RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals opened the post All-Star break portion of their schedule in Arizona last Friday and were swept by the Diamondbacks at Chase Field for the first time since 2007...the Cardinals begin a three game series against the Colorado Rockies with a 6-2 win last night to improve to 1-3 on their six-game roadtrip...following this week's series in Denver, the Cardinals will return home to open a 7-game homestand with the Padres (July 24-27) & Marlins (July 28-30) prior to the trade deadline.

BIRD WATCHING: St. Louis posted 51 wins before the All-Star Break, their most since 2015 (56)...it marked the first time the Cardinals had logged 50+ victories prior to the Break in back-to-back years since 2014-15 (52 & 56)... the Cardinals began today in 4th place in the NL Central, 8.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and 3.5 games behind San Diego for the 3rd and final NL Wild Card spot.

NO MORE TEARS: The Cardinals have won the season series vs. the Rockies 22 times in 31 seasons since Colorado joined MLB as an expansion team in 1993...the Cards & Rockies meet this week for the 1st time this season.

SHOT IN THE DARK: The Cardinals (109g), Cubs (105g), and Mets (107g) are the only three National League teams that have never had a pitcher throw a complete game at Coors Field ... Braden Looper (8.1 IP) came the closest by a Cardinal in Denver on May 6, 2008 ... The Cardinals, who also had no route-going efforts in their 12 games played in 1993-94 at Denver's Mile

High Stadium, also lack a complete game effort in their 66 regular season games at Philadelphia's Citizens Bank Park, although they

did have Chris Carpenter's Division Series clinching gem in 2011.

Marmol became manager in 2022. It's currently the longest active streak of four-run games at Coors Field of any Major League opponent. It also has matched the Cardinals longest such streak at the 30-year old ballpark, in which they had 10-game streaks of this sort twice (2002-05 & 1996-98). HELLRAISER: Ryan Helsley is one of five pitchers all-time and one of two active pitchers along with Devin Williams (10 app, 9.1

IP) to make 10+ appearances without allowing an earned run against the Rockies. Helsley has made 11 career appearances covering 12.0 IP & has 2 wins to go along with a perfect 5-for-5 in save opportunities. His lone unearned run came in his first career appearance vs. COL at Busch Stadium (8/25/19) earning the win with 2.1 innings in relief of Michael Wacha.

CRAZY TRAIN: The Cardinals plated their 6 runs over four consecutive innings of scoring last night, marking only the 2nd time this season that they had scored runs in 4+ consecutive innings...they scored 7 runs over five consecutive innings on June 17 in a 12-2 win at the Chicago White Sox...the Cardinals are 19-7 this season when they score runs in four or more innings.

SEE YOU ON THE OTHER SIDE: With the Cardinals next win, Oliver Marmol (2022-present) will record his 300th career managerial win, ranking 13th all-time among Cardinals managers, and 12 wins back of Gabby Street who ranks 12th with his 312 managerial wins from 1929-33.

BARK AT THE MOON: Masyn Winn put together a multi-hit game last night for the 3rd time in his four games played since the All-Star break...Winn is batting .529 (9-for-17) since the break, ranking 8th in MLB & 4th in the NL...his 9 hits over that four game span lead all of baseball and have matched his career best, also collecting 9 hits from 8/26-29/24 in a 4-game series against the Padres.

LIVE AND LOUD: Willson Contreras connected for his team leading 13th home run last night, sending a blast of 443 ft (tied with Alec Burleson for longest by a Cardinal) deep into the left field seats...Contreras is leading the Cardinals in games played (95), HR's (13), doubles (24), RBI (57), and GW-RBI (8) this season...his three-hit game last night was his 3rd this season and his 1st in a road game.

INTO THE VOID: With his 7th bunt single in last night's game, Victor Scott II moved into 3rd among Cardinals in bunt hits during the Busch III Era (2006-25), pulling closer to Kolten Wong's 10 in 2019 and Matt Carpenter's 8 in 2018; Victor has shown pop as well with 11 extra base hits (4 HR's) and 23 RBI in Road games this season..his 23 Road RBI are 2nd on the team to Contreras (26).

COLORADO CONNECTIONS

Nolan Arenado played eight seasons with Colorado (2013-20), where he was a five-time NL All-Star and the winner of four Silver Sluggers, eight Gold Gloves, and four Platinum Gloves...originally selected by Colorado in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft...Acquired by St. Louis with cash in exchange for **Austin Gomber**, **Elehuris Montero**, Tony Locey, Mateo Gil and Jake Sommers.

Nolan Arenado's cousin, **Josh Fuentes**, played three seasons with the Rockies (2019-21) and college baseball at Missouri Baptist Univ. (2014).

Garrett Hampson was selected by Colorado in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft...played parts of five seasons for the Rockies (2018-22).

Daniel Descalso played two seasons with Colorado (2015-16).

Kyle Leahy was born in and resides in Boulder.. graduated from Erie High School, and selected to play at the Colorado High School Futures Game at Coors Field...played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction (2016-18).

Austin Gomber pitched parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2018, '20)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 4th round of the 2014 MLB Draft...shared Cardinals Co-Minor League Pitchers of the Year honors with Alex Reyes in 2015.

John Mozeliak began his baseball career with the Rockies...initially served as a left-handed batting practice pitcher in 1993 and worked in a variety of positions in the home clubhouse and in baseball operations...joined St. Louis as an assistant in scouting operations following the 1995 season... graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, Colo., where he was a first baseman and pitcher... graduated from University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Asst. GM & Scouting Director Ran**dy Flores** pitched in 82 games in three seasons (2002, '09-10) over two stints with Colorado.

Cardinals Hall of Famer Matt Holliday was originally selected by Colorado in the 7th round of the 1998 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons for the Rockies (2004-08, '18) where he was a three-time All-Star and appeared in the 2007 World Series.

Rockies Bench Coach Clint Hurdle played in 78 games for St. Louis in 1986.

Rockies MLB.com Thomas Harding covered the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) for two seasons for the Commercial Appeal (1998-99)...mentored recent Cardinals MLB.com writer Anne Rogers.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch columnist Benjamin **Hochman** previously worked as a sports writer and columnist for the Denver Post (2007-15).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Derrick Goold** is originally from Boulder...graduated from Centaurus High School in Lafayette...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

Rockies Communications Coordinator **Kevin Collins** previously served as the 2015 Media Relations Intern for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA).

Rockies Digital Comm. Manager Nora Farrell previously worked in communications and so-cial media for St. Louis for part of seven seasons

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is making his 20th start of the season (153rd career appearance and 139th start).
- Has received zero runs of support in three of his last four starts and two or fewer in 10 of his last 11. His 1.90 RSA since May 10, is the lowest in MLB (min. 50 innings).
- With four outs recorded tonight, will pass the 100.0 inning threshold for the 4th MLB season (2021-22, 2024-25).
- Tied with Chase Dollander, Tyler Anderson, Bowdin Francis, and Jordan Hicks for 2nd-longest active loss streak with six, trailing only Justin Verlander (SF) with eight.
- Posted a 2.49 ERA and 1.29 WHIP in his 1st four starts during June, then allowed seven runs in both of his final two starts vs. Chicago Cubs (6/25) & at Pittsburgh (6/30).
- Has gone without a win in 11 straight starts since his CG shutout of the Washington Nationals on May 9.
- Since throwing his complete game/shutout at WSH (May 9), is 0-6 with a 5.70 ERA (52.0 IP) including four no-decisions.
- Has received just two runs of support or fewer in 13 of his 19 starts, however was given 10 runs when he threw a complete-game shutout vs. his former team on May 9 at Washington.
- The Cardinals are 5-14 in his starts in 2025, six of which were quality starts. Has pitched 5.0 innings or more in 15 of his 19 starts.
- 16 of his 53 runs allowed (5.66 ERA) have come in the first inning of starts.
- Issued 3+ walks in 10 of 19 starts (team-leading 4.20 BB/9 IP, 2nd-highest in N.L.)
- Is 3rd on the team in total chances (21) amongst the Redbirds pitchers trailing **Andre Pallante** (30), **Miles Mikolas** (23).

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed three runs on six hits over 4.2 innings in a no-decision in a 7-6 last-at-bat loss to the Braves on July 12 at Busch Stadium. All three runs came in the first two innings, including solo homers by Ronald Acuna Jr. and Marcell Ozuna.

2025 NOTES:

- Holds the Cardinals longest scoreless innings streak this season at 14.2 IP (May 9-14).
- Scattered six hits over 9.0 innings in his first complete game/shutout of his career at WSH (May 9), besting his original drafting team (WSH, 1st, 2014) in a 10-0 win. Became the 1st Cardinal with a whitewash since Jordan Montgomery blanked the Cubs on 8/22/22 at Wrigley Field. I was his first appearance at Nationals Park since leaving his drafting organization after 2022.
- His 6.0 no-hit innings on 4/9 at PIT represented the deepest that he had carried a no-no at the MLB level (previous best was 3.0 IP last on 6/18/21 vs. NYM).

CAREER NOTES:

- Has entered his 8th season in Major League Baseball and his 2nd to begin a season with the Cardinals. Has previously pitched for the Nationals (2017-22) and White Sox (2024) in MLB.
- Went 2-5 with a 3.72 ERA in his 10 starts with the Cardinals last season and had a 7-4 mark with 3.11 ERA in 21 starts for the White Sox.
- Was acquired by the St. Louis Cardinals with OF Tommy Pham in a three-team/nine-player trade from the Chicago White Sox which included the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 29, 2024.
- Played one season for NC Dinos of the KBO League in 2023 where he led the league in wins (20), ERA (2.00), strikeouts (209) and WHIP (0.95) over 30 starts covering 180.1 innings pitched.
- Earned the 2023 Choi Dong-won Award, annually awarded to the best pitcher in the KBO League.
- Played high school baseball at Las Vegas High School where he was teammates with Bryce Harper.

FEDDE VS. COLORADO

- Makes his 7th career appearance (6th start) against the Rockies tonight.
- Lifetime 2-2 with a 5.00 ERA (27.0 IP) and 22 strikeouts in his previous six outings against the Rockies.
- In his last outing vs. Colorado (Sept. 25, 2024), limited the Rockies to one run over 7.0 innings while striking out 10 at Coors Field. Was his 3rd career and most recent double-digit strikeout game.
- Career 2-1 with a 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP) and 16 strikeouts as a starter at Coors Field.
- Is 8-9 with a 4.47 ERA (114.2 IP) and 94 strikeouts in 24 games (21 starts) against the NL West.
