AROUND THE HORN

LOCK IN 2027 TICKETS NOW: D-backs 2027 Advantage Memberships feature Postseason ticket priority, along with discounted ticket plans, preferred seat priority and more, and are available now by placing a deposit at [dbacks.com/membership](#)...the 2027 schedule is packed with fan favorites and holiday staples including Mother's Day in May, Father's Day in June and the 4th of July, monthly NL West matchups and exciting Interleague action.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won 5 straight games vs. Dodgers for the first time since April 2-14, 2018...the last time they won 6 straight was from Aug. 29-Sept. 6, 2017.

- The D-backs are 7-3 in their last 10 games and 17-8 in their last 25 games.
- The D-backs' 17 wins since July 9 are tied for second most in the Majors (also: Braves), behind the Red Sox (21).
- The D-backs are a season-high-tying 7 games over .500 for the fifth time this season (also: 31-24 on May 27, 59-52 on Aug. 1, 60-53 on Aug. 4 and 61-54 on Aug. 6).
 - They were last 8+ games above .500 the final day of the 2024 season (Sept. 29 at 89-73, 16 games above).
- **Brandon Pfaadt's** 6 wins since June 30 are tied for most in the Majors with Cristopher Sánchez/PHI and his 1.55 ERA (8 R-7 ER in 40.2 IP) leads the NL [min. 6 GS].
 - The D-backs are 7-0 in his last 7 bids.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 18 straight home starts vs. Dodgers since 2023, batting .306 (22-for-72)/1.029 OPS with 8 doubles, 6 homers, 11 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt** has hit safely in 13 of his last 16 games at a .385 clip (20-for-52)/.966 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 homers and 6 RBI.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 4-3 vs. Dodgers last night on **Ryan Waldschmidt's** first career walk-off (HR) in the bottom of the ninth inning...the D-backs' 7 walk-offs are third most in the NL, behind the Cubs (11) and Padres (8).

- **Ryan Waldschmidt** slugged a 2-run walk-off homer (2) off Dodgers' closer Edwin Diaz.
- **Merrill Kelly** allowed 1 run in 5.2 innings before exiting with a right leg cramp (2 H, 4 BB, 4 K).
- **Nolan Arenado** gave the D-backs an early 1-0 lead with his solo homer (17) in the second inning.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** went 2-for-3 with 1 double, 1 triple and 1 RBI.
- **Kevin Ginkel** worked a perfect ninth inning (2 K) and recorded his fifth win.

HEART AND HUSTLE: Nolan Arenado will be recognized today during a pregame ceremony as the D-backs' 2026 Heart and Hustle Award winner, as announced yesterday by the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLBPAA).

- The annual award is given to active players who exemplify a true passion for the game and who best embody the values, spirit, and traditions of the game.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are currently tied for the second NL Wild Card spot with the Phillies (WC2), 6.0 games behind the Cubs (WC1) and 2.0 games ahead of the Padres.

ANSWERBACKS: The D-backs' 36 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (35) and Braves (33).

- The 36 comeback wins through 117 games are the most in franchise history (34 in 2017, 33 in 2013, 33 in 2002).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The D-backs have won or split 7 of their last 8 series (2-2 @ Padres, 3-0 @ Dodgers, 2-1 vs. Cardinals, 2-1 vs. Athletics, 1-2 @ Nationals, 2-1 @ Pirates, 2-1 @ Guardians, 2-2 vs. Padres)...does not include the 1-game makeup win on July 23 @ Cardinals.

NOOTBAAR'S NEW DIGS: Lars Nootbaar has reached base safely in his first 4 games as a D-back (3 H, 3 BB/.375 OBP) since being acquired on Aug. 3 from the Cardinals, including reaching base 2+ twice.

HOME SWEET HOME: The D-backs' .586 home win pct. (34-24) is tied for fifth in the NL (also: Marlins), behind the Braves (.661, 39-20), Brewers (.639, 39-22), Cubs (.593, 35-24) and Dodgers (.589, 33-23).

- The D-backs are 7-3 in their last 10 home games since July 18... in that span, they rank among the Majors in OPS (2nd, .853), SLG (2nd, .493), OBP (2nd, .360) and AVG (5th, .286).

BATS AFTER THE BREAK: Since July 26, the D-backs rank among NL leaders in hits (3rd, 107), behind the Cubs (122) and Padres (115), and are tied for extra-base hits (38) with the Mets, behind the Cubs (43) and Nationals (41).

STARTING PITCHERS: D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 11 bids, own a 2.42 ERA (21 R-17 ER in 63.1 IP), opponent .239 AVG (56-for-234), with 21 walks and 46 strikeouts.

DIVISION WINS: The D-backs' .649 division win pct. (24-13) ranks third in MLB, behind the Braves (.676, 25-12) and Brewers (.667, 22-11).

- The D-backs' .667 (14-7) win pct. at home vs. NL West opponents ranks second in the NL for best division home win pct., behind the Braves (.700, 14-6).

VS. DODGERS: The D-backs are 6-2 in their last 8 meetings and look to clinch back-to-back series wins for the first time since 2024 (May 20-22 and July 2-4)...swept their last 3-game series @ Dodgers from July 10-12.

- With a win, the D-backs would take their first season series from the Dodgers since 2018.

- **Tim Tawa**, in his last 5 games vs. Dodgers, is hitting .474 (9-for-19)/1.395 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 1 walk, including 3 games reaching base 2+ times.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in 12 of his last 14 home games vs. Dodgers, hitting .362 (17-for-47)/.869 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 6 RBI and 2 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in 7 straight games vs. Dodgers, batting .320 (8-for-25)/.892 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 RBI and 6 walks.

NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (10-4, 2.71)

- The D-backs are 8-2 in his last 10 starts.
- Had a quality start to earn the win in his last bid vs. Dodgers on July 10, allowing 2 runs over 6.0 innings (7 H, BB, 5 K).
- In his last 3 starts vs. Dodgers, is 1-0 with a 1.59 ERA (4 R-3 ER in 17.0 IP), opponent .246 AVG (16-for-65), 4 walks and 13 strikeouts.
