The Brewers look to go 10 games over .500 for the first time this season....the team has been 9 games over .500 eight times: 17-8, 20-11, 24-15, 26-17, 27-18, 30-21, 31-22 and 32-23.

#### Home Improvement

The Brewers are 9-3 in their last 12 home games after a 5-7 start.

#### Fo Sho!

Christian Yelich belted a 2-run homer off Shota Imanaga in the first inning last night....prior to the homer, the Brewers had not scored a run off a Cubs starter in 2024 (5g, 32.1ip)....the team scored 7 runs in 4.1 innings off Imanaga last night.

#### Rebel Yeli

Christian Yelich enters today's game needing 1 HR for 200 career and 2 doubles for 300 career.

#### I'll Go First

Joey Ortiz started in the leadoff spot for the first time in his Major League career last night....he reached base safely three times, going 2-for-3 with 3 runs (career high), a double, walk and a stolen base....Ortiz now has a .382 on-base percentage this season.

#### Everyday People

Willy Adames and William Contreras have both started each of the team's first 55 games....this is the longest streak to start a season by Brewers teammates since Ryan Braun and Prince Fielder in 2011 (56 games).

#### Iron Man

William Contreras has played in 92 straight games - all starts - dating back to last season....his last game missed came on 8/20/23 at Texas.

**AT HOME:** The Brewers are 14-10 at home, going 4-2-1 in series play....the team has gone 9-3 in its last 12 home games after a 5-7 start.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 18-13 on the road, going 5-4-1 in series play....the team took 2 of 3 games at Boston on its last trip to snap a streak of four straight road series losses....the Brewers went 4-0-1 in their first five road series this season.

**MANAGER:** Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing **Craig Counsell**....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

**COACHES:** First base coach **Quintin Berry** (4th season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (6th season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator **Walker McKinven** (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons** (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff....**Rickie Weeks** (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 12 replay challenges this season, going 7-5....their last challenge came on 5/28 vs. Chicago-NL as an out call at second base involving Willy Adames stood.

**TODAY'S STARTER: #48 - RHP COLIN REA (10g, 9gs, 4-2, 3.98)**

**REA AT A GLANCE:** Colin Rea, 33, will be making his 11th appearance and 10th start of the season....Rea last pitched last Saturday at Boston in relief and earned a 6-3 victory (5.2ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 3bb, 2k, 68 pitches)....the team is 6-3 in his starts....has has 3 quality starts....opponents are batting .249 (54-for-217, 7hr)....Rea is signed through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025....name is pronounced "RAY."

**LAST SEASON:** Rea went 6-6 with a 4.55 ERA in 26 games/22 starts during five stints with Milwaukee last season....the team went 14-8 in his starts....he had 4 quality starts....opponents batted .235 (110-for-468, 23hr)....he set career highs in wins (6), games (26), starts (22), innings pitched (124.2) and strikeouts (110).

**CAREER:** Is 18-16 with a 4.62 ERA in 72 games/58 starts (333.1ip, 171er)....has pitched in the majors for San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Chicago-NL (2020) and Milwaukee (2021, '23-24)....is 15-15 with a 4.72 ERA as a starter (301ip, 158er) and 3-1 with a 3.62 ERA as a reliever (32.1ip, 13er)....Rea was selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana State University....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 11/11/16, causing him to miss the entire 2017 season....Rea also pitched in Japan with the Fukuoka SoftBank Hawks in 2021 and 2022.

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 4-5 with a 4.42 ERA in 19 games/16 starts (89.2ip, 44er)....is 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA in 4 starts this season (24ip, 9er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 9-7 with a 4.74 ERA in 33 games/24 starts (150ip, 79er)....is 2-1 with a 4.45 ERA in 6 games/5 starts this season (30.1ip, 15er).

**CAREER vs. CUBS:** Is 0-0 with a 3.60 ERA in 2 starts (10ip, 9h, 4r, 4er, 4bb, 9k, 0hr)....his first start vs. Chicago came as a member of the Padres on 5/11/16 at Wrigley Field (5ip, 7h, 4r, 4er, 4bb-1bb, 3k, 1hbp)....Padres won, 7-4....his other start came on 9/29 last season in Milwaukee (5ip, 2h, 0r, 0bb, 6k)....Brewers won, 4-3, in 10 innings.
