THE NL CHAMPS: The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 7-5 @ Padres in extra frames with a 3-run 10th inning on Christian Walker's 2-run single and Jake McCarthy's RBI fielder's choice.

- Humberto Castellanos inherited and escaped a bas-es-loaded jam for his first career save.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. hit a solo homer in the fourth inning.
- Brandon Pfaadt worked 4.1 innings with 1 run allowed before being hit by a line drive and being removed in the fifth inning with a left ankle contusion.
