FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals begin a seven-game road trip through New York (Apr. 17-20) and Atlanta (Apr. 21-23) into the Easter holiday weekend. Toinght, the Cardinals start a four-game series with the National League East Division leaders, the New York Mets. The Cardinals and Mets play three games at Busch Stadium in two weeks (May 2-4) to conclude the season series. New York has won the last four straight between the two clubs dating back to April 28, 2024.

FOREVER YOUNG: With a victory yesterday afternoon, 38-year old **Oliver Marmol** earned his 256th career managerial win, passing **Roger Bresnahan** (1909-12) for 14th all-time in franchise history. **Eddie Stanky** (1952-55) is next in 13th place with 260 wins.

START ME UP: **Lars Nootbaar** drew a lead-off walk to begin yesterday's game marking the 6th time this season he has broken up a perfect game as the first batter. Nootbaar's six games with lead-off walks in March-April are the most in Major League Baseball this season and rank T-7th all-time. With three more in the Cardinals final 13 games in April, Nootbaar will set the MLB record for the early combined months, surpassing **Davey Lopes** (1975).

A NEW YORK STATE OF MIND: Despite a 26-28 all-time record at Citi Field, St. Louis enters today winners of 12 of its last 18 games in Queens while outscoring the Mets 97-81 over that period.

FINDING OTHER WAYS TO "WINN": Shortstop **Masyn Winn** (lower back spasms) was placed on the 10-day Injured List on April 12, and would be eligible to return on Tuesday, April 22 in Atlanta. Winn was batting .370 over his last eight games before landing on the Injured List. Since then, Cardinals playing shortstop (**Brendan Donovan & Thomas Saggese**) have batted .500 (9-18) with four doubles and two RBI.

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT: **Brendan Donovan** tied his career-high hitting streak with a hit in his 12th straight game yesterday afternoon against the Astros. Donovan's 12-game hitting streak is the longest active streak in MLB and tied for the 3rd-longest this season overall (**Jacob Wilson**, OAK, 15 & **Jackson Chourio**, MIL, 14). His 27 hits lead the National League and tied with **Aaron Judge** for the Major League lead. His .380 batting average leads the National League and is 3rd in MLB.

- Donovan's 27 hits are the most by a Cardinal in the team's first 18 games of a season since 3B **Matt Carpenter** (28 in 2015).
- The last Cardinal to lead the NL in hits was **Matt Carpenter** (199 in 2013), who shared the MLB lead with Rangers 3B **Adrian Beltré** ... The last two Cardinals to outright lead MLB in hits were 1971 NL MVP **Joe Torre** (230 hits) & 1952 **Stan Musial** (194 hits).
- Donovan has 18 career hits against the Mets including the longest hitting streak among active players against the Mets at 10 games. He has hit safely in 9-of-10 career games at Citi Field including his last seven straight. **Matty Alou** has the longest Cardinals hitting streak against the Mets in franchise history (1971-73) with 22.

BACKSTOP BRILLIANCE: St. Louis catchers **Iván Herrera**, **Pedro Pagés**, and **Yohel Pozo** combine to lead all MLB team catching combinations in batting average (.329), slugging pct. (.685), and OPS (1.057), hits (24), doubles (8), extra-base hits (14), total bases (50).

START ME UP: In seven starts since April 8, the Cardinals starting rotation leads Major League Baseball in ERA (1.15), average against (.140), opponent slugging (.191), OPS (.397), BABIP (.176), baserunners/9 (6.70), and WHIP (0.74) while ranking T-1st in wins (5). Cardinals starting pitchers have only allowed more than one run in a start once (4/12 vs. PHI - 3 runs) over that period, including four scoreless starts.

NEW YORK CONNECTIONS

Steven Matz was originally selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Ward Melville High School in East Setauket, NY and pitched parts of his first six seasons (2015-20) in New York...was born in Stony Brook, NY.

Brendan Donovan (April 25, 2022 at Busch III), and **Masyn Winn** (Aug. 18, 2023 at Busch III) made MLB debuts against the Mets.

Ryne Stanek was born in St. Louis

Phil Maton was traded to the Mets last season (July 9, 2024) and pitched in 31 games.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **José Oquendo** played the first two seasons MLB career with the Mets...traded by New York with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis for **John Young** and **Angel Salazar** (April 2, 1985).

Mets Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** was born in Middletown, NY...graduated from Valley Central High School in Montgomery, NY...played college baseball at Seton Hall University.

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator **Scott Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

FanDuel broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** was traded to the Mets with **Jeromy Burnitz**, **Lou Collier**, **Jeff D'Amico**, and cash (January 21, 2002)...attended Spring Training with New York before released (March 13, 2002).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jason Isringhausen** was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for and managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Mets (1975-77 & 1977-81).

Mets VP of Amateur Scouting **Kris Gross** was a Cardinals amateur scout for three seasons (2010-12).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** was born in nearby Poughkeepsie, N.Y....graduated from F.D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

Cardinals reporter **Jim Hayes** was born in New York City and raised in nearby Nyack, NY...graduated from SUNY-Genesee.

Tylor Megill's older brother, **Trevor Megill**, was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Cardinals Special Advisor **Gary LaRocque** previously served as Scouting Dir., AGM & VP/ Player Dev. and Scouting with the Mets from (1998-2005)...appointed VP of Pro Scouting in 2006.

The Mets made their National League debut in St. Louis on April 11, 1962, losing to the Cardinals at Busch Stadium I on Opening Day, 11-4...The day prior before the season opener was rained out, a dozen Mets players were trapped in the Chase Park Plaza elevator for about an hour.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Making his 4th start of the season as he makes his 34th career start in his 142nd career game.
- It's his 2nd road start of the season; took a no-decision in the Cardinals 5-4 loss in extra innings in Game 1 of 4/6 doubleheader at Boston
- Recorded his 20th career win (14th as a starting pitcher) in the Cardinals 2-0 win on 4/11 vs. PHI as he worked 7.0 scoreless IP.
- Is 3-5, 3.94 ERA in 15 career road starts; His last road win came on 8/23/24 at MIN (6-1)
- Since returning to the Cardinals starting rotation on May 26, 2024 he has led the team in wins (10, tied with Sonny Gray), qualifying ERA (3.38) and opponent BA (.224) in 23 starts; **He's one of just 15 National League starting pitchers with 10+ wins dating back to his insertion into the rotation last May 26.**
- Is leading the NL with his 69.6 groundball pct. & is 2nd in Groundball/Flyball ratio at 3.56 behind the Dodgers Yoshinobu Yamamoto (4.00).**
- As a starting pitcher in 2024 was 8-7 with a 3.56 ERA over 20 starts after going 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine relief appearances in April.
- Ranked 3rd on the Cardinals with eight wins in 2024 while his 3.78 ERA was the lowest among the club's pitchers with 100 or more innings.

LAST TIME OUT: Improved his record to 2-0 in a combined 2-0 shutout win over the Philadelphia Phillies last Fri. (4/11) at Busch Stadium, allowing just 2 hits in his 7.0 IP (93 pitches). After an injury to Masyyn Winn, catcher Pedro Pages played 4 innings (2nd thru 5th) of that game at 2nd base.

2024/CAREER NOTES:

- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 4th time (2022-2025).
- Utilized as a hybrid pitcher during his 2022 rookie season with 47 appearances and 10 starts. Led the Cardinals with 62 relief appearances in 2023. Began the 2024 season in the bullpen, was optioned on April 21, and returned to the rotation on May 26 finishing the season with 20 starts as one of the Cardinals most effective starters.
- Established single-season highs in wins (8), games started (20), innings pitched (121.1), strikeouts (94) and quality starts (7) in 2024.
- Since he started his career in 2022, has the 2nd-best ground ball percentage (66.4%) in MLB trailing only **Clay Holmes** (67.1%). min. 140 appearances.
- His first start came in his 18th career appearance, on June 4, 2022 at Chicago Cubs in the second game of a doubleheader. Threw 4.0 innings allowing one run in a no-decision the Cardinals rallied to win in extra innings (7-4).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since **Alan Benes** vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.
- Pitched for Team Italy in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.
- The San Clemente, Calif. native was 4th round (125th player overall) draft selection in 2019 out of University California-Irvine.
- Graduated from San Clemente High School that also produced Cardinals 2021 1st round pick RHP Michael McGreevy and Braves 2015 1st round pick Kolby Allard.

PALLANTE vs. METS:

- Is making just his 2nd career start and 9th career appearance against the Mets tonight.
- Is 0-1, 3.77 ERA career in his previous 8 appearances against the Mets, including an 8.2 scoreless innings streak over his 1st five career meetings with New York.
- Has no HR's allowed to Mets batters over his 14.1 career innings pitched against them.**
- His lone career start against NYM came in a make-game meeting at Busch Stadium on 8/5/24, a 6-0 Cardinals loss (4.2 IP/5 ER).
- Has made 4 career appearances (all in relief) at Citi Field and has yet to allow a run over 4.1 IP here in Queens.
