WIN THEM ALL YOU CAN'T: The Detroit Tigers this afternoon play the series finale of their four-game set at the Los Angeles Angels (2-1), the middle stop of a season-long 11-day, 10-game, three-city trip that began in Houston (1-2) and concludes with three games in Colorado starting Tuesday after a long-awaited off day tomorrow ... after two wins to begin this series on Thursday and Friday, the Tigers last night endured a 5-2 setback to even their road trip's record at 3-3.

- Despite last night's loss, the Tigers still awoke on May the Fourth in a statistical tie with the Seattle Mariners for best record in the A.L. ... at 21-13, the Tigers have their best record through 34 games to start a season in 11 years when they began 22-12 in 2014.
- The Tigers have gone 21-10, a .677 winning percentage, in their last 31 games starting March 31 since enduring a three-game sweep to start the season at Dodger Stadium ... their 21-10 record starting March 31 is the third-best record in all of baseball in that span.
- With a win today, the Tigers would improve to 8-3 in their 11 series this season ... Detroit is a perfect 5-0 in series at home and 2-3 in their five series on the road into this weekend.
- The Tigers today aim to win a series here in Anaheim for just the third time in their last 14 tries starting in 2011, as the Tigers have gone 2-11 in their last 13 series at Angel Stadium leading into 2025.

LONG HAUL IT HAS BEEN: The Tigers today conclude their stretch of 23 games in 24 days that began on Friday, April 11 in Minnesota ... despite the haul of games and limited off time, the Tigers have posted a 14-8 record through the first 22 contests, the fourth-best record in the majors in this span and behind only the Mariners (15-4, .789), Dodgers (13-6, .684) and Mets (14-7, .667), all of whom have played less games than the Tigers during this stretch.

- Detroit's 2.75 team ERA (59 ER/193.0 IP) during this stretch is the second-lowest in all of baseball, trailing only the San Diego Padres (2.52 ERA).
- The Tigers won't have much time between stretches of games like this, however, as they next have a scheduled run of 23 games in 24 days from May 16-June 8.

BEAT THE BEST YOU HAVE TO DO TO BE: So far this season, the Tigers have played 19 of their 34 games against teams with a .500 or better record ... the Tigers are the only team in the A.L. with a winning record against clubs with a record above .500 this season as the Tigers have gone 10-9 in those 19 games ... last night marked only Detroit's fourth loss against a sub-.500 team, dropping their record to a still-solid 11-4 against such clubs ... the 19 games against above-.500 clubs is tied for the fifth-most such games for an A.L. team.

COME TO AN END ALL GOOD THINGS MUST: Zach McKinstry last night went 0-for-3 to snap his career-best hitting streak at 12 games, which surpassed his previous career-best 11-game streak from August 17-31, 2024 ... his 12-game run was the longest by a Tiger since Kerry Carpenter's 13-gamer from August 4-18, 2023 and was already McKinstry's second hitting streak of eight or more games on this young season.

NEGLIGIBLE THIS DIFFERENCE ISN'T: The Tigers begin the day statistically tied for the best record in the A.L. on the strength of a +51 run differential this year, the second-best mark in the A.L. just behind the Yankees (+54) ... the Tigers are one of six A.L. teams in positive run-differential territory, but they and the Yankees are well ahead of the third-best Mariners (+36) ... overall, the Tigers are fourth in the majors with their +54 run differential.

GREENE IT'S NOT EASY BEING: While Riley Greene on Friday became the first player in major league history to hit two homers in the ninth inning, he also became the first Tiger in franchise history to hit two homers in the same inning on the road and just the third overall in club lore ... the other two? Magglio Ordóñez in the second inning on August 12, 2007 vs. the Oakland Athletics and Mr. Tiger, Al Kaline, in the sixth inning on April 17, 1955 vs. the Kansas City Athletics ... thanks to Elias.

START THE GAME HE WILL: Tigers starter Reese Olson takes the ball for the seventh time this season today ... Olson is coming off of a strong April during which he posted a 2.86 ERA (9 ER/28.1 IP) with 12 walks and 27 strikeouts in five starts ... in the same five starts and 28.1 innings pitched in April of 2024, Olson posted a 3.18 ERA (10 ER/28.1 IP) with 11 walks and 26 strikeouts ... the main difference?: in April of 2025, Olson had a 3-1 record while in April of 2024, Olson had an 0-4 record.

END OF THE NOTES THIS IS: The Tigers bullpen has combined to post a 2.56 ERA (32 ER/112.1 IP) this season, the lowest relief ERA in the American League and the third-lowest mark in all of baseball, behind only San Diego (1.79) and San Francisco (2.22).

- Threw a season-high 7.1 shutout innings on April 23 against San Diego...allowed just two hits and one walk while striking out seven to move to 3-1 and lower his ERA on the year to 3.29.
- Made 22 starts for the Tigers in 2024, posting a 4-8 record with a 3.53 ERA (44ER/112.1IP) and 101 strikeouts...set a career high in games (22) and innings pitched (112.1)
- Allowed a home run to Michael Massey on May 20 at Kansas City, snapping his streak of innings without allowing a homer to start the season at 48.1...in the Wild Card Era (since 1955), that was the third-longest streak by a Tigers starting pitcher to begin the season and sixth longest by any Tiger.
- Allowed one earned run-or-fewer in six consecutive starts from April 26-May 25...became the second Tiger in franchise history to post a sub-2.00 ERA (0.77) while allowing 40-or-fewer hits through his first 10 starts of a season, joining Tom Timmermann in 1972.
- Made his postseason debut on Oct. 6, pitching in relief and giving up a run on three hits with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings...became the first pitcher to throw 5.0-or-more innings of relief in his first career Postseason game since Ed Willett on Oct. 11, 1909, vs. Pittsburgh.

- Placed on the 15-day injured list on April 18 with right ankle inflammation...activated by Detroit on May 3.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster in 2025
- Pitched in 46 games (12 starts) for the Tigers in 2024, finishing with a 4-5 record, 3.59 ERA (27ER/67.2IP) and 69 strikeouts...set career-best marks in strikeouts, wins, holds (6), opponent batting average (.224), slugging percentage (.354) and OPS (.664).
- Started on Sept. 13 and 14 vs. Baltimore last season, becoming the first Tigers pitcher to start back-to-back team games, which were on consecutive days, since George Uhle on Aug. 4-5, 1929.
- Pitched in six games during the playoffs, combining for a 0-1 record, two saves, 1.50 ERA (1ER/6.0IP) and six strikeouts.
- Made his postseason debut on Oct. 1 at Houston, walking one in a scoreless two-thirds of an inning to pick up the save...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, he became the first pitcher in franchise history to record a save in his first career playoff game.
- Started his postseason career with 5.1 no-hit innings with two walks and six strikeouts in his first four outings.

- After getting optioned to Triple-A Toledo and starting the year on the injured list, made his season debut with Detroit on April 26, allowing just one hit over 0.2 scoreless innings.
