## First \& Last

Atlanta's two runs yesterday came in its first and final at-bats of the game, with Jarred Kelenic collecting a leadoff homer and Adam Duvall stroking a walk-off single.

Yesterday marked just the third time since the club moved to Atlanta in 1966 that its only two runs scored on a leadoff homer and a walk-off RBI.
It was first done on August 9,1966 vs. Los Angeles (NL), when Felipe Alou led off with a homer and Hall-of-Famer Eddie Mathews hit a walk-off shot - both off Hall-of-Famer Sandy Koufax.

Prior to yesterday, it was last done on May 10, 1975 vs. Philadelphia, when Ralph Garr led off with a homer and Earl C. Williams
hit a walk-off single in 2-1 win.


TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Pirates today conclude a three-game weekend series with what is the sixth and final scheduled meeting between the clubs this season...Atlanta played three games at PNC Park in Pittsburgh, May 24-26.

A The Braves walked off with a win, 2-1, yesterday afternoon and have won each of the first two games of this series...Atlanta dropped two-of-three in the series in Pittsburgh.
A Atlanta will go for the sweep and the season series this afternoon...Yesterday's win guaranteed at least a split of the six games.

A The Braves have won the season set with the Pirates every year since 2018 in which they have played, going a combined 28-11 (.718) in that span...That includes a perfect 7-0 record against Pittsburgh in 2022, one of just three instances in the franchise's modern era that they swept a season series of seven or more games with an opponent.
A Atlanta has never lost a series to Pittsburgh here at Truist Park, going 19-5 (.792) at home since the facility opened in 2017...The Braves and Pirates split four games in their first series here in 2017, and Atlanta has gone 17-3 in the 20 games since.
A RH Spencer Schwellenbach is set for just the sixth start of his major league career and his first versus Pittsburgh...The 6-foot-1, 200-pound native of Saginaw, MI, is 1-3 with a 5.40 ERA (16 ER/26.2 IP) over his first five career starts, but earned the only win of his career in his last start here at Truist Park, June 18 vs. Detroit, after pitching 6.0 one-run innings...Schwellenbach leads all of baseball with a $40.2 \%$ chase rate, and his one barrel allowed in 79 batted balls ranks in the 99th percentile.
A LH Bailey Falter has made four career starts against Atlanta and has compiled a 1-1 record with a 6.41 ERA (14 ER/19.2 IP), with his only such win coming earlier this season...The 6-foot-4, 175pound native of Chino Hills, CA, beat the Braves on May 24 at PNC, allowing six hits and three runs over 7.1 innigns....He is winless in the month of June, going $0-4$ with a 6.63 ERA (14 ER/19.0 IP) in four turns.
WIN: Adam Duvall lined a single into right center in the 10th inning to give Atlanta the walk-off win, 2-1, yesterday afternoon...The victory was the Braves fourth walk-off win of the season and their first since April 28 vs. Cleveland.
A The Braves improved to 5-3 (.625) in extra-inning games this season, with Pittsburgh falling to 5-5 (.500) in such games.

A Atlanta has allowed exactly one run in each of its last three games, dating to Thursday at Chicago (AL)...Across the majors, that is tied for the longest streak of its kind this season, matched by four other clubs...By expanding the parameters to surrendering one run-or-fewer, the Braves had a four-game run earlier this month, spanning June 17-21.

HALFWAY: The Braves yesterday played their 81st game of the 162-game regular season schedule...Atlanta's 46-35 (.568) record is seventh-best in the majors and fourth-best in the National League, behind Philadelphia (54-29, .651), Los Angeles-NL (52-32, .619) and Milwaukee (49-34, .590).
A In the Atlanta-era (since 1966), the Braves have won at least 46 of their first 81 games in a season 21 times, including each of the last three years.
A In the previous 20 instances, the club advanced to the postseason 17 times - failing to do so in 1983, 2011 and the strike-shortened 1994 season.
LEADOFF KELENIC: Jarred Kelenic reached base three more times yesterday afternoon, going 2 -for -3 with a walk...He drove the third pitch of the first inning out to right for his second career leadoff home run and his ninth homer in total this season.

A He has homered five times over his last 14 games, dating to June 15 vs . Tampa Bay...All nine of his home runs this season have come since May 7 vs. Boston (42 games), after going homerless through his first 26 games on the year.
A In 14 games since moving to the top spot in the batting order on June 15, Kelenic is hitting . 351 (20-for-57), with five home runs, two doubles, 11 RBI, eight runs and a 1.046 OPS...He's raised his season batting average from .259 to $.283(+0.24)$ over that span, and Atlanta has gone 9-5.
A Since that date, his 37 total bases out of the leadoff spot trail just Shohei Ohtani for most in the majors.

RILEY IN JUNE: Austin Riley is set to play his final game in the month of June this afternoon, and has batted .298/.377/. 553 with six homers over 26 games in the month...He reached base two more times yesterday afternoon, going 1 -for- 3 with a walk.
A Each of his six homers have come over his last 15 games, dating to June 14 vs. Tampa Bay...Since that date, he is hitting .385 (20-for-52) with six home runs, four doubles, 11 RBI and 13 runs.
A His 10 extra-base hits since that date match his total from his previous 45 games, dating to April 8 vs. New York (NL).
A In the month of June, he leads all qualified NL third basemen in runs (tied, 17) and OPS (.931), ranks second in on-base percentage (.377) and total bases (52), and is third in slugging percentage (.553), home runs (6) and doubles (tied, 6).

RISP: Atlanta pitchers held Pittsburgh hitless in 10 at-bats with runners in scoring position yesterday, and has allowed just one hit in its last 23 opponent at-bats (.043) in such situations.

A Yesterday marked the most hitless at-bats for Braves pitchers with runners in scoring position since holding the Mets to an 0 -for-12 effort on August 11 of last season.

A Ian Anderson made his first two career starts against Boston and New York (AL) in 2020, while Charlie Morton pitched against Texas and Los Angeles (AL) in his first two outings in 2008.
A Allowed seven hits, six runs, two walks and a home run with four strikeouts in his last start while facing the Red Sox.
A Joined Ian Anderson (2020) and Kyle Davies (2005) as the only Braves pitchers in franchise history to make one of their first two career starts in Fenway Park.
A Made his major league debut on May 29 against the Nationals...went 5.0 innings allowing five hits, three runs, one walk and striking out five Washington hitters.
A Became just the ninth pitcher in Braves franchise history to debut against the Nationals.

A Made his debut at age 23 years and 364 days, becoming the youngest starter to debut for Atlanta since AJ Smith-Shawver last season on June 4...Teammate Hurston Waldrep became the youngest pitcher to make their first start shortly after debuting at 22 years and 100 days.
A He was the sixth youngest starter to debut this season at the time of his start.
\& Pitched 13.0 scoreless innings in two starts with Double-A Mississippi while recording 17 strikeouts and issuing just one walk, earning the win in both games.
A Held hitters to a .122 batting average.
A Made six starts for High-A Rome and went 2-1 with a 2.53 ERA this season.
A It would rank as the third lowest ERA among qualified starters in the South Atlantic League.

A Enters today with 24 starts at the professional level between Single-A Augusta, High-A Rome and Double-A Mississippi.
