RAY MATTER—The Rays have lost four straight games, tying April 13-16 for their longest streak of the season, and they would need a win today to avoid their longest since June 27–July 3, 2021 (5)...the Rays are 1-6 on this 9-game road trip to Minnesota (1-2), New York (0-3) and Baltimore (0-1), their second of four 3-city road trips this season...this is the first time the Rays have gone 1-6 (or worse) over a 7-game stretch since June 16-23, 2021 (1-6)...the Rays are 4-8 in their last 12 games, 9-12 in their last 21 games and 17-19 in their last 36 games after an 18-10 start to the season... they have a ½-game cushion over Boston in regard to postseason play.

- + The Rays are 10-10 against AL East opponents this season, including 3-8 since May 20, after going 78-38 vs. the division from 2020-21.
- + The Rays are 2-4-2 in their last eight series after a 7-2-0 stretch.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays have played three straight 1-run games and lost all three, their longest such streak since Aug 3-5, 2018 (3)...they have played four straight games decided by 2 runs (or fewer) and lost all four, their longest streak since April 18-21, 2019 (4)...the Rays have played 23 1-run games this season, tied for 3rd in MLB behind the Blue Jays (24) and Marlins (24)...the Rays are 11-12 in 1-run games including four straight losses and 3-9 since May 8 after an 8-3 start...the Rays have played 34 games decided by 2 runs (or fewer), tied for 4th in the majors...they are 17-17 in those games, including five straight losses and 7-11 since May 16.

- + The Rays are 6-3 in extras after going 7-12 in 2021...their nine extra-inning games rank 2nd in the majors behind the Padres (10).
- + Last night marked the club's first 1-0 game since Oct 3, 2021 at NYY (loss)...the Rays were shut out by the Orioles for the first time since May 4, 2019 at BAL (3-0) and lost 1-0 to them for the fourth time: Oct 2, 2012 and Aug 5, 2012 at home and May 9, 2007 at BAL.

PITCHING PROPERLY—The Rays have pitched to a 3.13 ERA this season, 4th in the majors behind the Yankees (2.79), Dodgers (2.94) and Astros (3.03)...they have yielded 2 ER (or fewer) in five consecutive games, their longest such streak since April 23-29 (6)...the Rays have a 2.51 ERA in the last 33 games, 1st in the majors since May 11 ahead of the Yankees (2.95).

- + The Rays have allowed 22 hits, 9 runs (4 ER) in their last 5 games (1-4) and 17 hits, 9 runs (4 ER) on the 4-game losing streak (1.11 ERA)... the 4 ER are the fewest in the majors for a 4-game losing streak since the New York Giants from July 7-11, 1933 (3)...the 9 runs are the fewest for a 0-4 stretch since the Reds from April 2-5, 2019 (9) and fewest for an AL club since the Twins from June 15-18, 2014 (9).
- + The Rays have yielded 5 hits (or fewer) in five straight games, the longest streak in club history and longest in MLB this season...the Rays are the second team and first AL team since Baseball Reference data is available (1901) to allow 5 hits (or fewer) in four straight and lose each game, joining the Giants from May 14-17, 1972 (4).
- + The Rays have allowed 3 runs (or fewer) 40 times this season, tied for 1st in the majors...they are 30-10 when yielding 3 runs (or fewer), compared to 5-19 when allowing 4 runs (or more)...the Rays have yielded 2 runs (or fewer) 29 times this season, T-2nd in the majors.
- + The Rays bullpen ranks 5th in the majors and 4th in the AL with a 3.01 ERA...Rays relievers have a 1.51 ERA (41.2-IP, 7-ER) in the last 11 games since June 5...their 278 IP this season is 2nd in the majors behind the Orioles (279.2 IP)...they rank 7th in the majors in WHIP (1.15) and 9th in opp avg. (.223)...the Rays have seven pitchers with a save, tied with the Red Sox for most in the majors...last season they had 14 pitchers with a save, setting a major league record.

START ME UP—Rays starters have a 3.25 ERA this season, 3rd in the majors behind the Dodgers (2.63) and Yankees (2.76)...Rays starters haven't allowed an earned run in their last 13 IP and have allowed 1 ER in their last 25.1 IP...the starters have a 2.54 ERA in their last 33 games since May 11, best in the majors over the Yankees (2.76)...the Rays have used 12 starters this season, 2nd in the majors behind the Tigers (13)...the starters have combined for 293.1 IP, fewest in the AL and 29th in the majors (PIT, 281.1).

**FEAST OR FAMINE**—The Rays are averaging 4.05 runs per game this season, 25th in the majors and 11th in the AL...this is a 1.24 decrease from their 5.29 runs per game last season, the 3rd-largest in the majors behind the Tigers (-1.66) and Athletics (-1.36)...the Rays have seen the 4th-largest decrease in home runs per game, dropping from 1.37 in 2021 to 0.92 this season...the Rays rank 13th in the AL in avg. (.230), 7th in RISP avg. (.253), 13th in on-base pct. (.294), 12th in slugging (.370) and 10th in homers (59).

+ Last night the Rays were shut out for the second time in 4 games

- (Tues at NYY) and fifth time this season...they have been shut out five times in their last 34 games since May 10 at LAA after opening the season with 30 straight games without one...the Rays have been shut out eight times in their last 93 games since Sep 2, 2021.
- + The Rays have scored 4 runs in their last 4 games, their fewest in a 4-game span since Aug 11-14, 2017 (4)...they have scored 3 runs (or fewer) in four straight games, tying their longest streak this season.
- + The Rays have outhit their opponent in three of their last 4 losses... thirteen of the club's last 14 hits have been singles (one solo HR).
- + The Rays are 26-7 when scoring 4 runs (or more) and 20-5 when scoring 5 runs (or more), compared to 9-22 when scoring 3 runs (or fewer)...the Rays are 27-8 when scoring first and 8-21 when their opponent scores first...the Rays are 28-6 when they outhit their opponent and 6-21 when recording fewer hits than their opponent.
- The Rays have 44 SB, 3rd in the majors behind the Rangers (57) and Cardinals (47)...they have been caught 19 times, most in the majors (LAA, 17)...they are 69.8 pct. on steal attempts, 22nd in the majors.
- + This season the Rays are batting .291 (93-for-320) with RISP in their 35 wins, compared to .193 (39-for-202) with RISP in the 29 losses.
- + The Rays have made 30 outs on the bases this season, according to Baseball Reference, most in the majors (Astros, 27)...the site does not include pickoffs, caught stealing or force plays in this statistic.

**UNDER THE LEATHER**—The Rays have allowed 43 unearned runs this season, 2nd in the majors behind the White Sox (44) and their most before the All-Star break since the Devil Rays in 2007 (43)...this is 74.1 pct. of their total (58) from last season, when they didn't allow their 43rd unearned run until the 99th game (July 24)...the Rays have allowed five unearned runs in the last 4 games and eight in 7 games this trip...they have made 14 errors in their 35 wins, compared to 27 errors in their 29 losses.

- + The Rays are 23-13 in errorless games; 12-16 when making one.
- + The Rays have 41 errors this season, 9th in the majors...since May 20, they have 21 errors in 26 games, 4th in MLB and 1st in the AL.

**BUMP IN THE ROAD**—The Rays are 14-16 on the road this season after going 48-33 in 2021, best in the AL and tied for 3rd in the majors...excluding the shortened season, this is the first time the Rays have a losing road record in June (or later) since going 39-42 on the road in 2018...the Rays are 5-13 in 18 road games since May 8 after a 9-3 start...they have been outscored, 83-57, over this stretch and are averaging 3.17 runs per game.

+ Since 2021, the Rays have lost in walk-off fashion in the reg. season 16 times, most in the AL and 2nd in the majors behind Miami (18)... the four walk-off losses this season are tied for 4th in the majors.

RAYS vs. ORIOLES—The Rays are 4-3 in the season series (3-0 at home, 1-3 on the road) and have lost back-to-back games to them for the first time since July 31–Aug 2, 2020 (3)...the Rays have outscored them, 33-21, this season and have scored 6 runs (or more) in four of the last 5 games despite going 2-3 over that span...the Rays won nine straight series from Aug 25, 2020–April 10, 2022 and would need to win today and tomorrow to avoid back-to-back series losses for the first time since April 24–June 25, 2017.

- + The Rays are 16-3 against them since July 20, 2021 and 22-4 since the start of 2021, outscoring the Orioles, 183-92, over that stretch.
- + Since 2021, the Rays are 10-3 at Camden Yards and have totaled 103 runs (7.92 runs per game) and 30 HR...the Rays have scored 6 runs (or more) in 11 of 13 games here over the last two seasons.
- + OF Randy Arozarena is batting .406 (41-for-101) with 11 HR and 26 RBI in 25 career games against the Orioles...he has 7 HR in 14 career games in Baltimore, and 6 HR and 15 RBI in his last 8 games here.

FROM THE INFIRMARY—The Rays have 14 players on the injured list, tied with the Twins for most in the majors...the Rays have had 22 different players total 23 stints on the injured list this season...according to Spotrac's tracker, the 22 players with an IL stint are tied for 4th in the majors behind the Twins (25), Cubs (23) and Pirates (23)...Rays players have totaled 826 days on the IL this season, most in the AL and 3rd in the majors behind the Reds (950) and Cubs (835)...the Rays have used 43 players and 27 pitchers (excluding position players) this season after using 61 players and 38 pitchers in 2021, both of which were single-season club records.

+ The Rays have 11 pitchers on the IL, most in the majors...their three hitters on the IL were 10th in 2021 AL Most Valuable Player voting (Brandon Lowe), 3rd in 2021 AL Rookie of the Year voting (Wander Franco) and a 2021 Silver Slugger finalist catcher (Mike Zunino).

**LAST START**—On Sun at MIN, made a second straight scoreless start and extended his scoreless streak to 12.1 IP...did not allow a runner to reach scoring position, leaving 1-out singles in the 1st and 3rd innings and a 1-out walk in the 5th at first base...was replaced after issuing a 1-out walk to **Carlos Correa** in the 6th, and **Matt Wisler** went walk, flyout, flyout to end the frame...his line: W, 5.1 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 5 SO, 94 pitches, 59 str.

- + Has not allowed a run since the 4th inning on June 1 at TEX.
- + His 94 pitches were a career high...has four scoreless outings in his last 6 starts, pitching to a 1.10 ERA (32.2-IP, 4-ER) over that stretch.
- + Received 5 runs of support after the Rays offense failed to score in his prior 3 starts, in which he went 0-1 with a 2.12 ERA (17-IP, 4-ER).

vs. ORIOLES—Is 3-0 with a 1.02 ERA (17.2-IP, 2-ER) in 11 career apps (1 start) against the Orioles, including 1-0 with a 1.86 ERA (9.2-IP, 2-ER) in 4 apps (1 start) at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...last faced them on May 21 at BAL and his only hit allowed was a single by Trey Mancini to start the 2nd inning...escaped a 2-on, 2-out jam later in the frame with a popout... walked two of his last 3 BF, and was replaced with 2-on, 2-out in the 6th.

SPRING IN HIS STEP—Min. 40 IP, ranks among AL leaders this season in ERA (1.45, 1st), WHIP (0.91, 3rd), opp avg. (.189, 5th), opp OPS (.543, 4th) and swing-and-miss rate (30.5 pct., 8th)...from April 28—May 27, increased his workload in six consecutive apps (5 starts), going 2.2, 3.1, 4, 4.2, 5.2 and 6 IP in those outings...is 2-2 with a 1.83 ERA (39.1-IP, 8-ER) in 8 starts and 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (10.1-IP, 0-ER) in 8 apps in relief...entering the season, his longest outing was 3 IP, 3x-last June 8, 2019 (G1) vs. OAK (with TEX).

- According to FanGraphs, has induced a swing on 39.7 pct. of pitches outside of the strike zone, the 3rd-highest rate in the majors (min. 40 IP) and 2nd in the AL behind TOR Kevin Gausman (46.3 pct.).
- + Has allowed an avg. exit velocity of 86.5 mph this season, according to Statcast, which ranks in the 87th percentile in the majors.
- + Is a regular member of a rotation for the first time since 2017, when he spent the entire season with Class-A Down East and his first 17 apps came as a starter, going 1-8 with a 4.60 ERA (90-IP, 46-ER) in that role...transitioned to the Down East bullpen on July 26.
- + The Rays are 6-2 in his 8 starts, including three straight wins.

KEEP THE CHANGE—Has used his changeup on 36.6 pct. (275 of 752) of his pitches this season, the 2nd-highest rate in the majors (min. 750 pitches)...opponents are batting .193 (17-for-88) in at-bats ending with the changeup...dating back to last season, has yielded 1 HR on his last 394 changeups thrown (Nathaniel Lowe on June 1 at TEX)...the avg. exit velocity against his changeup is 82.0 mph, 10th in the majors (min. 25 batted balls)...his changeup is rated at 5.7 Runs Above Avg., the 10th-highest-rated offspeed pitch in the majors (min. 40 IP), according to FanGraphs.

+ Has induced a swing-and-miss on 38.8 pct. of swings against the changeup, the 9th-highest whiff rate in the majors (min. 50 PA).

2021 RECAP—In his first season with the Rays, led the team with 43 apps when he suffered a season-ending knee injury on July 31 vs. BOS...made his third straight Opening Day roster with three different teams...went 5-1 with a 3.43 ERA (44.2-IP, 17-ER) and 63 SO in 43 apps, setting career highs in wins, apps, innings and strikeouts...struck out 35.2 pct. of batters faced, the highest rate of his career...had a 48.2 pct. whiff rate on his changeup and a 39.3 pct. whiff rate on his sinker, according to Statcast.

- + Had a 1.04 ERA (8.2-IP, 1-ER) over his last 8 apps from July 9-31.
- + Yielded 9 HR, which tied for 3rd among AL relievers at the time of his injury...57.1 pct. (12 of 21) of his runs allowed came on homers.
- + Attempts to rehab his injury resulted in continued discomfort...underwent surgery on Aug 16 to reconstruct a torn ACL in his right knee...the procedure was performed by Dr. Koco Eaton in St. Pete.

CAREER REVIEW—Is 13-7 with a 3.82 ERA (179-IP, 76-ER) in 118 career apps (10 starts) with the Rangers (2018-19), Red Sox (2020) and Rays (2021-22)...since joining the Rays, is 8-3 with a 2.39 ERA (94.1-IP, 25-ER) in 59 apps (8 starts)...acquired by the Red Sox prior to spring training in 2020 and made 16 apps over two stints in the majors...was on the active roster from Opening Day-Aug 10 and Aug 22-Sep 25, going 0-2 with a 7.08 ERA (20.1-IP, 16-ER) in 16 apps...min. 20 IP, led the team with 12.39 SO/9 IP.

+ In 2019, went 4-1 with a 6.40 ERA (32.1-IP, 23-ER) in 25 apps over three stints with the Rangers, including his first Opening Day roster...his 4 wins ranked 2nd among Rangers relievers...was on the injured list for over two months with left shoulder inflammation.

# TOMORROW'S STARTER: RH COREY KLUBER (3-3, 3.50 ERA)

**LAST START**—On Tues at NYY, took a loss when yielding 0 ER for the second time in his career, joining Aug 18, 2012 at OAK (with CLE)...marked the eighth time a Rays pitcher allowed 0 ER in 6 IP (or more) and lost, first since **Charlie Morton** on Aug 16, 2019 vs. DET...retired nine of his first 11 BF...a dropped flyball by **Manuel Margot** in the 4th inning created a 2-on, 1-out jam, and an **Isiah Kiner-Falefa** 2-out RBI single plated 2 runs, the second coming around on an errant throw home by **Randy Arozarena**... marked his first unearned runs allowed since April 9, 2021 at TB (with NYY)...his line: 6 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HBP, 93 pitches, 64 str.

★ The 93 pitches were his most since Sep 17, 2021 vs. CLE (95, with NYY)...has pitched to a 2.53 ERA (32-IP, 9-ER) in his last 6 starts.

vs. ORIOLES—Is 5-1 with a 3.07 ERA (73.1-IP, 25-ER) in 12 career starts against the Orioles, including a 3.45 ERA (57.1-IP, 22-ER) in 9 starts at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...last faced them on May 22 in Baltimore, taking no decision after allowing 2 runs in 3 IP...remains tied with May 10 at LAA (3-IP, 8-ER) for his shortest start of the season...led 4-0 before taking the mound and left with a 4-2 lead after the 3rd...both runs allowed came with 2 outs in the 3rd, yielding a RBI single to Ramón Urías and RBI double to Rougned Odor...escaped a bases-loaded, 2-out jam in the 1st with a groundout and stranded a leadoff double and passed ball in the 2nd with a strikeout and two foul outs...his pitch count by inning was 26-20-27.
