## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (23-41) vs. WASHINGTON NATIONALS (27-35)

June 14, 2021 at Nationals Park, Washington, DC -- GAME #65/ROAD #33

RHP JT BRUBAKER (4-5, 3.90 ERA) vs. LHP JON LESTER (0-2, 4.19 ERA)

**THE PIRATES...**have lost a season-high seven straight games after winning three in a row...Have gone 11-30 in their last 41 games after winning three straight games to go above .500 (12-11) on 4/27...Were 30-34 after 64 games in 2019 (30-35 after 65 games).

**SUCCESSION OF SOUTHPAWS:** The Pirates will face lefthanders Jon Lester and Patrick Corbin in each of the first two games of this three-game series...It's the second time this season the Bucs will face an opposing left-handed starter in back-to-back games (the only other time it happened this year came in three straight games from May 29-31 against Colorado's Austin Gomber and Kyle Freeland and Kansas City's Mike Minor).

**SOUTHPAW STORY LINES:** Adam Frazier has the fourth-highest average (.329) in MLB among left-handed hitters vs. left-handed pitchers...The only three left-handed hitters with higher averages against opposing lefties this year are Anthony Rizzo (.377), Kolten Wong (.353) and J.P. Crawford (.346)...**Bryan Reynolds** is hitting .338 (23-for-68) this year vs. lefties...Reynolds' 23 hits against lefties are tied for the third-most among all National League players along with teammate **Adam Frazier** (Philadelphia's Jean Segura and Andrew McCutchen lead the way with 24 apiece).

**FAMILIAR FOE:** Adam Frazier is 7-for-19 (.368) with a pair of doubles in his career vs. Jon Lester...**Kevin Newman** is 7-for-20 lifetime vs. Lester...The only pitcher Newman has collected more hits against in his career is Jose Quintana (eight)...Between 2015-20 as a member of the Cubs, Jon Lester made more starts (25) against the Pirates than any other pitcher.

**ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER:** JT Brubaker is making his 12th start of the season tonight in the first game of this series against the Nationals...Brubaker has allowed a combined three runs in 10.2 innings in his last two starts after surrendering 12 runs in 11.0 innings in his previous two starting assignments on May 18 at St. Louis and May 23 in Atlanta.

**ALL OVER THE NL LEADER BOARD:** Bryan Reynolds enters today ranked sixth in the National League in on-base percentage (.391) and doubles (17), ninth in slugging percentage (.500) and batting average (.286) and seventh in OPS (.892)...His 2.3 Wins Above Replacement according to FanGraphs ranks 14th in all of MLB and sixth among all outfielders behind Nick Castellanos (3.4), Ronald Acuna Jr. (3.1), Cedric Mullins (2.9), Jesse Winker (2.7) and Kris Bryant (2.5).

**AN ALL-STAR SEASON:** Adam Frazier enters today's action tied for first in all of Major League Baseball in doubles (23) and first in hits (85)...He ranks third in the National League in batting (.336), fifth in OBP (.396), sixth in total bases (120), eighth in OPS (.871) and tied for eighth in extra base hits (28).

**FROM YESTERDAY:** Pirates starter Wil Crowe recorded eight strikeouts yesterday in Milwaukee while allowing two runs in 5.0-plus innings of work in a no-decision...Crowe's eight strikeouts were the most by a Pirates rookie since JT Brubaker punched out nine Cleveland Indians last season on September 21...Crowe, who was acquired by the Pirates from Washington along with pitcher Eddy Yean on December 24, entered the season rated by MLB Pipeline as Pittsburgh's 23rd-best prospect.

**THE MAN BEHIND THE MASK:** Jacob Stallings recorded his career-high 26th RBI of the season yesterday with a solo home run in the sixth inning off Brewers starter Adrian Houser...Stallings is tied for fourth among all catchers in MLB in RBI, trailing only Oakland's Sean Murphy (30), Kansas City's Salvador Perez (30) and St. Louis' Yadier Molina (28).

**BUCS-NATS:** This is the first time the Bucs and Nats are facing each other since a four-game series at PNC Park from August 19-22, 2019...It's Pittsburgh's first visit back to Nationals Park since winning two of three games here from April 12-14, 2019.

**NOTHING SHORT OF THE BEST:** Kevin Newman is the only Major League shortstop without an error this season (min: 45 games played)...He has gone 54 consecutive games without making an error at shortstop; tying his own club record for most consecutive errorless games at that position in a single season (he also went 54 straight games without a miscue in 2019 from May 24 to July 23).

**THE HITS KEEP COMING:** Ke'Bryan Hayes extended his hitting streak to 10 games with a single in the first inning in Sunday's game against the Brewers (Hayes has actually hit safely in each of his last 18 games dating back to last season)...Since being reinstated from the injured list on June 3, Hayes' 12 hits are the second-most among all rookies in Major League Baseball behind Miami's Jazz Chisholm Jr. (13).

**PLAYING THE FIELD:** The Pirates have been charged with a total of nine errors since May 20...That's tied for the third-fewest in all of Major League Baseball along with the Reds and Astros...The only two teams to commit fewer errors in that time are the Rays (seven) and Mets (eight).

**SIX UP, SIX DOWN:** Chasen Shreve retired all six batters he faced in his last outing Saturday afternoon...Shreve has been scored upon just twice in his first 14 appearances as a member of the Pirates...In addition, Shreve has limited left-handed batters to two hits in 19 at-bats (.105) while allowing just one hit in 16 at-bats with runners on base...The Pirates signed Shreve as a minor league free agent prior to spring training on February 7.

<b>TYLER ANDERSON:</b> The 31-year-old lefthander is scheduled to make his 13th start of the season tomorrow...Allowed two runs in 6.0 innings but lost a 2-1 decision against the Dodgers in his last start on 6/9 at PNC Park...Has lost four of his last five decisions after winning back-to-back starts on 4/14 vs. San Diego and 4/21 at Detroit...Allowed a career-high tying nine runs in 5.0ip on 5/21 at Alanta...Has surrendered nine home runs in his last five starts...Was signed as a free agent on 2/17...Spent 2020 with SF and went 4-3 with a 4.37 ERA (59.2ip/29er) in 13 games (11 starts).
<b>vs. WASHINGTON:</b> 1-0 with a 4.29 ERA (21.0ip/10er) in four career starts (his teams have won all four of his starts)...His last outing against the Nats came on 4/22/19 as a member of the Rockies where he allowed five runs in 3.0 innings in a no-decision...Scattered four hits over 7.2 shutout innings while winning a 12-0 decision on 9/30/18 at Coors Field.
