TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and White Sox today commence a three-game weekend series with the first of three games between the clubs this season...This is the only scheduled meeting between the two teams this year.

A The Braves booked their 23rd comeback win of the season on Sunday to secure a sweep and beat Pittsburgh, 3-2...Michael Harris II drove in all three runs during a pinch-hit plate appearance.

A Atlanta has just one series win against Chicago-AL in the last seven seasons, dating to 2020...All-time, the Braves are 4-5-1 in series play against the White Sox.

A Since first facing the White Sox in 2002, the Braves have averaged 1.51 home runs per nine innings, their second-best mark against any single opponent (MIN, 1.75).

A LH Brandon Eisert is scheduled to open for the White Sox as he precedes RH Erick Fedde...Eisert will make his third start and 14th overall appearance this season, and owns a 1-0 record and a 3.21 ERA (5 ER/14.0 IP) entering play...Eisert attended Oregon State University, where he was a 2018 national champion alongside current major leaguers Adley Rutschman, Steven Kwan, Trevor Larnach and Nick Madrigal.

A RH Erick Fedde is slated to pitch the bulk for Chicago this evening in what will be his 13th appearance this season...Fedde, a Las Vegas native, is 1-5 with a 4.94 ERA (32 ER/58.1 IP) this season...The right-hander has averaged 4.2 innings pitched in each of his "relief" appearances.

A RH Grant Holmes is slated to make his first career start against the Chicago White Sox...The right-hander enters play with a 4-2 record and a 3.86 ERA (27 ER/63.0 IP)...The native of Conway, SC, has limited opponents to three runs or fewer in 11 of his 12 turns this season, tied for the seventh most in Major League Baseball.

BULLPEN: The Braves' bullpen completed the final 3.0 innings on Sunday, holding the Pirates scoreless...Reynaldo López earned the win in relief, Tyler Kinley registered his ninth hold, and Didier Fuentes earned his first career save.

A At 20 years, 355 days old, Fuentes became the youngest Brave to notch a save since Mike McQueen did so at 20 years, 346 days-old on August 11, 1971.

A MLB-wide, the last player Fuentes' age-or-younger to log a save was Seattle's Andrés Muñoz on August 29, 2019...He was 20 years, 225 days-old on that date.

A As a unit, the Braves possess the only bullpen in MLB with a sub-3.00 ERA (2.96)...By ERA, three of the top four relievers in the National League pitch for Atlanta: Robert Suarez (0.63), Raisel Iglesias (0.87) and Dylan Lee (1.17)...San Diego's Mason Miller ranks third (0.98).

MICHAEL HARRIS II: Came off the bench on Sunday to rope Atlanta's hardest-hit ball of the day – a 109.5-mph, bases-clearing, go-ahead double...The three-RBI knock, which occurred in the seventh inning, shifted the game's win expectancy by 39.9%.

A He hit the double on the second pitch of the plate appearance...The last Brave to finish a game with three RBI and two-or-fewer pitches seen was Ehire Adrianza, who belted a pinch-hit, first-pitch grand slam on May 21, 2021.

A Harris II drove in Atlanta's only three runs of the game...The last team to win a game by having a pinch-hitter drive in all of its runs (min. 3 runs scored) was Baltimore...Jackson Holliday's three-run double on August 24, 2024 gave the Orioles a win over the Astros, 3-2...The Braves hadn't logged such a win since May 19, 1995, when Dwight Smith hit a pinch-hit, walk-off grand slam in a 4-0 victory.

A As a pinch-hitter, Harris II owns a career slash line of .625/.667/1.250 (5-for-8) with two doubles, a home run, seven RBI and three stolen bases...His pinch-hit batting average is the best by a Brave in the Expansion Era (since 1969)...Otto Lopez (.625) is the only other active player to match his pinch-hit batting average (min. 9 PA).

A Atlanta's centerfielder has garnered 0.78 RBI per pinch-hit plate appearance in his career, the highest rate of any active player.

COMEBACKS: After falling behind, 2-0 on Sunday versus Pittsburgh, the Braves rallied back and played to their 23rd comeback victory of the season...Atlanta has the most comeback wins and the highest comeback winning percentage (.697) in MLB.

A Atlanta also improved to 23-21 (.523) in games wherein it trails at any point, and still stands as the only team with a winning record in such scenarios...The Los Angeles Dodgers rank second, playing at a .452 clip when they trail.

A Over the course of a full, 162-game season, the last team to finish with a winning record in games it trailed was the 2004 iteration of the New York Yankees (61-59, .508).

A The MLB average winning percentage when trailing is .311.

HIGH WATER: With Sunday night's win, Atlanta set a new high-water mark for the season at 24 games above .500...The last time the club was this far above .500 was at the completion of the 2023 campaign, when the team finished 46 games over.

A With 45 wins, the Braves have tied their best 66-game start in team history...The club also went 45-21 in its first 66 games in 1998 and 2003.

A The last team to post a better start than Atlanta was Philadelphia in 2024, when it started 46-20 (.697).

A The Braves maintain the best record in MLB (45-21, .682), ahead of the Milwaukee Brewers (41-23, .641).

Today's Game

Makes his 13th start of the season and the 41st of his career in the opener of a three-game series at Chicago (AL)...Faces the White Sox for the first time, his first career appearance at Rate Field.

Today marks his fifth interleague start of 2026...He is 3-1 with a 2.66 ERA (7 ER/23.2 IP) over his first four interleague turns this season.

Earned the win in his most recent start June 3 against Toronto, allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings with two walks and four strikeouts on 89 pitches in Atlanta's 7-3 victory at Truist Park...Logged his fifth quality start of the season.

Has posted five quality starts over 12 outings this season, going 4-2 with a 3.86 ERA (27 ER/63.0 IP) and 57 strikeouts...Is holding opposing hitters to a .233 average (56-for-240).

Has issued 27 walks and surrendered 12 home runs through 12 starts, equating to a 3.86 BB/9 and a 1.71 HR/9.

Has generated 38 of his 57 strikeouts this season with his slider, the fifth-most in the majors.

Hitters are missing 40.8 percent of their swings against the pitch, the third-highest slider whiff rate among pitchers with at least 350 thrown.

Has held opponents 0-for-8 with the bases loaded in 2026.

Over his last five starts since May 12, owns a 3.16 ERA (9 ER/25.2 IP) with 28 strikeouts.

Enters with a streak of 33 consecutive appearances issuing at least one walk, dating to March 31, 2025, the 17th-longest active such streak in the majors.

His 40 career starts for the Braves are the most in Atlanta-franchise history by a South Carolina-born player.

2026

Earned the win June 3 against Toronto, allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings with two walks and four strikeouts on 89 pitches in Atlanta's 7-3 victory at Truist Park...Stranded the bases loaded with no outs in the first inning and surrendered a leadoff home run to Lukes in the third.

Recorded his 250th career strikeout within the start.

Received a no-decision May 29 at Cincinnati, allowing three runs on seven hits over 4.2 innings with one walk and five strikeouts on 80 pitches in the 8-3 win at Great American Ball Park...Made his first career appearance at the ballpark...Two runs scored on solo home runs in the fourth inning, with the third coming home after he departed.

Took the loss May 23 against Washington, allowing two runs on six hits over 5.0 innings with a season-high 10 strikeouts and two walks on 87 pitches in the 2-0 defeat at Truist Park...Both Washington runs came on solo home runs...Recorded the third 10-strikeout game of his career and his first of 2026, and fanned the side in order in the first inning, the first such frame by a Braves pitcher since Bryce Elder on May 4, 2025.

Reached 200 career strikeouts April 3 at Chase Field in Arizona.

Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five spring appearances (four starts), fanning 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk.

Career Recap

Awards: Midwest League Midseason All-Star (2015); Texas League Pitcher of the Week (July 30, 2017).

In his MLB debut season in 2024, went 2-1 with a 3.27 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) in 26 relief appearances and one start...Was recalled by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 8, 2024.

In 2022, pitched for three different minor league teams throughout the Oakland and Atlanta organizations...Separately, went 1-2 with Triple-A Las Vegas before joining the Braves system.

Pitched the entire 2021 season for Triple-A Las Vegas and saw more relief appearances (29) than starts (7) for first time in career.

Set career highs and led the team in games (50) and saves (13) in 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett...Led all Strippers relievers in strikeouts (74).

Named Gatorade Player of the Year in South Carolina following his senior year in 2014.

Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 June draft (Conway High School, SC).

On August 1, 2016, traded by the Dodgers to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Jharel Cotton for OF Josh Reddick and RHP Rich Hill.

Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut.

Signed by the Atlanta Braves as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.
