TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners go for a 3-game series sweep against their division rival Athletics today... Seattle is coming off a series loss at Kansas City (1-2) on the road trip...following Thursday's off-day, Seattle will host the Arizona Diamondbacks (3 G, 5/29-31) and New York Mets (3 G, 6/1-3) on the homestand... today's game will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call and **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...Seattle won yesterday's game by a 4-1 final score over the Athletics, securing a series win...Seattle is 23-14 when they hit a home run and 19-5 when they score at least 5 runs.

- **In West Sacramento** - Seattle holds a 5-3 record against the A's in Sutter Health Park.
- **Ouch!** - Mariners batters rank T-2nd in the Majors with 38 HBP this season, trailing only the Los Angeles Angels (39 HBP)...Seattle has led MLB in HBP in each of the last 3 seasons (2023-25).
- **Game Fit for a KING (5)** - Friday's game will be televised on KING 5 (and regional cable affiliates) in addition to Mariners TV.
- **Gabe is Back!** - Yesterday the Mariners reinstated LHP **Gabe Speier** from the 15-day Injured List (left shoulder inflammation) and optioned RHP **Nick Davila** to Triple-A Tacoma (post-game May 25)... Speier tossed a scoreless inning with a strikeout in his first appearance since his stint on the IL.

LEAD GUITAR...in 56 games this season, **Randy Arozarena** is batting .297 (60x202) with 38 runs, 15 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs, 25 RBI and going 14-for-16 in stolen base attempts, getting on base at a .386 clip and slugging .470 for an .856 OPS...among qualified AL hitters, he ranks 8th in average, T-4th in hits, T-2nd in doubles, T-5th in runs, T-3rd in SB and 7th in wRC+ (150)...in 24 games this month, Randy is batting .307 (27x88) with 6 doubles, 4 home runs, 14 RBI, 7 stolen bases and an .903 OPS.

LEAD VOCALS...**Julio Rodriguez** has reached base safely in 11-consecutive games (5/15-c)...Julio also recorded a 19-game on base streak from April 3-22 and owns 2 of the 3 longest on-base streak by a Mariners hitter this season (also: **Cal Raleigh**, 12 G)...Julio is batting .265 (26x98) with 15 runs, 5 doubles, 7 home runs, 12 RBI and an .839 OPS in 24 games in May...Rodriguez homered in both series played at Sutter Health Park in 2025 and has 13 home runs against the Athletics, tied for the most against any opponent in his career (also: Angels and Rangers).

HE'S RALEY CRUSHING IT...**Luke Raley** is batting .268 (37x138) with 20 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 11 home runs, 29 RBI, a .327 OBP and slugging .558 for an .885 OPS in 50 games...among AL hitters with at least 150 PA this season, his .885 OPS ranks T-9th and his .558 slugging percentage ranks 5th...over his last 17 games (5/8-c), he is batting .304 (14x46) with 1 double, 5 home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.012 OPS.

REALLY GOOD ARMS...the Mariners pitching staff has posted a combined 3.58 ERA (198 ER, 497.1 IP) with an MLB-fewest 144 walks, along with 477 strikeouts...among Major League pitching staffs they rank 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.31), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.61), 6th in ERA, 7th in WHIP (1.22) and 10th in strikeouts...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 318.1 innings pitched and ranks 4th in strikeouts (299) and T-5th in quality starts (24)...the Seattle bullpen ranks 6th in the Majors in ERA (3.17).

JOSH SPICE...over his last 33 contests (4/17-c), **Josh Naylor** is batting .336 (43x128) with 15 runs, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 17 RBI, 13 walks and 12 stolen bases, getting on base at a .394 clip, slugging .445 with an .839 OPS in 142 plate appearances...during that span, Naylor's .328 average ranks 5th in the big leagues (min. 100 PA)...Naylor's 12 stolen bases are tied for second most in the Majors since April 17, trailing only Nasim Nuñez-WSH (15).

COLT'S BIG DAY IN KC...on Sunday, **Colt Emerson** went 4-for-4 with 3 doubles and an RBI against the Royals...at 20 years, 308 days, he became the **youngest player** to record 3 doubles in a game since Hall of Famer Roberto Clemente (20 years, 284 days, 5/29/55 vs. PHI) and the youngest player in Mariners history to accomplish the feat...he also joined Ken Griffey Jr. (4x) and Alex Rodriguez (3x) as the only trio of Mariners to record 4 hits in a game before turning 21.

J.P. PRESENTS STEELHEADS UNIFORM TO NLBM...prior to the game on Saturday, **J.P. Crawford** presented his game-worn, autographed Seattle Steelheads uniform to **Bob Kendrick**, President of the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum located in Kansas City...manager **Dan Wilson** also presented Kendrick with a check for \$25,000 from the Mariners Care Foundation as a donation to the museum in support of its Buck O'Neil Education and Research Center...video and audio can be found on Marinersmedia.com.

ON THE UPCOMING HOMESTAND...following tomorrow's off-day, the Mariners return to T-Mobile Park for a 6-game homestand against the Diamondbacks (3 G, May 29-31) and Mets (3 G, June 1-3)...featured on the homestand is '90s weekend (May 29-31) with '90s Fireworks Night on Friday, **Julio Rodriguez** '90s Jersey Night on Saturday and '90s Pin Day on Sunday, as well as Pride Night on June 1.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Emerson Hancock** was stellar last night, turning in his second start of the season of at least 6.0 IP and 1-or-fewer hits allowed, 1 of 6 pitchers with multiple such starts this season, including teammate **Bryan Woo**, and...**AS YOU MAY ALSO KNOW**...the Mariners starters have combined to recorded 5 starts of 6.0+ innings and 1-or-fewer hits this season, 1 shy of tying the franchise record of 6 (2015 and 2025), but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...the 2026 Mariners are 1 of only 6 teams to get 5 such starts within their first 56 games of a season?...only the 2021 Brewers (6 G) have recorded more while Seattle matched the 1914 White Sox, 2002 Red Sox, 2016 Dodgers and 2018 Pirates.

ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 27

- **1981** - Mariners third baseman Lenny Randle got down on his hands and knees to blow a bunt foul against the Kansas City Royals at the Kingdome. The play was ruled a hit.
- **2001** - John Olerud went 4x5 in a 13-3 win at Kansas City. The win put the Mariners 25-games over .500 for the first time in club history.
- **2003** - Randy Winn goes 5x5 (plus a walk) to tie club record with 5 hits.
- **2003** - Edgar Martinez goes 2x4 with 5 RBI off of 2 home runs. This is his 21st multi-home run game.
- **2015** - Nelson Cruz hit a 3-run home run into the fish tank in center at Tropicana Field with 2 outs in the top of the 9th inning to break a scoreless tie...Cruz's blast backed a complete game shutout by Félix Hernández.
- **2019** - Outfielder Mallex Smith steals a franchise-record tying 4 bases in a 6-2 win vs. Texas, including "stealing for the cycle" in the 8th inning, as following a walk, he stole 2nd, 3rd and home.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- Gilbert, 29, is making his 12th start of the season and 2nd against the Athletics...it is the 158th start of his career and 16th career start against the Athletics.
• Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummaw on June 16, 2018.
• Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
• Named the 2022 and the 2024 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.
• Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2024.

LAST TIME OUT...

...on May 22 at Kansas City, threw 5.2 shutout innings, allowing 2 hits and 2 walks while striking out 6 batters...logged 94 pitches and 60 strikes...marks his 21st start with 5.0+ shutout innings, tied with George Kirby for the 6th most in Mariners history...is also his 29th start with 4-or-fewer base runners allowed over 5.0+ innings, the most such games in Mariners history and the 5th most in MLB since 2021.

FACING THE A'S...

...the Mariners are 12-3 when Gilbert starts against the Athletics...his K/BB ranks 4th (6.62), WHIP ranks 2nd (0.851), and opponent batting average ranks 7th (.196) among active starting pitchers against the Athletics (min. 5 GS)...has recorded 7 quality starts, 4 being 7.0+ innings, and has thrown 5.0+ innings with 3-or-fewer runs allowed in 10-of-15 starts against the A's.

THE ROAD SO FAR...

...will be making his 5th road start of the season...enters the game ranking 4th in ERA (1.59), T-5th in WHIP (0.79) and a 4th in K/BB in away games this season among MLB pitchers (min. 20.0 IP)...has recorded quality starts in 6 of his last 10 road games (8/13/25-c)...his 39 career starts with 6+ strikeouts and 2-or-fewer walks in away games since ranks 5th in MLB since 2021 behind Tarik Skubal-DET...owns 456 career strikeouts in away games ranking 5th most in Mariners history, surpassing Mike Moore's 452 in his last start...also leads AL starting pitchers since 2021...his 1.120 career WHIP on the road ranks 10th in MLB since 2021 (min. 300 IP).

IN COMMAND...

...made his 48th start with 7+ strikeouts and 1-or-fewer walks at Chicago-AL on May 10...his 48 such start are tied for 3rd most in MLB since 2021...also in his May 10 start, allowed only 1 base runner for his 7th career start with 2-or-fewer base runners allowed over 6.0+ innings...he leads the MLB in such games since 2021.

MASTER OF THE CRAFT...

...among all-time starting pitchers with over 900 strikeouts, he ranks 6th in K/BB (4.86)...ranks 7th in the AL in 2026 with a 4.5 K/BB and is 9th in BB% with 5.6% (min. 50.0 IP)...is 1-of-8 pitchers this season to own a BB/9 less than 2.0 and a K/9 greater than 9.0, along with Emerson Hancock (min. 50.0 IP)...is 1-of-3 pitchers to have finished the season in the top-10 in the AL in K/BB multiple times in the last 3 seasons ('23,'25) alongside Bryan Woo ('24,'25) and Tarik Skubal ('24,'25).

HEY BATTER BATTER SWING...

...his 28.4 whiff rate in 2026 is the 9th best in in the AL (min. 750 pitches) while his 2,050 career swing and misses rank 5th in MLB since 2021...owns a 43.4 career whiff rate on his splitter, ranking 3rd among pitchers with 1000 splitters thrown since 2021.

PLAYING THE LONG GAME...

...has thrown 29.1 innings over his last 5 games for the most innings pitcher over a 5 game span since he logged 31.0 on 9/7/24-9/29/24...has pitched the 12th most innings in the AL this season...his 83 career starts with 6.0+ innings thrown are tied for 3rd most in AL since 2021 while his 26 games with 7.0+ innings are 8th most...owns a 1.00 WHIP on pitches 76-100, ranking T-5th best in AL among starting pitchers (min. 10.0 IP) with a .267 opponent OBP, ranking 8th best in the AL and a K/9 of 9.00.

QUALITY CONTROL...

...has thrown a quality start with 1-or-fewer walks issued in 58 career games (last: 5/10 at CWS), the 5th-most such games in MLB since 2021, just trailing behind rotation-mate George Kirby (59)...his 27 quality starts without a walk are T-5th-most in MLB since 2021.

KEEPING COOPERSTOWN COMPANY...

...ranks 11th in WHIP (1.062) all-time among starting pitchers in MLB that have recorded over 900 strikeouts, just trailing Hall of Famer's Walter Johnson's 1.061 and Christy Mathewson's 1.058 WHIP...his base runners allowed per 9 innings (9.84) is tied with Walter Johnson for 9th best among all-time starting pitchers with 900+ strikeouts (min. 100 GS), just ahead of Chris Sale (9.93) and Pedro Martinez (9.94).

AMONG THE GREATS...

...his 3.61 career ERA (360 ER, 897.2 IP) is 6th-best among pitchers in Mariners history (min. 500 IP), trailing Randy Johnson, Félix Hernández, Hisashi Iwakuma, and James Paxton who each hold a 3.42 career ERA, and George Kirby (3.58)...his 947 career strikeouts are 5th-most in Mariners history...he also ranks 1st in WHIP (1.062), 3rd in K/9 (9.495), trailing James Paxton's 9.545 and Randy Johnson's 10.585 career K/9 mark, and 2nd in K/BB (4.856) only behind George Kirby's 6.174 (min. 500 IP).

WITHIN STRIKING DISTANCE...

...with a win, will become the 13th Mariners pitcher to record 50+ wins with the team...with 6.0 innings of work, Gilbert will tie Bill Swift (903.2 IP) at 11th most innings pitched for the Mariners...with 2.1 innings of work, will become the first pitcher to debut in 2021 to record 900 innings pitched.

AMONG THE LEAGUE...

...his 947 strikeouts since 2021 lead the American League while his 897.2 innings pitched are 3rd most and his 157 starts are 2nd in the AL across that span.

150 FOR THE M'S...

...made his 150th career start with the Mariners on April 12 vs. Houston Astros...he is the 7th pitcher to make 150 starts in a Mariners uniform...his 909 strikeouts rank second among Mariners pitchers' first 150 career starts, only behind Mark Langston (916 K)...ranks 9th in wins with 48 over a players' first 150 games pitched with the Mariners.
