**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals conclude their six-game roadtrip today with a series rubber game against Colorado...St. Louis opened the post All-Star break portion of their schedule last Friday in Arizona and were swept by the Diamondbacks at Chase Field for the first time since 2007...following today's game in Denver, the Cardinals will return home to open a 7-game homestand with the Padres (July 24-27) & Marlins (July 28-30) leading up to the MLB trade deadline.

**BIRD WATCHING:** St. Louis begins the day T-3rd in the NL Central with Cincinnati, 8.5 games behind division co-leaders Milwaukee and Chicago and 3.5 games behind San Diego for the 3rd and final NL Wild Card spot...the Cardinals were 51-46 before the All-Star Break, their most wins since 2015 (56), but have gone 1-4 to begin the 2nd half.

**FEDDE DFA/GRANILLO RECALLED:** Prior to today's game, the Cardinals designated RHP **Erick Fedde** for assignment and recalled rookie RHP **Andre Granillo** (#54) from Memphis (AAA)...Granillo has appeared in 5 games for St. Louis this season, going 1-0 with a 1.35 ERA & 1 save in his 6.2 IP.

**TAP THE ROCKIES:** The Cardinals have won the season series vs. the Rockies 22 times in 31 seasons since Colorado joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993...they are meeting this week for the 1st time this season.

**KYLE'S K's:** Pitching with a heavy heart after the passing of his grandmother earlier in the day, **Kyle Leahy** recorded 7 of his 11 outs via strikeout over his career high 3.2 IP in relief last night...Leahy's career-high 7 strikeouts were the most by a Cardinals reliever over 3.2 IP or fewer since **Tyler Lyons** did so on 6/17/17 at BAL; other Cardinals relievers to do so were **Dave LaPoint** (1983), **Doug Bair** (1982), **Bobby Shantz** (1963) and **Dizzy Dean** (1934).

**DEEP PURPLE:** In a pair of series match-ups against the lone pair of MLB teams (ARI & COL) that use purple among their team colors, the Redbirds have found themselves in deep deficits of 5-0, 6-0, 5-1 & 6-0 following the 1st three innings in each of their four losses on the current roadtrip, allowing 7 HR's in those 12 innings of play.

**MILE HIGH HIKE:** The Cardinals (110g), Cubs (105g), and Mets (107g) are the only three National League teams that have never had a pitcher throw a complete game at Coors Field ... **Braden Loooper** (8.1 IP) came the closest by a Cardinal in Denver on May 6, 2008 ... The Cardinals, who also had no route-going efforts in their 12 games played in 1993-94 at Denver's Mile High Stadium, also lack a complete game effort in their 66 regular season games at Philadelphia's Citizens Bank Park, although they did have **Chris Carpenter's** Division Series clinching gem in 2011.

**CONTACT PLAY:** Cardinals batters struck out just once in their 35 at-bats last night, that coming in the final out of the game...the last time they had just one K in more at-bats was on 5/31/10 vs. CIN (36 at-bats)...the Cubs have MLB's lone game with zero batter strikeouts this season...the Cardinals last zero K game was on 4/30/13 vs. CIN.

**FOUR!** The Cardinals have scored four or more runs in all 11 games that they have played at Coors Field since Oliver Marmol became manager in 2022. It's currently the longest active streak of four-run games at Coors Field of any Major League opponent and the Cardinals longest such streak at the 30-year old ballpark.

**HELLRAISER:** **Ryan Helsley** is one of five pitchers all-time and one of two active pitchers along with **Devin Williams** (10 app, 9.1 IP) to make 10+ appearances without allowing an earned run against the Rockies. Helsley has made 11 career appearances covering 12.0 IP & has 2 wins to go along with a perfect 5-for-5 in save opportunities.

**PICKET FENCE:** The Cardinals plated their 6 runs over four consecutive innings of scoring on Monday night, marking only the 2nd time this season that they had scored runs in 4+ consecutive innings...the Cardinals are 19-7 when they score runs in four or more innings.

**CLUB 300:** With the Cardinals next win, **Oliver Marmol** (2022-present) will record his 300th career managerial win, ranking 13th all-time among Cardinals managers, and 12 wins back of **Gabby Street** who ranks 12th with his 312 managerial wins from 1929-33.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY KT:** Cardinals bullpen catcher **Kleininger "KT" Teran** celebrates his 36th birthday today.

#### COLORADO CONNECTIONS

**Nolan Arenado** played eight seasons with Colorado (2013-20), where he was a five-time NL All-Star and the winner of four Silver Sluggers, eight Gold Gloves, and four Platinum Gloves...originally selected by Colorado in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft...Acquired by St. Louis with cash in exchange for **Austin Gomber**, **Elehuris Montero**, **Tony Loney**, **Mateo Gil** and **Jake Sonnier**.

**Nolan Arenado's** cousin, **Josh Fuentes**, played three seasons with the Rockies (2019-21) and college baseball at Missouri Baptist Univ. (2014).

**Garrett Hampson** was selected by Colorado in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft...played parts of five seasons for the Rockies (2018-22).

**Daniel Descalso** played two seasons with Colorado (2015-16).

**Kyle Leahy** was born in and resides in Boulder...graduated from Erie High School, and selected to play at the Colorado High School Futures Game at Coors Field...played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction (2016-18).

**Austin Gomber** pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2018, '20)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 4th round of the 2014 MLB Draft...shared Cardinals Co-Minor League Pitchers of the Year honors with **Alex Reyes** in 2015.

**John Mozeliak** began his baseball career with the Rockies...initially served as a left-handed batting practice pitcher in 1993 and worked in a variety of positions in the home clubhouse and in baseball operations...joined St. Louis as an assistant in scouting operations following the 1995 season...graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, Colo., where he was a first baseman and pitcher...graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Asst. GM & Scouting Director **Randy Flores** pitched in 82 games in three seasons (2002, '09-10) over two stints with Colorado.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Holliday** was originally selected by Colorado in the 7th round of the 1998 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons for the Rockies (2004-08, '18) where he was a three-time All-Star and appeared in the 2007 World Series.

Rockies Bench Coach **Clint Hurdle** played in 78 games for St. Louis in 1986.

Rockies MLB.com **Thomas Harding** covered the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) for two seasons for the Commercial Appeal (1998-99)...mentored recent Cardinals MLB.com writer **Anne Rogers**.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch columnist **Benjamin Hochman** previously worked as a sports writer and columnist for the Denver Post (2007-15).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Derrick Goold** is originally from Boulder...graduated from Centaurus High School in Lafayette...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

Rockies Communications Coordinator **Kevin Collins** previously served as the 2015 Media Relations Intern for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA).

Rockies Digital Comm. Manager **Nora Farrell** previously worked in communications and social media for St. Louis for part of seven seasons (2016-22).

TODAY'S GAME:

- Making his 20th start of the season today and his 50th career start (158th career appearance). Matches his single-season high with 20 starts from last season.
- Is 2-2 with a 3.98 ERA in six day game starts this season. Has not allowed more than three earned runs in any of those starts.
- Enters today's game leading all National League pitchers in Ground Balls, Ground Ball Pct. and Ground Ball/Fly Ball ratio, trailing only Angels RHP Jose Soriano in each category for MLB lead.**
- St. Louis is 8-1 in starts in which Pallante has received 2 or more runs of support, with the lone loss coming in his 6/3 start vs. KC, a 10-7 Cardinals defeat.
- Has not received more than one run of support in his last five starts with zero in three of them.
- Career 9-6 with a 3.86 ERA (149.1 IP) and 96 strikeouts in 66 games (15 starts) Post All-Star.
- The Cardinals are 9-10 in his 19 games started this season, and have lost his last four outings (June 26-present) with two total runs of support.
- Since returning to the Cardinals starting rotation on May 26, 2024, leads team in qualifying ERA (4.12) and is 2nd in wins (13) behind Sonny Gray (16 & 4.14).
- Since his 2022 MLB debut, has the best ground ball percentage (65.1%) in MLB (min. 150 appearances).
- Pallante's 61.1 groundball pct. as a starting pitcher (270.2 IP) is 5th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 250.0 IP as starter).**
- Has allowed home runs in 11-of-19 starts this season and his 14 HR's allowed have passed his total (8) for all of last season.
- Has had 30 total chances in the field, ranking 4th among MLB pitchers.
- Is 16-16 as a starting pitcher in his 49 career starts (270.2 IP) with a 4.09 ERA.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Allowed six runs (5 ER) over 4.2 innings in a 7-3 loss at Arizona (7/18). Received zero runs of support for the 5th start this season and 3rd time over his last five starts.

2025 NOTES:

- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 4th time (2022-2025).
- Received a no decision in a 1-0 Cardinals loss at Pittsburgh (July 1) as he exited after 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball, his lowest hit total in a start in his career. Ran his scoreless inning streak vs. PIT to 17.0 innings.
- His 2.28 run support average in April was MLB's 6th-lowest & 2nd among Cards starters to Miles Mikolas (1.90 - 3rd in MLB) for the month.
- Received a no decision at PIT (7/1) despite firing 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball in a game the Cardinals lost 1-0 on an 8th inning run.
- Yielded a pair of singles over 6.0+ shutout frames in 6-1 win over the Reds on 6/20; exited with a runner on first in the 7th inning and St. Louis leading 1-0. Improved to 6-2 over the Reds in his career.
- Allowed a pair of runs over a season-high 7.1 innings for 4-2 win over Washington at Nationals Park on 5/10. Also fanned a season-best seven while walking none. Yielded 2-run HR to Dylan Crews as his final batter faced in the 7th inning.
- Suffered his 1st loss of the season on 4/17 at NYM; threw a season-high 95 pitches over 6.0 IP with all 4 of his runs allowed in the 4-1 defeat coming in the Mets 2nd inning
- Improved his record to 2-0 in a combined 2-0 shutout win over the Philadelphia Phillies 4/11 at Busch Stadium, allowing just 2 hits in his 7.0 IP (93 pitches). After an injury to Masyn Winn, catcher Pedro Pages played 4 innings (2nd thru 5th) of that game at 2nd base.

CAREER NOTES:

- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.
- Pitched for Team Italy in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
- Graduated from San Clemente High School that also produced Cardinals 2021 1st round pick RHP Michael McGreevy and Braves 2015 1st round pick Kolby Allard.

PALLANTE vs. COLORADO:

- Makes his 2nd career start (1st at Coors Field) and 7th career appearance vs. the Rockies; Is 2-0 with an 0.68 ERA covering 13.1 innings pitched.
- Hurled 5.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts in a 5-1 win at Busch Stadium on June 9, 2024.
- Has only allowed one run coming on a solo home run to **Ryan McMahon** on Aug. 5, 2023 at Busch Stadium.
- Cardinals are 5-1 in his six appearances vs. COL.
- Is 1-0 with a 1.08 ERA in five relief appearances, three of those appearances of 2.0 innings or more.
