THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY	
On this date in 1970, the Orioles defeated Oakland 5-1, as LHP Dave McNally won his 20 th game...McNally became the first AL pitcher to win 20 games in three straight seasons since RHP Bob Lemon did so for the Indians, 1952-54.	



SPLIT DECISION: The Orioles defeated the Red Sox on Sunday by a score of 5-4 to earn a 2-2 series split...The O's finished their longest homestand of the season with a 3-7 record before departing for a seven-game road trip to Tampa Bay (three games) and Toronto (Buffalo; four games).

✎ **RHP Thomas Eshelman** earned the win after working 4.1 hitless innings in relief of **LHP Wade LeBlanc**, allowing just one walk while striking out two.

✎ **Rio Ruiz** led the offense with a career-high four RBI, hit a two-run, bases-loaded single in the third inning, and later connected on a two-RBI double in the seventh inning...He went 2-for-4 with runners in scoring position.

✎ **Ryan Mountcastle** went 2-for-3 with two doubles for his first career extra-base hits while notching his first career multi-hit game.

ROAD WARRIORS: At 8-1 (.889), the Orioles own the best road record in the majors...O's hitters lead the AL and rank second in the majors with a .300 team batting average on the road, trailing only Washington's .304 road batting average...The Orioles also lead the AL and rank second in the majors with a .865 team OPS on the road (Washington, .882)...Orioles pitchers own a 4.22 ERA (38 ER/81.0 IP) in nine games on the road this season to rank fourth in the AL and sixth in the majors...Top road records in the majors:

I SAN-TAN-DARE YOU: OF Anthony Santander went 1-for-5 with a double on Sunday against Boston...Santander's 10 home runs on the season lead the Orioles, are tied for third in the AL, and are tied for fifth in the majors...He is tied for second in the AL and is tied for third in the majors with 27 RBI this season...22 of his 33 hits this season have been for extra-bases (11 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs) and leads the majors with 22 extra-base hits.

✎ His 1-for-5 day on Sunday extended his current hitting streak to 18 games to mark a career high, passing his 12-game stretch from August 25-September 7, 2019...Santander is hitting .329 (25-for-76) with eight home runs, eight doubles, a triple, and 20 RBI in this 18-game stretch since Game 2 on August 5...It is the longest hitting streak by an Oriole since **Nick Markakis'** 18-game hitting streak from April 21-May 11, 2014.

CATCH THIS: The O's catching corps of **Pedro Severino**, **Chance Sisco**, and **Bryan Holaday** ranks among league leaders in many offensive categories...Severino ranks fourth in the AL with a .333 (27-for-81) overall batting average...O's catchers ranks (while catching):

THAT HANSER IS SO HOT RIGHT NOW: Since the start of the 2019 season, **INF Hanser Alberto** leads the majors with 95 hits off of left-handed pitching...In that time, he also leads the majors with a .393 (95-for-242) average against lefties...This season, Alberto ranks 10th in the AL with a .304 (35-for-115) average against all pitchers...Alberto is tied for first in the majors with 12 doubles.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: The Orioles have been one of the more successful teams in baseball when swinging at the first pitch...They rank first in the majors in batting average (.439), OPS (1.235), and extra-base hits (22), and lead the AL and are tied for first in the majors in doubles (13) and lead the AL and are tied for third in the majors in hits (47) as a team on the first pitch.

✎ **OF Anthony Santander** leads the Orioles with eight hits on the first pitch...He is tied for fifth-most in the majors and is tied for second in the AL...**Hanser Alberto** and **Renato Nuñez** are tied for 10th in the AL with six hits each on the first pitch of an at-bat.

✎ Santander is tied for first in the majors with five extra-base hits on the first pitch, while **C Pedro Severino** is tied for fifth in the majors with four extra-base hits on the first pitch.

ALL ABOUT THAT (ON) BASE: The Orioles rank third in the AL with a .780 team OPS (on-base percentage plus slugging percentage)...**OF Anthony Santander** (.994) leads the team and ranks eighth in the AL, while **C Pedro Severino** (.981) ranks 10th in the AL in OPS among qualifying hitters.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: On Friday night, **INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle** became the third O's player to make his Major League debut this season...He went 0-for-2 with two walks to become the second player in Orioles history (since 1954) with multiple walks in a Major League debut, joining **INF Glenn Gulliver** (1982)...**LHP Keegan Akin** and **INF Ramón Urías** have also made their debuts this season.

INJURED LIST: Seven players are on the Injured List...**INF Chris Davis** (left knee patellar tendinitis), **RHP Hunter Harvey** (right forearm strain), **OF Austin Hays** (non-displaced rib fracture), and **INF José Iglesias** (left quadriceps strain; retroactive to 8/16) are on the 10-day Injured List...**LHP Wade LeBlanc** (left elbow stress reaction), **INF/OF Trey Mancini** (colorectal cancer recovery/treatment), and **INF Richie Martin** (right wrist fracture) are on the 60-day IL.

THE SKIPPER: **Brandon Hyde** was named the 20th manager in O's history on December 14, 2018...He began his first Major League managerial role following 16 professional seasons in the coaching ranks and four as a player...Most recently, Hyde served as bench coach for the Chicago Cubs in 2018, his second season in that role (also 2014)...Hyde spent three seasons as the Cubs first base coach from 2015-17, and previously served as Chicago's Director of Player Development from August 2012-2013, after joining the Cubs in December of 2011 as their Minor League Field Coordinator...Prior to joining the Cubs, Hyde spent nine seasons in the Marlins organization.

LAST START: Made his fifth start of the season and third home start on 8/19 against Toronto...Suffered his third loss of the year despite tossing his second Quality Start of the year...Allowed three runs (all earned) on seven hits, including two home runs, with no walks and seven strikeouts through 6.0 innings...Was his fourth-straight start not issuing a walk...Has not issued a walk in his last 21.0 innings pitched.

CAREER VS. TAMPA BAY: Will be making his 10th appearance (seventh start) against the Rays...He has gone 3-4 with a 6.18 ERA (30 ER/43.2 IP) with nine walks and 30 strikeouts through his first nine appearances...His last start against Tampa Bay came on 8/2/20 in which he took a no-decision after allowing one run (earned) on six hits, one home run, with no walks and a season-high eight strikeouts...In six career appearances (four starts) at Tropicana Field, Milone has a 3-2 record and a 5.97 ERA (19 ER/28.2 IP) with eight walks and 18 strikeouts.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: This will be Milone's 27th career start (32nd appearance) against an AL East opponent...He is 5-16 with a 5.32 ERA (95 ER/160.2 IP), 37 walks, and 122 strikeouts in his first 31 games...In 13 career road starts (16 appearances), he has gone 3-8 with a 6.66 ERA (54 ER/73.0 IP), 20 walks and 54 strikeouts...In 13 career starts (15 games) at home against the division, he has gone 2-8 with a 4.21 ERA (41 ER/87.2 IP), 17 walks and 68 strikeouts.

THE GOOD AND THE BAD: Milone owns the only two Orioles Quality Starts of the season (8/7 at WSH and 8/19 vs. TOR)...In three of his starts (8/2 vs. TB, 8/7 at WSH, and 8/19 vs. TOR), he owns a 2.12 ERA (4 ER/17.0 IP) and 18 strikeouts...In his other two starts (7/24 at BOS and 8/14 vs. WSH), he has posted a 9.00 ERA (7 ER/7.0 IP) with seven strikeouts.

GETTING THE NOD: As a starter, Milone owns a 48-42 record and 4.31 ERA (376 ER/785.2 IP) in 141 career starts, compared to his 3-8 record and 5.50 ERA (69 ER/113.0 IP) in 38 outings as a reliever...Made six starts in 2019 and went 1-3 with a 4.65 ERA (16 ER/31.0 IP) while holding opponents to a .252 (30-for-119) clip...Made 17 appearances out of the bullpen in 2019 and pitched to a 3-7 record and 4.80 ERA (43 ER/80.2 IP) with a .237 (72-for-304) opponent average...Tossed four-or-more innings in 16 of his 17 relief appearances in 2019.

LIMITING THE LONG BALL: Milone has only allowed three home runs through his first five starts in 2020 after surrendering 24 home runs in 2019, tying the second-highest total in his career (also allowed 24 in 2012 with Oakland)...Allowed his first home run of the 2020 season on 8/2 off the bat of Tampa Bay's second baseman Brandon Lowe, which was the only home run he had surrendered this season until his last start on 8/19 in which he yielded two long balls against the Blue Jays.

HOME WOES: Milone is still seeking his first win at home as an Oriole...Made his fifth career start (sixth appearance) at Oriole Park on 8/19, and now owns a 0-2 record and 4.28 ERA (13 ER/27.1 IP) with six home runs allowed and 26 strikeouts in these outings...Made 12 appearances (four starts) at home last season, and posted a 1-6 record with a 5.46 ERA (37 ER/61.0 IP), compared to 3-4 with a 3.91 ERA (22 ER/50.2 IP) in 11 appearances (two starts) on the road.

OPENING DAY: Made his Orioles debut and first career Opening Day start on 7/24 at Boston...Was dealt the loss after surrendering four runs on four hits and three walks with five strikeouts through 3.0 innings...Milone now owns a career 0-4 record and 9.57 ERA (28 ER/26.1 IP) in six starts against Boston.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - ASHER WOJCIECHOWSKI (1-3, 4.84 ERA)

Wojciechowski will be making his sixth start of the season...Was dealt his third loss of the season on 8/20 vs. BOS after working a season-tying-low 3.2 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits (one home run) with a walk and four strikeouts; threw 88 pitches...Owns a 0-1 record and 5.00 ERA (10 ER/18.0 IP) in four career appearances (three starts) against the Rays...Made his Orioles debut last season in Tampa Bay on 7/2/19, working 5.1 innings, allowing four runs on five hits (one home run) with two walks and six strikeouts; was dealt the loss as the Orioles fell 6-3...His last appearance against Tampa Bay came on 9/2/19 at Tropicana Field when he allowed four runs on five hits (one home run) with a walk and five strikeouts in 7.0 innings of work; did not factor in the decision as the Orioles lost the game 5-4.
