**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles fell to the Rangers, 5-3, yesterday at Oriole Park... Have dropped the first two games of the three-game set, their first series loss since May 5-7 at Atlanta (1-2) and first at home since April 7-9 vs. New York-AL (1-2)...Are now 11-2-1 in their last 14 series since April 10...Have lost back-to-back games for the first time since May 14-15...Looking to avoid being swept for the first time this year and first time in a series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3); have not been swept at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3).

- 🦅 **Dean Kremer** was dealt the loss in his 50<sup>th</sup> career game after allowing three runs on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts in 6.1 innings...Left the game with a runner on base, who later scored...Threw 97 pitches, 63 strikes.
- 🦅 **Mychal Givens** appeared in his first game at Oriole Park since August 23, 2020 vs. Boston.
- 🦅 **Austin Hays** hit his sixth homer of the season in the seventh inning, a 411-foot blast to put the O's on the board...Has driven in six runs in his last seven games and seven in his last 10.

**CLOSE ENCOUNTERS:** Of Baltimore's 52 games this season, 47 have been decided by four or fewer runs, the most in MLB...The O's have gone 30-17 in those games, the most wins in MLB and second-best winning percentage (.638), behind Tampa Bay (.639, 23-13).

**FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME:** The O's are in the middle of a six-game homestand with three games against the Rangers through today (0-2) and three against the Guardians through Wednesday...The Birds are 15-10 (.600) in Baltimore and own the third-best home winning percentage in the AL and fourth-best in MLB.

**TAKING ON TEXAS:** The O's are facing the Rangers for the second and final time this season...The Birds took two out of three from the Rangers at Globe Life Field from April 3-5...Looking to split the season series against Texas with a win today; have not lost a season series against the Rangers since 2019 (1-6)...The Orioles won eight straight games against Texas from July 4, 2022 to April 4, 2023, their longest winning streak against a single opponent since also winning eight in a row against the Mariners from July 3 to September 19, 2012...Baltimore went 6-0 against Texas last season, their first sweep of a season series against a single opponent since 2020 against the Phillies (3-0) and their first season sweep of at least six games against a single opponent since 2010 against Los Angeles-AL (6-0)...Marked Baltimore's first season sweep of any length against Texas, and the first time the Rangers had ever been swept in a season series by an AL opponent.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The O's have won 24 of their last 36 games, 27 of 40, and 29 of 43...The 33-19 overall record ranks third in MLB to start the season (see box at right)... Entering today, the Rays (38-16), Rangers (33-18), Dodgers (32-21), Braves (31-21), Yankees (31-23), and Astros (30-21) are the only other teams with 30 wins this season, while the Rays and Rangers are the only other teams with fewer than 20 losses.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is managing his 600<sup>th</sup> career game today and his 599<sup>th</sup> as skipper of the Orioles; served one game as Miami's interim manager on June 19, 2011 against Tampa Bay, following the resignation of manager Edwin Rodriguez... Tomorrow, Hyde will become the sixth skipper to manage 600 games for the Orioles, joining Earl Weaver (2,541), Buck Showalter (1,353), Paul Richards (1,063), Hank Bauer (726), and Mike Hargrove (649)...Hyde is currently in his fifth season as manager of the Orioles after being named the 20<sup>th</sup> manager in club history on December 14, 2018...In 2022, he led the O's to an 83-79 record, his first winning season as manager and the club's first winning campaign since 2016...He was named the *Baseball America* MLB Manager of the Year and was voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers...He finished second in voting for the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) American League Manager of the Year award.

**MOUNT UP:** **Ryan Mountcastle** ranks fourth in MLB with 28 Barrels, per Statcast, trailing only Toronto's Matt Chapman (31) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge and New York-NL's Pete Alonso (29)...He ranks 10<sup>th</sup> in MLB with 78 Hard-Hit Balls...He has hit safely in his last five games, slashing .278/.364/.500 (5-for-18) with one double, one home run, four runs scored, three RBI, and two walks in that span.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** The Baltimore bullpen owns a 3.06 ERA (67 ER/197.1 IP), the second-best in MLB behind the Yankees (2.99)...O's relievers have 15 wins this season, tied with Arizona, Cincinnati, and Miami for the second-most in the majors, trailing only New York-AL (16)...The O's are second in MLB with 229 strikeouts from the 'pen, trailing Kansas City (240).

**ON THIS DATE IN 1978:** Orioles Legend and Hall of Famer **Jim Palmer** becomes the first — and to date, only — 200-game winner in Orioles history, shutting out Cleveland, 3-0, at Memorial Stadium.

**WRAPPING UP THE ROAD TRIP:** The Orioles went 5-1 on their seven-day, six-game road trip, their best road trip by winning percentage (.833) this season, ahead of a 4-1 (.800) trip from April 14-19...The most recent trip began with a three-game sweep of the Jays in Toronto from May 19-21...After an off day Monday, the Birds took two of three against the Yankees in the Bronx from May 23-25...The O's are off to an 18-9 start on the road, tied with the 1987 and 2005 teams for the second-best road start through 27 games in team history (since 1954), behind a 20-7 start in 1969...Baltimore currently owns the most road wins and second-best road winning percentage (.667) in MLB, behind Atlanta (.708, 17-7); the O's and Braves are the only teams without double-digit road losses so far this season.

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his ninth start of the season, fourth at home, and second against the Rangers...Made 23 starts in his rookie season with the Orioles in 2022...Went 4-7 with a 4.90 ERA (64 ER/117.2 IP) with 111 strikeouts to 46 walks...Was one of 13 O's players (7 pitchers) to make their debut in 2022...Started on the bump for **Adley Rutschman's** debut on May 21 vs. Tampa Bay...Tossed 16.0 consecutive scoreless innings across four starts from August 26 to September 6...Acquired by the Orioles along with **RHP Kyle Brnovich**, **RHP Zach Peek**, and **RHP Isaac Mattson** from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for **RHP Dylan Bundy** on December 4, 2019...Originally drafted by the Angels in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State...Teammates at NMSU with **INF Joey Ortiz**.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision on May 23 at New York-AL...Allowed four runs on seven hits (1 HR) with three walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...Threw 90 pitches, 51 strikes.

**CAREER AGAINST RANGERS:** Making his third career start against the Rangers this afternoon...Has pitched to a 1.35 ERA (1 ER/6.2 IP) in two career starts against the Rangers, both at Globe Life Field...Did not factor into the decision in his last start against Texas on April 3 after allowing one hit with one walk and two strikeouts in 1.2 innings...Exited the game in the second inning with a right foot contusion after being hit by a line drive from Jonah Heim.

**CAREER AGAINST THE AL WEST:** Making his seventh career start against the AL West...Owns a 3-0 record with a 1.04 ERA (4 ER/34.2 IP) and three quality starts through his first six outings against the division...Earned the win in his last start against the AL West on May 17 vs. Los Angeles-AL, allowing one run on four hits (1 HR) with five strikeouts in a season-high 6.2 innings...Issued zero walks in a start for the first time this season...Threw a season-high 94 pitches, 63 strikes.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Has gone 1-1 with a 4.80 ERA (8 ER/15.0 IP) through his first three home starts this season...Earned the win in his last outing at Oriole Park on May 17 vs. Los Angeles-AL...Owns a 2-6 record with a 4.96 ERA (43 ER/78.0 IP) in 15 career starts at Oriole Park.

**SWING AND A MISS:** Bradish registered 16 swings and misses on May 12 vs. Pittsburgh, his second-most in a game in his career behind the 17 he recorded on August 26, 2022 at Houston.

**SAVING HIS BEST FOR THE BEST:** Made 14 starts against teams that qualified for the 2022 playoffs in his debut season, going 4-4 with a 4.24 (36 ER/76.1 IP) ERA...The Orioles owned a 9-5 record in those games...He went 2-0 against Houston, tossing 8.0 scoreless innings on August 26 at Minute Maid Park and throwing another 8.2 shutout frames on September 22 at Oriole Park.

**2022 HIGHLIGHTS:** Started the season with Triple-A Norfolk, going 2-0 with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP) in three starts with the team...Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 11-17 after going 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (1 ER/9.0 IP) in two starts...Recalled from Norfolk on April 29 and made his MLB debut later that day against the Boston Red Sox...Placed on the 15-day Injured List (right shoulder inflammation) on June 24...Went 3-3 with a 3.28 ERA (26 ER/71.1 IP) in his final 13 starts after being reinstated from the 15-day Injured List on July 29...Notched his first win at Oriole Park on September 22 vs. Houston after surrendering two hits and recording ten punchouts in 8.2 scoreless innings...Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 16 of his 23 starts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP TYLER WELLS (3-1, 3.47 ERA)

Wells will make his 11<sup>th</sup> appearance of the season (10<sup>th</sup> start), sixth start at home, and fourth career appearance (second start) against the Guardians tomorrow afternoon...Did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 24 at New York-AL...Allowed a season-high five runs on five hits (3 HR) with two walks and a career-high-tying eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...Threw 95 pitches, 60 strikes...Also did not factor into the decision in his last start against Cleveland on June 4, 2022 at Oriole Park...Allowed two runs on two hits (2 HR) with two walks and one strikeout in 4.0 innings...Owns an 0-0 record with a 2.70 ERA (2 ER/6.2 IP) through his first three appearances against the Guardians...Will also be his 20<sup>th</sup> career appearance (11<sup>th</sup> start) against the AL Central; has gone 5-3 with a 3.68 ERA (26 ER/63.2 IP) with one save through his first 19 outings against the division...Entering play today, Wells leads MLB in WHIP (0.84) and opponent on-base percentage (.225); he also ranks among qualified leaders in opponent batting average (2<sup>nd</sup>, .176), H/9 (2<sup>nd</sup>, 5.68), and BB/9 (T-11<sup>th</sup>, 1.89).
