extra-base hits (118), runs (161) and stolen bases (20).
- Geraldo Perdomo has reached base safely in 26 of his 30 games vs. NL West, batting .324 (36-for-111)/.398 OBP/.514 SLG/.912 OPS with 10 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 21 RBI, 15 walks (16 K) and 2 stolen bases.
- Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 11 straight games vs. NL West (2 2B, 2 HR, 3 RBI, 10 BB) and in 26 of his 30 games vs. NL West this season, slashing .287/.403/.630/1.033 with 7 doubles, 10 homers, 20 RBI, 19 walks (19 K), 2 hit-by-pitches and 1 stolen base.
- In head-to-head play, Marte's 52 times on base rank first while Perdomo's 51 rank tied for second with Fernando Tatis Jr./SD.

LEADOFF TRIPLES & HOMERS:

Corbin Carroll's 5 leadoff triples tie for the most by any player in a season since the expansion era (1961), with Nyjer Morgan/WSH (2010), Curtis Granderson/DET (2006), Marquis Grissom/ATL (1996), Darren Lewis/SF (1994), Willie Wilson/KC (1985), Alfredo Griffin/TOR (1980), Omar Moreno/PIT (1980), Ralph Garr/ATL (1975) and Don Kessinger/CHC (1975).

- Carroll's 5 leadoff homers are tied for fifth with C.J. Abrams/WSH.
- Since 1961, Carroll is the only player to collect 5+ leadoff triples and 5+ leadoff homers within their first 100 games of a season...he is 1 of 3 players all-time to do so in an entire season:

ON-BASE MACHINE:

Geraldo Perdomo's 61 times on base since July 1 rank second in the Majors, behind Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR (64) and Nick Kurtz/ATH (64).

- He has reached base in 29 of his 32 games since July 1, hitting .322 (37-for-115)/.436 OBP/.443 SLG/.879 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 17 RBI and 21 walks (12 K).

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (11-7, 5.02)

- Won his last start on Aug. 4 vs. Padres, allowing 2 runs on 5 hits over 5.2 innings.
- Has allowed 6 or fewer hits in 19 of his 23 starts.
- Earned the win in his last home start vs. Rockies on Aug. 12, 2024, allowing 4 runs over 7.0 innings on 8 hits with 0 walks and 11 strikeouts.

## SNAKEBITES

**AT A GLANCE:** Second season with the D-backs (10th overall in MLB; did not pitch in 2020).

- Signed a 4-year contract in December 2023 (2024-2027) with a conditional option for the fifth year.
- Was a member of the 2018 World Series Champion Red Sox.
- Finished tied for sixth in the 2019 AL Cy Young Award vote after going 19-6 with a 3.81 ERA (86 ER in 203.1 IP) and 213 strikeouts.
- From 2018-23, his 63 wins tied for third most in the AL (also: Justin Verlander), behind Gerrit Cole (86) and Jose Berríos (66).
- Carried a no-hitter into the eighth inning on Sept. 4, 2016 @ Athletics that was broken up by a Marcus Semien 2-out single.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** 20th start (ninth @ home).

- In 3 starts post All-Star Break, is 1-1 with a 3.63 ERA (7 ER in 17.1 IP).
- His teams have won each of his last 5 August starts (3-0, 4.78) and 11 of his last 13 (9-2, 3.79).
- Celebrated 10 years of MLB service time on July 6.

**LAST START:** Won on Aug. 3 @ Athletics (2 ER in 5.0 IP, 5 K).

- Improved to 2-0 with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER in 17.2 IP) in his last 3 start vs. AL West.

**VS. ROCKIES:** Fifth career start...in 2 starts with the D-backs, is 1-0 (team is 2-0) with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER in 11.1 IP), 2 walks and 16 strikeouts.

- Over 4 career starts, is 2-0 (teams are 4-0) with a 5.24 ERA (13 ER in 22.1 IP) 6 walks and 31 strikeouts.
- Has struck out 10+ batters in 2 of his 4 starts.
- Has walked just 1 batter in 3 of his 4 starts.

**VS. NL WEST:** 17th career start (5-6, 5.56 ERA).

- In search of his first win since Sept. 18, 2024 @ Rockies (2 ER in 6.1 IP) and first home win since Sept. 19, 2019 vs. Giants (with Red Sox).
- Had a 4-game win streak (with Red Sox) from July 12-Sept. 19, 2019 (1.80 ERA).

**SNAKE SUPPORT:** All 4 of his wins have come when the D-backs scored 5+ runs.

- When the D-backs scored 6+ runs, is 2-0 with a 5.35 ERA and 46 strikeouts.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** In his last 10 starts, hitters are 12-for-60 (.200 AVG)/.550 OPS with 7 walks and 17 strikeouts.

**5.0+ INNINGS:** Has tossed 5.0+ innings in 13 of his 19 starts.

- All 3 of his 10+-strikeout games have come when tossing 5.0+ innings.
  - 12 on April 5 @ Nationals, 10 on May 4 @ Phillies and 10 on June 23 @ White Sox.

**RANKINGS AMONG STARTERS:** His 9.49 strikeouts per 9.0 IP rank sixth among lefty starters.

- Is 1 of 10 NL pitchers with 3+ starts of 10+ strikeouts (also: Spencer Schwellenbach/ATL, Jesús Luzardo/PHI, Chris Sale/ATL, Logan Webb/SF, Zack Wheeler/PHI, Sonny Gray/STL, Chase Burns/CIN, Cristopher Sánchez PHI and Dylan Cease/SD).
- His 18.7 in-zone whiff pct. ranks sixth among all lefty starting pitchers (min. 10 GS).
- His 88.1 MPH AVG exit velocity is the lowest among NL lefty starters, ahead of Matthew Boyd/CHC (88.4).

**SOFT CONTACT:** Since 2018, his 54 soft hits [*hits under 60 MPH or grounders and pop ups under 70 MPH*] are second among lefty starters, behind Max Fried/NYY (57).

**SINCE 2018 AMONG LEFT-HANDED STARTERS:** Since 2018, his 70 wins are fourth among lefty starters, behind Max Fried/NYY (84), Framber Valdez/HOU (79) and Clayton Kershaw/LAD (74), while his 909 strikeouts rank 10th.

**STRONG SECOND-HALF START:** In his first start post All-Star Break on July 22 vs. Astros, tossed 6.1 scoreless innings on 6 hits with 3 walks and 3 strikeouts.

- Retired 8 of his first 10 batters.

**JUNE BOUNCEBACK:** In 5 June starts (2 quality), went 2-1 with a 1.98 ERA (6 ER in 27.1 IP), 9 walks and 28 strikeouts.

- Was his lowest ERA in a single month (min. 5 GS) since April 2023 (1.72 ERA) while with the Tigers.
