RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their six-game, seven-day, Buckeye-State homestand tonight with the second game of a four-game series against the division-rival Cincinnati Reds ... The Cleveland Indians visit Busch Stadium for a two-game Interleague series beginning Tuesday ... Tonight is game 15 of 17 straight days without an off-day for the Cardinals (STL is 6-8) ... The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, 1.5 games behind the Chicago Cubs.

SEEING RED: The Cardinals are 13-7 at home vs. the Reds since 2019, the Cardinals have defeated Cincinnati (84-46, .646) more than any other opponent in Busch Stadium III history ... Only the Padres (16-32, .333), Nationals (14-32, .304), and Rockies (13-41, .241) have lower winning percentages at Busch III than Cincinnati (.354).

HOLY SCHNIKES!!: Tommy Edman stole his team-leading 11th base last night, T3rd-most in the National League this season ... Edman's 11 stolen bases through the first 57 team games are the most by a Cardinal since **Tony Womack** (12 in 2004) ... The franchise record is held by **Vince Coleman**, who swiped 41 of his league-leading 110 bags though the first 57 team games during his Rookie of the Year campaign in 1985.

OHHHHHHHH, CANADA!: **Tyler O'Neill** is riding a career-high 11-game hitting streak (16-41, .390/.419/.854, 5 HR, 11 RBI), 5th-longest active in MLB and one game shy of **Tommy Edman**'s team high of 12.

SAVE CRAVE: **Alex Reyes** has converted 18 consecutive saves to begin his career (16-for-16 this season) and currently ranks 3rd all-time behind **LaTroy Hawkins** (23) & **Tippy Martinez** (22) ... Despite a 1.38 WHIP, Reyes has MLB's lowest BA w/ RISP (.045) and the NL's lowest w/ runners on base (.081).

ROOKIE ROCKSTAR: Outfielder **Dylan Carlson** leads or is tied for the National League rookie lead in games (55), homers (6), RBI (26), on-base pct. (.360), and walks (24), outfield assists (5), while ranking 2nd in hits (53), runs (31), doubles (8), and total bases (83).

STRIKE FIRST, STRIKE HARD, NO MERCY: The Cardinals and Mets share MLB's highest winning percentage (.793, 23-6) when scoring first this season ... Leadoff man **Tommy Edman** shares the MLB lead in hits (16), doubles (5), triples (2), and runs scored (12) in the opening frame.

WALK IN THE PARK: St. Louis (257) and Cincinnati (233) pitching staffs have issued the most walks in Major League Baseball this season ... Cardinals pitchers have issued MLB-leading 15 bases loaded walks, six more than Cincinnati (9, 2nd) ... The last time St. Louis led the National League in walks issued was 1961 (570), while the last time the Cardinals led all of baseball in walks issued was 1912 (560).

BIRD SEED: **Matt Carpenter** is two walks away from reaching 681 for his career, tying **Lou Brock** (1964-79) for 6th in franchise history ... **Yadier Molina**'s 11 hits on the first pitch (0-0 counts) lead the Cardinals this season, as the 38-year-old backstop is enjoying career-bests in BA (.478), OBP (.458), SLG (.739), and OPS (1.197) on the first pitch of at-bats; Molina's 416 career hits on the first pitch are the most among Cardinals in data tracked since 1988, and rank 2nd among active players behind only **Miguel Cabrera** (562).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (June 4, 2011): Ten years ago, reigning Cardinals Minor League Player of the Year and 25-year-old **Matt Carpenter** makes his MLB debut in a start at third base for St. Louis in a 5-4 win over the Cubs in 12 innings at Busch Stadium. Wearing No. 19 that season, Carpenter doubles off **Kerry Wood** in the bottom of the 9th for his first hit, while **Albert Pujols** goes yard twice, his second being a walk-off, two-out solo blast off **Jeff Samardzija**. Pujols would hit another walk-off homer the following day off Cubs pitcher Rodrigo Lopez in a 3-2 win as the Cardinals improve to 36-25 and the best record across Major League Baseball.

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Daniel Ponce de Leon (38th round in 2012) and **Tyler Webb** (48th round in 2011) were both selected by the Reds, but did not sign.

Daniel Ponce de Leon (July 23, 2018 at GABP) and **Alex Reyes** (August 9, 2016 at Busch) made their MLB debuts vs. Cincinnati.

Mike Maddux was born in Dayton, Ohio...originally selected by the Reds in the 36th round of the 1979 MLB draft, but did not sign to attend the University of Texas at El Paso.

David Bell served as a Cardinals assistant hitting (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with **Pepe McNeal** and **Rick Heiserman** to St. Louis for **Ken Hill** (July 27, 1995).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12), where he was a 2010 Gold Glove Award winner and two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Reds outfielder **Scott Heineman**'s older brother, **Tyler Heineman**, is a catcher for AAA-Memphis.

Reds Asst. Hitting Coach **Joe Mather** was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2001 MLB draft...played parts of two years with St. Louis (2008, '10).

Reds Executive Advisor to the CEO **Walt Jocketty** served as the Cardinals GM for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, St. Louis compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-'06), two NL Championships ('04, '06), and one World Series Championship ('06)...named MLB Executive of the Year (2000, '04, '10).

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Max Schrock played in 11 games for the Cardinals in 2020...acquired by St. Louis with **Yairo Muñoz** from Oakland in exchange for **Stephen Piscotty** (Dec. 14, 2017).

Reds first base coach **Delino DeShields** played two seasons with St. Louis (1997-98).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for the Reds in 1996.

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds Special Asst. to the GM **Marty Maier** spent 24 seasons with St. Louis as an area scout, Latin American coordinator, asst. director of scouting, scouting director and special asst. to the GM.

Reds pro scout **Bruce Mano** worked in the Cardinals for six seasons as Director of Player Development (2002-06) and Senior Director of Pro Scouting & Special Assistant to the GM (2007).

Reds Bullpen Coach **Lee Tunnell** pitched in 32 games for St. Louis in 1987.

Reds Special Assistant to the GM, Player Personnel **Cam Bonifay** played two minor league seasons with the Cardinals...later worked for St. Louis as a professional scout and special assistant.

Reds Player Performance Special Asst. **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.

Reds Special Assistant to the GM **John Morris** played five seasons for St. Louis (1986-90).

Reds CEO **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Has entered his 15th season of professional baseball and his second with the Cardinals after playing 13 professional seasons in the KBO (Korean Baseball Organization).
- Makes his 9th start of the season and 16th career Major League start (17th app.).
- The Cardinals won each of his first five starts to begin 2021 but have dropped his last three. They're 11-5 overall (.571 win pct.) in his 16 career appearances from 2020-21.
- The Cardinals have won five of Kim's eight starts, and combined with Jack Flaherty (9-2), the team has gone a combined 14-5 (.737 win pct.) in the games started by those two.
- Kim's 2.61 career ERA is the lowest by a Cardinals pitcher (min. 75.0 IP) thru their first 16 career games since Shelby Miller posted a 1.89 mark (2012-13). It's the lowest by a Redbirds lefty since Luis Arroyo's 2.48 mark (1955).
- Has yet to pitch in the 7th inning. Five of his total 15 earned runs allowed have come in the 6th inning (27.00 ERA, 1.2 IP)

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed a career single-game high 9 hits and 4 runs in a 9-2 loss at Arizona last Sun. (5/30). It was his 3rd-straight defeat after Cards had gone 5-0 in his first 5 starts.

2021 SEASON

- Hurled 5.2 scoreless innings against the White Sox on 5/24 before giving up two-run HR and walk in the 6th inning, while throwing a career high 104 pitches.
- Did not allow HR in 23.2 IP over five starts from 4/23, 6th inning to 5/24, 6th inning.
- Suffered first career MLB loss, lasting just 3.1 IP in a 5-3 defeat vs. the Padres on May 16 at PETCO Park. Walked three and allowed four runs (1 earned), throwing 72 pitches.
- Compiled over 1,500 career strikeouts between the KBO (1,454) and MLB (48) when he struck out six batters at MIL (5/11), fanning Freddy Peralta for No. 1,500.
- Collected his first win of the season and first professional hit while striking out a career-high 8 batters in a 5-4 victory over the Reds (4/23).
- Pitched three innings at PHI (4/17) allowing three runs on five hits in a no-decision for his first action of the season.
- Was activated on April 17 from the 10-day Injured List after missing the first 13 games of the season with a back injury suffered during Spring Training.

CAREER

- 2020 Topps All-Star Rookie Team as a left-handed starting pitcher.
- Is 3-0 with a 1.38 ERA and one save in six career starts (7 app.) at Busch Stadium.
- Holds a 4-1 mark with a 2.18 ERA and one save in 11 appearances (10 starts) in night games with the Cardinals going 9-2.

2020 SEASON

- Among NL pitchers with at least six starts, ranked 1st in ERA (1.62), 12th in WHIP (1.03), 11th in opp. AVG (.197), 8th in opp. OBP (.260) and 10th in opp. SLG (.324).
- Missed 12 games on Injured List with an unspecified injury related to abdominal pain.
- Held his opposition to three hits or less in five of seven starts during 2020 season.
- His 0.33 ERA through his first five major league starts was second best among left-handed pitchers since ERA became an official statistic in 1913 (Fernando Valenzuela, 0.20) (Elias).
- One of only three pitchers in MLB history to have a stretch of four consecutive starts allowing no earned runs and three or fewer hits in at least five innings of work since runs became an official stat in 1912 (Jake Arrieta (CHI 2015-16) & Michael Fulmer (DET 2016), 4 each) (Elias).
