NOTABLE OFFSEASON TRANSACTIONS: **10/30**, declined the mutual option on **OF** Ryan Braun.....**11/4**, named **Ed Sedar** advisor to the Major League coaching staff; named **Quintin Berry** first base coach.....**11/19**, promoted **Matt Arnold** to senior vice president and general manager.....**12/2**, acquired a player to be named (**LHP** **Leo Crawford**) from Los Angeles-NL for **RHP** **Corey Knebel**.....**1/21**, signed **INF/OF** **Daniel Robertson** to a 1-year contract.....**2/5**, signed **2B** **Kolten Wong** to a 2-year contract with a club option for 2023.....**2/22**, re-signed **LHP** **Brett Anderson** to a 1-year contract.....**2/23**, signed **3B** **Travis Shaw** to a Minor League contract with an invitation to Major League camp.....**3/8**, signed **OF** **Jackie Bradley Jr.** to a 2-year contract with a player opt-out clause after 2021 and mutual option for 2023.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his seventh season as Brewers manager (435-414) and sixth full season.....Counsell ranks third in franchise history in managerial wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617) and Ned Yost (457-502).....under Counsell, the Brewers have made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history.....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach **Jacob Cruz** (2nd season), hitting coach **Andy Haines** (3rd season), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (3rd season), bullpen coach **Steve Karsay** (3rd season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach **Walker McKinven** (2nd season) and bench coach **Pat Murphy** (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff is first base coach **Quintin Berry**.

2020 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 29-31, finishing in fourth place in the NL Central, trailing the first-place Cubs by 5.0 games.....the team was the eighth seed in the National League postseason and fell to the top-seeded Dodgers, 2 games to none, in the Wild Card Series in Los Angeles.....the Brewers qualified for the postseason for the seventh time in franchise history and for a third straight season for the first time ever.

SPRING TRAINING: The Brewers went 15-11-3 this spring, winning each of their last 3 games.....the team played its home games at American Family Fields of Phoenix, the Spring Training home of the Brewers since 1998 (renovated in 2019).

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #25 - LHP BRETT ANDERSON (10gs, 4-4, 4.21era in 2020)

ANDERSON AT A GLANCE: Brett Anderson, 33, will be making his season debut tonight in Chicago.....Anderson went 2-1 with a 2.66 ERA in 6 starts during Spring Training [20.1ip, 24h, 9r, 6er, 4bb, 16k, 1hr].....he last started last Tuesday against the Rangers at Globe Life Field and earned a 6-3 victory (5ip, 6h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 4k, 87 pitches)..... Anderson, who signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 12/13/19, re-signed as a free agent on 2/22/21.

LAST SEASON: Anderson went 4-4 with a 4.21 ERA in 10 starts during his first season with the Brewers.....the team went 5-5 in his starts.....he made 4 quality starts..... opponents batted .270 (50-for-185, 6hr).....he began 2020 on the 10-day injured list with a blister on his left index finger.

CAREER: Is 63-65 with a 4.06 ERA in 198 games / 186 starts (1044.1ip, 471er).....is in his 13th Major League season.....has pitched for Oakland (2009-13, 2018-19), Colorado (2014), Los Angeles-NL (2015-16), Chicago-NL (2017), Toronto (2017) and Milwaukee (2020-21).....pitched in the postseason in 2012, 2013 and 2015.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-1 with a 3.99 ERA in 6 starts (29.1ip, 13er).....went 2-1 with a 4.56 ERA in 5 starts last season (23.2ip, 12er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 37-34 with a 3.78 ERA in 105 games / 100 starts (547ip, 230er).....went 2-3 with a 3.86 ERA in 5 starts last season (23.1ip, 10er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Is 1-1 with a 2.66 ERA in 4 starts (20.1ip, 6er), including 1-1 with a 3.12 ERA in 3 starts at Wrigley Field (17.1ip, 6er).....made 1 start against the Cubs last season as he took a 4-2 loss on 8/13 in Chicago (4.1ip, 5h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 5k, 1hr, 1hbp).
