FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a nine-game, 10-day road trip with the second game of a three-game series in Philadelphia. The Cardinals road trip encompasses three three-game series in Cincinnati (May 27-29), Philadelphia (May 31-June 2) and Houston (June 3-5) with an open date in Philadelphia on this longest road trip of their 2024 season. Tonight is the second of five straight night games for the Cardinals after playing 2-of-3 day games in Cincinnati.

RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals fell to the Phillies last night 4-2 as **Nolan Arenado** (#5) and **Brandon Crawford** (#1) each homered. The three hits by St. Louis tied their season-low all the way back to the first series of the season against the Los Angeles Dodgers. The Cardinals open today in 2nd place in the National League Central, six games back of first place Milwaukee.

WINN STREAK COMES TO AN END: Cardinals shortstop **Masyn Winn** had his career-long 18-game hitting streak end last night going 0-for-1 while pinch-hitting for **Brandon Crawford** with the Cardinals trailing 3-2 in the 7th inning. Winn's streak was the 2nd-longest by a Cardinals rookie trailing only Philadelphia native **Joe McEwing**, who ran off 25 games with a hit in 1999.

ALL EYES ON US: Tonight is the first of two National TV games for the Cardinals this weekend as FOX has tonight's matchup and ESPN will televise the Cardinals on Sunday Night for the second week in a row. Last weekend, the Cardinals swept a two-game series from the Chicago Cubs on FOX Saturday and ESPN Sunday, after a rain out on Friday.

CUE' THE BLUES: Tonight marks the 2024 debut of the Cardinals "Victory Blue" uniforms. Last season, the Cardinals were 5-5 in the blues and last wore them in a 5-2 win on Sept. 23, 2023 in San Diego. St. Louis is 1-0 in their City Connect uniforms this season as well. On July 2, 2022, the Cardinals defeated the Phillies 8-7 in the blues setting a Major League record with four consecutive 1st inning home runs.

GALLEGOS STARTS REHAB ASSIGNMENT: Cardinals RHP **Giovanny Gallegos** began his injury rehabilitation assignment in Memphis (AAA) last night and threw a scoreless inning with a strikeout on 10 pitches (7 strikes). Gallegos was placed on the Injured List May 6 with a right shoulder impingement.

PAIRS BEYOND COMPARE: The Cardinals have had three players hit home runs on consecutive games this road trip. It began when **Paul Goldschmidt** homered in Cincinnati on Monday coming off a multi-home run effort in St. Louis against the Cubs on Sunday. It rolled on as **Nolan Gorman** homered on Tuesday and Wednesday. **Nolan Arenado** homered on Tuesday, had Wednesday off, and homered last night in Philadelphia for the current active streak. This season, the Cardinals have had six instances of homers in consecutive games with Gorman pulling off the feat twice. The last Cardinal to homer in three or more consecutive games was **Willson Contreras** (3 - Sept. 6-9, 2023).

CLOSE & LATE AND LATE IN THE COUNT: Cardinals boast a few clutch hitters as outfielder **Alec Burleson** is tied for the Major League lead with 13 hits in Close & Late situations with **Marcell Ozuna** (ATL) and **Amed Rosario** (TB). Shortstop **Masyn Winn** is currently 2nd in MLB with a .308 BA in two-strike counts, trailing only **Kevin Pillar** (16-49, .327), while his 28 hits deep in the count are tied for 10th in MLB with teammate **Nolan Arenado**.

IT'S ALWAYS SONNY IN PHILADELPHIA: Cardinals starting pitcher **Sonny Gray** is making his 10th start of the season. His first start as a Cardinal was against the Phillies back on April 9. He celebrated it by tossing 5.0 scoreless innings for a 3-0 win. Gray continued his streak to a team-best 17.0 scoreless innings before it was snapped. He has registered a decision in each of his nine starts, the longest streak of decisions to start a season for the Cardinals since **Carlos Martinez** registered 12 to begin the 2016 season. Since the Live Ball Era (Post 1920), **Bob Gibson** holds the Cardinals record with 22 decisions to start the 1966 season.

HEL'S' BELLS: Cardinals relief pitcher **Ryan Helsley** has run off a Major League-best 18 consecutive saves and is 18-for-19 this season overall, with a blown save at Los Angeles on March 30. Helsley's 18 saves in the first 55 games of the Cardinals season is tied for the most with **Trevor Rosenthal**, who rescued 18 in the first 55 games of 2015.

PHILADELPHIA CONNECTIONS

Turner Ward played 17 games for the Phillies and 70 games for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Red Barons (AAA) in his final season in 2001.

JoJo Romero pitched parts of three seasons in Philadelphia (2020-22)...originally selected by the Phillies in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft.

Edmundo Sosa signed with the Cardinals as an international free agent (July 2, 2012)...played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2018-22)...traded to Phillies for **JoJo Romero** (July 30, 2022).

Kyle Gibson pitched parts of two seasons with the Phillies (2021-22)...was originally selected by Philadelphia in the 36th round of the 2006 MLB Draft, but did not sign to attend Mizou.

Michael Siani was born in and resides in Glenside, Pa...graduated from William Penn Charter School in Philadelphia...same high school as Phillies broadcaster **Ruben Amaro**.

Nolan Arenado is the last Cardinal to hit for the cycle (2nd career) on July 1, 2022 at Philadelphia...became the 17th in Cardinals history and first since **Mark Grudzielanek** in 2005.

Paul Goldschmidt was born in nearby Wilmington, Del...moved to Texas when he was one.

Phillies Amateur Scouting Director **Brian Barber** was a 1st-round (#22) selection in the 1991 MLB draft by St. Louis from Dr. Phillips (Fla.) High School, same school as **Oliver Marmol**...pitched in 10 games for St. Louis (1995-96).

Phillies Bullpen catcher/Asst. Catching Coach **Brad Flanders** played two seasons (2003-04) at the University of Missouri...coached at Saint Louis University for three seasons (2011-13).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Bill White** played three seasons with Philadelphia (1966-68)...traded to the Phillies in 1965 and back to St. Louis in 1969.

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** was originally selected by the Phillies in the 2nd round of the 1993 MLB draft... Played parts of seven seasons with Philadelphia (1996-2002)...Traded to St. Louis with **Doug Nickle** & cash for **Placido Polanco**, **Bud Smith**, & **Mike Timlin** (July 29, 2002).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Tom Herr** was born in nearby Lancaster, Pa. (April 4, 1956)

Phillies Visiting Clubhouse Manager **Kevin Steinhour** began his career as a batboy & clubhouse worker for Springfield (A) in the Cardinals organization (1981-87) before serving as Louisville Redbirds (AAA) Equipment Manager (1988-89).

Phillies Sr. Director, International Scouting **Sal Agostinelli** was selected by St. Louis in the 20th round of the 1983 MLB draft... played six seasons (1983-88) in the Cardinals minor league system.

- Makes his 10th start of the season tonight and his 7th career start against the Phillies.
- Opened the season on the Injured List and made his first start on April 9 at Philadelphia, 12 games into the season. Since April 9, ranks among National League leaders in starts (9), wins (7, T-2nd), strikeouts (67, T-4th), and strikeouts/9 IP (11.60, 3rd).
- Enters tonight start with 11.0 scoreless innings streak vs. the Phillies & no HR's allowed in last 17.1 IP against Philadelphia.
- Has allowed six home runs this season in 52.0 innings pitched after an MLB-low eight homers allowed over 184.0 innings pitched (among 2023 qualifiers).
- Has 61.3 K% on Sweeper pitch, fanning 38 in 62 plate appearances, ranking 4th in MLB.
- Leads the Cardinals and ranks 3rd in the National League with seven wins. Has recorded decisions in all nine starts, with both of his losses coming against Milwaukee.
- Surpassed 1,600 career innings vs. CWS (5/3), firing 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball in a 3-0 win, his 7th career win vs. the Pale Hose, the opponent he has his 3rd-most wins against.
- Opened the season with 17.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and 4th-longest in MLB. The last time a Cardinals starting pitcher opened the season with 17.0+ scoreless innings was **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003, who set the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - Elias
- Had an 0.89 ERA through his first five starts with St. Louis, lowest by a Cardinal in his first five appearances as a starter with the organization since 1910.
- Struck out 12 batters vs. Milwaukee (April 21), his most since a career-high 13 vs. Houston (April 7, 2023); the 15th double-digit strikeout game of his career.
- Ranks 13th among active pitchers with 105 career wins. Is joined by teammates **Lance Lynn** (138, 6th) and **Kyle Gibson** (108, T-10th) in the top-20.
- Gray is one of three free-agent starters (**Lance Lynn & Kyle Gibson**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Has joined his fifth Major League team: Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), Twins (2022-23) and Cardinals (2024).

LAST TIME OUT

- Blanked the Cubs over his 5.0 IP, winning his 3rd-straight decision, as the Cardinals completed a rain-shortened series sweep over Chicago. Improved his record to 7-2 to join Lance Lynn & Lynn McGlothen for most wins in 1st nine STL starts since 1969.

- Selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 1st round (18th overall) of the 2011 Major League Draft out of Vanderbilt University.
- His 3.44 career ERA ranks 6th among active pitchers & 1,588 strikeouts rank 16th.
- Has made 11 career starts at Busch Stadium, with six of those being Quality Starts. He is 5-4, 2.24 ERA career at Busch (64.1 IP/16 ER).

- His current 3-game win streak is tied with Kyle Gibson for the team's best in 2024.
- Has struck out 67 batters over his first nine starts for the Cardinals, most in franchise history through first nine starts as a Cardinal and his 7 wins are T-1st for most in first nine starts with the club dating to 1969.
- Allowed a career-high 3 HR's and a season-high six runs in 7-1 loss at MIL on May 9.
- Struck out a season-high 12 batters over 6.2 innings in a 2-0 loss to MIL (4/21). Marked his 15th career double-digit strikeout game and first since a career-high 13 vs. HOU (4/7/23).
- Carried a no-hitter into the 6th inning before back-to-back errors, followed by a three-run home run by Gunner Henderson on May 20 that escalated it into a 31-pitch inning
