TODAY'S GAME: The Cardinals wrap up a seven-game homestand with the last of a four-game series against their National League Central Division rivals, the Chicago Cubs. Following today's game, the Cardinals will fly to Cleveland to begin a nine-game/10-day road trip visiting Cleveland, Pittsburgh and Chicago.

RECENT REDBIRDS: St. Louis won the first two games of this four-game series before dropping an 8-0 decision last night as the Cubs score eight unanswered runs including three home runs.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals entered today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 3.5 games behind first place Chicago and one game behind Milwaukee for 2nd place. If the season ended today, the Cardinals would be one game out of the final Wild Card position in the National League. Since Flag Day (June 14), the Cardinals are 8-3, the 2nd-best record in the National League behind the Los Angeles Dodgers (9-2). St. Louis is on a stretch of playing 28-of-29 days with their two open dates over the calendar month both in Chicago (June 16 & July 3).

IT'S A TRADITION: Since the Cubs installed lights at Wrigley Field, the Cardinals and Cubs have played 312 days games in their series in St. Louis, Chicago and London, England. The Cardinals are 160-152 over that period under the sun including 66-36 (.647) in the Gateway City, 93-116 (.445) in the Windy City and 1-0 across the pond.

PUT ME IN, COACH: Last night, newly acquired utility man **Garrett Hampson**, started the game in centerfield, moved to shortstop for the 8th inning and pitched the 9th inning. He became the first player in MLB history to play exclusively those three positions in a single game and the 6th all-time playing the three positions in a game joining the five players who played all nine positions in the same game.

A NEW DEBUT: With **Garrett Hampson** pitching in his first game as a Cardinals position player, he snapped a 21-year streak since **Cody McKay**, a catcher, pitched in his first Major League game after appearing as a pinch-hitter earlier in the game. McKay pulled off the feat April 8, 2004 vs. Milwaukee at Busch Memorial Stadium. However, Hampson is the second player this season as INF **Nicky Lopez** pitched for the Los Angeles Angels on Opening Day in his first game with the Halos.

PUTTING ON A SHŌ: Cardinals shortstop **Masyn Winn** is 3-for-7 with a home run in his career against today's starting pitcher **Shōta Imanaga**. The three hits are tied for the 2nd most among all MLB players. Only former Cardinal and current Dodger **Tommy Edman** has more hits going 4-for-8 with three home runs against the Cubs' southpaw.

HALF WAY MARK: The Cardinals played their 81st game of the season last night and matched their win mark from the 2022 season at 44-37. It's the most wins at the halfway point since the 2015 club went 53-28 thru 81 games en route to a 100-win season.

FOUR!: A win today would give the Cardinals their series win against the Chicago Cubs in a series of four games or more since Aug. 22-25, 2022, when they took 3-of-5 games at Wrigley Field. The last time the Cardinals won a series of exactly four games was Sept. 24-26, 2021, when they swept a four-game series at Wrigley Field. The Cardinals last took a four-game series at home against the Cubs, July 19-22, 2021, at Busch Stadium when they took 3-of-4.

BOMBS AWAY: Despite last night's shutout, the Cardinals have hit seven home runs total over the first three games of this series. With two home runs today, the Cardinals would match their most home runs in a four-game series during Oliver Marmol's managerial post, with a four-game series against Los Angeles (NL) May 18-21, 2023, when they whacked nine, including seven in one game alone on May 18.

Willson Contreras played parts of seven seasons with the Cubs (2016-22)...was a three-time All-Star and member of the 2016 World Series Champions...originally signed as an international free agent with Chicago (July 2, 2009).

Sonny Gray was originally selected by the Cubs in the 27th round of the 2008 MLB Draft, but did not sign to attend Vanderbilt University.

Stubby Clapp (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made his MLB debut vs. the Cubs.

Brant Brown was the Cubs 3rd round draft pick in 1992 and played parts of four seasons (1996-98 & 2000) with the North Siders.

Daniel Descalso played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

Jon Jay played in 141 games for the Cubs in 2017 and was part of their playoff run to the NLCS.

Lars Nootbaar and **Shota Imanaga** were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Chip Caray served as the Cubs play-by-play announcer for seven seasons (1998-2004) on WGN...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, spent the final 16 years of his career broadcasting Cubs games (1982-97).

Cubs catcher **Carson Kelly** was drafted by St. Louis in 2012 and played three seasons (2016-18) for the Cardinals.

Cubs Scouting VP **Dan Kantrovitz** previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cards 25th Rd. draft pick from Brown Univ...took first job in MLB as the Cardinals Scouting Coordinator

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Yohel Pozo's father, also named Yohel, played 36 games for the Rockies/Cubs partner team in the Arizona Rookie League in 1992.

Nolan Gorman won the 2017 Under Armour High School All-America Game HR Derby at Wrigley Field. Marquee Sports Network Analyst **Rick Sutcliffe** played for St. Louis in 1994.

Cardinals VP/Special Projects **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Cubs Special Assistant to the GM **Jaron Madison** previously served as the Cardinals Assistant Director of Scouting (2008-09).

TODAY'S GAME:

- Making his 16th start of the season today, as he makes his 46th career start; It's his 154th career appearance; **His 16th start will be 4 shy of his career-high 20 in 2024.**
- **Enters tonight's game leading all National League pitchers in Ground Balls, Ground Ball Pct. and Ground Ball/Fly Ball ratio.**
- Today's game is his 3rd career start against the Cubs and comes in his 11th career appearance against Chicago.
- Has not allowed more than three earned runs in his five day game starts this season.
- The Cardinals are 9-6 in his 15 games started this season.
- **Cardinals are 8-1 in starts in which Pallante has received 2 or more runs of support**, with the lone loss coming in his 6/3 start vs. KC, a 10-7 Cardinals defeat.
- Sporting a career-best .277 BABIP for the season.
- Since returning to the Cardinals starting rotation on May 26, 2024, he ranks 2nd on the team in wins (13) behind Sonny Gray (14) and leads in ERA (3.95) in 35 starts.
- Since his 2022 MLB debut, has the best ground ball percentage (65.9%) in MLB (min. 150 appearances).
- **Pallante's 62.3 groundball pct. as a starting pitcher (248.0 IP) is 6th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 200.0 IP as starter).**
- Has allowed home runs in 9-of-15 starts this season and his 11 HR's allowed have passed his total (8) for all of last season.
- Has had 23 total chances in the field, ranking T-4th in MLB among all pitchers.
- Is 16-13 as a starting pitcher in his 45 career starts (248.0 IP) with a 3.96 ERA.

LAST TIME OUT: Yielded a pair of singles over 6.0+ shutout frames in last Friday's 6-1 win over the Reds in the homestand opener. Exited with a runner on first in the 7th inning the St. Louis leading 1-0. Improved to 6-2 over the Reds in his career.

2025 NOTES:

- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 4th time (2022-2025).
- The Cardinals are 9-6 in his games started, going 4-3 at Home and 5-3 on the Road.
- His 2.28 run support average in April was MLB's 6th-lowest & 2nd among Cards starters to Miles Mikolas (1.90 - 3rd in MLB) for the month.
- Allowed a pair of runs over a season-high 7.1 innings for 4-2 win over Washington at Nationals Park on 5/10. Also fanned a season-best seven while walking none. Yielded 2-run HR to Dylan Crews as his final batter faced in the 7th inning.
- Suffered his 1st loss of the season on 4/17 at NYM; threw a season-high 95 pitches over 6.0 IP with all 4 of his runs allowed in the 4-1 defeat coming in the Mets 2nd inning
- Improved his record to 2-0 in a combined 2-0 shutout win over the Philadelphia Phillies 4/11 at Busch Stadium, allowing just 2 hits in his 7.0 IP (93 pitches). After an injury to Masyn Winn, catcher Pedro Pages played 4 innings (2nd thru 5th) of that game at 2nd base.
- Went without a decision for his 3rd-straight start on 6/9, as the Cardinals dropped a 5-4 game to Toronto in 10 innings after rallying to take a 4-3 lead in the 8th on Ivan Herrera's 3-run HR; Worked 6.0+ IP for the 1st time since his 5/16 start at KC (7.0 IP), but received zero runs in support and left the game trailing 2-0.

CAREER NOTES:

- Utilized as a hybrid pitcher during his 2022 rookie season with 47 appearances and 10 starts. Led the Cardinals with 62 relief appearances in 2023. Began the 2024 season in the bullpen, was optioned on April 21, and returned to the rotation on May 26 finishing the season with 20 starts as one of the Cardinals most effective starters.
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.
- Pitched for Team Italy in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
- Graduated from San Clemente High School that also produced Cardinals 2021 1st round pick RHP Michael McGreevy and Braves 2015 1st round pick Kolby Allard.

PALLANTE VS. CHICAGO CUBS

- Makes his 11th career appearance (4th start) against the Cubs. Enters today 0-2 with a 2.45 ERA (22.0 IP) and 13 strikeouts vs. the Cubs.
- In three career starts, is 0-2 with a 3.38 ERA (13.1 IP) and eight strikeouts, while receiving three total runs of support (STL is 1-2).
- Sports a 1.04 ERA (8.2 IP) in seven relief outings against the Cubs.
- Made a relief appearance vs. Cubs at London Stadium (June 25, 2023). Pitched a scoreless 8th inning allowing one hit and recorded a Hold, setting up Jordan Hicks for the save in the 9th inning.
- In 15 career starts against the NL Central Division since 2022, is 6-5 with a 2.66 ERA (81.1 IP) and 67 strikeouts. He's allowed 1 run or fewer in 8 of those 15 starts.
- In his most recent start vs. the Cubs, exited after 3.1 innings and 59 pitches taking the loss at Wrigley Field (June 15, 2024) pitching opposite **Shōta Imanaga**. Had two inherited runners score, one on an error.
