FRIDAY NIGHT LUMBER FIGHTS: The Twins lost to the Astros last night by a score of 13-12 at Target Field... Pablo López (8-7) was the starter and dealt the loss, allowing six runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 17 hits, four from Jose Miranda, who hit his 20th double and his ninth home run, scoring three runs and driving in two (more on Miranda below)...17 hits were the most in a 9-inning loss since 2017...Carlos Correa hit his third career grand slam to narrow the deficit to one run in the ninth inning, but the Twins fell one run short.

IT'S THAT DANG JOSE, HE'S SO HOT RIGHT NOW: Jose Miranda is hitting .369 (48-for-130) with 13 doubles, one triple, five home runs, 30 RBI, a .410 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.010 OPS in his last 37 games, since May 24...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in batting average, tied for sixth in RBI, eighth in slugging and OPS, and 11th in on-base percentage.

MIRANDANOTHER ONE, AND ANOTHER ONE, AND ANOTHER ONE...: Last night's four-hit game for Miranda gave him 10 consecutive at-bats with a hit, setting a club record (since 1961), passing the previous record of nine, held by Tony Oliva (1967), Mickey Hatcher (1985) and Todd Walker (1998):

SPACEBALLS: The Twins have gone 2-2 against the Astros this season, going 2-1 at Minute Maid Park from May 31-June 2, followed

by a loss last night.

After going 0-6 against the Astros in 2022, the Twins have gone 6-4 in regular season games vs. Houston since the start of 2023... in that span, they have outscored the 'Stros 52-47.

The Twins are 41-46 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 30-37 since Houston joined the American League in 2013.

Notable numbers against Houston this season: Carlos Santana is 4-for-11 (.364) with a double and a home run...Jose Miranda is 7-for-14 (.500) with two doubles, two home runs and five RBI.

SURE-LEE YOU CAN'T BE SERIOUS: Twins number two prospect Brooks Lee made his major league debut on Wednesday night and has gone 6-for-11 with one walk, two doubles and four RBI in three games to begin his major league career...the last Twin to begin their career by hitting in each of their first four was Luis Arraez from May 18-21, 2019...the club record for a hitting streak to start a career is 13 by Glenn Williams, from June 7-28, 2005.

In 23 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota, Lee has hit .354 (34-for-96) with six doubles, seven home runs, 25 RBI, 21 runs scored, 10 walks, a .411 on-base percentage, a .635 slugging percentage and a 1.047 OPS.
