#### TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 1 of a 4-game series vs Luke Henne's Pirates and the fourth game (2-1) of a 7-day road trip that includes a 2-1 series victory at Chc.
- This road trip does not officially include the 2 days (Sat & Sun) the Redlegs spent in Bristol, TN playing the Braves in the inaugural MLB Speedway Classic, as Cin served as the home team in that game.
- The Reds haven't had a day off since 7/24.
- With a win tonight, the Reds would be 6 games over .500 for the third time this season...haven't been 7 games over .500 since 8/3/23 (59-52).
- Following Sun's game, the Reds return home for a 7-day, 6-game homestand vs Phi (8/11-8/13) and Mil (8/15-8/17).

## MLB SPEEDWAY CLASSIC: The Reds fell to the Braves, 4-2, in the inaugural MLB Speedway Classic on Sun at Tennessee's Bristol Motor Speedway.

- Originally scheduled for Sat, the start of the game was delayed by rain for 2 hours, 17 minutes...when play finally began at 9:41 PM, 4 outs were recorded before another rain delay stopped action for 27 minutes...the game was eventually suspended at 10:25 PM, with Cin leading 1-0 in the bottom of the 1st inning...it was completed the next day.
- Was the Reds' 14th game to be impacted by weather this season, including 10 delays, 3 suspensions, one rain-shortened game, and one postponement...before Sat's suspension, the Reds were scheduled to have their first off day on a Sun since 8/20/33...courtesy Reds Hall of Fame.
- The MLB Speedway Classic broke MLB's all-time regular season attendance record, attracting 91,032 fans to the first American or National League game ever played in Tennessee.

**NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM:** The Reds have not been swept in any of their first <u>37 series</u> of 2025, including the recently-completed 3-game set at **Chc** (2-1).

- This 37-series streak without being swept is the longest run in club history, eclipsing the <u>1970</u> National League championship team, which opened its season with <u>32</u> straight series without getting swept.
- <u>Cin is the only Major League team not to have been swept this season.</u>
- On 6 occasions avoided being swept with a win in the final game of a set (4/23 at Mia, 5/15 vs CWS, 6/22 at StL, 7/2 at Bos, 7/23 at Wsh, 7/30 vs LAD).
- Cin hasn't been swept in a series of at least 2 games since 9/24-9/25, 2024 at Cle (2g), a span of 38 straight series...per Elias, that marks the fifth-longest streak of sweepless sets in team history (see below).

**DEADLINE DEALS:** Cin made 3 trades leading up to the 7/31 deadline:

- 7/31: Acquired from the Athletics INF/OF Miguel Andujar (ahn-DOO-har) in exchange for RHP Kenya Huggins.
- 7/30: Acquired from the Pirates 3B Ke'Bryan Hayes (key-Bryan, #3) in exchange for LHP Taylor Rogers, SS Sammy Stafura, and cash considerations.
- 7/30: Acquired from the Rays RHP Zack Littell (lih-TELL, #52) in exchange for LHP Adam Serwinowski and RHP Brian Van Belle.

TOUGH ROAD AHEAD: The Reds are in the midst of a final 59-game stretch in which 38 games <a href="https://example.com/hearth-page-4">heave been/will be played</a> against opponents with records <a href="https://example.com/hearth-page-4">er above .500</a> (3-0 vs TB, 1-2 vs LAD, 2-1 at Chc, 3g vs Phi, 3g vs Mil, 3g at LAD, 3g vs StL, 3g vs Tor, 3g vs NYM, 3g at SD, 3g at StL, 4g at Chc, 3g at Mil).

 As of today, the Reds have the toughest remaining schedule in the Major Leagues, based on opponents' winning percentage (.524).

MAN OF STEAL: SS Elly De La Cruz stole his 30th base of the season in Sun's MLB Speedway Classic, becoming the ninth Major Leaguer in the live-ball era (since 1920) with at least 30 steals in each of his first 3 career seasons, the first since KC's Bobby Witt Jr. (2022-24).

**SERIES NOTES:** The Reds lost 2 of 3 at **Pit** in their last meeting (5/19-5/21) and swept the **Pirates** in 3 games at **Great American Ball Park** in the first series this year between the clubs (4/11-4/13)...it was Cin's first sweep of **Pit** since 8/5-8/8, 2021 at **GABP** (4g).

- Cin has played the Pirates 501 times since both teams became charter members of the National League Central in 1994 (261-240, .521), more than any other Pit opponent.
- The 2-0 loss at Pit on 4/23/23 was the Reds' 100th loss at PNC Park... are 96-107 overall here...the Reds and Pirates played the first regular-season game at PNC Park on 4/9/01 (8-2 Reds triumph).
- The Redlegs have lost 43 of the last 62 games they've played at PNC Park, including an 11-game losing streak spanning 9/3/18 to 9/27/19 and an 8-game losing streak to begin the 2019 season (4/4-9/27, 2019).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the 3-2 win on 8/1 vs Atl (6.0ip, 4h, 0r, 1bb, 10k, 97TP).

- Season-high 10 strikeouts...was his fifth career double-digit strikeout game (last: 10k, 3/31/24 for KC vs Min).
- Struck out all 3 batters he faced in the 1st inning, the 10th time he's done that in his career (last: 7/22/23 at NYY).
- Fanned Eli White in the 2nd inning for his 750th career K.
- Eclipsed the 800.0-inning mark for his career.
- · Was his second straight quality start.
- Was his second scoreless start of the season (also: 3/31).

**JULY 27 vs TB:** Earned the 2-1 win on 7/27 vs TB (7.1ip, 3h, 1r/1er, 1bb, 8k, 1hr, 97TP).

- 7.1ip marked his longest start since 6/26/24 for KC vs Mia (also 7.1ip).
- Was his sixth start of the season in which he allowed 3 hits or fewer.
- Marked his eighth quality start of the season, the 57th of his career
- Is approaching career milestones in innings pitched (5.0 shy of 800), strikeouts (4 shy of 750), and starts (5 shy of 150).

**JULY 21 at WSH:** Suffered the 10-8 loss at Wsh on 7/21 (2.1ip, 5h, 7r/7er, 2bb, 1k, 1hr, 1hbp, 57TP).

- Matched his shortest start of the season (also: 5/10 at Hou).
- Allowed 4 runs in the 1st inning (25TP)...pitched a perfect 2nd inning (11TP)...gave up a home run to lead off the 3rd followed by a lineout, single, and hit-batter (21TP) before he was pulled for reliever Lyon Richardson...Richardson allowed both inherited runners to score.

JULY 12 vs COL: Didn't factor in the decision in the Reds' 4-3 walkoff win vs Col on 7/12 (6.1ip, 7h, 3r/3er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 93TP).

- Was his seventh quality start of the season.
- His 9 strikeouts matched a season-high (also: 6/25 vs NYY).

**JULY 7 vs MIA:** Suffered the 5-1 loss vs Mia on 7/7 (5.0ip, 7h, 2r/2er, 1bb, 3k, 1hb, 96TP).

- Entered the game having not allowed a hit to any of his previous 32 batters on which he reached 2 strikes...that streak was snapped at 39 by Kyle Stowers' full count single in the 4th inning.
- Held Mia scoreless through 4 and until Agustín Ramírez'
   2-out RBI-double in the 5th inning...the next batter, Liam Hicks, singled home Ramirez...Kyle Stowers popped out to end the inning...Stowers was Singer's last batter faced.

**JULY 1 at BOS:** Didn't factor in the decision in the 5-3 loss at Bos on 7/1 (3.0ip, 3h, 2r/2er, 4k, 56TP).

• The game was suspended due to weather in the top of the 4th inning and completed the next day...LHP Sam Moll took over for Singer on the mound when play resumed the following afternoon
