**THE TWINS:** After going 2-4 on their six-game homestand last week (1-2 vs. Toronto, 1-2 vs. Texas), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a loss in Houston last night...today, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three at Daikin Park and finish the series tomorrow afternoon...Minnesota will continue the trip with an off-day in Cincinnati on Monday, followed by three games against the Reds at Great American Ball Park from Tuesday-Thursday.  
✦ Twins are 29-18 in their last 47 games since April 22, tied with New York-NL (29-18) for the second most wins in baseball since that date, and trailing only Detroit (32-16).

**ASTROS BLASTOFF IN OPENER:** The Twins lost to the Astros last night at Daikin Park by a score of 10-3, their third time allowing 10-plus runs in their last four games...Chris Paddock (2-6) was the starter and dealt the loss, allowing a career-high tying nine runs (8 earned) on a career-high 12 hits...Justin Topa pitched 2.0 perfect innings of relief with three strikeouts...Griffin Jax pitched 1.0 scoreless inning with three strikeouts...Danny Coulombe snapped his scoreless inning streak at 17.1 innings and 21 games to start the season — a Twins record...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Royce Lewis...Minnesota's three runs were scored on solo homers by Willi Castro (7), Lewis (2) and Ty France (5)...it marked the Twins third-straight series opener loss.

**NORTH STARS TO LONE STARS:** The Twins and Astros are playing the fifth of six games in 2025.  
✦ After going 0-6 against the Astros in 2022, the Twins have gone 9-7 in regular season games vs. Houston since the start of 2023.  
✦ Twins need to win both these remaining games to finish their season against Houston 3-3 and avoid losing the season series, which would be their first such loss since 2022 (0-6).  
✦ Byron Buxton is hitting .357 (10-for-28) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, a .400 on-base percentage, a .536 slugging percentage and a .936 OPS in his last seven games against the Astros...he has reached base safely in all seven.  
✦ Ty France is hitting .331 (87-for-263) with 12 doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBI, a .395 on-base percentage and an .885 OPS in 72 career games against the Astros...87 hits are his most against any opponent...72 games are also his most.  
✦ Matt Wallner is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with a .909 OPS in six career regular season games against the Astros.

**HOTELS AND HANDSHAKES:** The Twins have gone 12-7 in their last 19 road games, since May 3, after beginning the season 4-14 in their first 18, through May 2...below are their offensive (above) and pitching (below) comparisons this season:

**SERIES STUFF:** Twins are looking to avoid losing their 11th series of the season today...Minnesota is 11-10-1 in series play, going 6-4-1 at home and 5-6-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 10-6-1 in their last 17.  
✦ After losing their series to Houston at Target Field from April 3-6 (1-2), the Twins are looking to avoid losing two series' to the Astros in one season since 2022.

**JUNE SLUG:** Minnesota enters today with 60 runs scored this month, fourth-most in baseball, trailing New York-NL (69), Boston (67) and Texas (62)...additionally, they ranks second in baseball in on-base percentage (.347) and seventh in batting average (.265) for the month...below are the offensive monthly totals:

**FROM PARIS WITH LOVE:** Ty France has reached base safely in a career-high 24-straight games...it marks the longest for a Twin this season and longest since Byron Buxton reached in 24-straight, from April 25-May 24, 2023...the last Twin to reach in 25-straight was Jorge Polanco, who reached in 37-straight, from May 13-June 25, 2019...France's streak is the fourth-longest active streak in baseball, trailing José Ramírez (38), Vinnie Pasquantino (28) and Ketel Marte (25).  
✦ During the streak, France is hitting .319 (29-for-91) with three doubles, two home runs, 16 RBI, seven HBP and a .380 on-base percentage.  
✦ Also, during the streak, France has hitting streaks of eight games (May 19-30), six games (June 1-6) and five games (June 8-current).

**I'M A BE-LEE-VER:** Brooks Lee has hit safely in 13-straight games with an at-bat, extending his career-high...the streak is the longest by a Twin this season and the longest active streak in baseball...Minnesota's last streak as long was from Kyle Farmer, who hit in 13-straight from September 3-22, 2024...the last Twin with 14-straight was Carlos Correa, who hit in 16-straight, from June 26-September 18, 2024.  
✦ During the current streak, Lee is hitting .327 (17-for-52) with two doubles, one home run and seven RBI.

**WILLMATIC:** In his last 24 games, Willi Castro is hitting .354 (28-for-79) with four doubles, one triple, six home runs, 12 RBI, 11 walks, 17 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .440 on-base percentage, a .658 slugging percentage and a 1.098 OPS.  
✦ In his last eight road games, since May 30, he is hitting .367 (11-for-30) with five home runs, seven RBI, a .900 slugging percentage and a 1.372 OPS...since that date, he ranks tied for second in baseball in road homers with Pete Alonso and trailing Aaron Judge (6)...and his .900 slugging percentage ranks fourth, trailing Judge (.1.037), Ketel Marte (1.000) and Alonso (.967).

**BUCK NASTY:** Byron Buxton has posted a .435 on-base percentage in his last 14 games, recording 17 hits and drawing 10 walks in 62 plate appearances...over his last six games, he has posted a .560 on-base percentage, recording seven hits with seven walks in 25 PA.  
✦ Since June 1, he has posted a 18.6 walk percentage, which ranks eighth in baseball...additionally, he has posted a 1.33 walk/strikeout ratio, ranking 11th-best in MLB.

**BROCKSTAR GAMES:** After starting the season with an 8.31 ERA (4.1 IP, 4 ER) in his first six games, through May 3, Brock Stewart has posted a 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP, 1 ER) with two walks, 17 strikeouts and a .136 opponent batting average...since May 4, he ranks first in baseball (min. 10.0 IP) in soft contact percentage (40.7%), third in WHIP (0.62), tied for fourth in fewest hits allowed (6) and eighth in opponent batting average (.136).  
✦ Additionally, he has held right-handed batters to 0-for-31 to start the season...the last righty with a hit off Beef Stew was Pete Alonso with a double in his final outing of 2024 on July 29.

- LAST TIME OUT:** Last started on June 8 against Toronto at Target Field opposite Bowden Francis...earned his third-straight win and seventh of the season in Minnesota's 6-3 victory...allowed three runs (2 ER) on four hits, with three walks and six strikeouts over 5.0 innings...runs scored came on a second-inning RBI double by Alan Roden and back-to-back RBI hits, a single by Alejandro Kirk and a double by George Springer, in the third inning.
- ⌘ Walked Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in the first inning, the fifth time this season Ryan's walked a batter in the opening frame; did so just twice in 2024.
  - ⌘ Marked the 13th time in his career that he's given up three-or-more walks in an outing...has allowed three-or-more runs and walks in back-to-back outings for the first time in his career.
  - ⌘ Marked his 12th consecutive game allowing an extra-base hit, tying the second-longest streak in his career; did so in 24-straight games in 2023-24 and 12-straight games in 2022 and 2024.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started on June 2 against the Athletics in Sacramento, opposite Luis Severino...earned his sixth win of the season in Minnesota's 10-4 victory...allowed four runs on six hits (1 HR) over 5.0 innings, with a season-high three walks and four strikeouts...recorded his 600th career strikeout in the third inning...three of the four runs he allowed came via a two-out three-run home run by Lawrence Butler in the fourth inning...loaded the bases with no outs on a single, hit by pitch and walk in the fifth inning, but escaped the jam with two popouts and a grounder.

- FACING HOUSTON:** In six regular season starts against the Astros, including two starts in Houston, is 2-4 with a 7.58 ERA (29.2 IP, 25 ER), 10 home runs, 12 walks and 37 strikeouts...last faced the Astros earlier this season, on April 3 at Target Field, and allowed four runs on five hits (2 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts over 5.0 innings; took the loss, his first of the year and first at home since May 16, 2024.
- ⌘ Astros batters are slashing .252/.336/.557 in 115 regular season at-bats against Ryan...his .557 opponent slugging percentage vs. Houston is his sixth-highest against all opponents faced (has faced 27 total teams at the major league level).
  - ⌘ Ryan started Game 4 of the 2023 American League Division Series against the Astros in Minnesota, allowing one run on two hits, including a solo home run to Michael Brantley, with no walks and one strikeout over 2.0 innings.

- HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Is making his eighth road start of the season...is 4-1 with a 2.93 ERA (40.0 IP, 13 ER), five home runs, seven walks and 40 strikeouts, compared to 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA (33.0 IP, 11 ER), four home runs, eight walks and 42 strikeouts in six home appearances (5 starts)...in his career, is 18-15 in 48 road starts, with a 3.96 ERA (263.2 IP, 116 ER), a 1.10 WHIP and a 4.79 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- ⌘ In his seven road starts this season, opposing batters are slashing .216/.284/.372 in 148 at-bats.
  - ⌘ In two career starts in Houston, is 0-2 with a 10.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 10 ER), six home runs, five walks and 10 strikeouts...Astros batters are hitting .333 (12-for-36) with an .861 slugging percentage and a 1.266 OPS when facing Ryan in Houston.

- LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, lefties have slashed .218/.281/.379 with eight doubles, four home runs, seven walks and 28 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .184/.253/.340 with seven doubles, five home runs, eight walks and 54 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .208/.270/.364 with 69 walks and 237 strikeouts, while right-handed hitters are slashing .231/.277/.438 with 55 walks and 370 strikeouts.
- ⌘ In the regular season, Houston's left-handed hitters have gone 7-for-33 (.212) with five home runs, 10 RBI, six walks, nine strikeouts and a 1.017 OPS against Ryan, while Houston's right-handed hitters are hitting .268 (22-for-82) with five doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, six walks, 28 strikeouts and an .842 OPS against Ryan.

- THE ARSENAL:** Through 13 appearances (12 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ⌘ With 1171 pitches thrown this season, Ryan's chase rate is 25.3 percent and his whiff rate is 27.2 percent...his fastball run value of 11 ranks in baseball's 98th percentile...his walk rate is 5.2 percent, which ranks in baseball's 88th percentile, and his strikeout rate is 28.3 percent, which ranks in baseball's 83rd percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.3 mph while his hard hit rate is 39.7 percent.
  - ⌘ Prior to his outing on May 19 vs. Cleveland, Ryan had not utilized his curveball since September 30, 2022...has thrown a total of 200 curves in his career with an average velocity of 74.6 mph; his curveball has yielded a 23.1 percent strikeout rate and a 2.6 percent walk rate.

**600 CLUB:** Ryan is four strikeouts away from passing Eddie Guardado (610 K) for 16th all-time in Twins history (1961-present)...since 2010, only 11 pitchers in baseball have struck out more batters than Ryan (607) in their first 97 career games...of the 74 pitchers who debuted career in 2021 and have pitched 97-or-more games since, Ryan is the only one to have recorded 600-or-more strikeouts; the next closest is Logan Gilbert, who struck out 552 through his first 97 games.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2025: 2-3, 5.74 ERA // CAREER: 7-9, 4.65 ERA)
