AROUND THE HORN

D-BACKS USA250 PACKAGE: There is no better place to celebrate Independence Day weekend than Chase Field as the D-backs host a 2-night must-see Fireworks Spectacular presented by Bar-S on Friday, July 3 and Saturday, July 4...in recognition of America's 250th anniversary celebration, the D-backs are offering a special USA250 ticket package for the July 3 and July 4 games...fans can purchase 4 lower-level or club-level tickets for \$250 by using offer code USA250.

HERE'S THE STORY: Gabriel Moreno has reached base in a career-high 19 straight games, hitting .324 (22-for-68)/.948 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 12 walks...owns the longest active streak among catchers and second longest this season, 1 shy behind Shea Langeliers/ATH (20).

- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 17 of his last 19 games and 27 times overall (19 H, 6 BB, 2 HBP)/.840 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 triples, 4 homers and 13 RBI.
- **Corbin Carroll** has hit 5 homers in 10 career starts vs. Rays...is batting .317 (13-for-41)/1.105 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 12 RBI and 2 walks, including a 7-game hitting streak...his 5 homers are tied for most among NL players vs. Rays since 2023 (also: Willy Adames/SF).
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 14 of his last 15 games, hitting .317 (19-for-60)/.929 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 homers, 8 RBI and 5 walks, including reaching base 2+ times in 8 of those.
- **Merrill Kelly** has allowed 2 or fewer runs in 4 of his last 5 road bids, with 4 quality starts...in his last 5 road starts, is 2-2 with a 2.70 ERA (10 ER in 33.1 IP).

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 4-2 @ Rays last night.

- **Geraldo Perdomo** (3-for-4, 2B) recorded his fifth 3-hit effort.
- **Corbin Carroll** gave the D-backs an early lead with his RBI single in the first inning.
- **Ketel Marte** hit his team-leading 14th homer (solo) in the eighth inning to cut the deficit to 4-2.
- **Gabriel Moreno** extended his career-high on-base streak to 19 straight games.
- **Juan Morillo** (1.0 IP), **Kevin Ginkel** (1.0 IP) and **Taylor Clarke** (1.0 IP) combined for 3.0 scoreless innings (H, 2 BB, 3 K).

MILESTONE WATCH: Ketel Marte (1,180) is 2 hits away from tying Paul Goldschmidt (1,182) for second most hits in franchise history, behind Luis Gonzalez (1,337).

STAY CALIENTE, GABI: Gabriel Moreno's 19-game on-base streak is the longest for a D-backs catcher since Miguel Montero's 19-gamer from June 2-27, 2012.

- Is 1 game shy of tying the franchise's third longest streak by a catcher held by Miguel Montero (20) from Aug. 30-Sept. 22, 2012 and Carson Kelly from April 7-May 8, 2021.
- Has reached base safely in 30 of his last 33 games, hitting .328 (39-for-119)/.923 OPS with 6 doubles, 5 homers, 17 RBI and 18 walks, including 2+ times in 19 of them.

FAMILIAR FOE: Jonathan Loaisiga is scoreless in 13 straight games (16.1 IP) vs. Rays, going 0-0 with 1 save, a 0.73 WHIP, with 7 hits, 5 walks and 12 strikeouts.

- In 18 career relief appearances vs. Rays, is 0-0 with 1 save, a 0.75 ERA (2 ER in 24.0 IP), opponent .148 AVG (12-for-81)/.480 OPS, 7 walks and 23 strikeouts.

BULLPEN SPOTLIGHT: Kevin Ginkel is scoreless in 12 of his last 13 road games, going 3-0 with a 0.77 ERA (1 ER in 11.2 IP), 9 hits, 3 walks and 14 strikeouts.

- **Taylor Clarke** is scoreless in 17 of his last 18 road games, going 1-0 with a 0.98 ERA (2 ER in 18.1 IP), 11 H, 5 walks and 7 strikeouts.
- **Paul Sewald** vs. Rays, is scoreless in 9 of his last 10 games, going 1-1 with 2 saves, a 2.53 ERA (3 ER in 10.2 IP), opponent .139 AVG (5-for-36), 0.66 WHIP, 2 walks and 18 strikeouts.

DOUBLE UP: The D-backs' 81 road doubles are second most in the Majors, behind the Giants (94)...the D-backs have 2+ doubles in 7 of their last 9 games.

ALL-STAR CALIBER: Ketel Marte ranks among NL second basemen in SLG (2nd, .462), homers (2nd, 14), total bases (2nd, 145), extra-base hits (2nd, 33) and RBI (2nd, 48)...defensively, is the only qualified second baseman without an error (0 E in 552.1 inn.).

- **Corbin Carroll** ranks among NL outfielders in extra-base hits (T-1st, 40), triples (1st, 10), OPS (2nd, .904), SLG (2nd, .539) and total bases (4th, 159)...defensively, his 8 Outs Above AVG rank third among NL outfielders, behind Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (14) and Jacob Young/WSH (11).
- **Gabriel Moreno**, since May 13 [min. 100 PA] leads NL catchers in AVG (.328), OPS (.923), OBP (.418), walks (T-1st, 18) and ranks in SLG (2nd, .504), hits (2nd, 39) and homers (3rd, 5)...defensively [min. 50 G], is tied for the second fewest errors (1) with Tyler Stephenson/CIN, behind William Contreras/MIL (0).
- **Nolan Arenado** ranks among NL third basemen in doubles (2nd, 15), SLG (3rd, .389), homers (T-4th, 8) and extra-base hits (4th, 23)...defensively, has the second fewest errors (3), behind Manny Machado/SD (2).

BATS TRAVEL WELL: Gabriel Moreno has reached base in 17 of his last 18 road games, hitting .385 (25-for-65)/1.053 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 11 RBI and 11 walks, including a 7-game hitting streak.

- **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 8 of his last 9 road games, batting .316 (12-for-38)/.918 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 3 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base in 18 of his last 21 road games (22 H, 10 BB, 2 HBP)/.821 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers and 8 RBI.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 19 of his last 21 road games (22 H, 12 BB)/.795 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers and 6 RBI.

VS. RAYS: The D-backs are playing just their sixth ever series @ Rays and first since 2024.

- **Nolan Arenado** has an 9-game hitting streak vs. Rays, batting .406 (13-for-32)/1.020 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 10 career starts vs. Rays, hitting .324 (11-for-34)/.351 OBP with 1 double, 1 RBI and 2 walks.

ON DECK VS. GIANTS: The D-backs have swept both of their 3-game series this season (vs. Giants May 18-20 and @ Giants May 25-27)...the D-backs are 9-1 in their last 10 meetings, outscoring the Giants 59-31...the lone loss came in an 11-inning contest (5-1).

NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (6-2, 2.27)

- The D-backs are 6-1 in his last 7 starts and 6-2 overall in his 8 road games.
- Has allowed 1 or fewer runs in his last 3 starts, going 1-0 with a 1.10 ERA (3 R-2 ER in 16.1 IP), 11 hits, 11 walks and 13 strikeouts.
- In his 8 road starts, is 2-1 with a 2.83 ERA (13 ER in 41.1 IP), 40 H, 22 walks and 35 strikeouts.

- Is tied for the second-longest tenured active D-back with Zac Gallen and Kevin Ginkel, behind Ketel Marte (10th season), and is 1 of 12 D-backs all-time to play 8+ seasons: Ketel Marte (10), Nick Ahmed (10), Miguel Montero (9), David Peralta (9), Zac Gallen (8), **Merrill Kelly (8)**, Kevin Ginkel (8), Randy Johnson (8), Luis Gonzalez (8), Andrew Chafin (8), Christian Walker (8) and Paul Goldschmidt (8).
- Since 2022, is 1 of 5 starters with 3+ seasons of 12+ wins and 175.0+ innings (also: Framber Valdez/HOU-4, Carlos Rodón/NYY-3, Zac Gallen/AZ-3 and Logan Webb/SF-3).
- Re-signed with the D-backs on Dec. 19, 2025 (2-year contract through 2027 with a vesting option for 2028).
- Was traded to the Rangers on July 31, 2025 for prospects RHP David Hagaman (No. 8), LHP Kohl Drake (No. 12) and LHP Mitch Bratt (No. 14).

LAST START: Recorded his sixth quality start on June 22 @ Cardinals (L, 3 ER in 6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 BB, 2 K).

ON THE ROAD: In his last 5 road starts (@ COL, @ SF, @ SEA, @ MIA, @ STL), is 2-2 with a 2.70 ERA (10 ER in 33.1 IP), opponent .225 AVG (27-for-120), 9 walks and 12 strikeouts.

VS. RAYS: Third start, first since 2024...was first drafted by the Rays in 2010 and played in their Minors system until 2014, reaching Triple-A before signing to play in the KBO from 2015-18.

- Did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 18, 2024 (6 ER in 5.0 IP, 8 H, 4 K).
- Earned the win in his lone start vs AL East this season @ Orioles on April 14 (2 ER in 5.1 IP, 5 H, 4 BB, 3 K).

THE CHANGEUP: With his changeup (25.5 pct. usage), is holding opponents to a .233 AVG (20-for-86) with 19 strikeouts and a 30.2 whiff pct.

WITH THE LEAD: When the team is ahead, is holding opponents to a .200 AVG (16-for-80) with 4 walks and 17 strikeouts.

FINISHING STRONG: In innings 5-8, is holding opponents to a .198 AVG (17-for-86) with 11 runs, 7 walks and 13 strikeouts.

1,000 INNING CLUB: Is 1 of 4 D-backs all-time to reach 1000.0 innings with the franchise (1028.2 IP) along with Randy Johnson (1630.1 IP), Brandon Webb (1319.2 IP) and Zac Gallen (1050.2 IP).
