## PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (62-35) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (49-48)

July 20, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #98/HOME #48 LHP CRISTOPHER SÁNCHEZ (7-4, 2.96 ERA) vs. RHP LUIS ORTIZ (4-2, 2.84 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...improved to 9-5 this month with last night's walkoff win...Are tied with Arizona for the best record in the National League while also being tied for the thirdbest record in all of MLB this month (Detroit has a league-best 10-4 record in July)...Are over .500 for the first time since being 13-12 on 4/24...Have won 11 games in their last at-bat (the most since winning 13 games in the final at-bat of 2022)...Have gone 36-3 (.923 winning percentage) when outhitting

their opponents this season...Have drawn at least one walk in 62 straight games, which is the longest active streak in MLB (the longest streak for the season is 75 straight games by the Phillies from 4/15 to 7/9)...Have played in 32 one-run games, which are the second-most among National League teams behind the Cubs (34)...Have the fourth-most quality starts (45) in MLB behind the Mariners (59), Phillies (53) and Royals (49)...Have the second-best ERA (3.60) among all starting rotations in the National League, trailing only the Phillies (3.26)...Rank second in all of MLB in stolen base percentage (83.9 percent), trailing only the Brewers (84.7 percent)...Have gone 11-2 on the 13 occasions the team has stolen multiple bases in a game this year...Have won eight straight and 11 of their last 12 games when scoring at least four runs...Have gone 15-2 since the beginning of June when scoring first in a game.

STATE-MENT GAME: Nick Gonzales completed Pittsburgh's comeback with his second walkoff RBI of the season to lift the Pirates to an 8-7 win last night against the Phillies...Gonzales leads the Pirates with seven game-winning RBI this season...The Bucs have now walked off the Phillies three times in the last four seasons...In addition to last night, the Pirates also beat Philadelphia on July 31, 2021, on a Jacob Stallings game-ending fielders choice off Jose Alvarado in the ninth inning, and on July 30, 2023, on a Joshua Palacios home run in the 10th inning off Andrew Vasquez.

**PACK PNC:** Last night's paid attendance of 39,530 was the largest for a regular season game at PNC Park since April 13, 2015, against the Tigers (39,933)...The 2015 Wild Card game against the Giants on October 7 had a paid attendance of 40,889...It was also the largest crowd for a Friday game in PNC Park history (the previous high was 39,404 on August 7, 2015, against the Dodgers).

**CRUZ CONTROL:** Oneil Cruz has knocked in six runs in his last three games, which marks the first time he has recorded an RBI in three straight games since May 11-13...Cruz' 47 RBI are tied for the sixth-most among all shortstops in MLB behind Willy Adames (67), Bobby Witt Jr. (65), Gunnar Henderson (63), Francisco Lindor (50) and CJ Abrams (48).

PICKING UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF: Bryan Reynolds, who comes into today third in the

National League in hits (113) and total bases (193), is 9-for-13 with a double, home run and five RBI in his last three games... Reynolds ranks eighth in all of MLB with a .362 average this month, tied for sixth in total bases (37), tied for seventh in RBI (15), 13th in slugging (.638) and 14th in OPS (1.041).

HOT ROWD: Rowdy Tellez has recorded 26 RBI since June 2... That's tied for 12th among all players in the National League... The Pirates have won each of the last 12 games (and 17 of 18

games this season) when Tellez knocks in at least one run...Pittsburgh's first basemen rank sixth in the National League and tied for 10th in MLB in RBI (51)...Philadelphia's first basemen lead all of MLB with 73 RBI.

**PEN POWER:** Pittsburgh's bullpen allowed one run in 5.1 innings Friday night...Since June 25, Pittsburgh's bullpen has posted the fourth-lowest ERA in all of MLB...The only three teams in MLB with a lower bullpen ERA during that time are the Braves (2.61), Mariners (3.19) and Cubs (3.24)...Carmen Mlodzinski has an 0.89 ERA (20.1ip/2er) in his last 15 appearances out of the bullpen...Colin Holderman ranks ninth among all National League relievers in ERA (1.72)...David Bednar is tied for the second-longest active saves streak (16) in MLB...Kyle Nicolas has an 0.84 ERA (10.2ip/1er) in his last 10 outings.

HIGH FIVE: The Pirates have won a season-high tying five straight games for the second time this season...The Bucs have outscored their opponents 28-14 during their current five-game streak...A win tonight would give the Bucs their first six-game winning streak since May 30 to June 5 of last season...The team's longest winning streak of 2023 was seven games from April 17-23.

# 2024 RECORD: 4-2, 1 SAVE, 2.84 ERA

**HEIGHT/WEIGHT:** 6-2/240 **BATS/THROWS:** R/R

**BORN:** January 27, 1999

AGE: 25 SIGNED: Thru 2024

**HOW ACQUIRED:** Signed by Pittsburgh as a non-drafted free agent on Oct. 2, 2018

**STARTING OFF:** The 25-year-old righthander is in his third Major League season, all with the Pirates...Entering today, he's made 47 career appearances (22 starts) for the Bucs, including 22 relief appearances in 2024 (three starts)...He made the first Opening Day roster of his career with the Pirates in 2024 after making just two appearances (both starts) with the club in 2022 and 18 appearances (15 starts) over two stints with the Bucs in 2023...Ortiz was signed by the Pirates as an international free agent on October 2, 2018 and is one of four players to come up through the team's Dominican Academy and reach the Major Leagues with the club, joining RHP Yerry De Los Santos, RHP Osvaldo Bido and INF Rodolfo Castro.

**LIKE RIDING A BIKE:** Today will be Ortiz' 23rd career Major League start and his fourth of the season, having last made the start on July 13 at Chicago-AL, taking a no-decision after allowing just one run on four hits with five strikeouts and one walk in 5.2 innings pitched...Served in the bulk role following Carmen Mldozinski "opening" for the Bucs three times this season...Ortiz threw 4.1 shutout frames on June 8 vs. Minnesota, allowed one run in 5.0 IP on June 14 at Colorado and allowed 6 earned runs in 4.0 innings pitched on June 21 vs. Tampa Bay.

- Has posted a 3-1 record with a 2.33 ERA (10 ER in 38.2 IP) in his last seven starts since September 4, 2023, allowing two runs or fewer in six of those games and one run or fewer in five of them.
- Ortiz was a starter in 19 of his first 22 career Major League games with the Bucs from 2022-23 before primarily pitching out of the bullpen this season.
- He started 67 of his 72 appearances in the Minor Leagues from 2019-2023.

**EFFECTIVE WORK:** In 19 games (three starts) since April 20, Ortiz has gone 3-1 with one save, a 2.51 ERA (16 ER in 57.1 IP) and 52 strikeouts against 13 walks.

• Has pitched more than 1.0 inning in 17 of those 19 games.

**STARTING OFF:** Ortiz has posted a 1-0 record with a 1.02 ERA (2 ER in 17.2 IP) with 17 strikeouts against one walk in three starts this season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ortiz did not factor in the decision on July 13 at Chicago-AL after tossing 5.2 innings of one-run baseball, allowing just four hits with five strikeouts and one walks.

**<u>VS. PHILADELPHIA:</u>** Ortiz will be making his first career start and second career appearance against the Phillies today...His lone other appearance came earlier this year at Citizens Bank Park on April 12, taking home a hold after pitching one shutout frame, allowing one hit with one strikeout.

**SHUTTING IT DOWN:** Ortiz earned the first save of his big league career on June 1 at Toronto, facing a total of 10 batters in 3.0 scoreless innings while throwing 36 pitches.

**2023 RECAP:** Ortiz had two different stints with the Pirates last season, going 4-5 with a 4.93 ERA (40 ER in 73.0 IP) in his 15 starts and 1-0 with a 3.95 ERA (6 ER in 13.2 IP) in three relief appearances.

 Pitched with the Dominican Republic team in the World Baseball Classic, making one appearances and striking out three batters in 2.0 scoreless innings.
